#### WHATS AHEAD

Rivals, Akron and Kent State, will battle for the Wagon Wheel on Tuesday, Nov. 11 at 7:30 p.m. on ESPNU with Chuckie Kemp (PxP) and Darius Walker (Analyst) calling the action. The Zips enter the rivalry game with an overall record of 4-6 and 3-3 in league play, while the Flashes look are (3-6, 2-3) and both teams battling for postseason births.

### **SCOUTING KENT STATE**

Under first-year head coach Mark Carney, the Golden Flashes currently sit at 3-6 overall and 2-3 in MAC play. KSU averages 18 points per game on 271.8 total yards of offense per game. The Flashes attack averages 184.0 yards through the air and 87.8 yards on the ground. Defensively, opponents average 34.3 points on 440.9 yards per game, allowing 250.89 yards in the air and 190.0 on the ground.

Starting QB, Dreu Desheilds leads the offense, completing 94 of 165 attempts with two interceptions for 1,321 yards (165.1 avg) and 11 touchdowns.

Case Wolford leads the receiving corps with 406 yards and 45.11 yards per game on 16 receptions and a team-high 6 touchdowns. Da'Shawn Martin (23-293 yds, 2 TDs), Wayne Harris (26-256 yds, TD) and Ardell Banks (8-161 yds, TD) all support the air attack. RB Gavin Garcia provides the bulk of the work on the ground, averaging 3.8 yards per carry and 42.2 yards per game on 100 attempts for 380 yards with one TD. Jordan Nubin share's the groundwork with 62 carries for 210 yards (42.0 vards per game and 3.4 per rush) with one TD.

Defensively, KSU generated 51 tackles for loss of 218 yards with 18 sacks (142 yds). CJ Young paces the defense with 69 tackles with 6.0 TFL (23 yds), 1.5 sacks (5 yds) and one INT. Mason Woods follows with 64 tackles and team-high 6.5 TFL (18 yds) and one Sack (10 yds). Jamond MAthis leads the unit with a team-high4.5 sacks (34 yds) and 6.0 TFL (38 yards) while recording 19 total tackles.

Akron is meeting Kent State for the 68th time in program history with the Zips owning a 37-28-2 series advantage. Akron reclaimed the Wagon Wheel in 2023 with a 31-27 victory, snapping Kent's four-game winning streak. In 2024, the Zips retained the Wheel with a 38-17 win at Kent State. Prior to those meetings, the series was deadlocked 5-5 in the last 10 years with both teams winning four straight games. The Zips won four straight games from 2015-2018 and Kent State won four-straight from 2019-2022. In 2022, the Golden Flashes posted a 33-27 win at Dix Stadium (10/22/22). Akron posted wins in 2013 (16-7), 2015 (20-0), 2016 (31-27), 2017 (24-14) and 2018 (24-23 OT). KSU posted wins 2014 (27-24), 2019 (26-3), 2020 (69-35), 2021 (38-0) and 2022 (33-27). The series between the two schools dates back to the 1923 campaign when Akron earned a 32-0 home victory over Kent State. The Zips and Golden Flashes have met every season since 1992.

### THE LAST MEETING: AKRON at KENT STATE

The Akron Football team claimed the Wagon Wheel for the second straight season after defeating rival Kent State 38-17 at Dix Stadium Tuesday evening.

Akron's rushing attack helped the Zips roll past the Golden Flashes with 277 yards gained on the ground. Redshirt junior Jordon Simmons led the ground game with 113 yards and 10.3 per carry. Redshirt sophomore Charles Kellom also cracked the century mark with 104 yards rushing and one touchdown. Redshirt junior Tahj Bullock rushed for two touchdowns and 35 yards.

Sophomore Adrian Norton recorded over 100 receiving yards against the Golden Flashes, posting 107 yards on five receptions and 21.4 yards per catch. Kellom added 44 yards receiving to his rushing performance while redshirt junior Jarvis Rush recorded his first NCAA touchdown reception on a 36 yard strike from redshirt junior Ben Finley.

Finley threw for 250 yards (14-29-0) and one touchdown when he found Rush.

Redshirt junior Garrison Smith was perfect on night kicking, going 3-for-3 after hitting 43,27 and 26 yard field goals.

The Zips racked up 527 total yards on offense, 277 on the ground and 250 through the air, while averaging 6.8 yards per play and out-gaining Kent State.

Redshirt sophomore Elijah Reed and junior Bryan McCoy led the Zips defense with seven tackles each while seniors Antavious Fish and Paul Lewis III combined for 10 tackles with five each. Senior CJ Nunnally IV and redshirt junior Justin Anderson and Dimitri Madden all recorded a sack in the win. Reed recorded one interception and returned the INT for 26 yards.

Akron's defense held up against Kent State's offense, giving up 281 total yards.

The Zips improved to 3-8 on the year and 2-5 in Mid-American Conference play, while the Golden Flashes fell to 0-11 and 0-7.

### **How It Happened**

Kent State took an early 7-0 lead, but Akron got on the scoreboard with 10:34 left in the first guarter to cut the deficit to 7-3 when Smith hit a 43-yard field goal.The Zips then took the lead on a three-yard rushing touchdown from Bullock, making the score 10-7.

Akron continued to expand its lead, scoring again with 13:05 left in the second quarter to go ahead 17-7 when Kellom ran for 13 yards. The Zips continued to add to their lead after Kent State narrowed the gap to 17-10, scoring again to go ahead 20-10 after Smith hit a 26-yard field goal.

