QUICK HITTERS

- Under Coach Groce, the Zips have posted a 147-57 overall record since the 2019-20 season and a 85-27 conference record in that same span.
- Under coach Groce, Akron is 113-15 (.883) at home.
- Akron recorded its 800th win at the Div. I level against Concord on Dec. 29, 2025.
- Since 2009, Akron has claimed the MAC Regular Season and Tournament title six times each. Akron has made back-to-back NCAA Tournament Appearances behind a pair of MAC Tournament titles (2024+25).
- With the 2025 MAC Tournament title, coach Groce is tied with former Zips' coach Keith Dambrot for the most tournament titles (3) by one coach in Akron's Div. I history.
- Akron has made at least one 3-pointer in its last 818 games when it was held without a 3-pointer against Purdue in the 2000-01 season.
- Akron earned its sixth NCAA appearance with its fifth MAC Championship on March 16, 2025.
- Enrique Freeman became the first Akron player to be selected in the modern two-round NBA Draft era as the Indiana Pacers selected him with the 50th overall pick (2nd round) on June 27, 2024.

WHAT'S AHEAD

The Akron Zips battle the Miami RedHawks on Saturday, January 3 at 3:30 p.m. for the 74th all-time meeting between the two schools.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Saturday's game marks the 74th meeting in series history between Akron and Miami, and 25th meeting for a Groce coached squad (17-7), 16th at Akron (11-4). Akron leads the series 40-33, and the Zips have won 11 of the last 12 meetings, including a sweep in 2022 the lone meetings in 2023 and twice in 2025 with the Blue and Gold coming up victorious 76-74 in the MAC Championship. Akron took the lone regular season meeting in 2024-25 with a 102-75 victory at the JAR on January 25. The Zips fell to the RedHawks on the road in the first meeting in 2023-24, 70-68 on January 27 before defeating the RedHawks in the MAC Tournament 75-63. Akron is 23-9 at home, 4-1 at neutral site courts and 13-23 in Oxford.

LAST TIME OUT (VS CONCORD 12/29/25)

AKRON, OHIO - Tavori Johnson became the 50th Zip in program history to record 1,000 points and the Akron men's basketball team recorded its 800th win at the Div. I level with a 115-64 victory over the Concord Mountain Lions at James A. Rhodes Arena on Monday.

The last Zip to reach the 1,000 point milestone was Ali Ali, who scored his 1,000th point as a Zip in the 2023-24 season.

Akron recorded its 23rd consecutive win at the JAR while also notching its ninth game of the season with 10 or 3's and seventh game with 20 or more assists.

It was also the fifth game this season that the Blue and Gold scored 100 or more points in a game.

The Zips (10-3) had four players score in double figures, led by Johnson, who had 28 points, six assists and three steals. Evan Mahaffey added a career-high 18 points and three steals, Shammah Scott added 12 points, five assists and three rebounds from the bench while Amani Lyles recorded 12 points, seven rebounds and four assists, two steals and one block.

Akron out-rebounded Concord 41-31 in Monday's game, led by Lyles' seven boards.

The Akron defense held Concord shooters to just 33.3 percent from the field.

Akron started out the scoring by going on a 13-0 run, culminating in a bucket from Lyles, to take an early lead with 16:41 left in the first half. The Zips then added nine points to that lead by the end of the period and entered halftime with a 47-25 advantage. Akron did most of its first half damage in the paint, scoring 28 of its 47 points close to the basket.

Following the intermission, Akron kept widening that lead, expanding it to 90-56 before going on a 15-0 run, finished off by Ognjen Stankovic's layup, to grow the lead to 105-56 with 3:11 to go in the contest. The Zips kept expanding the margin and coasted the rest of the way for the 115-64 win. Akron took care of business in the paint, recording 44 of its 68 points in the lane.

LAST TIME AGAINST MIAMI (3/15/25)

CLEVELAND, Ohio - Nate Johnson hit a buzzer-beating shot with only two seconds left on the clock to lead the Akron men's basketball team over Miami, 76-74, to capture the program's sixth Mid-American Conference Tournament title and seventh NCAA Tournament berth at Rocket Arena on Saturday (March 15).

The Zips (28-6) had two players score in double figures, led by Nate Johnson, who had 22 points and five assists. Junior Tavori Johnson tacked on 15 points and junior Amani Lyles added six points and 14 rebounds.

Akron out-rebounded Miami, 35-26, in Saturday's game, paced by Lyles' 14 boards. The Zips also grabbed 13 offensive rebounds and scored seven second-chance points.

Akron narrowed its deficit late in the second half to 72-67 before going on a 7-0 run to seize a 74-72 lead with 1:05 to go in the contest. The Zips held onto that lead for the rest of the game for the 76-74 win. Akron shot well from three-point range in the half, hitting seven shots from deep to score 21 of its 42 points.

Akron is 1-1 in road contest this season, falling to No. 2/1 Purdue while defeating Tulane.

The Zips were 8-4 on the road in 2024-25.

ZIPS AT A GLANCE

Akron returns to Mid-American Conference action when it travels to Oxford, Ohio, to battle the Miami RedHawks.

The Zips enter Saturday's contest with a 10-3 overall record and a 1-0 record in the MAC.

