To ensure a community for children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of Holocaust Survivors where we can safeguard the importance of connecting, remembering and sharing our collective and individual histories, and teach present and future generations about intolerance and indifference, and inspire righteousness and respect. This group joins

our other speakers and provides presentations in schools across Minnesota and the Dakotas educating audiences about prejudice, hate and discrimination. 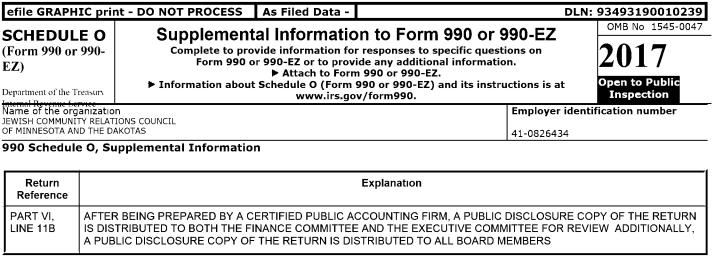

PART III, LINE 4D	JCRC SPEAKERS BUREAU - Our group of dedicated volunteers gave nearly 500 presentations this past year, making it one of the most active grassroots programs of its kind in the United States Our audiences include organizations such as churches, schools, synagogues, and civic groups. It has been recognized internationally as a best practice. The two signature presentations are "Israel and the Middle East. The Challenge of Peace" is an educational presentation. In PowerPoint format focused on clear, meaningful goals to maximize learning about the Arab-Israeli conflict that is balanced and thought provoking. The dedicated volunteers share a multimedia presentation that outlines key facts, history, geography and cull ture underlying the current state of affairs between Israelis, Arabs and Palestinians. "Ju daism On One Foot an Introduction to Jewish Beliefs and Practice" uses PowerPoint and per sonal ritual objects to explain the beliefs, values, and religious traditions upon which the Jewish faith is based Participants learn about the diversity of Jewish observance and how Jews express their faith in their everyday lives. JUSTICE SQUARED - Since 1996, Justice Squared (J2) has mobilized the Jewish community to combine social justice advocacy and community service to improve the lives of Minnesotas children, youth, and families. By bringing a Jewish voice and perspective to todays most challenging issues, J2s social action work helps shape public policy, protect civil rights, and improve the quality of life for all citizens including youth, new immigrants, and those experiencing poverty. In 2018, the JCRC accomplished this work primarily through its collaboration with other organizations, including A Minnesota Without Poverty and the Jont Religious Legislative Coalition.