Akron continued to extend its advantage, scoring again with :00 left in the second guarter to go up 23-10 on another field goal from Smith, this time a 27-yard field goal.The Zips kept scoring, tacking on a touchdown to increase their advantage to 30-10 when Bullock scored on a eight yard rush.

Akron held the Golden Flashes off the board before scoring for a final time with 4:17 left in the third quarter, stretching their lead to 38-10 when Finley hit Rush on a 36-yard reception. Akron didn't score again and Kent State tacked on seven more points to finish off the scoring.

Jordan Gant MAC Offensive Player of the Week on Monday (Sept. 22).

Gant anchored the offensive efforts for the Zips in a 51-7 win over Duquesne (Sept. 20). Akron registered 514 yards of total offense, including 265 yards on the ground.

Of the 265 rushing yards, Gant was responsible for 161 yards on only 13 carries, recording 12.4 yards per rush. Gant found the endzone three times, scoring 21 of the Zips 51 points. Gant set a career high in all three categories; rushing yards, touchdowns and yards per rushing attempt.

Gant scored the initial touchdown of the game on a 17 rush, while PK Owen Wiley buried the PAT, with 8:02 left in the first quarter.

Gant found paydirt twice in the second quarter to help give the Zips a commanding 38-0 advantage.

His second TD of the game came with 8:34 left in the second frame, finishing a 53-yard drive with a nine-yard rush to the endzone.

For his final score of the evening, Gant finished a 7-play, 60-yard drive with an eight-yard rushing touchdown. Wiley made both PATs.

### AKRON'S JORDAN GANT IS DOAK WALKER NATIONAL RUNNING BACK OF THE WEEK (Oct.7)

Akron running back Jordan Gant led all FBS players in rushing yards last weekend with his career-high 176 yards and added a receiving touchdown as the Zips defeated Central Michigan 28-22. Gant is the Doak Walker National Running Back of the Week.

Gant's 16-yard catch-and-run touchdown with 3:13 left before halftime put Akron (2-4, 1-1) ahead for good at 14-10. He finished with a season-high of 28 receiving yards to total 204 all-purpose yards.

It was a banner effort for the 5-foot-10 redshirt junior from Lakeland, Fla. Gant has posted 100-yard rushing games in two of Akron's last three games and he is now tied for 19th in FBS rushing with 476 yards with three touchdowns. Akron outgained Central Michigan 417-374 and the run game helped them convert 9 of 15 third downs.

Both of Akron's wins have come with Gant topping 100 yards, although his first start didn't come until Sept. 27 at Toledo. His other top game was taking 13 carries for 161 yards and three touchdowns in a Sept. 20 win against Duquesne, a performance that made

him the Mid-American Conference Offensive Player of the Week. His 5.73 yards per carry on the season (83 attempts) list 42nd nationally. The surge in the past three games for Akron's rushing leader has upped his per-game yardage to 79.3 for the season.

Gant transferred to Akron following three seasons at Tennessee State. In 2024 he appeared in 14 games and rushed for 251 yards on 70 attempts, scoring one rushing touchdown and twice with receptions.

Gant now joins the members of the preseason Doak Walker Award candidates list among the strong group of players vying for the prestigious honor.

Presented annually by the PwC SMU Athletic Forum, the Doak Walker Award recognizes the top running back in college football. Named after Doak Walker, a legendary figure in college football and the NFL, the award has honored the nation's best running back since 1990. The Doak Walker Award winner will be unveiled live on ESPN on The Home Depot College Football Awards on Friday, Dec. 12.

The Doak Walker Award is a member of the National College Football Awards Association (NCFAA), which encompasses college football's most prestigious awards. The NCFAA's 25 awards have honored more than 950 recipients since 1935. This season, 13 NCFAA awards will honor national players of the week each Tuesday. ### **A DEFENSIVE STANCE**

Akron's defense has shown flashes of real promise in 2025, highlighted by disruptive playmakers across all three levels. The Zips have forced 17 turnovers in 10 games. The defense has also been strong in the red zone, limiting opponents to scores on just 72.7-percent of trips (2nd in MAC), including forcing six turnovers inside the 20. As a unit, the Zips' defense has demonstrated the ability to limit big plays and create turnovers, keeping the team competitive in every game. With continued growth and cohesion, Akron's defense is poised to remain a cornerstone of the team's success as the season progresses.

Individually, linebacker Shammond Cooper (60 tackles) and fellow linebacker DiMarco Johnson (48) anchor the middle, combining for 10.8 tackles per game. Defensive back Malcom DeWalt IV has emerged as a difference-maker with 47 tackles, seven breakups, two interceptions, and a pick-six, while corner Elijah Reed has a pair of interceptions and safety Markus Boswell recovered a fumble and took it to the house. Up front, Julien Laventure and have provided steady pressure as Leventure leads the squad in TFL with 10 for 50 yards with 3 sacks (22 yds), while Dull has 8.5 tackles for loss (38 yds) and four sacks (25 yds), giving Akron a proven disruptors on the defensive line. The defensive line posted five sacks against Central Michigan and Buffalo, recording 22 for the season with a loss of 144 yards. Dull (4-25 yds), Laventure (3.5-22 yds), Cyrus Durham (3-10 yds), Melvin Spriggs (2.5-14 yds), Gage Summers (1.5-11 yds) and six players with one sack and three with 0.5 sacks.

