Facilities: 10-point, 50 foot Smallbore Range and separate 8-point, 10 meter Air Rifle Range: [Both ranges](#) are equipped with new state of the art [Sius electronic scoring systems](#). All matches will be live streamed at [www.shooteronline.net](#) .

Relays: Each relay will consist of a maximum of 10 competitors on the smallbore range and a maximum of 8 competitors on the air rifle range. Both ranges will be operated concurrently.

Course of Fire: One USA Shooting 3x20 Smallbore match (60 shots in 90 minutes, Kneeling, Prone then Standing) scored in whole number. One International Air Rifle match (60 shots in 75 minutes) scored in decimal will be fired and counted for both individual and team scores. Teams do not have to fire as a unit. All teams must be declared prior to the first shot fired by a designated team member.



Air rifle and pistol is an approved USAS ranking match.

USA Shooting Ranking Match Statement: "An athlete can only shoot one ranking score per day. If more than one score is fired on the same day only the first score will count toward the ranking list."

Rules: The current [USA/ ISSF Rifle Rules](#) will be followed.

Targets: [Sius Electronic Scoring System](#) will be used with the current USA 50ft and USA 10m air rifle target specifications.

Teams: Team categories will be Collegiate Club, junior/scholastic and open. "Shoot 5, count 4" will be used for all team scores, or shoot 4 count 4 if you only have 4 team members.

Coaching: Nonverbal coaching is **permitted**.

Entries: Advance registration is required, and relay assignments will be assigned in the order they are received.

Entry Fees: Please pay match fees on your date of competition via credit card, cash or check. Make checks payable to: The University of Akron
Individuals competing in one discipline/gun only----- \$25.00
Individuals competing in both Air and Smallbore----- \$40.00
Teams may be declared for no additional fee.
One Tee-shirt for each competitor will be included in the match fees.

A 50% cancelation fee will be charged after March 14th
