Reached base a season-high 22 straight games... Ranked in the top 80 in the nation in sacrifice flies.
- Rodney Hibler Jr. has recorded 23 multi-hit games (two three-hit games) and seven multi RBI games... Had a season-best 14-game hitting streak... Current streak of 16 games reaching base... Ranked seventh in country in stolen bases and ninth in stolen bases per game... Ranked 29th in the nation in triples and 57th in triples per game.
- Jordan McCladdie has recorded 22 multi-hit games (six three-hit games and one four-hit game) and eight multi-RBI games including one of five-plus... Had a team-high 24 consecutive game streak of reaching base... Had a season-high 12 game hitting streak... Leads the conference in hits... Ranked 11th in the nation in stolen bases and 12th in stolen bases per game... Ranked eighth in the nation in triples and ninth in triples per game.

AMONG THE LEADERS IN STOLEN BASES

- As a team, Jackson State is currently ranked eighth in the nation in stolen bases and ninth in stolen bases per game.
- The Tigers currently have 122 stolen bases on the season and trail just VMI (161), Southern (155), Oakland (149), FDU (146), Bethune-Cookman (138), Northeastern (134), and Wofford (127).
- Individually, Rodney Hibler Jr. is currently seventh in the nation in stolen bases with 32, while Jordan McCladdie is currently 11th with 31 total.

TOP 10 IN THE NATION IN SACRIFICE BUNTS

- Jackson State is currently third in the nation in sacrifice bunts heading into the series with Alabama A&M.
- The Tigers are currently sitting at 57 total and trail just Western Kentucky (68) and Prairie View A&M (58).
- Individually, Sebastian Cabeza is currently 17th in the nation with 10 sacrifice bunts, and is also 23rd in sacrifice bunts per game at 0.21.

WHY NOT ADD TRIPLES TO THE NCAA TOP 10

- Jackson State is currently in the top 10 in triples (24) and triples per game (0.49). They are ranked third in triples and third in triples per game, while also leading the Southwestern Athletic Conference.
- The Tigers trail Wofford (29) and Northern Kentucky (26) heading into the weekend and are tied with Arizona and Oakland.
- Individually, Jordan McCladdie is currently eighth in the nation in triples (six) and ninth in triples per game (0.13), while hitting second in the order.

TIGERS AMONG THE NATION'S BEST AS A TEAM

- Not only does Jackson State rank in the top 10 in the above-mentioned categories, but they are also in the top 50 of several others.
- The Tigers are currently 14th in batting average (.315), 22nd in sacrifice flies (30), and 28th in on-base percentage (.417).
- They are just outside the top 50 in runs (58th) and win-loss percentage (58th).

TIGERS AMONG THE NATION'S BEST AS INDIVIDUALS

- Jackson State has several individuals in the top-50 in the country including Garrett VanDeventer who is third in complete games (three) and 16th in games started (nine).
- Jordan McCladdie is eighth in triples (six), ninth in triples per game (0.13), 11th in stolen bases (31), and 12th in stolen bases per game (0.65).
- Rodney Hibler Jr. is seventh in stolen bases (32), ninth in stolen bases per game (0.67), and 29th in triples (four).
- Myles White is 29th in the nation in triples (four).
- Isaiah Williams is 42nd in the nation in complete games (one) and 38th in the nation in strikeouts (88).
- Sebastian Cabeza is 17th in the nation in sacrifice bunts (17) and 23rd in sacrifice bunts per game (0.21).
- Christian Womble is currently 34th in the nation in saves (seven) entering the weekend.

DOUBLE-DIGIT MULTIPLE HIT GAMES

- Six different players have recorded double-digit hits in games this season, with 17 different players picking up multiple hits in a game this season.
- Rodney Hibler Jr. (23), Jordan McCladdie (22), Joseph Eichelberger (19), Lenny Montesano (17), Myles White (14), and Robert Tate Jr. (11) have each reached double digits.

DOUBLE-DIGIT RBI GAMES

- Jackson State has had 16 different players record multiple RBIs in a game this season, including five with seven or more.

- Lenny Montesano (13), Joseph Eicheberger (nine), Jordan McCladdie (eight), Rodney Hibler Jr. (seven), and Myles White (seven) lead the team in that category this season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT HIT STREAKS

- Jackson State has had four different players reach double-digits in hit streaks this season, including one active streak.
- Rodney Hibler Jr. has recorded the longest streak of the season at 14 and has picked up a hit in back-to-back games. Meanwhile, Lenny Montesano recorded a 13-game hitting streak earlier this season.
- Jordan McCladdie had a 12-game hitting streak snapped earlier this season.
- Joseph Eichelberger, who led the nation in hitting early this season, has recorded a 11-game hitting streak.