Melvin Spriggs was honored by the Mid-American Conference as its Defensive Player of the Week (Oct. 27).

Spriggs anchored the defensive efforts for the Zips in a 24-16 win over Buffalo (Oct. 25). Akron issued 10 tackles for loss (50 yards) and five sacks (37 yards) to go along with five takeaways.

Spriggs paced the Zips defense with a team-high 14 tackles, including 8 solo stops. He led the squad in tackles for loss, generating 3.5 takedowns for loss of 15 yards. Additionally, Spriggs led the team in sacks, recording half of the Zips total with 2.5 sacks for 14 yards of loss.

The Zips limited Buffalo to 195 yards of total offense in the second half. In the third quarter, Spriggs accounted for five total tackles and one tackle for loss as the Bulls scored three points on 14 plays and 100 yards.

In the fourth quarter, Spriggs again led the way with four total tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Buffalo scored three points on 18 plays and 95 yards.

The University of Akron Zips' 2025 offense has shown real promise, highlighted by strong individual performances. QB Ben Finley has been the offensive cornerstone, leading the team with 1,875 passing yards, including 252-yard, three-touchdown outing against Central Michigan, 291-yard outburst with three TD's against Ball State, 230-yard effort with three touchdowns against Buffalo, 197-yard, 28-rushing (7.0 per carry) with two passing TDs and rushing TD.

RB Jordan Gant has emerged as a dynamic force in the backfield. After transferring from Tennessee State, Gant has accumulated 850 rushing yards, averaging 5.0 yards per carry. His breakout performance came in Week 6 against Central Michigan, where he rushed for 176 yards and a touchdown, earning him the Doak Walker National Running Back of the Week honor. GAnt ahs rushed for 150+ yards in three games this season, including a 153 yards and two touchdowns against UMass. Sean Patrick has also contributed for the RB room (65 att, 262 yds, 4.0/rush, 1 TD, 25 yd long, 32.75 yds/g).

WR Kyan Mason leads the receiving corps with 418 yards and five TDs. WRs Israel Polk (373 yds, 6 TDs) and Marcel Williams (361 yds), while the TE room is productive in the passing game, scoring three TDs and supporting the offense: Conner Cravaack (14-114 yds, 2TDs) and Max Whisner (3-34 yd, TD) and Jake Newell (4-14 yds). The O-Line faced challenges early, but has held ground as of late to establish a consistent running game and protecting the quarterback.

### THE ZIPS SPECIAL TEAMS

Akron's special teams have been a consistent strength in 2025, providing the Zips with strong field position and momentum. P Joseph Castle averages 43.0 yards per punt, with 10 kicks over 50 yards and 14 pinned inside the 20-yard line. Brayden Johnson adds depth, averaging 41.1 yards per punt. In the return game, Brandon Hills leads with 468 yards on 21 returns (22.9-yard average), including a long of 33 yards. Terence Thomas contributes with 48 yards on two returns (24.0-yard average), highlighted by a 25-yard return. Sean Patrick has handled punt returns, posting a 6.8-yard average with a long of 15. On the kicking front, Owen Wiley and Matthew Schramm are a combined 10-of-16 on field goals, including a 6-6 effort from Schramm. Akron is a perfect 23-for-24 on PATs. With strong punting, reliable returns, and dependable placekicking, Akron's special teams have been a dependable strength and a unit the Zips can continue to lean on.

#### **WHO IS WEARING NO. 1**

Senior WR **Myles Walker** and junior DL **Julien Laventure** and have emerged as leaders under fourth-year head coach Joe Moorhead and the duo was recently rewarded with the No. 1 jerseys for 2025. Under Moorhead at Akron, head strength and conditioning coach Orie Sahlfeld identifies one player on each side of the ball that demonstrated their leadership both on and off the field over the course of the spring to earn the privilege of wearing the No. 1 jersey in the Akron Blue and Gold for the 2025 season.

"Coach Moorhead and I spoke about performance and leadership and all the qualities you want in someone in an elite or leadership position," said Sahlfeld. "They earned it all the way from January being accountable, holding their teammates to higher standards, doing all the little things right on a day-to-day basis and being consistent. They have a voice on the team and when they talk people listen. Both are the leaders on their side of the ball when it comes to holding their teammates accountable, having a high standard for themselves and their teammates and bringing people with them and picking people up when they're having bad days."

### THE ZIPS LAST TIMEOUT

The Akron Zips football team scored in every quarter as it took down UMass 44-10 at InfoCision Stadium-Summa Health Field. Ben Finley led Akron's air game with 197 yards, tossing two touchdowns without throwing an interception. The signal caller also added 28 rushing yards, seven yards per carry, and one touchdown. Jordan Gant totaled 153 yards, his third 150+ yard rushing performance of the season, to lead the Zips' ground attack and added two touchdowns in the game, picking up 5.5 yards per carry. Taven Curry also tacked on 55 yards on the ground, picking up 6.9 yards per carry. Akron recorded a big outing on the ground, totaling 237 rushing yards while averaging 5.2 yards per carry and out-rushing UMass by 160 yards. Finley's most prolific target was Marcel Williams, who caught four passes for a career-high 104 yards. Williams also set a career-high for longest reception (46 yrd). Kyan Mason caught four passes for 38 yards and one touchdown while Max Whisner reeled in two catches for 33 yards.