The Blue and Gold recorded its fifth game this season with 100 or more points when it took down Concord at the JAR 115-64 on Dec. 29. Tavari Johnson led the Zips in scoring with 28 points and became the 50th 1,000-point scorer in program history.

Johnson leads the Blue and Gold in scoring (20.5) and assists (5.1). Amani Lyles leads Akron in rebounding (6.5) while Evan Mahaffey leads the way in steals (1.7). Chabi Barre holds the top mark for blocks (10) so far this season.

Akron is scoring 97.1 points per game while outscoring its opponents by 20.2 points per game. The Zips shoot .532 from the field while shooting .386 from beyond the arc and average 10.8 3-pointers per game. The Blue and Gold hold a .754 ft percentage while averaging 39.1 rebounds, 21.1 assists, 9.8 turnovers, 8.0 steals and 3.5 blocks per game.

Akron ranks in the top five in the MAC in scoring offense (1st - 97.1), scoring margin (3rd - +20.2), fg pct (2nd - .532), fg pct defense (3rd - .421), 3pt pct (3rd - .386), 3pters made per game (3rd - 10.8), ft pct (3rd - .754), rebounds (3rd - 39.1), off rebounds (4th - 12.0), def rebounds (3rd - 27.1), reb margin (4th - +5.3), turnover margin (2nd - +4.69), assist-turnover ratio (1st - +2.16), blocked shots (4th - 3.54), assists (1st - 21.08) and steals (2nd - 8.00).

The Zips rank 1st in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (+2.16), 4th in assists per game (21.1), 77th in bench points per game (29.62), 5th in effective fg pct (.612), 19th in fastbreak points (.612), 4th in fg pct (.532), 50th in fewest fouls per game (15.6), 67th in ft pct (.754), 94th in rebound margin (+5.2), 88th in def. rebounds (27.00), 83rd in rebounds per game (39.0), 17th in scoring margin (+20.2), 2nd in scoring offense (97.1), 99th in steals per game (8.0), 21st in 3pt pct (.386), 27th in 3pters made per game (10.8), 17th in turnover margin (+4.8), 65th in turnovers forced per game (14.54), and 23rd in fewest turnovers per game (9.8).

Individually, Evan Mahaffey is 7th in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (4.64). Tavari Johnson is 28th in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (3.47), 79th in fg attempts (180), 73rd in fg pct (.561), 16th in made fg (101), 45th in ft pct (.895), 37th in total points (266) and 27th in points per game (20.5). Shammah Scott is 56th in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (3.00). Amani Lyles is 29th in fg pct (.613).

SCOUTING THE REDHAWKS

The Miami RedHawks enter Saturday with a 14-0 overall record and a 2-0 record in the MAC.

The RedHawks' 14-game winning streak is the second longest in the nation behind Nebraska's 17-game streak, which stretches back to 2025 when they captured the College Basketball Crown title in Las Vegas, Nev. Miami is also on a 22-game home winning streak.

Miami recently defeated Bowling Green, 93-83, on December 30. Brant Byers and Peter Suder each led the RedHawks with 17 points, while Luke Skaljac (15) and Antwone Woolfolk (14) added double figures in scoring. The RedHawks were 22-of-24 from the free-throw line while shooting 54.5 percent from the field.

Byers leads the RedHawks in scoring (14.6) while Skaljac is the leader in assists (4.2). Eian Elmer serves as the leading rebounder (5.9), Woolfolk leads the squad in steals (1.5), while Tyler Robbins leads the way in total blocks (13).

Miami is scoring 94.9 points per game while outscoring its opponents by 23.0 points per game. The RedHawks shoot .546 from the field while shooting .439 from beyond the arc and average 11.0 3-pointers per game. Miami holds a .778 ft percentage while averaging 36.7 rebounds, 18.1 assists, 11.0 turnovers, 7.6 steals and 3.3 blocks per game.

Miami ranks in the top five in the MAC in scoring offense (2nd - 94.9), scoring defense (5th - 71.9), scoring margin (1st - 23.0), fg pct (1st - .546), fg pct defense (2nd - .416), 3pt pct (1st - .439), opp 3pt pct (2nd - .310), 3pters made per game (1st - 11.8), ft pct (1st - .778), opp rebounds (1st - 31.1), def rebounds (1st - 28.5), reb margin (3rd - +5.6), turnover margin (4th - +2.71), assist-turnover ratio (2nd - 1.64) and assists (3rd - 18.07).

The RedHawks rank 35th in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (+1.64), 37th in assists per game (18.1), 22nd in bench points per game (35.36), 1st in effective fg pct (.643), 1st in fg pct (.546), 93rd in fg defense (.416), 75th in fewest fouls per game (16.1), 14th in ft pct (.778), 92nd in made ft per game (17.0), 81st in rebound margin (+5.6), 29th in def. rebounds (28.5), 11th in scoring margin (+23.0), 7th in scoring offense (94.9), 1st in 3pt pct (.439), 90th in 3pt defense (.310), 5th in 3pters made per game (11.8), 68th in turnover margin (+2.7), and 89th for fewest turnovers per game (11.0).

Individually, Luke Skaljac ranks 29th in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (+3.47). Evan Ipsaro ranks 93rd in the NCAA in assist-turnover ratio (+2.60). Brant Byers ranks 30th in 3pt pct (.443).

