SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

DANCE POLICY:

Students of St. Henry District High School and their guests attending a dance sponsored by any SHDHS organization shall abide by the following dance policy. Our goal is not to entirely restrict the generation's style of dancing but to eliminate inappropriate and/or sexually suggestive movements that have been deemed inappropriate by the administration of the school. Examples of such dancing are inappropriate touching and/or inappropriate bodily contact with one another. On-sight administrative representatives, such as an adult chaperone or the sponsoring organization's moderators, will initially confront any dancing that is contrary to the Christian/Catholic standards upheld by the school. Also, any actions on the dance floor that may cause physical harm to the students will not be tolerated. If the verbal warning is ignored or the student gives an inappropriate response, further consequences and formal disciplinary action may be initiated.

DRESS POLICY:

Females

- The neckline of the dress should be modest, which means no cleavage shows.
- The back of the dress needs to be appropriately contoured and modest and cannot dip below the natural waistline.
- No midriff cut-outs or bare midriffs will be permitted. Cut-outs may not extend past the midline of the body on the side, including those covered by mesh. Dresses with cut-outs in the front may be altered by sewing matching fabric under the cut-out area; however, the fabric may not be flesh-tone.
- Slits in a dress can be no higher than 4" above the knee.
- Length of dress can be no shorter than 4" above the knee when standing up, and should not ride up while walking or dancing.
- If clothing is altered after a student has entered the dance, the student will be asked to leave.

Males

- Males must wear dress pants, shirt, and a tie. No jeans and no ball caps are permitted.

NOTE: *It is up to SHDHS students to inform their dates of the dress code policy for the dance ahead of time. Guests must abide by the same dress code.*

Coat racks will be provided at the dance.

DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY:

Any student under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol or in possession of drugs or alcohol while at a school-sponsored event is in violation of the school's drug and alcohol policy. SHDHS reserves the right to test or breathalyze students for drugs and/or alcohol at school-sponsored events.

- Law enforcement officers may be on duty to breathalyze anyone at anytime for any reason. If a student is in violation of the drug & alcohol policy, parents will be called to pick up the student. Additional consequences may be given by school administration.
- No water bottles or drinks may be brought into the dance. All drinks will be provided.
- SHDHS retains the right to search anyone asking to be admitted to the dance.