The Zips won the turnover battle in Tuesday's game, forcing three turnovers while coughing the ball up one time, with Akron turning those takeaways into 21 points. Akron's defense limited UMass' offense, giving up 169 total yards. The Zips kept UMass under 100 yards on both the ground and through the air, allowing only 92 passing and 77 rushing yards. This was the first time September 12, 2009 that the Zips kept an opponent under 200 total yards (Morgan State, 127 yrds). Shammond Cooper and Malcom DeWalt IV led the Zips' defense in tackles with seven each. DeWalt tied his career-high of seven tackles against the Minutemen. Gage Summers recorded four tackles while recovering two fumbles; with one being returned 25 yards for a touchdown. Julien Laventure recorded six tackles, 2.5 tfl (26 yrds) and a forced fumble that Summers recovered for a score. In addition, Laventure had multiple sacks negated by flags.

### **VS BUFFALO**

Akron rallied from a seven-point halftime deficit to beat Buffalo 24-16 at UB Stadium, snapping the Bulls seven-game winning streak over the Zips. Akron handed Buffalo its first Mid-American Conference loss of the season , outscoring the Bulls 21-6 in the second half with three touchdowns and four interceptions. QB Ben Finley led the Akron offense with 230 yards passing on 17 of 32 with two touchdowns and one interception. The signal caller also added a rushing touchdown with a career-high with a 38 yard rush for paydirt. The two touchdown passes went to WR Kyan Mason and TE Conner Cravaack. Mason recorded one reception for nine yards for six points, while Cravaack caught two passes for 32 yards with a score. WR Marcel Williams and WR Israel Polk led the receiving corps as Williams pulled down six passes for 74 yards and a long of 36 yards. Polk followed with three receptions for 67 yards , including a long of olf 46 yards. The Zips' ground attack was fueled by RB Jordan Gant, who totaled 92 yards on 25 carries.

Akron's defense was tough against the run, limiting Buffalo to only 91 yards on the ground with five sacks and five takeaways. Akron recorded 10 tackles for loss of 50 yards, including five sacks for 37 yards of loss. LB Melvin Spriggs led the Zips with 14 total tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss (15 yards) and 2.5 sacks (14 yards). S Jamari Somerville and S Mekhi Flowers added nine tackles each as Somerville tallied a sack for a loss of 13 yards. DLJon'Trel Mixon also registered a sack for seven yards of loss, while LB Gage Summers posted a 0.5 sack for three negative yards. Summers also had a pair of interceptions, while DB Ben Kamara and DB Malcom DeWalt IV each had one interception. DeWalt recorded 12 return yards. Akron turned those takeaways into seven points.

### **VS BALL STATE**

Although leading at the half, the Akron football team fell to Ball State 42-28 on Saturday. Ben Finley led Akron's passing attack with 291 yards through the air, tossing three touchdowns, two going to Israel Polk, and two interceptions. Jordan Gant paced the Zips' rushing attack by accumulating 94 yards over the course of the game, averaging 4.9 yards per carry. Sean Patrick added 24 yards on the ground. Tim Grear, Jr. reeled in a career-high four receptions while also setting career-highs in receiving yards (87) and longest reception (37). Polk added to the Zips' receiving numbers, tying his career-high for touchdowns (2) and receptions (5) while adding 72 yards. The Zips also got 53 yards receiving and one touchdown from Kyan Mason in the contest.

Defensively, Akron held the Cardinals to 158 yards. The Zips' defense disrupted Ball State's backfield all game, racking up four sacks and eight total tackles for loss. Julien Laventure led the Akron defensive effort, collecting a career-high nine tackles, 2.0 TFL, one sack, and one recovered fumble. DiMarco Johnson added eight tackles and one interception and Cyrus Durham had four tackles, 1.0 TFL, and one sack in the loss. Bruno Dall added to his team leading sack total (4) with one coming against the Cardinals while adding four tackles. Markus Boswell recorded one sack resulting in a loss of 14 yards. Boswell also had four tackles and a forced fumble.

### **VS MIAMI**

Akron Zips fell 20-7 to Miami at InfoCision Field Summa Health Field on Saturday afternoon. Ben Finley led Akron's passing attack with 211 yards on 21 of 39 passing which included a touchdown and an interception. Finley a 20-yard long pass to Kyan Mason, who finished with a team-best 52 receiving yards on five receptions. Israel Polk also caught five passes, including a 5-yard TD pass with 6:54 left to play in the game for the Zips lone score. Jordan Gant rushed for 35 yards to lead the Zips' ground attack, while Sean Patrick (20 yards) and Finley (7 yards) followed.

Defensively, the Zips caused major problems for the RedHawk offense in the first half, limiting Miami to a field goal and only 147 total yards on the ground. Shammond Cooper led the Zips in tackles with eight takedowns with four solo stops and 0.5 tackles for loss of one yard -- DiMMarco Johnson also registered 0.5 tackles for loss. The Zips had four total tackles for loss as Gage Summers posted a teambest two sacks for three total yards of loss and Cyrus Durham had the other sack for a two-yard loss. Summers and Johnson recorded six and three tackles, respectively. Elijah Reed registered Akron's lone takeaway with an interception at the end of the first half and collected six total tackles.