AKRON IN THE MAC

Akron is 83-26 since the 2019-20 season in MAC play, owning the highest winning percentage (.761) in the league. The Zips are 69-23 in the MAC under the new conference format without divisions (new in 2020-21). Akron is 110-28 (.797) at home in league play since the start of the 2011 MAC schedule. UA has seen a ton of success in league play since the start of the 2004-05 season, and is 252-109 overall (.698), including a 152-32 mark in MAC play at home (.826). The Zips' 252 wins are the most in the league during that stretch. The Zips have won 167 of their last 252 MAC games (.663).

HOME SWEET HOME

The Zips own a 491-136 (.783) all-time record at the James A. Rhodes Arena. In the last 21 seasons, Akron has posted a 287-40 (.878) record at the JAR. Akron is currently on a 23-game winning streak at the JAR dating back to the 2024-25 season, which currently is the third longest home winning streak in the country. Saint Thomas currently has won 25 straight to lead the nation. Duke is second with 24 while Akron is third with 23 straight home wins. Miami (OH) is close behind with 22 straight home wins.

Under coach Groce, Akron is 112-15 (.882) at home. The Zips were 15-1 at home in 2022-23, 13-1 in 2023-24, 16-0 at the JAR in 2024-25 and are 7-0 in 2025-26.

Akron owns a 103-21 (.831) home-opening record and 39-4 (.907) at Rhodes Arena. The Zips have been winners in the last 23-of-24 home opening games. Akron is 26-8 in MAC openers, and 13-1 at home since joining the league in 1992. Over the last 19 seasons, the Zips are 16-3 in MAC openers and 8-1 at home. Akron has won the last 10-of-11 MAC openers.

Akron went 12-4 at Rhodes Arena in Groce's first year as head coach and followed with a 14-3 effort. The Zips went 15-2 at home in 2019-20 en route to the regular season MAC Championship. The Zips set the all-time longest home winning streak record at Rhodes Arena with 30 consecutive wins during the 2015-17 seasons, replacing the 26-game run the Zips made during the 1985-87 seasons under head coach Bob Huggins. The streak ranked No. 2 in the NCAA.

TAVARI JOHNSON: DOING A BIT OF EVERYTHING

Tavari Johnson has shown a knack for not only scoring but distributing the ball.

The senior guard has scored in double-figures 12 times, and has recorded 10 or more points in 10 consecutive games, this season while scoring 15 or more points in 10 games. Johnson has recorded five or more assists in eight games, setting a new career-high of 11 assists against Milwaukee, and has led Akron in assists in six game.

Johnson is averaging 20.5 points per game, with a career-high 35 coming against Yale in the Paradise Jam. He is also averaging 5.1 assists, 2.1 rebounds and 1.4 steals per game.

Tavari was named to the Early Season Lou Henson All-America Watch list on Dec. 18, 2025.

Named to the All-MAC First Team and All-Tournament team last season, Tavari was named to the Preseason All-MAC First Team this year. Last season for the Blue and Gold he appeared and started all 35 games, averaging 24.7 minutes per game. He averaged 13 points per game, scored 20+ points in seven games, scored in double figures in 24 games and scored a then career-high 27 points against Northern Kentucky (12/3/24).

Johnson recorded 3.8 assists per game for a team-high 133. He recorded a career-high 10 assists at Eastern Michigan (1/11/25) and led the Zips in assists in 17 games.

CLOSING IN ON THE TOP 10 FOR ASSISTS

Tavari Johnson currently has 291 career assists as a Zip. He is 10 away from passing Joe Jakubick's (1980-84) 300 career assists for 10th all time. Steve McNees (2007-11) is 9th all-time with 318 assists.

1K SCORING AS A ZIP AND CLIMBING

Tavari Johnson recorded his 1,000th career point wearing the Akron Blue and Gold against Concord on Dec. 29, 2025 with a 28 point performance. He became the 50th player in program history to record 1k points. Sam Serves (1942-47) is No. 49 on the all-time scoring list with 1,013 points.

AMONG THE BEST IN THE MID-MAJORS

The Zips rose to No. 2 in the Collegelinsider.com Mid-Major Poll after winning games against South Dakota State and Southern Mississippi to begin the 2023-24 season on November 13. The Zips claimed their highest ranking in program history in the Mid-Major rankings.

In addition the Zips No. 2 (Nov. 13) ranking is the highest ranking since the 2016-17 season when the Zips climbed to No. 7 on Jan. 30, 2017.

1K POINTS, 300 ASSISTS

Tavari Johnson stands at 1,000 points and 291 assists in his time at Akron. He'd become the first player since Loren Cristian Jackson to record 1k points and at least 300 assists in his career as a Zip and just the eighth player all-time.

SIXTH MAN OF THE YEAR TO STARTING 5

Shammah Scott was named the Mid-American Conference's Sixth Man of the Year in 2024-25 and has moved into a starting role in 2025-26.

Scott has shown a balanced game, averaging 12.4 points per game, 3.2 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 0.4 steals per game. He has scored in double-figures seven times this season while recording 5+ assists in four games. He set a career-high in scoring against Yale in the Paradise Jam with 25 points falling on a 9-of-12 night. Scott has led the Zips in scoring twice this season while leading in assists three times.

