 - Paul referred to this as being *“made alive together with Christ.” Eph 2:4-7*

- Is Promised to the Faithful.
 - Jesus is the “firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.”
1 Cor 15:20-21; cf. Acts 26:23

The Resurrection of Life...

- Is Promised to the Faithful.
 - In Christ all shall be made alive.
1 Cor 15:22-28
 - Paul wrote, *“For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.”* ***1 Cor 15:22***
 - The order: Christ the first fruits. Afterward, those who are Christ’s at His coming.

- Is Promised to the Faithful.
 - The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption.

1 Cor 15:42-49

- *“It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in **glory**.”*
- *“It is sown in weakness, it is raised in **power**.”*
- *“It is sown a natural body, it is raised a **spiritual body**.”*

 - The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption.

- *“And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, **we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.**” vs 49*

The Resurrection of Life...

- Is Promised to the Faithful.
 - The mystery of the resurrection.
1 Cor 15:50-58
 - Flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God. ***vs 50***
 - All the faithful will be changed. The corruptible must put in incorruption. ***vs 51-56***
 - God gives us victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. ***vs 57-58***
