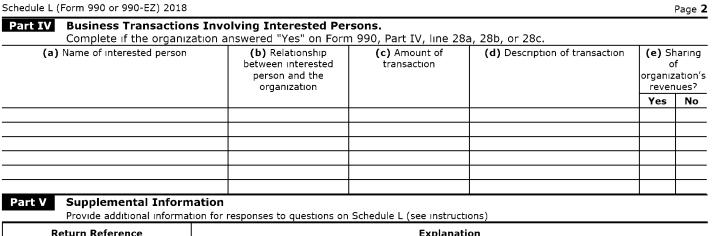

The Associate Vice President for Human Resources also collects and analyzes published compensation data from peer group institutions, local surveys, and the other members of the Claremont Colleges for each senior administrator and other key employee positions. The Vice President for Finance and Administration reviews the data. Then, it is forwarded to the President and Board Chair along with performance evaluations and salary recommendations. After review and discussion, compensation is determined and approved for each senior administrator and other key employees.