He made 34 appearances last season, where he averaged 24.4 minutes per game. He averaged 9.4 points per game while scoring in double figures in 19 games with a season-high 18 coming at Ball State (2/25/25). He also dished out 2.68 assists per game last season, where he recorded a career-high seven assists at Ohio (2/22/25).

AMANI LYLES: AN AKRON GUY

A four-year member of the Zips, Amani Lyles has shown tremendous growth since first coming to the Rubber City.

The veteran big man averages 15.2 points per game while adding 6.5 rebounds, 1.0 steals and 2.7 assists per game. He has also recorded nine blocks this season.

Amani has scored in double figures 11 times and scored 15 or more points seven times this season. Lyles set a new career-high in scoring (25) against Milwaukee. He's led the team in rebounding seven times and recorded 5+ assists three times.

Lyles appeared in 34 games last season and averaged 18.1 minutes per game. He averaged 7.6 points per game and recorded a career-high 17 against Ohio (1/17/25+2/22/25). He also scored in double-figures 13 times while averaging 5.2 rebounds per game, leading the Zips in rebounds seven times. He recorded a career-high 14 rebounds against Miami in the MAC Championship game (3/15/25). Amani also led Akron in blocks with 42 total, recording a career-high four blocks at Buffalo (1/21/25).

THE MAHAFFEY BROTHERS

Evan and Eric Mahaffey have been a dynamic duo for the Zips this season. The brothers average a combined 19.1 points per game, with Evan scoring 10.9 and Eric scoring 8.2. The Mahaffey's average 10.9 rebounds with Eric currently averaging 5.8 and Evan with 5.1 per game. The brothers combine for 5.6 assists per game as well.

Evan has notched double-figure scoring in 10 games this season, 5+ assists in four games, has led the team in rebounds in three, and has led the team in assists three times. Eric has scored in double-figures five times with a season-high 20 points against Iona while leading Akron in rebounds six time. He has recorded 5+ assists in one game this season.

ADD ANOTHER RECORD TO THE LIST

The Zips won a program record 28 games in 2024-25 with a 76-74 victory over Miami in the MAC Championship game. The previous record (27) was set by the 2016-17 squad.

MOST WINS IN THE REGULAR SEASON

The 2024-25 Akron squad set a program record for most regular season wins (25) after defeating Buffalo 88-70 on Mar. 7 to conclude the regular season. The previous record (24) was reached most recently by 2006-07 and 2019-20 teams.

PERFECT AT HOME

Out of the 364 Div. I basketball teams, just six went perfect at home in 2024-25. One of those teams were the Akron Zips, who finished the regular season with a 16-0 record at their home crib. Akron was the only team in the MAC to post a perfect home record. One team that Akron played, Yale (11-0), was among the six teams to post a perfect record at home. New Orleans (Southland) was the only school to not win at home. On the flip side, just Houston was the only school to go perfect on the road (10-0).

PROTECT THE JAR!

The 2024-25 Akron squad became just the fourth team to go undefeated at the JAR after finishing the season 16-0. The previous three teams to go undefeated at the JAR were the 1986-87 (18-0), 2005-06 (13-0) and the 2015-16 (15-0) squads.

REGULAR AND TOURNAMENT CHAMPS

The Zips took home the regular season title and conference tournament title in 2024-25. It was the first time since 2013 that Akron has won both titles.

A LOT OF HARDWARE IN A SHORT TIME

Akron has taken home five MAC trophies since 2020. The Zips won the regular season title in 2020 and 2025 while winning the conference tournament in 2022, 2024 and 2025.

LIMITED EDITION

The 2024-25 Zips became just the second team in Mid-American Conference history to finish the regular season with a 17-1 record, which is the best mark in the modern era of the MAC. Kent State was the first team to reach that mark when they went 17-1 in the 2001-02 season.

WHAT IS A ZIP?

- One of the unique nicknames in collegiate athletics belongs to The University of Akron.
- Originally Zippers, athletic director Kenneth "Red" Cochrane officially shortened the nickname to the Zips in 1950. Twenty-five years earlier a campus-wide contest had been conducted to choose a nickname for the University's athletics teams.
- Suggestions submitted by students, faculty, and alumni included GoldenBlue Devils, Tip Toppers, Rubbernecks, Hillbillies, Kangaroos, and Cheveliers.
- The winner, freshman Margaret Hamlin, received a prize of \$10 for Zippers, a \$6 pair of rubber overshoes and a brand name of the BF Goodrich Company.
- The evolution of Zippy, UA's mascot, began 40 years ago when the student council decided the University needed a mascot.
- "Zippy" the kangaroo was officially declared the school's mascot on May 1, 1953. The first known printed reference to the mascot as "Zippy" was a 1965 Zip football press brochure. The Buchtelite's first use of the name "Zippy" came Sept. 24, 1965, in an identification of a photo of the cheerleaders listing "Mascot - 'Zippy' - Charles Huettner."
- In 2007 and 2024 Zippy was named the Capital One National Mascot of the Year.

GROCE DEBUTS WITH A WIN

Zips' head coach John Groce has spent over two decades on the sidelines of a basketball court as a coach and enters his 18th season as the lead man, and eighth at Akron. On April 6, 2017, Groce was named the 22nd head coach in Akron Basketball history.