#### VS CENTRAL MICHIGAN

The Akron football team posted a 28-22 win over Central Michigan on Homecoming at InfoCision Stadium Summa Health Field on Saturday. Ben Finley powered the Zips' air game with 252 yards (18-29-1) and three TDs with a long of 62. Michael Johnson Jr. added a TD while going 2-for-2. Jordan Gant paced the Zips rushing attack with a career-high 176 yards while averaging 5.5 yards per carry. Gant also tacked on 28 receiving yards and a touchdown. Kyan Mason recorded his first 100+ yard receiving performance as a Zip, reeling in five catches for a career-high 125 yards and one score. He also recorded a career-long 62 yard reception. Marcel Williams had 33 yards on two receptions. Among the four Zips to catch a TD, Max Whisner recorded his first career collegiate touchdown while Conner Cravaack also found the end zone for the first time in his collegiate career. Akron converted on 60 percent of third-down attempts on the day. The Zips also went 1-for-1 on fourth down. The Zips' defense recorded its fifth consecutive game of 60+ tackles with 77 coming against the Chippewas.

Bruno Dall followed close behind with a career-high eight tackles while recording one tackle for loss. Gage Summers had eight tackles as well while recording one tackle for loss resulting in eight yards. Julien Laventure had three tackles while recording two sacks for 15 yards. The Zips improved to 2-4 on the year and 1-1 in Mid-American Conference play, while the Chippewas fell to 3-3 and 1-1.

### **VS TOLEDO**

Akron fell 45-3 to Toledo on the road at the Glass Bowl on Saturday. Brayden Roggow led the Zips passing game with a career-high 51 yards on seven completions on 12 attempts while Michael Johnson Jr. added 28 yards (7-13-0). Jordan Gant totaled 22 yards to lead the Zips' ground attack, while Cam Macon tacked on 17 yards. Israel Polk was one of five receivers with multiples receptions, leading the Zips with 16 yards. Marcel Williams and Kyan Mason both added 15 yards. Akron's defense recorded its four consecutive game of 60+ tackles with 69 tackles coming against the Rockets. The Zips were led by DiMarco Johnson's eight tackles while Mehki Flowers added seven. Dimitri Madden and Jason Hocker combined for the Zips Ione sack of the game while Julien Laventure and Melvin Spriggs each recorded a team-high one tackle for loss.

#### **VS DUQUESNE**

Akron used a huge 265-yard performance on the ground, including 161 yards from Jordan Gant and three rushing touchdowns to pick up a 51-7 win against Duquesne Saturday night at home at InfoCision Stadium-Summa Health Field. Akron had an outstanding day offensively, logging 514 total yards, 265 on the ground and 249 through the air, while averaging 7.7 yards per play and out-gaining Duquesne. Ben Finley led Akron's passing attack with 219 yards through the air, tossing two touchdowns and one interception. Brayden Roggow added 30-yards on a 3-of-4 passing night. Gant led all Zips rushers with a career performance of 161 yards and three touchdowns, picking up 12.4 yards per carry. Sean Patrick added 28 yards on the ground, averaging 4.7 yards per carry, along with 34 receiving yards. Myles Walker reeled in five catches for 65 yards to lead the receiving corps, while Kyan Mason hauled in three balls for 58 yards and one touchdown. Israel Polk added 47 yards on two catches.

The Zips' defense registered three takeaways with a pair of interceptions, one for a touchdown and a forced fumble, leading to 14 points. Malcom DeWalt IV came away with a 22-yard pick-six to go along with four tackles while Elijah Davis also picked off the Dukes. Rodrick Hunter forced a fumble on a 10-yard sack that was picked up by Cyrus Durham. Bruno Dall, Shammond Cooper and Melvin Spriggs led the way in tackles with five each. Dall also added a sack to his season total while coming away with two tackles for loss against Duquesne. As a unit, the Zips recorded its third consecutive game of 60+tackles, with 70 takedowns and allowing only 230 total yards The Zips won the turnover battle, forcing three turnovers while coughing the ball up one time, with Akron turning those takeaways into 14 points.

### **VS UAB**

The Akron Zips were unable to overcome a first-half deficit, as they fell 31-28 to the UAB despite holding the Blazers scoreless in the second half at Protective Stadium. Ben Finley led Akron's passing attack with 282 yards, throwing two touchdowns. Finley tossed a career-long 75-yard strike to Israel Polk for the Zips' opening score and first touchdown of the season. Polk led the Zips receiving corps with a career-high 99 yards, a career-high two touchdown catches while setting a career-long 75-yard reception from Finley. Myles Walker got in on the action in the passing game as well, hauling in four targets for a career-high 69 yards. Sean Patrick paced the Zips' rushing attack by accumulating a career-high 81 yards, which included his first collegiate touchdown. Patrick averaged 4.3 yards per carry, while Jordan Gant added 67 total yards and 6.1 yards per carry. As a unit, the Akron defense recorded 66 tackles, the second consecutive game the Zips have recorded 60 or more tackles (at Nebraska, 66).

Rodrick Hunter led the Zips' defense with a career-high eight tackles. Malcom DeWalt IV and DiMarco Johnson followed close behind with seven tackles each. Johnson led Akron with two tackles for loss, while Bruno Dall added 1.5 sacks for a loss of nine yards to go with his three tackles. Markus Boswell recorded his team-leading second interception of the year, resulting in a 44-yard return deep into Blazer territory. Akron neutralized the UAB rushing attack, holding the Blazers to 81 yards on the ground. In part because of that stellar defense, Akron runners out-gained their UAB counterparts 159-81.

