STATEWIDE FOOD RECOVERY AND DISTRIBUTION: The Great Plains Food Bank (GPFB) is the only food bank serving the state of North Dakota and Clay County, Minn. Our mission is to end hunger through community partnerships. During FY20, the Great Plains Food Bank served 14.4 million meals to over 135,000 people struggling with hunger; 37% were children and 14% were seniors. The GPFB's core business is to recover surplus shelf-stable and perishable food that would otherwise go to waste, and get it into the hands of hungry children, seniors and working parents. The GPFB works with hundreds of FOOD DONORS (grocers, manufacturers, growers, retailers and

The GPFB serves nearly 200 partner agencies (food natures, shelters, soun kitchens, and other charitable feeding programs operating) in 95 communities, who are on the front lines providing food to those in peed. Direct

pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and other charitable feeding programs operating) in 95 communities who are on the front lines providing food to those in need. Direct Service Programs like the Mobile Food Pantry, Senior Food Box Program and the BackPack Program, allow the GPFB to get food to people in need through a variety of targeted programs. VOLUNTEERS are the backbone of our operation. Their service enables us to distribute food efficiently. More than 5,000 VOLUNTEERS share nearly 20,000 hours' worth of time at GPFB, repackaging bulk items, packing food packages, handing out food, or sorting food drives items. The GPFB is supported by thousands of FINANCIAL DONORS who keep our organizational operational. For every \$1 donated, the GPFB can distribute food for 3 meals. We rely on COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS in every corner of the state to help us design and implement community-based services that tackle both the immediate and long-term root causes of hunger. And finally, we collaborate with our CLIENTS by regularly seeking their guidance and feedback to improve services, reduce barriers, and adapt programs to better meet their needs.Our COVID-19 response started in March 2020. As food donations declined, we had to purchase truckloads of food to meet the growing food needs. We hired temporary staff to tackle additional food deliveries, distributions, and enhanced cleaning/sanitizing practices. We also invested in our physical infrastructure to ensure safe storage and handling

CHILD HUNGER PROGRAMS: The Great Plains Food Bank operates a trio of programs aimed at eradicating childhood hunger. These programs include the BackPack, Youth Summer Meals and School Pantry Programs. The BackPack Program is the cornerstone of the GPFB's suite of programs directly targeting childhood hunger. Each year, more than 33.000 kids qualify for and greatly rely on the free and reduced cost school lunch program. But on the weekends when the school lunch program is not available, many

The BackPack Program provides a bag full of kid-friendly food to children for the weekend, ensuring children return to school Monday morning healthy and ready to learn. The School Pantry Program is a simply a food pantry located in a school, ensuring families and youth in need of assistance have easy access to food and other necessities. In FY20, the GPFB was able to provide nearly 47,000 meals to over two dozen schools. The Youth Summer Meals program is designed to feed low-income children over the summer, when they don't have access to school meals. The GPFB operates meals sites in low-income neighborhoods to provide well-balanced, nutritious meals to any child under age 18, free of charge.