REACHED BASE STREAKS, DOUBLE DIGITS

- Jackson State has had eight different players reach double digits in reaching base this season as far as streaks go including one current streak.
- Jordan McCladdie reached base in 24 straight games earlier this season and is on an two-game streak currently, while Lenny Montesano hit 22.
- Joseph Eichelberger (19/current), Myles White (17), Rodney Hibler Jr. (16/current), Robert Tate Jr. (13), Sebastian Cabeza (12), and Ledy Alvarez (10) have all hit double digits.

SWAC CO-HITTER OF THE WEEK (APRIL 9)

- Third baseman Lenny Montesano was named the SWAC co-Hitter of the Week for the week of April 9.
- Montesano finished the week hitting .563 on the week in contests against UAPB and Bethune-Cookman, helping Jackson State split the four games. He hit .615 in three conference games against Bethune-Cookman. He had multiple hits in three of the four games this week with five runs scored and seven RBI.
- He also had four extra-base hits including a pair of home runs in a single game against Bethune-Cookman on Sunday. He went 4-for-6 with three runs scored and six RBI in the series finale against the Wildcats while picking up a pair of hits in each of the first two games of the series including a double in the opener. The junior also collected a triple in non-conference action against UAPB in a mid-week contest.

SWAC CO-HITTER OF THE WEEK (MAY 7)

- Second baseman Myles White was named the SWAC co-Hitter of the Week for his performance against Mississippi Valley State.
- He finished the series hitting .600 in a three-game series that was shifted to Sunday-Monday and to Braddy Field.
- White finished the series going 9-for-15 with a double and a triple in the series sweep.
- He scored four runs and knocked in another eight while slugging .800 and recording an on-base percentage of .625.

SWAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK (MAY 14)

- Erick Gonzalez was named the SWAC Pitcher of the Week after combining with two pitchers for a 5-0 shutout of Bethune-Cookman.
- He worked the first 6.1 innings of the game scattering five hits and striking out four before leaving in the top of the seventh after taking a line drive off the leg.

JOHNSON HELPS OUT WITH TEAM USA ... AGAIN

- Omar Johnson was selected, and served in that role, to assist USA Baseball during the Collegiate National Team training camp for international competition.
- The USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training

Camp featured 56 of the premier non-draft eligible college players for a four-game Stars vs. Stripes intra-squad series in Cary, North Carolina from June 23–29. Johnson coached the Stripes team and help USA Baseball in naming a final, 26-man Collegiate National Team roster that represented the United States in the friendship series against Chinese Taipei and Japan later this summer.

- This is the second straight year Johnson has coached with USA Baseball. Last August, he was a part of the new 13U / 14U Athlete Development Program.

JACKSON STATE IN THE CONFERENCE

- Jackson State has won 17 Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) championship in its history (1968, 1971, 1973, 1977, 1978, 1980, 1982, 1986, 1989, 1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 2000, 2005, 2006, 2021).
- The Tigers have won three conference tournament titles in their history in the conference (2000, 2013, 2014) and have appeared in three NCAA Tournaments - two of those under head coach Omar Johnson.

ONLY SWAC SCHOOL IN THE DRAFT

- Jackson State is the only school in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) that can boast of having players drafted in four major sports.
- The Tigers have had players selected in football, men's basketball, women's basketball, and baseball drafts.

SINCE 1958, SIX COACHES FOR JACKSON STATE

- Since 1958, Jackson State has had just six coaches at the helm of the program.
- Robert Braddy, whom the field is named after, served the longest at 28 years and amassed 811 wins; while Omar Johnson is in year 18.
- A.F. Smith (three years), Robert Hill (one year), W.C. Gorden (two years), and Mark Salter (eight years) have all served as the head coach of the program.

JACKSON STATE ON THE MOUND

- With so much attention to offense, the Jackson State pitching staff has quietly recorded 380 strikeouts as a staff including a team-high 88 by Isaiah Williams.
- Williams has combined with Christian Womble and Garrett VanDeventer to register 52.9 percent of the team's strikeouts.
- In conference play, the Tigers have combined for 177 strikeouts with Williams accounting for 40.
- Je-andrick Lourens and Christian Womble have combinef for 44 total strikeouts in conference play.

