For the two Associate Directors' salaries, the Director, along with the HR manager, prepares a memo for the Board, again with data for comparable positions at similar institutions, and the Director makes a recommendation on the salary increase for each of these positions. The Compensation Committee of the Board, which is comprised of independent persons, reviews the recommendations and determines the action to be taken. The Committee documents its decision on all three positions in writing to the Human Resources Officer. Investment Office The Institute participates in a survey annually conducted by Mercer for investment offices of foundations and universities. The survey provides wages and benefits (including incentive structures) for key investment office personnel at institutions with endowments comparable in size and complexity to the Institute. The Associate Director for Finance and Administration, in consultation with the Director and the HR Manager, prepares a set of recommendations for review by the Compensation committee in conjunction with the Investment Committee of the Board of Trustees. The results are communicated in writing by a member of the Compensation Committee to the Associate Director.
