



---

- ❖ A Jew born in Alexandria.
- ❖ “an eloquent man.”
- ❖ “mighty in the Scriptures.”

- ❖ Speaking in the synagogue
- ❖ Aquila and Priscilla took him aside
- ❖ “vigorously refuted the Jews publicly”

# APOLLOS: THREE LESSONS

## ❖ LISTEN, as did Apollos.

- Consider Judah's sin. ***Zech 7:8-12***
- Listen so we do not drift. ***Heb 2:1-4***
- Continue in what we have heard.

***1 Tim 4:16***

# APOLLOS: THREE LESSONS

## ❖ CHANGE, as did Apollos.

- The 5000. *Acts 3:19-21; 4:1-4*
- God commands everyone to repent (change). *Acts 17:30-31*
- To change, we must follow. *John 8:12*

# APOLLOS: THREE LESSONS

## ❖ TEACH, as did Apollos

- He refuted the Jews. *Acts 18:27-28*
- He continued to teach. *1 Cor 3:5-6*
- We must teach. *Matt 28:19; Mk 16:15*
- Give an answer. *1 Pet 3:15; Heb 5:12*
