The Zips' radio broadcast will air on the Akron Sports Network [SportsRadio 1350 AM (WARF) in Akron (flagship), 1420 WHK in Cleveland, 1440 WHKZ in Warren/Youngstown] with **Steve French** calling the action, **David Skoczen** providing analysis, and **Joe Dunn** with sideline report. The pregame show starts one hour prior to kickoff. A free audio stream is available at SportsRadio1350.com, iHeart Radio, and TuneIn.com/Akron Zips.

Under the guidance of first-year head coach **Tom Arth**, Akron returns 57 letterwinners, including 10 starters, to its pro style offense and multiple defensive schemes.

Akron returns redshirt senior RB **Deltron Sands** (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.) who rushed for 128 yards on 39 carries in 2018. Under center, redshirt junior **Kato Nelson** (Hollywood, Fla.) went 178-of-342 for 2,329 yards and 15 touchdowns last fall. Junior WR **Andre Williams** (Orlando, Fla.) was the top receiver with 649 yards and six touchdowns on 46 receptions. Defensively, senior LB **John Lako** (Monroe, Mich.) was the top Zip with 126 tackles, 10.0 TFL, three break-ups, a fumble recovery, and a hurry.

The Fighting Illini, under the guidance of fourth-year head coach **Lovie Smith**, return 46 letterwinners, including 18 starters, to their multiple offensive and 4-3 defensive schemes.

Illinois returns senior RB **Reggie Corbin**, the 2018 team leader, who rusher for 1,085 yards and nine touchdowns on 128 carries. The Fighting Illini will be breaking in a new quarterback as graduate transfer **Brandon Peters** is expected to get the starting nod. In two seasons under center at Michigan, Peters went 58-of-110 for 680 yards and four touchdowns. At wide receiver, junior **Ricky Smalling** led the 2018 squad with 406 yards and five touchdowns on 33 receptions. Defensively, junior LB **Jake Hansen** is the top returning defender after finishing with 95 tackles, including 8.5 TFL, last fall.

Illinois has just one player from the state of Ohio- junior RB **Ra'Von Bonner** [Cincinnati, Ohio | Sycamore HS].

UA senior DB **Alvin Davis, Jr.**, freshman DB **Adetutu Daranijo**, junior S **Zaire Jacobs**, and redshirt senior RB **Deltron Sands** and Illinois' junior PK **James McCourt** and junior RB **Mike Epstein** were teammates at Fort Lauderdale's St. Thomas Aguinas HS.

Redshirt senior DE Josh Ward (Delray Beach, Fla.) and senior WR Trenard Davis (Boynton Beach, Fla.) were teammates at American Heritage HS. Redshirt freshman LB Zach DiLauro's (Akron, Ohio) cousin **Christian DiLauro**, named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team in 2014, was a four-year starter at offensive tackle for Illinois.

Coach **Tom Arth** has played at Illinois' Memorial Stadium before. In a preseason NFL game on August 9, 2003, the Indianapolis Colts (and back-up QB Arth) played the Chicago Bears at Memorial Stadium in Champaign while Soldier Field underwent renovations. During the 2005 season, Arth was with the Indianapolis Colts when they played the Chicago Bears, coached by Lovie Smith, in a preseason game at the RCA Dome (August, 20, 2005). The Bears won, 24-17.

#### AKRON-ILLINOIS: THE SERIES

Saturday's game is just the second meeting between Akron and Illinois in series history which began in 1996. The Fighting Illini hold a 1-0 record over the Zips. In the teams' first meeting on Sept. 21, 1996, Akron faced its first Big Ten opponent since moving up to Football Subdivision (FBS) play (since 1987). The difference in the ballgame was Illini back Robert Holcombe, who rushed for 151 yards and three touchdowns.

