- 98 You, through Your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; For they are ever with me.
- 99 I have more understanding than all my teachers, For Your testimonies are my meditation.

- 100 I understand more than the ancients **aged**,
Because I keep Your precepts.
- 101 I have restrained my feet from every evil
way, That I may keep Your word.
- 102 I have not departed from Your judgments,
For You Yourself have taught me.

- 118 You reject all those who stray from Your statutes, For their deceit is falsehood.
- 119 You put away all the wicked of the earth like dross ^{*slag, refuse}; Therefore I love Your testimonies.
- 120 My flesh trembles for fear ^{*awe} of You, And I am afraid of Your judgments.
