2 Timothy 2:15, NASB
 - Consider Paul’s instructions to the church in Ephesus. ***Eph 4:11-16***

The Benefits of a Gospel Meeting

- Helps All Members to...
 - Grow in faith and trust. ***Romans 10:17***
 - When we assemble together, we hear the word of God. ***Cf. 2 Timothy 2:2***
 - Learning what God has done should cause our faith to grow. ***Cf. Hebrews 11:1-3, 6***
 - Learning the outcome of our faith should cause our faith to grow. ***Hebrews 12:1-2***

The Benefits of a Gospel Meeting

- Helps All Members to...
 - Grow in living godly.
 - Paul told Titus to teach that “*we should live soberly, righteously, and godly.*” **Titus 2:11-14;**
 - Follow Peter’s pattern of growth. **2 Peter 2:5-11**

The Benefits of a Gospel Meeting

- Helps All Members to...
 - Be edified or built up.
 - The worship service is designed to build us up, to make us stronger. **1 Corinthians 14:5, 12, 26**
 - When we come together to worship the Lord, we can provoke or “incite” others to love and to good works. **Hebrews 10:24-25**