After a scoreless first quarter, Illini QB Scott Weaver completed an 11-yard touchdown pass to Jason Dulick. The Zips tied the game at 7-7 at half, after a 33-yard punt return by Matt Thiry and an eight-play, 47-yard drive capped by DE Jason Taylor's one-yard touchdown catch, the only touchdown of his collegiate career. The future Hall of Famer lined up as a TE on the goal line for the UA's only score. Akron LB Nate Boyd racked up 15 tackles, and S Andre McCray forced two fumbles to lead the defensive effort. Sophomore P **Mike Hayes** averaged 44.0 yards on eight kicks.

#### **ZIPS QUICK HITS**

- Seven of Akron's 2019 opponents were bowl eligible last fall: UAB (Boca Raton), Troy (Dollar General), Buffalo (Dollar General), Northern Illinois (Boca Raton), Miami (not selected), Eastern Michigan (Camillia), and Ohio (Frisco).
- Akron has 52 student-athletes on its roster from the state of Ohio; 44 of those live within a 30-mile radius to campus.

#### **MAC PREDICTIONS**

Akron was selected to finish fifth in the Mid-American Conference East Division this fall by the media. Akron earned 54 points. Ohio was picked first, followed by Miami, Buffalo, Kent State, and Akron. Bowling Green rounded out the picks.

In the West Division, Toledo was selected first, followed by Western Michigan, Northern Illinois, and Eastern Michigan. Ball State and Central Michigan rounded out the predictions.

The Ohio Bobcats were also predicted to win the 2019 MAC Championship Game which will be held on Saturday, Dec. 7, at Noon at Ford Field in Detroit.

# **OFFENSE**

#### **NELSON TO LEAD QUARTERBACKS**

Redshirt junior QB **Kato Nelson** (Hollywood, Fla.) returns to lead the Zips for the third consecutive season. As a redshirt freshman in 2017, the three-star recruit took over the quarterback reigns and started the last five games, leading Akron to appearances in the MAC Championship game and the Boca Raton Bowl. In 11 games in 2018, the quarterback went 178-of-342 for 2,329 yards and 15 touchdowns. His 15 touchdowns rank sixth on UA's TD passes in a season, while his 2,329 passing yards rank ninth on UA's season passing yards chart. He rushed for 303 yards and a touchdown on 131 carries. On Akron's career list, Nelson moved up to No. 11 in career passing yards with 3,318.

Nelson will be backed up by redshirt senior **Robbie Kelley** (Springfield, III.), who went 12-of-26 for 179 yards and two touchdowns in seven games off the bench in 2017. Kelley missed the 2018 season while rehabbing from off-season surgery.

Providing support are redshirt sophomore **Alex Ramart** (Richmond, Texas), who was 9-of-32 for 61 yards and a touchdown in six games last fall; redshirt sophomore **Drew Hodgson** (Dublin, Ohio); and redshirt freshman **T.J. DeShields** (Beloit, Ohio).

#### YOUNG BUT EXPERIENCED RECEIVERS RETURN

Perhaps Akron's most experienced and deep position, the UA receivers look to pick up where they left off. Junior **Andre Williams** (Orlando, Fla.), who played in 12 games as a true freshman in 2017, was the Zips' leading receiver with 649 yards and six touchdowns on 46 receptions last fall.

Redshirt junior **Nate Stewart** (Bethlehem, Pa.) returns to the starting line-up after missing the last two games with an injury. Stewart had 280 yards and a touchdown on 22 receptions in 10 games last fall.

Expected to move into a starting role is redshirt sophomore **Jeremiah Knight** (Jefferson, Ohio). In 2018, he had 129 yards on nine receptions in 10 games.

Expected to see game action are junior **Dustin Burkhart** (Akron, Ohio), sophomore **Timothy Scippio** (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.), and true freshman **Michael Mathison** (Covington, Ga.). The Zips will be without returning starter **Jonah Morris** (Akron, Ohio), who will miss the 2019 season with an injury.

