Somers Point Man Charged with Sexual Assault of Child Victim, Child Pornography and Additional Offenses

On Sunday, March 29, 2026, Shaun M. Stubbins, 43, of Somers Point, NJ, was arrested on charges of first-degree aggravated sexual assault of a victim under the age of 13, first-degree permitting a child to engage in pornography, second-degree photographing a child in a sex act, second-degree endangering the welfare of a child by sexual act, third-degree showing obscenity to a minor, and fourth-degree criminal sexual contact. The charges stem from reported incidents involving multiple victims from 2014 to 2025.

An ongoing investigation found that over a period of over ten years, Stubbins allegedly committed multiple sexual acts against multiple victims under the age of 13. He is also alleged to have created and possessed child sexual abuse material (CSAM), otherwise known as “child pornography.”

Stubbins was arrested by officers of the Somers Point Police Department and is presently lodged in the Atlantic County Justice Facility, where he is pending a detention hearing.

Stubbins is employed as a pre-kindergarten teacher’s aide at Woodbine Elementary School.

The investigation was conducted by the Somers Point Police Department with the assistance of the Atlantic County Prosecutor’s Office Special Victims Unit.
