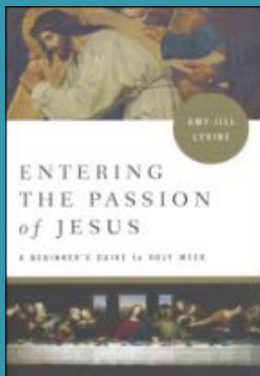

***Weigh in to Defend SNAP**

On February 1, the Trump Administration proposed a rule that would restrict states' flexibility to provide nutrition assistance to people who struggle to put food on the table. In effect, this rule will eliminate Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits over 10 years. The proposed rule is **currently open for public comment until April 2, 2019.** [Review Here](#)

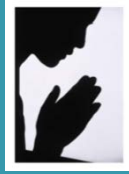
What are Phishing Scams and how to protect yourselves from them

If you are not sure, reach out to the sender by other means, phone call or text. Don't act impulsively. Always send personal and financial information from your own personal computer on your own personal Wi-Fi. If you receive any scam emails, before deleting forward it to the Federal Trade Commission at spam@uce.gov.

Important Insurance Informational Meeting

As you know Western PA residents have a challenging situation with the regards to health care. The consent decree between UPMC and Highmark ends June 30, 2019. Unless something changes by then, this will create disruption for many residents, and in particular PCUSA pastors and staff members who work at PCUSA employers who are covered by Blue Cross Blue Shield. By now you should have received a communication from the Board of Pensions about these significant changes. If not, please contact the presbytery office for a copy of that communication. **In addition there will be an information session held on April 9th from 10:30 – noon at the Pittsburgh Presbytery Center 901 Allegheny Ave, Pittsburgh. You are encouraged to attend, or access the information afterwards, for further insight.** Your inattention to this conversation could have significant negative impact on your finances if you are not prepared for it.