#### WHO'S IN THE BACKFIELD?

With the graduation of three-year starter **Van Edwards**, **Jr.**, the Zips will look to redshirt senior **Deltron Sands** (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.) as a team leader. In 11 games in 2018, Sands had 128 yards on 39 carries. He also had four receptions for nine yards.

Also expected to see playing time are redshirt freshman **Devanier Floyd** (Akron, Ohio) and sophomore **Keyondre White** (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.).

#### **SENIORS ANCHOR TIGHT ENDS**

Led by redshirt sophomore **Maverick Wolfley** (Morgantown, W.Va.), the tight end unit is rattled with senior leadership. In 12 games in 2018, Wolfley had four receptions for 58 yards and a touchdown.

Adding depth will be redshirt seniors **Nick Johns** (Leesburg, Va.), **De'von Jones** (Akron, Ohio), and **Brandon Junk** (Clearwater, Fla.). Johns and Junk saw action in all 12 games in 2018, while Jones played in 11 games.

#### **EXPERIENCED O-LINE TO PROVIDE PROTECTION**

Offensive coordinator and offensive line coach **Tommy Zagorski** has four returning starters to the O-line this fall. Replacing four-year starter **Kyle Ritz**, who played several guard and tackle positions, is the biggest challenge.

Moving to left guard is redshirt junior **Brandon Council** (Tar Heel, N.C.), who has 12 career starts. After starting the first three games of the 2018 season, Council suffered a season-ending injury. Redshirt junior **Austin Sample** (Sylvania, Ohio) is expected to provide depth.

Returning to his starting role at center is junior **Bryce Petersen** (McKinleyville, Calif.), who started all 12 games last fall. Freshman **Ryan Beckman** (Avon Lake, Ohio) is expected to back up Pedersen.

Returning to left guard is redshirt sophomore **Hunter Corne** (Dunnellon, Fla.), who was one of just nine freshmen nationally to start every game on the o-line. Redshirt senior **Rich Kallay** (Largo, Fla.) will provide depth.

The battle for the starting role at right tackle is between redshirt sophomore **Shawn Muldowney II** (Diamond, Ohio) and redshirt junior **Landon Forman** (Kingfisher, Okla.). Muldowney played in all 12 games last fall on the kicking unit.

## **DEFENSE**

#### **NEW LOOK DOWN THE LINE**

While the Zips' defense lost eight starters from 2018, the 2019 defense will also sport a new look, switching to multiple defensive schemes under defensive coordinator **Matt Feeney**. Expected to move into a starting role at defensive end is junior **Dylan Meeks** (Orlando, Fla.), who saw action in all 12 games last fall. He totaled five tackles, 1.5 TFL, a break-up, and a hurry.

At nose tackle, senior **Davon'te Jest** (Ocala, Fla.) should take over after signification action in 2018. Playing in all 12 games with one start, Jest had 15 tackles, 2.5 TFL, a sack for a loss of nine years, two forced fumbles, and four hurries.

At tackle, redshirt freshman **Logan Hawkins** (Harrison City, Pa.) is expected to make his collegiate debut.

Adding depth to the front three will be redshirt senior **Andy-Jean Baptiste** (Miami, Fla.), redshirt junior **Michael Stuhldreer** (Grosse Pointe, Mich.), and junior **DeAndre Brimage** (Akron, Ohio).

#### VETERAN LINEBACKERS IN THE MIDDLE

The Zips' defensive strength lies in the linebacker unit. Returning to starting roles are redshirt seniors **Josh Ward** (Delray Beach, Fla.) and **John Lako** (Monroe, Mich.).

Moving to outside linebacker this fall, Ward played in all 12 games with 11 started at defensive end in 2018. He had 33 tackles, 7.0 TFL, 4.0 sacks, and two forced fumbles.

At inside linebacker, Lako returns to anchor the defense. The Zips' defensive leader in 2081, Lako had 126 tackles, 10.0 TFL for a loss of 27 yards, three hurries, a fumble recovery, and a hurry em route to third-team All-MAC honors.

