### **WHATS AHEAD**

The Zips conclude their first road trip of the 2017-18 Mid-American Conference season when Akron travels to Athens, Ohio to take on Ohio University on Jan. 6, 2018. The Zips and Bobcats are slated to face off at the Convocation Center at 1 p.m.

**SCOUTING THE BOBCATS**The Ohio Bobcats stand 7-6 overall through 13 games, while owning a 1-1 record in league play in week number one.

In the conference opener, the Bobcats took down the defending MAC Tournament champions, Toledo, 78-61, before falling to the preseason favorite to win the 2018 MAC tournament, Central Michigan by a score of 58-82. In the non-conference portion of its schedule, Ohio won four of their first five contests before the teams fifth win over Big Ten Conference opponent, Purdue (77-71).

A trio of Bobcat's lead the offensive efforts for Ohio recording double figure scoring including, Amani Burke (13.1), Cierra Hooks (12.5), and Dominig Doseck (10.5). In addition to leading the team in scoring, Burke is shooting 35-percent from the field, 29-percent from long range, recorded 20 steals, and nine assists. Hooks leads the team in rebounding with 64 total rebounds, 38 defensive boards, and 26 offensive caroms, while averageing 4.9 per contest. The Bobcats point guard, Taylor Agler, owns a team-best 56 assists and 4.3 per game.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

The Zips and Bobcats are scheduled to square off for the 59th time, as Akron and Ohio have battled on the court 58 times in each programs respective history. Since the first meeting in 1976-77, Akron trails in the all-time series history, 18-40, against the Bobcats.

### **THE LAST MEETING**

The University of Akron women's basketball team was unable to maintain its early momentum as the Zips dropped a 62-48 decision at Ohio on March 4, 2017, in the regular season finale for both schools.

Hannah Plybon directed Akron's efforts with a team-high 13 points, while Alex Ricketts and Haliegh Reinoehl each collected a game-high 10 rebounds for the Zips. Quiera Lampkins led the Bobcats with a game-best 14 points. Jasmine Weatherspoon posted a 12-point, 10-rebound effort, while Amani Burke notched 12 points as well.

#### **MID-AMERICAN CONFERENCE MEMBER**

The Zips have been a member of the Mid-American Conference for the past 26 years after joining the league in 1992 from the North Star Conference

#### **COACHES**

- **Ohio:** Bob Boldon is amidst his fifth season as the head coach of the Ohio Bobcats women's basketball program. Boldon led the Bobcats to back-to-back MAC regular season titles (2014-16) and four consecutive postseason appearances.
- Akron: Jodi Kest, the all-time winningest coach in program history, is in her 12th-season in charge of the Zips program. The longest-tenured coach in the Mid-Américan Conference holds an all-time record of 176-180 (.494) at Akron and a 402-333 (.547) in her 25 years as a head coach

### **JODI KEST COACHING TREE**

Ohio's head coach, Boldon, spent five seasons as an assistant coach on Jodi Kest's coaching staff spending one season at Gannon, two seasons at Texas A&M Corpus Christi, and two seasons with the Zips. In two seasons in Texas, Boldin aided Kest in leading the Islanders to a combined 34-21 record in two seasons, while the duo helped start Akron's turnaround into a top competitor inside the MAC.

### **WITH A WIN OVER OHIO THE ZIPS WOULD**

- Earn their seventh win of the 2017-18 season.
- Claim its first MAC win
- Earn the program's 450th all-time victory.
- End a three-game slide.

**2017-18 ZIP BREAKDOWN**Under the guidance of Kest, the Zips have 13 young and talented players eager to make an impact in 2017-18 highlighted by returning starters, sophomore guard **Shaunay Edmonds** (Pittsburgh, Pa.), sophomore forward **Haliegh Reinoehl** (Westfield, Ind.), and sophomore forward **Caitlin Vari** (Revere, Ohio), along with the veteran presence of senior forward **Greta Burry** (Lakewood, Ohio), senior guard **Lauren Hung** (Waterford, Mich.), and redshirt junior guard **Megan Sefcik** (Austintown, Ohio).

Edmonds has taken on the role as the team's facilitator and floor general, while also having the ability to score the ball. Through 13 games, Edmonds is averaging 10.8 points, a team-high 4.2 assists, and 2.4 steals per game. The Zips' point guard scored a season-best 19 points and tied her career mark with seven assists against Youngstown State, while posting a career-best six steals against Harvard.

