

Atlantic City Man Sentenced on Two Separate Burglaries

MAYS LANDING, NJ – On Friday, August 29, 2025, Angel Ortiz-Caraballo, 56, from Atlantic City NJ, was sentenced to by the Honorable Joseph Levin, J.S.C., to three years in New Jersey State Prison on two counts of third-degree burglary.

On June 14, 2024, Atlantic City Police Officers responded to 1617 Madison Avenue in reference to a male inside of the caller's parked car. When police arrived, they observed Ortiz-Caraballo walking away from the caller's car holding items belonging to the victim. Police arrested Ortiz-Caraballo on scene.

On April 6, 2025, Ortiz-Caraballo entered A Dam Good Sports Bar in the Tropicana casino after business hours and used a tool to pry open the liquor storage cage, causing approximately \$400 in damages. He then unlawfully took liquor bottles worth approximately \$800. Atlantic City Police Officers arrested Ortiz-Caraballo on scene.

On April 25, 2025, Ortiz-Caraballo pled guilty to the above burglaries. The court declined to release Ortiz-Caraballo pending sentencing.
