  - Paul referred to Jesus as the “*the King of kings and Lord of lords.*” **1 Tim 6:15**

**Jesus Is King of Kings**

# Jesus Is King of Kings

- **Jesus is reigning as King of kings.**
  - God has highly exalted Jesus. ***Phil 2:5-11***
  - Jesus reigns with a scepter of righteousness.  
***Heb 1:8-12***
  - Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father.  
***Heb 1:13; cf. Psa 110:1-2; Matt 22:43-44***
  - Jesus will continue to reign until He has put all enemies under His feet. ***1 Cor 15:23-28***

# Jesus Is King of Kings

- **Jesus is reigning as King of kings.**
  - Paul declares Jesus to be King of kings.  
***1 Tim 6:15-16***
  - Revelation depicts Jesus as the King of kings. ***Rev 19:11-16. cf. Rev 17:14.***

**Let Us Be Subject To Our King**

# Let Us Be Subject to Our King

- Our King has all authority on heaven and on earth. ***John 17:1-2; Matt 28:18***
- Our King can sympathize with our weaknesses. ***Heb 4:14-16***
- The words of our King will judge us. ***John 12:47-50***
- Our King is the “*author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him.*”  
***Heb 5:7-11***

# Conclusion

- **If Jesus is your King then . . .**
  - Submit unto His reign.
  - Honor Him as King.
  - Obey all His commands.
  - Do not revolt against Him.
  - Worship Him in humility and holiness.
