A Father is . . .

DETERMINED

- “Do not Grow Weary” Principle
 - *Gal 6:8-9*
 - *2 Thess 3:13*
 - The role which God has given fathers is good. Fathers must never grow weary in fulfilling their roles.

A Father is . . .

DETERMINED

- “Run with Endurance” Principle
 - *Heb 12:1-2*
 - Lay aside every weight and sin.
 - Run with endurance.
 - Look unto Jesus, the author and finisher of their faith.

A Father is . . .

ASTUTE

- Definition:
 - Astute – keen discernment, sharpness, being highly observant
 - “having or showing shrewdness and an ability to notice and understand things clearly, mentally sharp or clever...” (m-w.com)

A Father is . . .

ASTUTE

- “Get Wisdom! Get Knowledge”
Principle
 - *Prov 4:5-9*
 - This begins with the fear of the Lord.
Prov 1:1-7
 - Fathers should pray for wisdom to lead their homes. *Cf. James 1:5*
 - Consider the example of Solomon.
1 Kings 3:9

ASTUTE

- “Get Wisdom! Get Knowledge”
Principle
 - Astute fathers are watchful and aware.
 - Astute fathers recognize dangers facing their families.
 - Astute fathers pay attention to the state of their family.

A Father is . . .

DEDICATED

- “We Will Serve the Lord” Principle
 - *Joshua 24:15*
 - A father is dedicated to serving the Lord.
 - A father is dedicated to leading his family in service to the Lord.
 - *Cf. Deut 6:4-9*
