The End of a Dynasty

- ❖ The end of David's dynasty came around 586 B.C.
 - God's people did not remain obedient.
 - Israel - carried off into Assyrian captivity in 722 B.C.
 - Judah – the Babylonian captivity began around 605 B.C.

The End of a Dynasty

- ❖ The Babylonian influence began around 605 B.C.
 - King Jehoiakim submitted to Nebuchadnezzar.
 - He later rebelled.
 - The Babylonian army marched against Jerusalem.
 - Jehoiakim died either during or just before the siege on Jerusalem began.

The End of a Dynasty

- ❖ The Babylonian influence began around 605 B.C.
 - Jehoiachin succeeded his father around 598 B.C.
 - Jehoiachin reigned for three months and ten days.
 - Jehoiachin surrendered in 597 B.C. He was taken captive to Babylon along with his family and 10,000 others. **2 Kings 24:8-12**

❖ The fall of Jerusalem, ca. 586 B.C.

- King Nebuchadnezzar appointed Zedekiah, Jehoiachin's uncle, king over Judah. **2 Kings 24:17**

The End of a Dynasty

❖ The fall of Jerusalem, ca. 586 B.C.

- Zedekiah would reign for 11 years, from 597 to 586 B.C.

- City Jerusalem sieged in 588 B.C.
- Jerusalem was destroyed in 586 B.C.

- ❖ Nebuchadnezzar's dream, ca. 604-603 B.C.
 - The breakdown: ***Dan 2:31-45***
 - Head of Gold: Babylonia - 605 B.C.
 - Chest & Arms of Silver: Medo-Persia - 539 B.C.
 - Belly & Thighs of Bronze: Greece - 330 B.C.
 - Legs of Iron: Rome - 63 B.C.
 - Feet of Clay: Rome - 63 B.C.

Promises of Future Restoration

- ❖ Nebuchadnezzar's dream, ca. 604-603 B.C.
 - The breakdown: ***Dan 2:31-45***
 - Great Stone: Kingdom of God - 33 A.D.
 - *"And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed..." Dan 2:44*
 - *"...it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever." Dan 2:44*

Promises of Future Restoration

- ❖ Jeremiah's prophecy, ca. 598 B.C.
 - The Lord would *"raise to David a Branch of righteousness; a King shall reign..."* **Jer 23:5-6**
 - The prophecy may have been written during Zedekiah's reign.

Promises of Future Restoration

❖ Ezekiel's prophecy, ca. 585 B.C.

- The reuniting of Israel and Judah and the anointing of a King. **Eze 37:15-28**
 - God would reunite Israel and Judah. **vs 15-23**
 - God would anoint His servant David as king, shepherd, and prince over His people forever. **vs 24-28**

❖ Zechariah's prophecy, ca. 520-500 B.C.

○ The coming King. ***Zech 9:9-11***

- *“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.” vs 9*

❖ Zechariah's prophecy, ca. 520-500 B.C.

○ The coming King. ***Zech 9:9-11***

• Heard when Jesus entered Jerusalem. ***Matt 21:4-5***

▪ *"All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: Tell the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.'"*
