GAME NOTES

EDMONTON - For the first time since 2010, the Golden Bears will play for a Canada West banner, as they visit the UBC Thunderbirds on Saturday in the 86th Hardy Cup.

Alberta booked their ticket to the Hardy Cup with a dominant 40-17 home win over Saskatchewan last weekend in the second Hardy Cup Semifinal — their first home playoff win since 2005, and the first for head coach Chris Morris.

Bears QB Eli Hetlinger tossed for 279 yards and for touchdowns in the win, with Carter Kettyle (WR) and Jonathan Giustini (DB/K) earning Canada West Player of the Week honours.

UBC secured a second-straight Hardy Cup appearance with a 29-21 home win over Manitoba in the first semifinal. The Thunderbirds erased an early 17-3 deficit, outscoring Manitoba 19-4 in the second half.

UBC handed Alberta their only two losses of the season in 2023, earning a 54-37 home win on September 22nd, and a 23-10 win at Foote Field on October 28th to clinch the No. 1 seed and home field advantage through the CW playoffs.

Alberta is looking for their first Canada West title since 1981, while UBC seeks their first since 2015.

KEY STATS

- Saturday will mark the 6th time — and first since 1987 — the Bears and Thunderbirds have met in the Canada West post-season, with all six of their previous meetings coming in the Hardy Cup. The Bears hold a 3-2 all-time record against UBC in the playoffs, but did fall to UBC 26-8 in the 51st Hardy Cup in Vancouver, their most recent playoff meeting
- UBC has won three-straight home games against Alberta, including their Week 4 win this season. The Thunderbirds have also won 10 of the last 11 home games against the Bears, with Alberta's lone victory since 2011 coming in 2019 (40-20).
- The Bears and Thunderbirds ranked first and second in CW in points, yards, and first downs per game this season.
- The two programs also combined for 20 Canada West All-Star selections, with UBC leading the conference with 14 all-stars.
- Saturday will mark the first Hardy Cup hosted by UBC since 1997, a 39-21 Thunderbirds win over Calgary.
- Saturday's winner will host the 2023 Mitchell Bowl against the AUS Champions, one of two U SPORTS Semifinals. St. FX and Bishop's are slated to meet in the Loney Bowl on Saturday in Halifax. St. FX has won two-straight AUS titles, and three of the last four.

LAST MEETING

EDMONTON - Isaiah Knight rushed for 128 yards and a touchdown on 23 carries, adding 31 receiving yards, leading the #10 ranked UBC Thunderbirds to a 23-10 road win over the #6 ranked Alberta Golden Bears.

In bitterly cold and windy temperatures at Foote Field, UBC finished with a 102-yard advantage on offence, holding the Bears to just 261 yards in the loss. The Week 9 win gives UBC (6-2) the No. 1 seed in Canada West, while Alberta (6-2) slides down to the No. 2 spot. UBC will host the Manitoba Bisons (3-5) in the first Hardy Cup semifinal next Saturday at 1:00 p.m. PST, followed by Alberta hosting Saskatchewan (5-3) at 5:00 p.m. MST.

UBC's ground game, combined with Alberta's inability to move the ball efficiently was the difference on Saturday. The Bears mustered just 13 first downs on offence, turning the ball over three times.

Eli Hetlinger finished the game 14/22 passing for 85 yards, with neither a touchdown nor interception. By comparison, Garrett Rooker seemed to have no issue with the conditions, tossing for 167 yards on 18/26 passing, adding one touchdown.

HEAD COACH CHRIS MORRIS

Chris Morris was named the Head Coach of the Golden Bears football program on December 4, 2012.

Morris, originally from Scarborough, Ont., holds two degrees (bachelor of physical and health education – University of Toronto 1995 and bachelor of education – University of Alberta 1997), is a two-time CIS all-Canadian while playing for the University of Toronto Varsity Blues, and he won the J.P. Metras Trophy as the most outstanding down lineman in the country in 1990. He also played in the East-West Shrine Bowl before getting drafted in the first round (8th overall) of the 1992 Canadian Football League draft by the Edmonton Eskimos. He started in his rookie season, and played an additional 14 seasons, or 237 games for the Eskimos. He was a team captain, and he played in five Grey Cup games with the Eks, winning three (1993, 2003, and 2005), and was given a plaque on the Eskimos' Wall of Honour in Commonwealth Stadium in 2008.

While still playing in the CFL, Morris became a full-time teacher within Edmonton Public Schools in 1997, earning a provincial teacher of excellence nomination during that time. He ascended to principal in 2009, and as principal of Spruce Avenue Junior High, he turned around the school's historical Provincial Achievement success rate from 50% to close to 90%, the highest in the history of the school. Morris has also been extremely active with Edmonton and area charities and communities, including the Make-A-Wish Foundation, Ronald McDonald House, and the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, since his arrival in 1992.

He has also served as the offensive coordinator of the Harry Ainlay Titans football program, helping the Titans to three city championships, two Northern championships, and one provincial championship title.
