Liabilities for uncertain tax positions are measured based upon the largest amount of benefit that is greater than 50% likely of being realized upon settlement. The guidance on accounting for uncertainty in income taxes also addresses de-recognition, classification, interest and penalties on income taxes, and accounting in interim periods. With a few exceptions, The Endowment is no longer subject to income tax examinations by the U.S. federall, state or local tax authorities for years before 2017. Management has evaluated the Endowments tax positions and has concluded that the Endowment has taken no uncertain tax positions that require adjustment to the consolidated financial statements to comply with the provisions of this guidance.

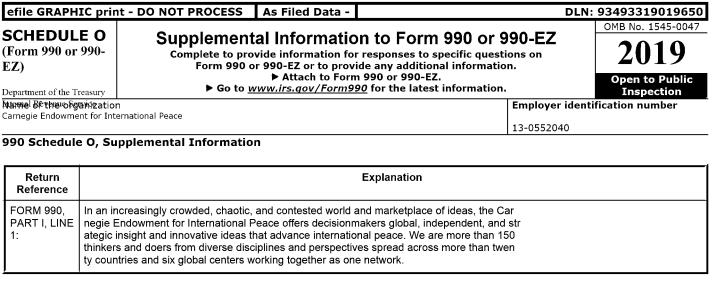
