Participants will build vocal strength, physical expressiveness, and ensemble awareness through theatre games, improvisation, and monologue practice, sharpening their ability to tell compelling stories and make bold, fresh choices on stage. The session culminates in a live showcase for friends and family. CAN Academy's performing arts programs foster academic success, empathy, responsibility, and creative thinking which are skills that last a lifetime.