After coming off the bench in a reserve role during the first 13 games of her freshman season, Reinoehl became a staple in the starting-five down the stretch for Akron and in the 2017-18 season. Reinoehl recorded a career-best game against Southeastern Louisiana (21 pts/11 reb) and a double-double against SIU Edwardsville (11 pts/10 reb). The forward is the team's third-leading scorer, 6.8 points per game and leads the squad in rebounding with 106 total rebounds, 8.2 per contest.

Following a career-best year last season, Sefcik has continued to impress and has scored in double figures in ten of Akron's 13 games. The Zips' guard broke the Akron single-game three-point record with 10 triples against Ohio Christian, while also tying the MAC record. The Zips sharpshooter is averaging a team-best 13.7 points per game and scoring 3.5 triples per contest.

Burry, the Zip with the most playing experience on the roster, is the centerfold of the squad. In 214 minutes of play and 12 starts, Burry is averaging 6.5 points and 4.9 rebounds per tilt. Burry grabbed a season-high 10 rebounds against SLU and scored a season-best 14 points against EKU.

Vari, a member of the Zips front court, has seen 229 minutes of action while grabbing 5.3 rebounds, a team-best 24 offensive rebounds and averages 4.9 points per contest.

### THE NUMBERS ON AKRON BASKETBALL...

Fueled by a program-best 14-4 league record, the Zips captured their first ever MidAmerican Conference Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berth in 2013-14.

Akron has made six postseason appearances in its history, five of which have come in the last eight seasons. In addition to the NCAA Tournament in 2014, the Zips advanced to the WNIT in 2016, 2015, 2013 and 1999, and the Women's Basketball Invitational in 2010.

The Zips have placed a student-athlete on the All-MAC Academic Team 21 times, highlighted by Jessie Crooks (2004-07) and Hannah Plybon (2014-17 making the squad three seasons in a row. A record five student-athletes earned Academic All-MAC recognition in 2012-

The number of wins Akron posted in 2013-14 and 2012-13, which is a program record. The 23 victories two years ago marked a nine-win turnaround from the previous season. 46.6 The number of points that Rachel Tecca and Hanna Luburgh combine to score per game as seniors in 2013-14. Together, the seniors make up the highest scoring duo in the country.

104 The number of three pointers Hannah Plybon connected on during the 2015-16 campaign, a school record.

The number of victories for head coach Jodi Kest at the University of Akron. She is the winningest head coach in Akron women's basketball history.

The number of assists for Kacie Cassell in 2012-13, which ranks third all-time in the Mid-American Conference for a single season. As a junior, she broke UA's single-season assists record after just 21 games, and finished the year as the national leader in assists per game with 7.8.

Sophomores **Alyssa Clay** (Indianapolis, Ind.) and **Shayna Harmon** (Ashville, Ohio) have seen a significant bump in playing time in year two. Harmon has started all 13 contests and owns the second-most assists on the squad (36). Clay has seen 193 minutes of action through 13 contests, which is over double her playing time in 13 games in 2016-17. Clay owns the teams' second-best shooting percentage from beyond the arc (.387, 18-of-45) and scored a career-high 13 points against Duquesnė.

**Freshmen Kynnedy Azubike** (Columbus, Ohio), **Sarah Leyendecker** (Lawrenceburg, Ind.) and **Destiny Perkins** (Indianapolis, Ind.) made their collegiate debuts for the Zips three games into the season and have combined to score 123 points. Perkins has taken over the backup point guard role after returning from injury and has since recorded 28 assists, third-most on the squad.

Kest named Burry, Sefcik, and Reinoehl as the 2017-18 season captains.

- **Destiny Perkins** made her collegiate debut against SELU (Nov. 17).
- Halieigh Reinoehl recorded her first career double-double against SELU (Nov. 17) with a careerbest 21 points and pulled in 11 rebounds, one shy of her career-best.
- Caitlyn Vari recorded 16 rebounds against SELU (Nov. 17), a career-best, beating her previous record of five.
- Alyssa Clay played a then career-high 14 minutes en route to scoring a then career-best eight points.
- **Destiny Perkins** first significant playing time resulted in a 10 point, four assist, and two steal performance against Florida Gulf Coast (Nov. 18).
- Haliegh Reinoehl tied her single-game career-best 12 rebounds against Eastern Kentucky (Nov. 22). The point guard trio of Shaunay Edmonds, Shayna Harmon and Destiny Perkins are averaging a combined 9.2 assists per contest and 119 of Akron's 176 assists.
- The Zips have won the battle on the glass in five of its 13 games.
- In Akron's six wins, the opposition is averaging just 48.5 points per game, a shooting percentage of .300, a three-point percentage of .242, have outrebounded their opponents, 275-to-227, forced 102 turnovers.
- Shaunay Edmonds scored a season-best 19 points against Youngstown State, tied a career-best seven assists, and a season-high four steals.
- Shaunay Edmonds' four triples against YSU are the most she has knocked down in a singlegame in her career.
- Megan Sefcik has now scored in double-figures in nine of the last 11 contests and hit at least three triples in ten contests.
- In the 75-58 win over YSU, **Shayna Harmon** tallied a career-best 10 points.
- Alyssa Clay scored a career-best 13 points with 12 of her points coming from beyond the three-
- point line (4-for-5).