On Nov. 11, 2017, Groce and the Zips accomplished something that has only been done 10 times in Akron's history, debuting a coaching career with a win. Akron defeated Cleveland State 67-57 in Groce's Akron coaching debut to become the first coach since the 1984-85 season to win their initial game.

In fact, the last coach to start his Akron career with a win was Bob Huggins during the 1984-85 season against Western Illinois, 64-57. Prior to Huggins, six coaches were unsuccessful in accomplishing that feat since Thomas Dowler did so in 1939-40 against Franklin, 34-25.

THE SPARK PLUGS OFF THE BENCH

Serving as the first man off the bench, Sharron Young has been electric this season after coming off an All-MAC Freshman team selection in 2024-25.

Young is currently averaging 8.5 points per game with a career-high 20 points coming against Murray State. He is averaging 2.9 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 0.8 steals per game. Young has scored in double-figures four times this season.

Young made 35 appearances last season, where he averaged 16 minutes per game. Averaging 7.4 points his freshman season, he scored in double figures in 11 games and scored a season-high 18 points against Ball State (2/4/25).

Bowen Hardman has been one of the go to guys off the bench for the Zips the past two seasons, and has excelled at the 3-point shot since coming from Ohio State.

Scoring in double figures three times this season, Hardman averages 8.1 points this season with a .364 percentage from beyond the arc. He is currently third on the squad for made 3's (28) and holds an .833 mark at the free throw line. He has also made at least one 3-point shot in 13 consecutive games.

2024-25 saw Hardman appear in 35 games while making three starts. He averaged 6.6 points per game while leading the Blue and Gold in made 3's with 66. He scored in double-figures nine times, scored 15 or more points in four games and led the Zips in scoring three times with a career-high 20 points falling against SUNY Brockport (Dec. 7, 2024).

HIGH OCTANE OFFENSE

One of the nation's top scoring team's, Akron ranks in the top 10 in scoring offense (2nd - 97.1). The Zips are 10-2 this season when scoring 85 or more points. The most recent game this season to feature 85 or more points was 115 against Concord on Dec. 29.

Akron scored 85 or more points in 19 games in 2024-25, were 19-0 when hitting that mark and finished ranked No.8 in the nation in scoring offense (84.0).

Under John Groce, Akron is 61-5 (.924) when scoring 85 or more points.

DISHING OUT DIMES

Ranking in the top 10 in assists per game in the NCAA (4th - 21.1), the Zips aren't afraid to share the rock. Akron has recorded 20 or more assists in seven games with a season high 32 coming against PSU Shenango (Nov. 12). The most recent game with 20+ assists was against Concord (23) on Dec 29.

The Zips are 7-0 this season when recording 20 or more assists and 34-0 with John Groce leading the Blue and Gold.

Akron is also one of the top teams in the country when it comes to assist-turnover ratio, ranking no. 1 (+2.16).

The Zips ranked 4th in the nation in assists per game (17.7) last season. The Blue and Gold recorded 20 or more assists in 15 games with a season high 28 coming against Ohio Wesleyan (11/8/24).

LONG RANGE ARTILLERY

The Zips currently feature five players with 15 or more made 3's this season and three players with 25 or more made triples. Tavari Johnson leads the list with 30 while Shammah Scott (29), Bowen Hardman (28), Sharron Young (18) and Amani Lyles (17) round out the list.

Hardman is on a 13-game streak with at least one made 3-pointer, which currently stands as the season high.

PRESEASON HONORS

Coming off a Mid-American Conference Regular Season and Tournament title, the Akron men's basketball team was predicted to finish first in the MAC Preseason Coaches' Poll while three Zips were named to the Preseason All-MAC team, the conference office announced Tuesday, October 21.

Akron was tabbed to finish first with 11 first-place votes and 143 points. Miami was picked to finish second with the final two first-place votes and 133 points, while Kent State was picked to finish third after receiving 122 points.

Tayari Johnson, a 2025 All-MAC First Team selection, was named to the Preseason All-MAC First Team. Johnson was also named to the 2025 All-MAC Tournament Team, was named a finalist for the Nolan Richardson Award and was named to the NABC East District Second Team. He appeared and started all 35 games while averaging 24.7 minutes per game. Johnson also averaged 13.0 points per game, scored 20+ points in seven games, scored in double figures in 24 games and led the Zips in assists in 17 games.

Shammah Scott, the 2025 MAC Sixth Man of the Year, and newcomer Evan Mahaffey were named to the Preseason All-MAC Second Team. Scott appeared in 34 games, starting one while averaging 24.4 minutes per game. He averaged 9.4 points, scored in double figures in 19 games and compiled a season-high 18 points at Ball State (2/25/25).

Mahaffey, the older brother of current Zip Eric Mahaffey, is a 6'6" perimeter player from Cincinnati, Ohio, who played at Archbishop Moeller High School prior to stints with Penn State and Ohio State. At Ohio State, he played in 68 games while starting 38 and averaged 20 minutes per game over the last two seasons. He shot over 67 percent from the field last season, tallying 114 points, 98 rebounds, 28 blocks and 27 assists. As a true freshman, Mahaffey made 34 appearances for the Nittany Lions, including both NCAA Tournament games against Texas A&M and Texas.

