- This Hebrew letter is mostly used as a prefix in Hebrew writings, i.e. and, but, also, now, etc.

- vs 41 – “Also let come to me...”

- vs 42 – “So shall I have...”

- vs 43 – “And not...”

- vs 44 – “So shall I keep...”

- vs 45 – “And I will walk...”

- vs 46 – “And I will speak...”

- vs 47 – “And I will delight myself...”

- vs 48 – “And I will life up...and I will meditate”

- Pictured like a nail
- A connecting letter
- Gen 1.1 = “heavens and (וְאֶת) earth”

- 41 Let Your mercies come also to me, O LORD—Your salvation according to Your word.
- 42 So shall I have an answer for him who reproaches me, For I trust in Your word.
- 43 And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth, For I have hoped in Your ordinances.
- 44 So shall I keep Your law continually, Forever and ever.
