During the 2020-2021 school year, a 10-point grading scale was implemented by the Diocese of Covington.






## **Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS)**

# Crusader Check & Connect (CCC)

The CCC program at St. Henry District High School is an is an extension of our Multi-Tiered



System of Support (MTSS). This program checks on the well-being of our students through a mutli-disciplinary approach. CCC encourages collaboration among teachers, students, parents, counselors, and mentors. The goal of the program is to take a positive interest in each student and proactively assess their needs. At-risk students are flagged through a weekly screening process and mentors are assigned to help them set goals for improvement and acknowledge positive progress along the way.