  Sarah Leyendecker tallied eight blocks against Ohio Christian, which puts her tied for second in the program for most blocks in a single-game. Her 11 rebounds against the Trailblazers were also a career-best.
- After tying her career-mark twice, Megan Sefcik surpassed her 20 point career-mark with 32 points against Ohio Christian.
- En route to her 32 points, **Megan Sefcik** hit 10 three-pointers to break the Akron women's basketball single-game record and tied the Mid-American Conference record.
- As a team, Akron recorded 14 triples against Ohio Christian, tied for the second most in a singlecontest by a unit.
- Haliegh Reinoehl recorded her second double-double of the season and her career in the Zips win against SIUE.
- The Zips defense held the opposition in single digits in four of the eight quarters played against Ohio Christian (3) and SIU Edwardsville (1).
- Caitlin Vari registered a new career-high 10 points against Buffalo in the MAC opener, while Shayna Harmon tallied a career-best five assists against the Bulls.
- Akron owns a home record of 72-114 at James A. Rhodes Arena since the 2013-14 campaign.
- The Zips bench has outscored its opponents reserves, 298-to-188, and the Akron subs are averaging a combined 23.1 points per contest.
- Akron is 5-1 when its bench outscores the opposing bench.

### RECORDS ARE MADE TO BE BROKEN

In the Zips 93-33 win against Ohio Christian, **Megan Sefcik** drained ten three-pointers in a single-contest to break the Akron women's basketball program. The record was set a season ago in 2016-17 by Hannah Plybon with nine triples against Canisius on Nov. 20, 2016.

<u>CLIMBING THE CHARTS</u>
Megan Sefcik continues to climb into the list of all-time best three-point shooters in Akron women's basketball program history. Sefcik is now eighth overall in three-pointers made in a career (122) and three-point attempts

### **400 MILESTONE CLUB**

With the Zips 75-58 win over Youngstown State, the all-time winningest coach in Akron history, **Jodi Kest**, earned a historic 400th career victory.

In her 25-year career, Kest earned 48 wins at Wilkes University, 105 victories at Gannon University, 73 W's at Texas A&M – Corpus Christie, and now the longest tenured coach in the MAC earned her 174th win with UA to total her 400th career victory.

Inside the Mid-American Conference, the Zips return the second-youngest squad with 4,964 minutes returning for the 2016-17 campaign. The Akron sophomore class made up nearly half of the minutes amassing over 2,000 minutes of action a season ago, while the upperclassmen saw over 1,200 minutes of the court.

**ZIPS WOMEN'S BASKETBALL DRAFTS BRAYDEN MCDONALD FROM TEAMIMPACT**The University of Akron women's basketball team and head coach **Jodi Kest** announced the signing of **Brayden McDonald** on Nov. 21 The 8-year-old Akron native signed her national letter of intent to join the Zips' women's basketball squad this season.

Team IMPACT, an organization that connects children facing chronic or life-threatening illnesses to college athletic teams in an effort to improve their quality of life, orchestrated Brayden's recruitment with the Akron women's basketball program. Brayden's determination to persevere through adversity has already made her an inspiration to her Zips teammates.

Since 2011, Team IMPACT has matched more than 1,300 children with more than 500 colleges and universities in 47 states, reaching over 35,000 participating student-athletes. The child joins the athletic team and the student-athletes join the child's support team – from Draft Day to Graduation.

Miller, a 5-9 guard, comes from local powerhouse St. Vincent-St. Mary's High School in Akron, Ohio. As a junior, she averaged 10.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 5.0 assists per game. Miller posted seven double-digit scoring efforts in her third season with the Fighting Irish, including a season-high 14 points against Walsh Jesuit.

