K-12 EDUCATION - THE RCF EDUCATION TEAM SUPPORTS OVER 150 SCHOOLS AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS PREDOMINANTLY IN THE AREA OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION, PARENT EDUCATION, SCHOOL LEADERSHIP, COLLECTIVE IMPACT, NEW SCHOOL CREATION AND SCHOOL TRANSFORMATION. THE MAJORITY OF EDUCATION FUNDING GOES TO THE FORT WORTH-DALLAS METROPOLITAN AREA WITH A FEW GRANTS GOING TO NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS. THE RCF EDUCATION TEAM'S DIRECT ACTIVITIES INCLUDE PROVIDING LEADERSHIP AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FOR TEACHERS, NON-PROFIT AND SCHOOL LEADERS.
