AS WELL AS UNIQUE PROGRAMS OF PUBLIC AND PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION, CLINICAL TRIALS AND CANCER RESEARCH. DURING JULY 1, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020, THE CANCER PROGRAMS SCREENED 5,688 PEOPLE AT 200 FREE CANCER SCREENING EVENTS FOR BREAST, PROSTATE, ORAL, COLON AND SKIN CANCERS. SINCE 2002, OVER 95,000 PEOPLE THROUGHOUT SOUTHEAST LOUISIANA HAVE BEEN SCREENED FOR CANCER AT NO COST TO PARTICIPANTS. 