Neitzel, a 6-1 forward from St. Joseph Academy in Cleveland, Ohio, earned All-District Honorable Mention honors, was named to the Northeast Lakes District team, and earned Cleveland.com All-Star honors. **ZIPS GO WIRE-TO-WIRE WITH TOLEDO BUT FALL SHORT 60-54.**The University of Akron women's basketball team went wire-to-wire with the reigning Mid-American Conference Champions, Toledo, for 40 minutes, but the Rockets were able to pull away down the stretch with a 12-2 run in the final two minutes of the contest to defeat the Zips, 60-54, Wednesday night at Savage Arena in Toledo, Ohio.

Sophomore guard Shaunay Edmonds (Pittsburgh, Pa.) would lead the way in the point column for the Zips and tallied a game-high 13 points. The Akron point guard also dished out a game-best six assists and four steals. Clay was the Zips second-leading scorer with eight points, six of which came from beyond the arc, while sophomore Caitlin Vari (Richfield, Ohio) added seven points and Reinoehl chipped in six points to go along with a team-high 10 rebounds.

#### **ZIPS FALL TO BUFFALO 89-66 IN MAC OPENER**

Redshirt junior guard Megan Sefcik (Austintown, Ohio) scored a team-high 14 points, but it wasn't enough as Akron fell 89-66 to Buffalo in 2017-18 Mid-American Conference opener Saturday afternoon at James A. Rhodes Arena.

The Zips were limited to 34.5-percent shooting on the day, including 7-of-23 (30.8 percent) from beyond the arc. Akron, which had hit six or more 3-pointers in all but two games this season entering the contest, was unable to get on track from long distance.

### HALFTIME DEFICIT TOO MUCH TO OVERCOME AS ZIPS FALL TO HARVARD, 76-63

Harvard jumped out to a 13-point lead at the halftime break that was too much to overcome, as the Akron women's basketball team fell to Harvard, 76-63, on day two of the FGCU Hilton Garden Inn Classic in Fort Myers, Fla.

Redshirt junior Megan Sefick (Austintown, Ohio) and Shaunay Edmonds (Pittsburgh, Pa.) each scored 14 points in the afternoon affair. Sefcik scored 12 of her 14 points from long range (4-for-13), while Edmonds added three assists and a career high six steals in a game. Sophomore forward Haliegh Reinoehl (Westfield, Ind.) grabbed a team-high eight rebounds and scored an additional eight points for the Zips.

### **ZIPS HOLD ON IN FINAL MINUTES TO DROP SIU EDWARDSVILLE, 59-58**

In a game that saw 13 lead changes between the Zips and Cougars, the Akron women's basketball team battled SIŲ Edwardsville down to the wire and came out on top with a 59-58 victory on day one of the Florida Gulf Coast Hilton Garden Inn Classic at the Alico Arena in Fort Myers, Fla.

The Zips (6-4) offensive charge was led by sophomore Haliegh Reinoehl (Westfield, Ind.) and redshirt junior Megan Sefcik (Austintown, Ohio) who each scored in double-figures. Reinoehl went on to record her second double-double of the season and career, scoring 11 points and pulling in 10 rebounds. Sefcik, who has scored in double-digits in eight of the Zips ten games, added a 10 point, two assist, one steal, and one block effort. Sophomore guards Shaunay Edmonds (Pittsburgh, Pa.) and Alyssa Clay (Indianapolis, Ind.) also pitched in eight points each.

### SEFCIK BREAKS AKRON RECORD, RAINS THREE'S, AND ZIPS ROLL TO 93-33 WIN OVER OHIO CHRISTIAN

Redshirt junior guard Megan Sefcik (Austintown, Ohio) broke the Akron women's basketball program record for most three-pointers in a single-game, 10, and scored a career-best 32 points as the Zips rolled to a 93-33 victory over Ohio Christian at James A. Rhodes Arena Saturday evening.

Sefcik found herself with the hot hand going 11-of-19 from the floor, with 10 of her made field goals coming from beyond the arc, which broke the program record. The Zips guard surpassed the previous record which was set a season ago by Hannah Plybon when she hit nine triples in a win against Canisius on Nov. 20, 2016. To go along with breaking a school record, Sefcik also tied the Mid-American Conference record for three-pointers in a single-game and beat her previous career-mark of 20 points with her 32 points, two rebound, two assists, two blocks, and two steal performance.

