



Alabama A&M Tailgating – 2026 FAQ

1. How much does tailgating cost for the 2026 season?

Non-Power Tailgate Access Pass — \$1,000

Power Tailgate Access Pass — \$1,500

Spaces are limited and sold on a first-come, first-served basis.

2. What is a Tailgate Access Pass?

A Tailgate Access Pass provides you with a reserved tailgate space for the entire season. This is the only way to secure and maintain a tailgating location for Alabama A&M; home games.

3. What is included with my Tailgate Access Pass?

- 1 A reserved tailgate space for the season
- 2 (1) additional parking pass for the Tailgate Lot
- 3 (2) general admission game tickets for the season

4. When can I check in for tailgating?

Check-in begins Friday at 12:00 PM (Noon), the day before each home game.

5. When do I have to check out?

All tailgaters must clear their space no later than 12:00 PM the day after the game.

6. Can I check in early or stay beyond the deadline?

Early check-in will result in a FINE, and late check-out will result in a FINE and/or towing at the owner's expense—these policies are strictly enforced.

7. Do guests need a game ticket to enter the tailgate area?

Yes. All individuals in the tailgating area must have a valid game ticket. This policy is enforced to maintain a controlled and safe game day environment.

8. Where is tailgating located?

Tailgating takes place in designated areas surrounding Louis Crews Stadium, including the George Jones Tailgate Plaza. Detailed maps and access instructions will be provided prior to each game.

9. Are golf carts, ATVs, or similar vehicles allowed?

No. ATVs, golf carts, and similar vehicles are not permitted on campus unless operated by authorized Alabama A&M; personnel. Violators will be subject to immediate towing at the owner's

expense.

10. What is the Bulldog Collective and why is it included?

The Bulldog Collective plays a key role in supporting Alabama A&M; student-athletes and strengthening our athletic programs.
