

Atlantic City Man Pleads Guilty to Conspiracy to Commit Burglary

MAYS LANDING, NJ – On Thursday, September 3, 2026, Kevin Thomas, 31, of Atlantic City, NJ, pleaded guilty to third-degree conspiracy to commit burglary before the Honorable Daniel Kurkowski, J.S.C. The plea calls for a recommended sentence of three years in New Jersey State Prison.

On March 31, 2026, the Atlantic City Police Department was dispatched to the Ocean Casino in reference to a vehicle burglary on the fourth floor of the parking garage. Surveillance footage from the incident showed Thomas acting as a lookout as his co-defendant, Adam Ross, 35, also from Atlantic City, rummaged through the vehicle and stole several items valued in excess of \$500.00. Thomas admitted to being the lookout for the burglary during his guilty plea.

Sentencing is scheduled for October 13, 2026.

Ross' case is still pending.