#### **VS NEBRASKA**

The Akron Zips fell 68-0 to Nebraska on the road Saturday night. The Cornhuskers improved to 2-0 on the season while the Zips dropped to 0-2. Sean Patrick led all Zips rushers with 64 yards in the contest, picking up 5.3 yards per carry. Jordan Gant also added 31 yards on the ground. Marcel Williams hauled in two catches for 28 yards. Myles Walker also added two receptions. For the second straight week, Shammond Cooper led the Zips in tackles. Cooper recorded a team-high nine tackles while DiMarco Johnson followed behind with six. Justin Anderson caused a goal line fumble fumble to prevent a

Nebraska touchdown while Cyrus Durham came away with the recovery. As a unit, the Akron defense recorded a season-high 66 tackles.

#### **VS WYOMING**

The Akron Zips opened their 2025 season at InfoCision Stadium-Summa Health Field, falling 10-0 to Wyoming. The Zips' defense kept them within striking distance, holding the Cowboys (1-0) to just a field goal through three quarters, but the offense struggled to sustain drives. Akron (0-1) managed 228 total yards and finished just 3 of 15 on third down. As a team, Akron recorded 48 tackles with Shammond Cooper notching a team-high 10 tackles. Justin Anderson and Alex Branch followed closely behind with nine takedowns each. The unit forced an interception and held Wyoming to just one red-zone score on two trips. Akron broke out the Turnover Tire in the season opener when Markus Boswell recorded an interception off a deflected pass courtesy of Bruno Dall in the third quarter.

QB Ben Finley went 16 of 38 for 139 yards and one interception, while Marquese Williams paced the Zips rushing attack by accumulating 30 yards over the course of the game, averaging 5 yards per carry. Sean Patrick added with 26 rushing yards and a team-high 47 receiving yards. Joseph Castle punted six times for the Zips with an average of 49.5 yards per punt while pinning the Cowboys inside their own 20 three times.

### **DID YOU KNOW**

- Zippy is just one of eight female-gendered college mascots in Division I athletics. Do you know the other seven? (YoUDee, the Delaware Blue Hen; Mrs. Wuf of N.C. State; Lucy Lobo of New Mexico; Sue E. Pig of Arkansas; Miss Pawla of South Alabama, Kate the Lion of Hofstra; and Wilma Wildcat of Arizona).
- Åkron was the first school to jump from Division I-AA football (now called FCS) to I-A (now called FBS).
   The Zips made the move in 1987.
- Hall of Fame coach John Heisman coached football from 1893-94 for Buchtel College (Akron's original name). The Cleveland native went on to take Georgia Tech to the national championship in 1917. The Heisman Trophy, given to the nation's most outstanding college player, is named in his honor.
- On Sept. 12, 2015, an 8-ft., 750-lb. bronze statue of Heisman was unveiled at InfoCision Stadium (outside Gate 1).
- Only one player in school history has had his number retired– #89 **Chris Angeloff**. The junior tight end collapsed and died of cardiac arrest during UA's 20-8 victory over Marshall on Sept. 6, 1975. The Chris Angeloff Scholarship was created in his honor.
- Three players, two coaches, and two teams are members of Akron's Ring of Honor: Coach **Jim Dennison**, **Chris Angeloff**, **1968 team**, and the **1976 team** (all inducted in 2003); **Jason Taylor** (2004); **Gordon Larson** (2005); and **Charlie Frye** (2015).

# **AKRON TRADITIONS**

### **JOHN HEISMAN**

The story goes that Buchtel College's quarterback, 6-foot-4 inch Harry Clark, had trouble bending low enough to pick up the football when the center snapped it to him.

Squirted it to him was more like it.

At that point in football history, 1893, the center transferred the ball to the quarterback by putting one hand over the front of the ball and pressing down on the back with his other hand. When he released the front hand, the ball would flip up and back in the general direction of the backfield.

It was an awkward maneuver, to say the least, and resulted in many fumbles.

Buchtel's coach had a better idea. Why not have the center simply pitch the ball back through his legs? Shotgun-style, we'd call it today.

It worked.

Clark saved his back, and Buchtel cut down on its fumbles. No one objected, and by the end of the season all colleges were using the new center snap.

So how did Heisman end up in Akron?

After the 1892 season, the students again besieged the Reverend Orello Cone, Buchtel's president since 1880, pleading with him to convince the Board of Trustees to hire someone to coach the college's club teams. Cone pushed the measure through.

The students' first choice was Heisman, and they moved quickly to get him. The young coach was invited to campus in January, and after inspecting the facilities he spelled out the terms under which he would render his services. At a meeting of the trustees' executive committee on Jan. 28, 1893, the committee agreed to extend Heisman a one-year contract as "gymnasium director" and "special teacher of gymnastics in baseball and football." The board not only agreed to pay Heisman \$900, but to build a long-sought baseball cage - provided the students raised \$300 toward Heisman's salary and paid off the remaining salary of the previous gym director. The weekly student newspaper, The Buchtelite, ran the headline:

"HEISMAN! HEISMAN! Rah! Rah! Rah!"

Alas, John W. Heisman's association with Buchtel wasn't a long or especially satisfying one for him – the faculty and trustees got together and legislated his job out of existence. But it did have its moments. In 1894, when he technically wasn't even working for the college, Heisman engineered a 12-6 win over Ohio State. He played quarterback in the game to boot.

After retiring from coaching, Heisman served as the New York City Downtown Athletic Club's first athletic director, starting in 1930. The club awarded its first trophy to the nation's top college football player in 1935 and renamed the trophy in memory of Heisman when he died a year later at age 66.

