a. S.50.2020

Some of their items are donated but they also have to pay for some. Glasses, soap, and medications and medical supplies, and teaching children oral hygiene are some more examples of what funds will be used to purchase.

e. S.54.2020

Elder moved for the adoption.

Taylor allotted her time.

The stunt team representatives spoke about how the sport is all female with one volunteer coach. They take girls from different backgrounds. They would like to expand their club up to 40 girls. They can have 36 girls on the team and 4 alternates. They need funding because they have asked the girls for a lot of money for travel, shoes, clothes. The money would be used for the hotel, for gas money, and for their uniforms. The girls would only need to pay for their shoes and apparel which they could keep.

VIII. Presidential Privilege

Michael had a few updates. Monday and Tuesday this week they had a board of trustees meeting. They approved a plan for demolition for the two unused dorms. It will be used for greenspace and potentially housing. Housing and dining were increased by 3%. The 3% was already contractually agreed upon and there was 2% increase to make sure buildings are staying maintained. Bathrooms in Whitehall will be updated. These projects will start next fall. Chem Phys will still be on schedule. There is a proposal going to university senate to propose reading days. It will be on the agenda next semester. If you are a college senator and making it to university senate meetings is an issue for you, you need to chat with him. There

were a lot of people who missed all three meetings. We have 6 senators who will be leaving us at the end of this semester. Have a good break.

Blackstone asked how strong the chances are that the new space will have student living.

Hamilton said it will be structurally and based on how they take down the buildings, the foundation will be able to support halls.

Beecham asked about a lawsuit going on with a student.

Hamilton said they haven't heard anything, but UK is paying the student fees.

Blackstone asked if there was a student voice in deciding if the space was to be used for greenspace or halls.

Hamilton said students have been asking for more greenspace.

Baird asked if they are doing anything with the complex to preserve the foundation.

Hamilton said no, but there are underground utility lines. They will be filling it in rather than putting it on top

Lo asked if there was opportunity to provide opinion on the new space in the student center.

Hamilton said the associate provost, Dr. Turner looped him into conversations and information. It was originally going to be used for a triage service space. It will most likely be predominantly a first-generation student space. Will be a space for everyone but will have space for services to be brought in.

Lo asked if this was close to being finalized.

Hamilton said the third floor will be wanting more input, but the space above the dining hall is pretty finalized.

Lo said on the senate council they said that there was discussion of changing the start date of second semester to Monday instead of Wednesday.

Hamilton said this was in result to a reading day.

Kelly asked if it will be for the fall as well.

Hamilton said it won't be for the upcoming semester, it will be for the next academic year or the next.

Farmer was wondering if the board gave reasons for 3-3.2% increases.

Hamilton said when he asked the question, they said in our contract with EDR they can request up to a 4% increase. We have to honor the request or we have to compound it in the future. We wanted to pace the increase.