RAINING 3'S

Ranking in the top 30 for made 3's per game (27th- 10.8), Akron has been one of the top 3-point shooting teams in the country the past couple of seasons. The Zips have made 10 or more 3pters in nine games this season, with a season-high 15 falling against Princeton.

Akron is 7-2 this season when hitting 10 or more 3's and went 18-2 in during the 2024-25 season. Under the direction of John Groce, Akron is 95-22 (.812) when making 10 or more 3's.

Akron ranked 8th in the nation for made 3's per game in 2024-25 (10.7). The Blue and Gold hit 10 or more 3's in 20 games, 15 or more in six, while connecting on 19 3's against South Alabama (Feb. 8), which is the second most in program history.

FOUR OR MORE

The Zips have had four or more players score in double-figure scoring in nine game this season. The most recent game with four or more Zips scoring in double figures happened on Dec. 29 when four Zips scored 10 or more points against Concord. The season-high was seven Zips on Nov. 29 against Milwaukee.

Akron had four or more players record double-figure scoring in 21 games in the 2024-25 season. The season high was seven players scoring 10 or more points against SUNY Brockport (Dec. 7) and Eastern Michigan (Jan. 11).

THE SENIOR CLASS: A WHOLE LOT OF WINNING

Akron's senior class has seen a great deal of success wearing the Blue and Gold. Since the 2022-23 season, the Zips have gone 84-32 (.724) overall and 44-11 (.800) in the MAC. Akron has also claimed the MAC Regular Season Title (2025) and MAC Tournament Title (2024+25) in that span as well.

SINCE 19-20

Since the 2019-20 season, Akron has recorded a 147-57 (.720) overall record and an 84-27 (.757) record in the MAC. The Zips have claimed the MAC Regular Season Title twice ('20, '25) and the MAC Tournament Title three times as well ('22, '24-'25).

20-POINT PERFORMANCES

The Zips have seen five Zips record 20 or more points in a game this season. Tavari Johnson leads the way with seven games while scoring a career-high 35 points against Yale. Amani Lyles has three games while scoring a career-high 25 against Milwaukee. Shammah Scott has two game while scoring a career-high 25 against Yale. Eric Mahaffey has one game while scoring a career-high 20 points against Iona. Sharron Young has one game while scoring a career-high 20 against Murray State.

A WISE MAN SAID "IT TAKES A VILLAGE"

The Zips have seen scoring come from multiple avenues with seven players averaging eight or more points per game while four Zips average 10 or more points. The Blue and Gold have also seen 5 different Zips lead the squad in scoring this season.

THE ZIPS AND 50

Through 13 games, Akron has scored 50 or more points in a half 10 times.

FRESH COAT OF PAINT

A prolific 3-point shooting team, the Zips have also shown the ability to beat teams in the paint. Akron has scored 40 or more points in the paint 10 times and 50 or more points five times. Akron produced a season-high 72 points in the paint against Concord on Dec. 29, 2025

A HALF DOESN'T MAKE A GAME, BUT...

The Zips are 9-0 when leading at the half compared to a 1-3 record when trailing at the half.

PLAYING WITH THE LEAD

In all but one of the Zips wins this season, the Blue and Gold have led for 30 or more minutes.

THE SMALL THINGS ADD UP

The Zips are 10-0 when shooting better than their opponent from the field, 10-1 when shooting 50% or above from the field, 6-1 when shooting 40% or better from 3-point range, 10-0 when out rebounding their opponents, 8-0 when attempting more FT, 9-0 when holding opponents below 80 points and 10-2 when scoring 85 points or more.

HOW COACH GROCE STACKS UP AT AKRON

John Groce currently has 178 wins as the head coach at Akron. He currently stands tied for the third most wins in program history and is just the fourth coach in Akron history to record 150 or more wins as a Zip.

IN THE ASSOCIATION

Enrique Freeman became the first Akron player to be selected in the modern two-round NBA Draft era as the Indiana Pacers selected him with the 50th overall pick (2nd round) on June 27, 2024.

He became the seventh Zip to be drafted in the NBA Draft, joining Louis Arko (Syracuse Nationals, 1950), Bill Turner (Golden State Warriors, 1967), Len Paul (Detroit Pistons, 1973), Nate Barnett (Houston Rockets, 1975), Joe Jakubic (Cleveland Cavaliers, 1984) and Marcel Boyce (Phoenix Suns, 1987). In addition, Fred "Fritz" Nagy (Pittsburgh Ironmen, 1947) and Joe Wahl (Philadelphia Warriors, 1948) were selected to the Basketball Association of America that existed for three seasons and merged with the NBA in 1949.

MAC-SBC CHALLENGE

This will mark the third season the Mid-American and Sun Belt Conferences will battle in the MAC-SBC Challenge. Akron is 3-2 all-time in the challenge with a perfect record at home.

Akron has picked up wins over Southern Miss (2023-24), South Alabama (2024-25) and James Madison (2025-26) at the JAR while falling to James Madison (2023-24) and Arkansas State (2024-25) on the road.

FATHER-SON COMBO

Akron is one of 24 schools this season to have a father coach their son. The Zips are joined by Auburn, Canisius, Central Arkansas, Chicago State, Dayton, Elon, George Mason, Indiana, Jackson State, Lehigh, Memphis, Nebraska, North Carolina, North Texas, Northern Iowa, Notre Dame, Ohio, Saint Louis, St. Thomas, St. Thomas, Towson, Troy and Wisconsin.

