NORMAL REFUSE COLLECTION

Normal refuse collection occurs on Monday and Tuesday and recycling occurs on Thursday and Friday. Residents provide their own trash receptacles and the Village provides recycling bins. All trash needs to be bagged within any receptacles, as the trash is collected manually. Trash should be normal household trash and not bulk items, furniture, yard debris, etc. A trash and recycling schedule can be found on our website.

HOLIDAYS

When a holiday occurs on Monday, our refuse pickup occurs on Tuesday and Wednesday. Recycling occurs on the normal days.

When a holiday occurs on Tuesday, refuse pickup normally scheduled for Tuesday will occur on Wednesday. Every other day remains unchanged.

When a holiday occurs on Thursday, the recycling pickup normally scheduled for Thursday will occur on Wednesday. Every other day remains unchanged.

When a holiday occurs on Friday recycling pick up occurs Wednesday and Thursday. Refuse is collected on the normal days during the week.

The following Holidays are observed:

New Year's Day*	Independence Day*
Martin Luther King Jr. Day	Labor Day
Presidents Day	Thanksgiving Day
Memorial Day	Christmas Day*

*if the holiday falls on a Saturday, it will be observed on Friday; if it falls on Sunday, it will be observed on Monday.

RECYCLE GUIDELINES

Lucas County collects our recycling materials – we must follow their recycling rules. See the Keep Toledo/Lucas County Beautiful website for recycling of other materials.

Plastics – Numbers 1, 2, 4, 5, 7	Cleaned and in recycling bin
Aluminum & Bi-Metal Cans	Cleaned and in recycling bin
Glass Bottles and Jars	Cleaned and in recycling bin
Cardboard Boxes	Broken down, bundled or placed in another cardboard box
Newspapers	Placed in paper grocery sack or tied with string or duct tape
Magazines	Placed in paper grocery sack or tied with string or duct tape

- Plastics, aluminum and glass can be co-mingled in the recycle bin
- Removing labels is not necessary but please remove all caps
- Items such as window glass, mirrors, and light bulbs are unacceptable for recycling.
- Don't over stuff grocery bag



LARGE BOX PICK UPS ON WEDNESDAYS

On Wednesdays residents can schedule a pick up of large cardboard boxes. This is intended for moving containers or other large boxes - you don't need to flatten or bundle these boxes for pick up.

BULK ITEM PICK UP

The Village coordinates a monthly Bulk Item Pick Up fee service. Details, dates, pricing and sign up for this service can be found on the website.

YARD WASTE

Due to landfill restrictions, the Village does not pick up grass clippings or other yard waste. Yard waste may be taken to various yard waste recyclers, the closest being **Clean Wood Recycling** located at 6505 W. Bancroft (between Holland-Sylvania and McCord Road). This facility allows drop-off of yard waste including leaves, grass clippings, branches (less than 6 feet in length), shrubbery, wood chips, tree trunks (less than 10" in diameter). The Village coordinates a subscription yard waste pick up program with a private contract. Check the website to sign up for this service.

For your convenience biodegradable paper yard waste bags are sold at the Village Offices during regular business hours. You can purchase any yard waste bags for the yard waste program.

LEAF PICK UP

The Village has a fall curbside leaf pickup program. Leaves are collected at the curb, but the leaf piles cannot contain limbs or other materials which will damage our leaf equipment. The leaves are taken to a compost facility.

CHRISTMAS TREES PICK UP

Christmas trees are picked up at the curb for several weeks following the holiday.