### THE WAGON WHEEL

According to legend, the "Wagon Wheel" came into being in the spring of 1870 when John R. Buchtel, an Akron industrialist, at the insistence of Rev. Andrew Willson of the Kent Universalist Church, set out for Kent in search of a site for a proposed college. However, his wagon became bogged down in the mud where Kent State University is currently located, the horses broke



away and left bits and pieces of the carriage scattered, including one of the wheels, which remained wedged in the mud.

Buchtel eventually found his way back to Akron, where he settled on a site for Buchtel College, the forerunner of the present University of Akron.



During construction of a pipeline along the Western Reserve Trail in 1902, the wheel was discovered and eventually became the property of Dr. Raymond Manchester, who in 1945 as the Kent State Dean of Men, suggested the wheel be set up as an award to the winner of the annual Akron-Kent State football game.

Manchester had the wheel painted blue and gold, the school colors of both schools, and it has been a prized trophy ever since. Each spoke bears a plaque verifying the score of each game.

In 1946, Kent State defeated the Zips, 13-6, to capture the Wagon Wheel Trophy. After a KSU win in 1954, the series between the two schools went into hibernation. Not until Sept. 9, 1972, was the series revived. In that game, played at the Rubber Bowl, 25,131 saw UA grab a 13-0 lead, but KSU battled back to score 13 fourth-quarter points, and the contest ended in a tie. Akron was then awarded custodial rights for a two-year period for its first possession of the prized trophy since its inception.

The Zips 37-28-2 in the Wagon Wheel Series. In 2011, the Wagon Wheel was the inspiration behind the creation of the Crystal Clinic Wagon Wheel Challenge. The Wagon Wheel Challenge broadened the Akron-Kent State rivalry to include all 14 NCAA varsity sports that are sponsored by both programs. The Crystal Clinic Wagon Wheel Challenge ended after 2022-23 academic year.

- Zippy is just one of eight female-gendered college mascots in Division I athletics. Do you know the other seven? (YoUDee, the Delaware Blue Hen; Mrs. Wuf of N.C. State; Lucy Lobo of New Mexico; Sue E. Pig of Arkansas; Miss Pawla of South Alabama, Kate the Lion of Hofstra; and Wilma Wildcat of Arizona).
- Akron was the first school to jump from Division I-AA football (now called FCS) to I-A (now called FBS). The Zips made the move in 1987.
- Hall of Fame coach John Heisman coached football from 1893-94 for Buchtel College (Akron's original name). The Cleveland native went on to take Georgia Tech to the national championship in 1917. The Heisman Trophy, given to the nation's most outstanding college player, is named in his honor. in his honor.
- On Sept. 12, 2015, an 8-ft., 750-lb. bronze statue of Heisman was unveiled at InfoCision Stadium (outside Gate 1).
- Only one player in school history has had his number retired- #89 **Chris Angeloff**. The junior tight end collapsed and died of cardiac arrest during UA's 20-8 victory over Marshall on Sept. 6, 1975. The Chris Angeloff Scholarship was created in his henor his honor.
- Three players, two coaches, and two teams are members of Akron's Ring of Honor: Coach Jim Dennison, Chris Angeloff, 1968 team, and the 1976 team (all inducted in 2003); Jason Taylor (2004); Gordon Larson (2005); and Charlie Frye (2015).

### <u>'Symbolic in a lot of ways': Akron football team finds inspiration in Turnover Tire</u>

Viral moments related to the University of Akron football team rarely turn up in the program's favor. That changed Saturday when the Zips and their Turnover Tire enjoyed a moment in the spotlight after beating the Morgan State Bears on the type of play that sealed the team's fate in the past.

On a third-and-9 at their own 21 with 59 seconds left in the game and protecting a four-point lead, running back J.J. Davis took a handoff for the Bears. UA defensive lineman CJ Nunnally IV busted through the left side of the Bears O-line and poked the ball free. A split second later, linebacker Bryan McCoy scooped the ball up and ran 13 yards for a UA touchdown to ultimately give them a 24-21 victory in their home opener.

For their efforts, the team brought out the Turnover Tire in recognition.

The symbolism of it being associated with a college football team representing the Rubber City is inescapable, but it goes beyond that for UA coach Joe Moorhead, who is in his second year coaching the team.

The tire was something he conceived at the tail end of camp, he told the Beacon Journal on Tuesday.


"Other people have the chains and the thrones and the slot machines, and that's kind of a lot of pomp and circumstance and glitz and glamor, and that's cool," he said. "But the identity that I want this football team to kind of embody is what the Akron area is." Moorhead understands where Akron fits in the fabric of Northeast Ohio and had his equipment manager acquire a couple of worn-down tires.

"It's almost symbolic in a lot of ways of how people view this program that we are just not a worthy or worthwhile program," he said. "And at the end of the day, what we got to do is find a way to dust it off and shine them up. And there's still plenty of tread on the tires in this program and we're going to find a way to make it work, put it on the car and drive this thing, drive this thing to success."

### Akron Zips football get positive feedback for Turnover Tire

Not surprisingly, his players greeted the addition of the tire with enthusiasm. And Moorhead admits that it's pretty cool that it had a viral moment on the national stage, but he also appreciates hearing from fans.

"I was taking out the garbage [Monday] night and the guy who lives across the street from me was having a catch with his son and yelled across the street, 'Hey coach, great win. Congratulations. Love the tires, keep it rolling,'" he said. "So, I didn't mean for it to be gimmicky, there really is some substance to it, but at the same time it's kind of the anticelebration in a lot of ways."