SHUTOUT STREAK

- Jackson State had their shut out streak of 45 games dating back to last year (at Bethune-Cookman (5/18/23) in a 5-0 loss) snapped with a 12-0 loss to Florida A&M (4/28/24).
- They were also shut out by No. 22 Louisiana in the last non-conference game (5-0, 5/7/24).

TIGERS AGAINST THE SWAC WEST DIVISION

- Jackson State has played several teams from the SWAC West Division, going 8-1 against those teams.
- The Tigers defeated Alcorn State (four times) and Grambling State (twice). The Tigers could face Grambling State in the conference tournament.
- They also dropped a game to Texas Southern (9-5) in the season opener, a potential first round opponent.

CLINCHING THEIR SPOT IN THE CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

- Jackson State secured its spot in the conference tournament with its 5-0 victory over Bethune-Cookman (5/11/24) just hours before Alabama A&M dropped its second game in the series against Mississippi Valley State the same day that would have locked them in the tournament.
- The Tigers have a chance to move up a spot in the seeding depening on the last regular season series for both them and Alabama State - with just two games separating the two - and both are on the road.

HEAD COACH OMAR JOHNSON

Year after year, Omar Johnson continues to make Jackson State baseball one of the top programs in the Southwestern Athletic Conference.

Since taking the helm of the program prior to the 2007 season, Johnson has led JSU baseball to a winning season every year with 13 30-win campaigns in 17 seasons. In 2022, Johnson earned his 500th win as JSU head coach, joining former JSU head coach and former Athletics Director Robert “Bob” Braddy as the only coaches in program history to surpass 200, 300, 400, and 500 wins. Under Johnson’s leadership, Jackson State has finished with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or better every season.

The current Dean of Southwestern Athletic Conference baseball coaches at one school in his 18th season, Johnson’s Tigers have averaged nearly 32 wins per season, winning seven SWAC Eastern Division titles and two SWAC Championships.

In his first season at the helm of the Tigers program (2007), Johnson posted a 33-23 record, the first of four consecutive 30-win seasons. The following season, 2008, his Tigers recorded 37 wins, at the time the fourth-highest single-season total in program history. During the 2009 season, Johnson became the first JSU baseball coach to reach the 100-win plateau within his first three years.

Johnson led JSU to another string of 30+plus win seasons, as the Tigers posted eight consecutive 30-win seasons from 2012-19. Johnson captured back-to-back Southwestern Athletic Conference titles in 2013 and 2014, going undefeated in the conference tournament and earning NCAA Tournament berths after each title.

During the 2014 NCAA Tournament, JSU knocked off the No. 1 ranked Louisiana Ragin’ Cajuns 1-0 to mark the programs’ and Jackson State’s first Division I NCAA postseason win and the program’s first victory over a No. 1 ranked NCAA team. In 2018, Johnson led JSU to 38 wins, tied for the third highest win single-season win total in program history (52 - 1978; 42 - 1977; 38 - 1981).

In 2021, JSU baseball was ranked the No. 1 team in Black College Nines (BCN) HBCU Baseball large school top ten poll and received votes in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Top 30 poll. Jackson State became only the second conference baseball team to go 24-0 in SWAC play, advancing to the SWAC Tournament finals and finishing the season 34-9.

Last season despite a myriad of injuries, Johnson led the Tigers on the brink of another 30 win season. On April 23, 2022, Johnson posted his 500th career win in a victory of Alabama State.

Prior to coaching at Jackson State, Johnson worked at the University of North Alabama for four years. In 1999, for the first time

in university history, the University of North Alabama won the South Central Regional Championship and appeared in the 1999 NCAA II College World Series. In 2008-2010, Johnson served on the German national team coaching staff, competing in the World Baseball Challenge, World Cup, and European baseball championship, where he received a bronze medal. In 35 years of international competition, this was the first time the German national team placed and in the WBC defeating team USA. Johnson has had the privilege of coaching numerous players who have played professional baseball.

In the summer of 2004, Johnson traveled to serve as a coach with Major League Baseball Envoy program. The Envoy Program sends baseball coaches to teach the fundamentals of the game to players and coaches in countries throughout the world. Johnson says his mission as a head coach is twofold: 1) to win games and 2) to prepare young men to contribute to their families and society positively.

Johnson and his beautiful wife, Kira, have been married for 17 years. They have one lovely daughter, Olivia.
