

Services, Supports and Resources Coordinated by SummitDD

Summit DD SSAs coordinate services and connect people with developmental disabilities to individualized supports, whether they are provided by Summit DD or a private service provider. Below are the various ways that Summit DD connects people to the many paid and natural supports around them.



Summit DD staff will work with individuals and families to administer assessments and collect documentation based on an individual's age to determine eligibility for supports.

Through the Assessment tool, Summit DD SSAs learn about what matters most to each person, helping them to create a person-centered ISP, meaning that all aspects of a person's supports and services are based on what is important to that individual.

Summit DD ensures the health and safety of individuals in a number of ways including provider compliance, QARN, or Quality Assessment Registered Nurse, continued coordination of services and monitoring, and the investigation of any major unusual incidents or unusual incidents.

SSAs use an individual's budget to coordinate and connect individuals to the provider of their choice (Free Choice of Provider) based on his or her personal goals and personal preferences, as outlined in their ISP or IFSP document.

An individual's budget for services is based on a person's assessed needs and disability. Their ISP contains a self-directed budget to pay for services and supports that considers earnings, federal Medicaid dollars (if eligible), and state or local dollars from Summit DD's operating levy. Services Coordination: Summit DD listens to what's important to people and connects them to the right-fit supports and resources such as day programs, community employment services, natural supports, and residential and transportation services. Services are provided by both Summit DD and a network of quality private providers.

Day programs:

Programs focus on community integration, habitation supports, and vocational services, based on each person's unique needs

Employment services:

SSAs help connect people who have employment goals to the resources they need to be successful on their path to employment

Transportation:

Summit DD SSAs connect people to the transportation services that best fit their daily needs, including employment locations or day programs

Residential:

Coordinated through Summit DD SSAs, residential supports are offered by a network of quality providers for adults living in their own communities

Natural Supports:

In addition to the paid supports that a person receives, natural supports, such as family or friends, can help people reach their goals and their ideal life

Professional Services:

Professional services, or wraparound services, are supplementary services based on individual needs that can include treatment services, personal support services or other services that help meet an individual's specific needs