BROTHERS TEAMING UP

The Zips' Eric and Evan Mahaffey are one of 17 sets of brothers playing on the same team this season. Akron is joined by UT Martin, Duke, Northern Iowa, St. Thomas, Campbell, Troy, Delaware, Furman, Florida Gulf Coast, Michigan State, Florida, Illinois, Oakland, North Dakota and Southern Illinois.

GROCE & 20 WINS

Not including the shortened 2020-21 season, John Groce has won at least 20 games in all but two seasons leading the Zips, which includes four consecutive (2021-22 - 2024-25). In total, Groce has won at least 20 games nine times as a head coach (5 at Akron, 2 at Illinois, 2 at Ohio).

HOT START TO #MACTION

The Zips started the 2025 MAC schedule with 13 straight wins before falling at Ohio on Feb. 22. The 13 wins to begin conference action is the best start for a UA-led John Groce squad.

The last, and only other time, the Zips started 13-0 was back in 2012-13. The 2012-13 squad finished 26-7 overall and 14-2 in the MAC. Akron holds the best start to MAC play at 13-0 with both the 2012-13 and 2024-25 squads hitting that mark.

Kent State (2001-02) and Toledo (2022-23) hold the conference record for most consecutive MAC wins with 15 each. The Rockets' regular season MAC win streak eventually ended with a total of 20 in a row, spanning from January, 14 2023 to January 16, 2024.

OPENING MAC PLAY

Akron is 26-8 in MAC openers since joining the league in 1992. Over the last 20 seasons, the Zips are 17-3 in MAC openers. Akron has won the last 17-of-18 MAC openers, including an 8-1 mark under head coach John Groce. The Zips fell in Groce's initial MAC opener, but have won seven straight.

ON NATIONAL TV

The Zips are 0-1 this season in national televised games after falling to Purdue (Big Ten Network).

Akron will be featured three more times on national television, with five wildcard dates to be possibly selected. Akron will be featured on CBSSN when they travel to Bowling Green (Jan. 9) and host Kent State (Jan. 30), while playing on ESPNU at Ohio (Jan. 23).

The remaining dates will be announced 21 days prior to the contests, which may affect five game dates for Akron, including three home games against Toledo (Jan. 27), UMass (Feb. 13) and NIU (March 6), as well as a pair of road games at Ball State (Feb. 20) and Kent State (Feb. 27).

Akron went 6-2 on the national stage in 2024-25 with wins at Bowling Green (71-68), against Ohio (92-80) at Kent State (85-71), against Kent State (77-72), against Toledo (100-90) and against Miami (OH) (76-74). The two defeats came at Ohio (84-67) and against Arizona (93-65).

LOU HENSON EARLY SEASON WATCH LIST

University of Akron guard Tafari Johnson was named to the Lou Henson Early Season Watch List, as announced by ColleagueInsider.Com on December 18.

The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the top player in Division I college basketball.

Johnson has been one of the top performers in the Mid-American Conference this season. He is currently averaging 19.4 points, 5.0 assists, 2.1 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game. He has 20 or more points in five games this season, with a career-high 35 coming against Yale in the Paradise Jam. He is also shooting .545 from the field, while shooting above 60 percent in four of the last five games, and .426 from beyond the arc. Johnson has also recorded five or more assists in six games, with a career-high 11 coming against Milwaukee. **(Stats as of Dec. 19)**

TAVARI JOHNSON-PLAYER OF THE WEEK (12/8)

Tafari Johnson was named the Mid-American Conference Player of the Week on December 8.

Tafari was electric for the Zips this past week, helping the Blue and Gold to a 2-0 record. Johnson shot 60 percent or better from the field (.682) and beyond the arc (.600) while averaging 20.5 points per game.

He started the week with a 23-point outburst against Bucknell on an 8-of-11 (.727) shooting performance from the field and a 5-of-8 (.625) night from beyond the arc. He also added five assists, one block, one steal and one rebound to his stat line against the Bison. On the road at Tulane, he notched 18 points on a 7-of-11 (.636) shooting night while going 4-of-7 (.571) from 3-point range. He added five more assists and two rebounds in the Zips' second win of the week.

NON-CONFERENCE FOES AT THE JAR

Under John Groce, Akron is 53-1 (.981) at home against non-conference opponents. Akron is on a 42-0 run against non-conference foes at the JAR since losing to Marshall on Dec. 15, 2018.

CAREER-HIGHS AGAINST THE EAGLES

- Zach Halligan tied his career-high in points (7), rebounds (5) and made FT (3) against Eastern Michigan in his first career start at Akron.
- Evan Mahaffey recorded his first career career double-double behind a career-high 10 rebounds against Eastern Michigan.

Sharon Young set a new career-high in points against Murray State (12/13/25) with 20 points on a 6-of-8 shooting performance. He also set a career-high for made free throws with a 7-of-7 day from the line.

Eric Mahaffey set a career-high in rebounds (11) en route to his first career double-double (10 pts, 11 reb) on Dec. 6 against the Tulane Green Wave.

The 2024-25 season saw the Zips and Groce reach new heights. Akron set a program record for most wins in a single season (28) and wins in the regular season (25). The Zips also won the MAC regular season and tournament title in 2024-25, the first time since 2013 an Akron squad won both.

