- Must have an active relationship with Christ.

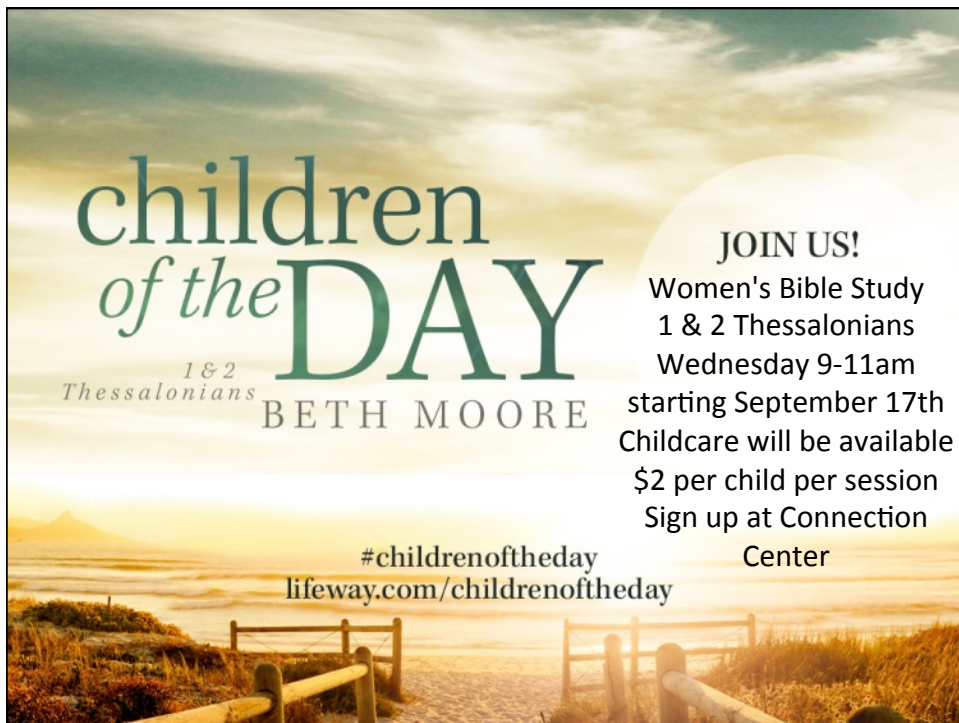
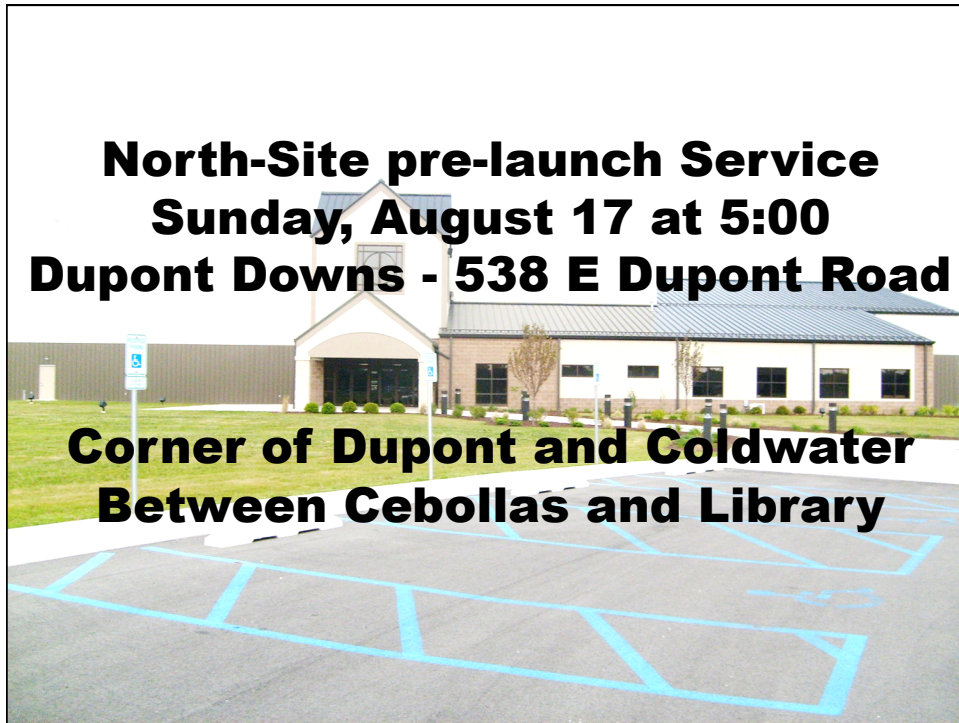