Junior college transfer **Demetrick Watts** (Riverside, Calif.) will replace three-time All-MAC LB **Ulysees Gilbert II**.

Other linebackers expected to see action include junior **Michael Scott** (Tallahassee, Fla.), redshirt sophomore **Bubba Arslanian** (Aurora, Ohio), and redshirt junior **DeMarkus Glover** (St. Petersburg, Fla.).

First-team All-MAC DB **Alvin Davis** (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.) returns for his senior season, the sole returning starter in the secondary. In 11 games in 2018, Davis was the top defensive back (and fourth overall) with 77 tackles, a national-best/team-best four interceptions for 149 yards and two touchdowns, three break-ups, two forced fumbles, and two fumble recoveries.

Expected to join the starting line-up are redshirt senior **Shawn Featherstone** (Pittsburgh, Pa.), junior **Zaire Jacobs** (Miami Gardens, Fla.), and sophomore **Jalen Hooks** (Warren, Ohio). Featherstone played in the first two games of 2018 before suffering a season-ending injury. He's been granted a sixth year by the NCAA. Jacobs played in nine games with two starts at safety in 2018, while Hooks was one of just two true freshmen to play in all 12 games a year ago.

Providing support will be redshirt sophomore **Jeffrey Lubin** (Hollywood, Fla.), redshirt sophomores **Sammy Laster** (Miami Gardens, Fla.) and **Jordyn Riley** (Citra, Fla.), and freshman **Adetutu Daranijo** (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.).

At Nickel, redshirt freshman **Reggie Corner, Jr.** (Canton, Ohio) and freshman **Kyshad Mack** (Massillon, Ohio) will battle for the final starting position.

## **SPECIAL TEAMS**

#### LOOKING FOR SOMEONE TO LEAD KICKING UNIT

Special teams coordinator **Chris Hurd** has a huge task this season. He has to fill the punting and the placekicking positions.

Replacing three-year punter and kicker **Nick Gasser** will not be easy. Competing for the spots are redshirt junior **Jerry Fitschen** (Orange, Calif.) and redshirt freshman **Cory Smigel** (North Royalton, Ohio). Fitschen kicked off in all 12 games last fall. Overall, he kicked off 52 times for 3,203 yards (61.6 average) with 29 touchbacks. Smigel transferred to Akron in the spring after redshirting his freshman season (2018) at Syracuse.

The Zips also have to break in a new holder after the graduation of four-year holder **Kyle Foster**, who now serves as the team equipment manager. Redshirt sophomore P **Jonah Wieland** (Hudson, Ohio) and freshman P **Kyle Romenick** (Fort Mill, S.C.) will battle for this crucial position.

Redshirt sophomore **Cameron Lyons** (Morgantown, W.Va.) returns to handle long snapping duties Junior **Peyton Coffman** (Grand Blanc, Mich.) will provide depth.

#### **SPEEDY RETURNERS**

Junior WR **Andre Williams** and sophomore **Jeremiah Knight** are expected to return punts and kicks again this fall. In 2018, Knight was Akron's top punt returner with 11 returns for 142 yards and a touchdown. He was also is the top kickoff returner with 245 yards on 16 returns.

Senior DB **Alvin Davis, Jr.,** and freshman WR **Michael Mathison** (Covington, Ga.) are also expected to handle returns.

# **ON THE SIDELINES**

#### THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Akron opens its 11th season in 2019 on campus at InfoCision Stadium–Summa Field. The Zips have a 25-34 record at the venue. Attendance from each of the six Zips' home games in 2017 ranks among the Top 15 best attended games since the stadium opened in 2009. The Zips' average attendance (9,232) ranked No. 2 nationally in the NCAA's list of largest increase in attendance from the previous season.

The 30,000-seat stadium features 17 suites, state-of-the-art video board, and 80,000 square feet of academic space used daily by all University students. Additionally, the Sport Science and Wellness Education Department conducts classes on two levels, and the University's Alumni Association resides there as well.