# Head Coach Fourth Season at Akron Fordham '96

Joe Moorhead, an inspirational leader of student-athletes and one of the most ingenious offensive minds in football, was named the head coach of The University of Akron football program on Dec. 4, 2021.

In his third season at Akron, Moorhead secured back-to-back Wagon Wheel victories as the Zips posted a 4-8 overall record and 3-5 in MAC play. Akron ended the season on a two-game winning streak. The Zips won the rivalry game at Kent State (38-17) and returned to Akron for an overtime win in the season finale against Toledo (21-14). For the third straight season, five Zips were named to the All-MAC squad, brining the career total to 15 (First Team - DL CJ Nunnally, IV, P Avery Book | Second Team - WR Adrian Norton, LB Bryan McCoy | Third Team - DB Paul Lewis III). Book was also named a CSC Academic All-American (first for Akron since 2016).

In his second season at Akron, Moorhead brought the Wagon Wheel back to Akron as he led the Zips to a 2-10 overall record and 1-7 in MAC play. The Zips continued the trend of being competitive as Akron dropped five games by seven points or less, including three overtime games against Indiana (40T), Eastern Michigan (3 OT) and Buffalo (OT). Five Zips were named to the All-MAC squad, brining the total (First Team - DL CJ Nunnally, IV | Second Team - WR Jasaiah Gathings, WR Daniel George | Third Team - LB Bryan McCoy, S KJ Martin).

In his first season with the Zips, Moorhead led the Zips to a 2-10 overall record and 1-7 in MAC play. The Zips ability to be competitive and be in a position to win games was evident as Akron dropped five of-the final eight games by seven points or less. Five players were named to the All-MAC team (First-Team - LB Bubba Arslanian, WR Alex Adams | Third-team - QB DJ Irons, WR Shocky Jacques-Louis and OL Anthony Whigan).

A native of Pittsburgh, Moorhead returns to the Midwest, where he was a member of the Zips coaching staff from 2004-08, including serving as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2006-2008.

Moorhead, who has spent two seasons as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Oregon, has a proven track record of success over his nearly quarter century in coaching, including six seasons as a head coach at Mississippi State (2018-19) and Fordham University (2012-15).

Moorhead has been the play-caller for five programs that have won a conference championship, including Oregon (2020), Penn State (2016), Fordham (2014), Connecticut (2010) and Akron (2005).

Moorhead has played an integral role in player development during his coaching career, including mentoring 20 players who have been chosen in the previous five NFL drafts. Among those selections were four first-round picks, headlined by New York Giants running back Saquon Barkley, who was named the Associated Press Offensive Rookie of the Year in 2019.

Moorhead guided Oregon's offensive efforts in 2021 in his 14th season as a team's primary offensive play-caller in the last 15 years. He played a key role in the success of the Oregon football team last fall, a 10-4 squad that played in its third consecutive Pac-12 Championship Game before competing at the Valero Alamo Bowl against No. 16 Oklahoma.

Moorhead directed the Ducks' offense to success last fall as Oregon ranked 42nd in the NCAA with 31.4 points per game and 50th with 423.6 yards of total offense per contest. Moorhead's unit was even more impressive on the ground as the Ducks rated 24th nationally with 202.4 rushing yards per tilt, including 36 rushing touchdowns, a total that ranked sixth in the NCAA in 2021.

Moorhead came to Oregon from Mississippi State, where he served as head coach during the 2018 and 2019 campaigns. He led the Bulldogs to back-to-back bowl appearances, the first Mississippi State head coach to do so in their first two seasons in program history, while also sparking the Bulldogs to a pair of triumphs over rival Ole Miss, claiming the Golden Egg Trophy both seasons.

Prior to his time at Mississippi State, Moorhead spent a pair of seasons at Penn State (2016-17), where the Nittany Lion offense averaged 39.3 points per game, including scoring 30 or more points 21 times, a mark that represents the third-highest total in the NCAA from 2016-17. He was honored as National Offensive Coordinator of the Year in each of the two seasons in State College.

Moorhead spent four seasons as the head coach at Fordham, compiling a 38-13 record from 2012-15. After taking over a program that was 1-10 in 2011, Moorhead led the Rams to a 12-2 record, the best season in program history in 2013 and the Patriot League title in 2014.

Fordham reached the FCS playoffs the last three seasons under his leadership while compiling a 32-8 record. The Rams reached the highest ranking in program history, No. 5 in 2013, and the highest final in program history, No. 9 in 2013 and 2014, while recording the first two wins over FBS schools in program history.

In 2013, Moorhead earned AFCA Regional Co-Coach of the Year and Patriot League Coach of the Year honors and was also a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award and the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year.

Moorhead served as the assistant head coach, pass game and recruiting coordinator on Akron's Mid-American Conference championship team in 2005 when the Zips claimed the MAC Eastern Division title and then edged Northern Illinois in the MAC Championship Game, 31-30, to secure the school's first-ever bowl appearance.

Moorhead is a graduate of Fordham University, where he earned a bachelor's degree in English in 1996. A team captain and three-year starter at quarterback, he garnered second-team All-Patriot League accolades as a senior en route to ranking 13th nationally in total offense.

Moorhead and his wife, Jennifer, have three children: daughter Kyra, and sons Mason and Donovan.