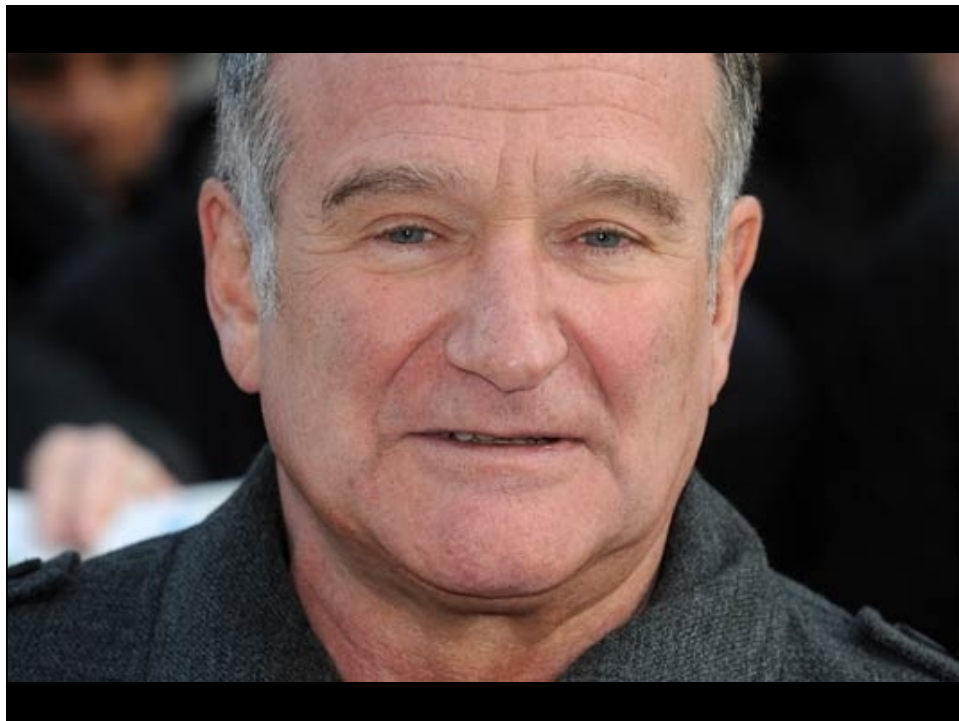

**When inward change doesn't occur and re-occur regularly, the heart eventually grows cold with only an appearance of spirituality.**