#### **ZIPS IN THE COMMUNITY**

The UA football team put its free time to good use during the spring. They combined to work on a community service project each week with a goal of 1,000 volunteer hours. Among the projects the Zips worked were: filled orders at the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank, weeded flower gardens at the Haven of Rest, and cleaned out an abandoned warehouse for Well Akron.

#### **ZIPS IN THE CLASSROOM**

In just his first semester at the University of Akron, head football coach Tom Arth made an impact on his players not only on the gridiron but in the classroom.

At the conclusion of the Spring semester, Zips showed vast improvement. As a team, the 85 players on the spring roster combined for a 2.954 grade-point average (GPA), up from 2.466 from Fall 2018 (an increase of 0.488). The average semester GPA improvement was 0.619 per student.

A total of 73 percent of all grades earned were A's or B's. The number of A's earned increased by 83 percent, while the number of A's and B's earned increased by 40 percent from Fall to Spring.

#### **CRYSTAL CLINIC WAGON WHEEL CHALLENGE**

Akron tackles Kent State for the Crystal Clinic Orthopaedic Center Wagon Wheel Challenge during its Homecoming game on Oct. 12. The 16-sport rivalry series between Akron and Kent State is based on a time-honored competition for an historic wooden wagon wheel trophy awarded originally in 1945 to the winner of the annual Akron-Kent State football game. Akron has won the last four Wagon Wheel football games.

Akron football coaches **Chris Cook** (tight ends/offensive tackles) and **Jonathan Cooley** (defensive backs/corners/nickels) were selected by the NFL for 2019 Bill Walsh Diversity Coaching Fellowships. The program's objective is to use NFL clubs' training camps, offseason workout programs, and minicamps to give talented coaches opportunities to observe, participate, and gain experience.

Cook worked with the Atlanta Falcons, while Cooley was with the Los Angeles Rams. For Cook, this was his second honor as he worked with the Falcons in 2018 as well.

A three-time All-Mid-American Conference selection, LB Ulysees Gilbert III was selected by the Pittsburgh Steelers with the 34th pick in the sixth round (207th pick overall) of the 2019 National Football League Draft.

Gilbert became the 17th Zip in school history to be drafted into the NFL and the first draftee since 2016 [LB Jatavis Brown, 35th pick of the fifth round (175th pick overall) by the San Diego Chargers]. Gilbert was the sixth defensive Zip player to be drafted and second linebacker (following Brown).

#### **CONEY, ALBANY WIN ARENA BOWL XXXII**

Former WR A.J. Coney, Jr. (Oviedo, Fla.) and the Albany Empire captured the ArenaBowl XXXII championship on August 11, defeating the Philadelphia Soul, 45-27, at the Times Union Center.

Coney, who signed with the CFL'S Winnipeg Blue Bombers last year and played in two games, saw action in 12 games for the Empire this season. In the regular season, he had eight receptions for 90 yards and two touchdowns. Coney also had 19 kick returns for 340 yards (17.9 average).



Grandfather **Ray Mansfield** started at the University of Washington and played 14 years in the NFL, including 13 with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