All 11 players that saw minutes on the court for the Zips contributed to Akron's 93 total points. Three Akron players led the way for the Zips balanced offensive attack scoring in double-figures, including a career-night for Clay scoring 13 points after going 4-5 from the floor, nailing all four of her baskets from beyond the arc. KEST EARNS 400TH CAREER WIN IN 75-58 VICTORY OVER YOUNGSTOWN STATE AKRON, Ohio- Redshirt junior Megan Sefcik (Austintown, Ohio) and sophomore Shaunay Edmonds (Pittsburgh, Pa.) scored a combined 39 points to lead the Akron women's basketball team to a 75-58 win over Youngstown State and earned head coach Jodi Kest her 400th career victory, Tuesday night at James A. Rhodes Arena. In her 25-year career, Kest earned 48 wins at Wilkes University, 105 victories at Gannon University, 73 W's at Texas A&M – Corpus Christie, and now the Zips' all-time winningest coach earned her 174th win with UA to total her 400th career victory.

Sefcik recorded a team-high 20 points, her second 20-point effort of the season, which again tied her career-mark. Sefick has now scored in double-figures in five which again the ther career-inak. The longest tenured women's basketball head coach in the Mid-American Conference, Jodi Kest is in her 12th season at the helm of The University of Akron women's basketball program. The all-time winningest coach in program history, returns to the sidelines after guiding a young Zips' squad to a 9-21 record for the 2016-17 campaign.

Kest coached senior Hannah Plybon to her third Mid-American Conference postseason honor following the 2016-17 season, as the Zips career leader 3-point leader earned All-MAC honorable mention. The Zips finished last years campaign rated Nos. 3, 4 and 9 in the Akron single-season record book in three pointers attempted (681), triples made (206) and games played (30).

Kest has amassed nearly 400 victories in her coaching career, highlighted by registering at least 19 wins in three consecutive campaigns (2014-16). She has guided Akron to four postseason berths in the past five seasons (NCAA 2014, WNIT 2013, 2015 and 2016) and five overall postseason appearances in the last eight years.

Under Kest's tutelage, Akron has become well-known for its up-tempo style of play and has established itself as one of the top-scoring teams in the country. Kest's squad was ranked 54th nationally during the 2015-16 campaign in scoring offense averaging 71.3 points per game. Her 2015-16 team also rated in the top 50 nationally in three-pointers attempted (780), triples per game (7.8), three-pointers made (258) and rebounds (1,354).

Led by first-team All-Mid-American Conference performer senior Anita Brown, Akron finished the 2015-16 campaign with a 19-14 ledger en route to a second-place finish in the MAC Eastern Division at 11-7. The Zips garnered their fourth-consecutive postseason berth being selected to participate in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT), where Akron hosted Bucknell in the program's first-ever home postseason game.

A pair of Akron players earned All-MAC recognition as Brown was named a first-team selection, while junior Hannah Plybon was tabbed to the second team.

The 2015-16 Zips set several new single-season records, including, most games played (33), three-pointers made (258) and attempted (780) and triples made in a game (15) versus Buffalo in the semifinals of the MAC Tournament.

Akron's senior class of Megan Barilla, DiAndra Gibson and Brown capped an unprecedented run in Akron women's basketball success garnering more victories (87) than any other class in program history. The trio also became the first Zips' senior class to appear in the postseason during every year of their four-year careers.

In addition to its team accomplishments, Akron fielded several impressive individual accolades. Brown and Plybon registered the third- and ninth-best single-season scoring outputs in program history scoring 701 and 537 points, respectively. Plybon connected on a single-season record 104 three pointers, while Barilla recorded the first-ever triple-double in Akron's Division I history with a 10-point, 10-rebound and 10-assist performance in a 74-54 victory past Central Florida.

Additionally, Kest earned her 375th career victory at Eastern Michigan, 68-65, in overtime, before collecting her 150th triumph at Akron over Bowling Green, 71-55.

Brown garnered first-team All-MAC accolades after starting all 32 games in which she appeared for Akron this season en route to leading the conference in scoring (21.9) and ranking sixth in rebounding, pulling down a team-best 7.4 rebounds per game.

During her 10 seasons, Kest has seen 18 of her student-athletes earn All-MAC recognition, eight make the All-Freshman Team, two earn Sixth Player of the Year honors, and two named Player of the Year and WBCA All-Region. Additionally, she has coached 20 Academic All-MAC selections, including a record four in 2015-16 as Alli Ball, Plybon, Hannah Scipio and Megan Sefcik all earned the distinction.