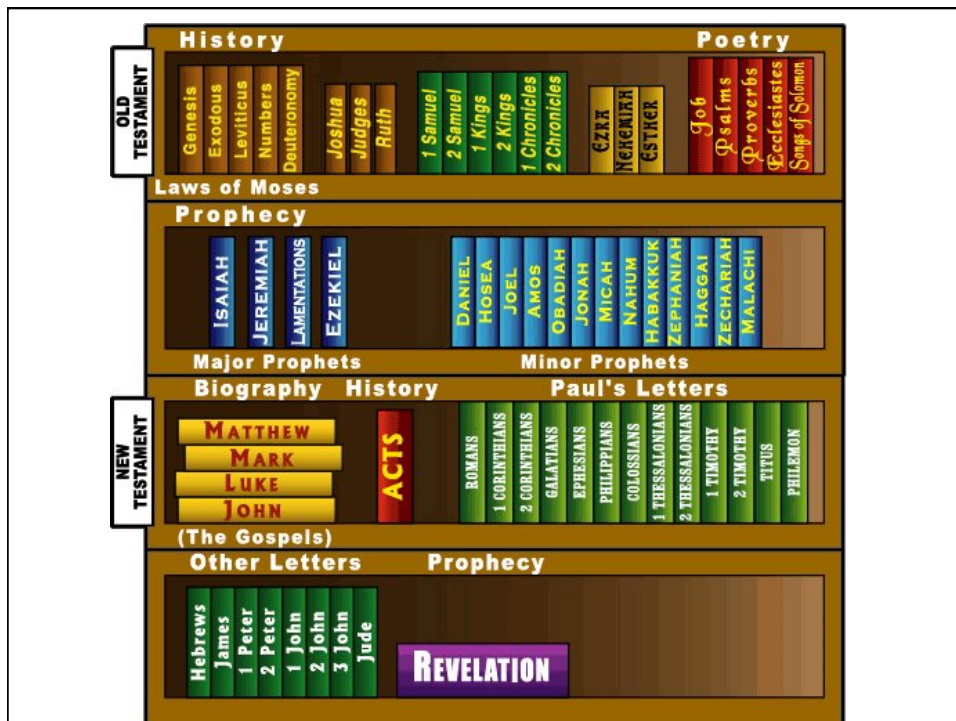

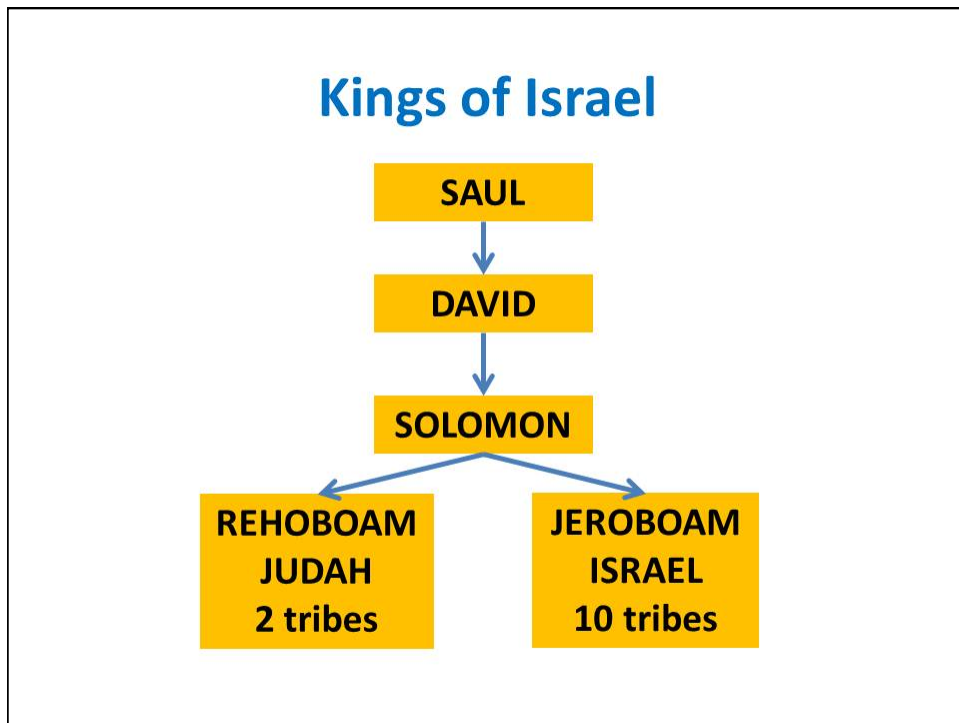

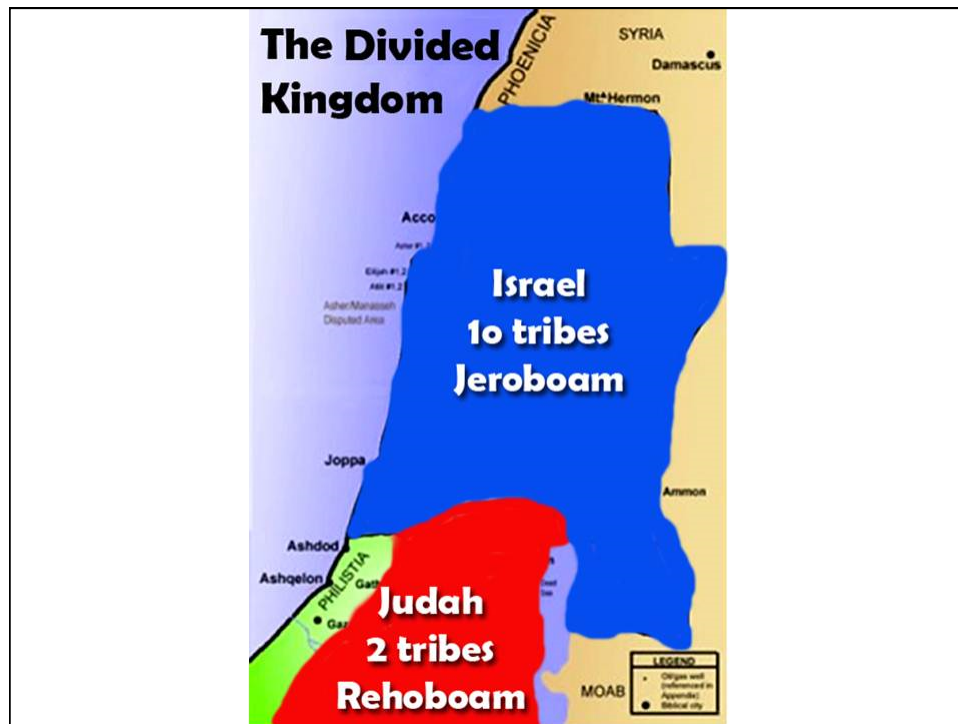