Groce was named the Hugh Durham Mid-Major Coach of the Year while also being named the MAC Coach of the Year. He also coached the MAC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in Nate Johnson, while Shammah Scott was named the MAC Sixth Man of the Year. N. Johnson and Tavari Johnson earned All-MAC First Team honors while Sharron Young was named to the All-Freshman Team and Isiah Gray was an All-MAC Honorable mention.

His 2024-25 squad became just the fourth team to record a perfect record at James A. Rhodes Arena after posting a 16-0 record at home. The Zips were just one of six teams to go undefeated at home this season.

In 2023-24, Groce led his squad to a Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship behind a 24-11 overall record and 13-5 conference record, the first since 2022. Defeating rival Kent State (62-61) in the MAC Championship game, the Zips advanced to the NCAA Tournament where they played Creighton in the First Round in Pittsburgh, Pa. Enrique Freeman was named the MAC Player of the Year, an All-MAC First Team and All-MAC defensive team selection while Ali Ali was named to the All-MAC First Team and Greg Tribble was named to the All-MAC Defensive Team and Honorable Mention All-MAC.

Under Groce's guidance, Freeman became the first Zip selected in the modern two-round NBA Draft era and the first since 1987. Freeman was named an honorable mention All-American by the Associated Press while being named a top-five finalist for the Karl Malone Award, a finalist for the Lou Henson National Player of the Year Award along with being named to the Oscar Robertson All-American list.

The 2022-23 season saw Groce lead the Zips to a third-place finish in the MAC where they eventually fell to Kent State in the semifinals. The Zips finished the season with a 22-11 overall record, a 13-5 conference record, and a 15-1 record at home. Akron saw Xavier Castaneda and Enrique Freeman named to the All-MAC First Team while Greg Tribble and Freeman were named to the All-MAC Defensive Team. Freeman was also a Kar Malone Award Top 10 nomination.

In 2022, The University of Akron basketball program claimed the 2022 MAC Men's Basketball Tournament Championship and advanced to the 2022 NCAA Tournament for the fifth time in program history. Akron entered the NCAA Tournament as a No. 13 seed and played against the No. 4 seed UCLA Bruins in the First Round of the East Region at the Moda Center in Portland, Oregon on March 17, 2022. The Zips fell 57-53. Akron won eight consecutive games entering the NCAA Tournament, including the last five regular season games and the three MAC Tournament games. The Zips finished the season with a 24-10 overall record and 14-6 record in league play.

In 2020, the Zips matched the best regular season record in program history at 24-7. Groce led the Zips to five consecutive Mid-American Conference Tournaments, earning the No. 4 seed and defeating fifth-seeded Buffalo (70-68) in the quarterfinal round, top-seeded Toledo (70-62) in the semifinal round and second-seeded Kent State (75-55) in the finals. Akron earned No. 1 seed in 2020 - the 2020 MAC Tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

During his 28-year coaching career, he has helped coach teams to 20 postseason appearances in 25 opportunities, including six regular season conference championships, nine conference tournament championships, a National Runner-up, an Elite 8, an NCAA Sweet 16 and seven Round of 32 appearances. Over 28 years his teams have not only shown consistent success on the court but have demonstrated sustained excellence in the classroom as well.



GROCE'S RECORD VS OPPONENTS

Prior to joining the Zips, Groce was head men's basketball coach at the University of Illinois for five seasons. During his tenure at Illinois, he led the Illini to an average of 19 wins per season along with postseason appearances in four of his five years in Champaign, owning a 95-75 record.

He arrived at Illinois after four seasons as head coach at Ohio University, where he led the Bobcats to an 85-56 overall record as well as Mid-American Conference Tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances in 2010 and 2012. Groce pursued building a championship program in all phases. There were signature wins on the court, player development improvements, recruiting success, and achievement in the classroom as well.

Ohio was the story of the 2012 Tournament, advancing to the Sweet 16 as a No. 13 seed with victories over No. 4 seed Michigan followed by No. 12 seed South Florida. The Bobcats made a strong push for the Elite Eight before falling to No. 1 seed North Carolina in overtime in the regional semifinal. It marked just the second time in Ohio's school history and first since 1964 that the Bobcats won multiple games in the NCAA Tournament. Ohio finished the 2012 season with a school-record 29 wins and was known for its pressure defense, ranking second nationally in turnover percentage and third in steals percentage.

Ohio also made noise in the 2010 postseason. Playing in the school's first NCAA Tournament game in five seasons, the Bobcats received a No. 14 seed and defeated No. 3 seed Georgetown. With the 2010 and 2012 NCAA performances, Ohio became just the sixth school ever to win Tournament games as both a 13 and 14 seed.

Groce earned his first head-coaching job at Ohio following four seasons on Thad Matta's staff at Ohio State from 2005-08, the first two as assistant coach and last two as associate head coach. During Groce's time in Columbus the Buckeyes amassed a record of 105-35, advanced to the NCAA Championship game in 2007 and second round in 2006, claimed back-to-back outright Big Ten Championships in 2006 and 2007 and won the NIT in 2008.

Groce played a key role in recruiting many of the top players at Ohio State and was named Rivals' 2006 National Recruiter of the Year.