# DID YOU KNOW???

- Akron football is one of a very few programs in the country that practices in the mornings to accommodate the upperclassmen's afternoon class schedule.
- Zippy is just one of eight female-gendered college mascots in Division I athletics. Do you know the other seven? (YoUDee, the Delaware Blue Hen; Mrs. Wuf of N.C. State; Lucy Lobo of New Mexico; Sue E. Pig of Arkansas; Miss Pawla of South Alabama, Kate the Lion of Hofstra; and Wilma Wildcat of Arizona).
- Akron was the first school to jump from Division I-AA football (now called FCS) to I-A (now called FBS). The Zips made the move in 1987.
- Hall of Fame coach John Heisman coached football from 1893-94 for Buchtel College (Akron's original name). The Cleveland native went on to take Georgia Tech to the national championship in 1917. The Heisman Trophy, given to the nation's most outstanding college player, is named in his honor.
- On Sept. 12, 2015, an 8-ft., 750-lb. bronze statue of Heisman was unveiled at InfoCision Stadium (outside Gate 1).
- Only one player in school history has had his number retired- #89 **Chris Angeloff**. The junior tight end collapsed and died of cardiac arrest during UA's 20-8 victory over Marshall on Sept. 6, 1975. The Chris Angeloff Scholarship was created in his honor.
- Three players, two coaches, and two teams are members of Akron's Ring of Honor: Coach **Jim** Dennison, Chris Angeloff, 1968 team, and the 1976 team (all inducted in 2003); Jason **Taylor** (2004); **Gordon Larson** (2005); and **Charlie Frye** (2015).

# TOM ARTH

#### **Head Coach**

First Season at Akron Seventh Season Overall John Carroll '03

Former NFL quarterback and Ohio native Tom Arth was named the Zips' head football coach on December 14, 2018. Arth is the Zips' 28th all-time head coach and just the eighth person to hold the position since 1960. He is also just the sixth head coach for the Zips since moving up to Division I in 1987.

Arth takes the reins at Akron after two seasons at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. During his tenure, Arth hit the ground running, putting together a top-notch staff that went out and secured one of the best recruiting classes in the Football Championship Subdivision in less than two months. He mixed a talented roster of returners with some outstanding newcomers in 2017.

He followed up his first season with the Mocs with the top recruiting class in the Southern Conference. He entered the 2018 season with a solid core of experienced returners.

In four seasons at John Carroll University, his alma mater, Arth owned a 40-8 overall record while guiding the Blue Streaks to three postseason appearances. His building of the John Carroll program was highlighted by road victories over two No. 1 ranked opponents in Mount Union and Wisconsin-Whitewater.

The 2016 Ohio Athletic Conference Coach of the Year guided the Blue Streaks to the NCAA Division III Playoffs for the third time in his four-year tenure. In the four seasons under Arth's leadership, John Carroll was among the nation's elite, finishing inside the top 25 every season including top 5 finishes in 2016 (No. 3) and 2014 (No. 5).

John Carroll won the league's automatic bid for the first time in school history in 2016, breaking Mount Union's run of 24 consecutive OAC titles. The Blue Streaks finished the season ranked No. 3 in the nation, tying a school record with a 12-2 overall tally and a 9-0 mark in league action. It was their first outright conference championship since 1989.

After graduating from JCU in 2003, Arth spent three seasons as a backup quarterback to Peyton Manning with the Indianapolis Colts. He spent part of those years playing in NFL Europe and was on the preseason roster with the Green Bay Packers in 2006.

Arth returned to John Carroll in 2010, where he assisted for three seasons before taking the reins as head coach in 2013. In the four seasons prior to Arth becoming head coach, JCU was 19-21. His squads averaged 10 wins per season since. Arth earned NCAA Division III Regional Coach of the Year honors after a 9-2 record in his first season in 2013. Those nine wins were


the most by a first-year JCU head coach, and the Blue Streaks climbed into the top 25 in the national polls.

The 2014 team made it back to the DIII playoffs, giving John Carroll back-to-back appearances for the first time in school history. His charges matched a school record soaring to a No. 5 national ranking, while advancing to the quarterfinals with an 11-2 record.

A native of Cleveland, Arth earned a bachelor's degree in physical education from John Carroll in 2003 where he played quarterback. A unanimous All-American as a junior and senior, he set 18 school records. As a senior in 2002, he guided JCU to a 12-2 record, and East region championship, and a berth in to the NCAA Division III national semifinals for the first time in program history. He is a graduate of Cleveland's St. Ignatius High School.

Arth, 38 (born May 11, 1981), and his wife Lauren have five children- Caroline, Tommy, Kate, Patrick, and Elizabeth.




