  - Serving as the Hands and Feet of Christ by supporting effective strategies at Lutheran churches and church-affiliated organizations to meet the basic short-term needs of disadvantaged people, and to create pathways toward greater self-sufficiency and empowerment for all people
- Seminary Financial Aid for non-traditional paths to ordination.
- o Pastoral Leadership Development continuing education for ordained pastors.

### **Grant Cycles**

Siebert has two grant cycles per calendar year, which we call Spring and Fall based on when the grant decisions are made by our Board of Directors. - 3. If applicable, submit a Letter of Inquiry (LOI)

# o Online Application Tips

- We suggest you develop your grant application in Word first, in order t outilize the built-in spell check fuction and to also count characters to comply with character/word count limits. After you have completed the application, you can cut and paste from Word into the online grant application fields. Utilize the grant application question PDFs listed above for the application process that is applicable to your program/project.

# 5. Decision Making and Notification

- o The Board of Directors make funding decisions based on the schedule in the table above.
- o Foundation staff will advise in writing of the Board's decision regarding your application.
- o If approved, you are required to sign and return the Foundation's Grant Agreement prior to distribution of funds.

# 6. Outcomes Reporting

- After a grant request is approved and funds disbursed, the organization is required to report on progress toward expected results.
- O A final outcomes report will be required at completion of the project. In some instances, interim reports during the lifetime of the project will also be required. This will be detailed in the terms of the Grant Agreement. These reports are completed in the grant application website. Access it via the Apply Now page, clicking the "Login" button.
- An organization may only have one Siebert Lutheran Foundation grant working each year.
   However, in special circumstances, permission is given to submit a proposal for a new project or program. Follow-up reports must be submitted prior to applying for new funding.
