GATORS WELCOME BIG RED TO MEADVILLE IN WEEK THREE

Allegheny concludes its two-game home stand with a Saturday afternoon bout with North Coast Athletic Confer-

ence rival Denison. The Gators look to even their conference record at 1-1 after falling 49-35 in an offen-

sive slugfest with Wooster last Saturday night at Frank B. Fuhrer Field. Quarterback Logan Lee threw for 282 yards and four touchdowns, while Alex Victor made five catches for 159 yards and two scores in the defeat. This week marks the

conference opener for the Big Red, who are coming off of a bye week after out-slugging Southwestern 49-31 in their opener on Sept. 2. The Ga-

tors will be looking for their first win over the Big Red since 2011, after falling 42-28 at Denison last season.



I'LL TAKE BIG PLAYS FOR SIX, ALEX

In last week's loss to Wooster, Allegheny sophomore receiver Alex Victor hauled in five catches for 159 yards and two touchdowns, highlighted by an 85-yard score from quarterback Logan Lee on Allegheny's first offensive play from scrimmage. It marked Victor's 11 career receiving touchdown, already moving him into a tie for sixth most in program history. Of Victor's 11 TD grabs, five have covered at least 40 yards, while three have gone for 80 or more. Among players with five or more receptions this season, Victor ranks third in NCAA Division III with an average of 30.9 yards per catch.

GATOR BLUE > BIG RED

Two members of the Allegheny coaching staff enjoyed stellar playing careers at Denison University. Allegheny offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach Braden Layer was a four-year letterman for the Big Red from 2009-12. A wide receiver, he was twice named All-NCAC, while he was named a prestigious Capital One Academic All-American following his senior season of 2012. Layer ranks as the fifth leading pass catcher in Denison history, with 122 receptions, 1,613 yards, and 13 touchdowns. Layer was college teammates with his current coworker Matt Cochran, the Gator offensive line coach, Cochran started 39 of a possible 40 games on the offensive line for the Big Red between 2010-13, earning a pair of All-NCAC citations and serving as team captain during his senior season.

THE GENERAL

In last week's home loss to Wooster, Allegheny junior quarterback Logan Lee completed 17 passes for 282 yards and four touchdowns, becoming the first player in program history to throw for four touchdowns in back-to-back games. Lee, who also threw for four TDs in last season's week two matchup at Wooster, is now just the second quarterback in team history to have three four-touchdown games under his belt, joining Paul Bell, who did so twice in 1992 and once in '93. Through the first two games this sason, Lee has yet to throw an interception, while he has been sacked just once.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

Through Allegheny's first two games, five different receivers have made at least one touchdown reception, already tying the amount of TD recipients from a season ago. The last season in which Allegheny had more players with at least one touchdown reception was 2006, when there were seven

POINTS APLENTY

The Gators' 35-point output last week against Wooster followed the team's 38 points in the week one win at Thiel. The 73 points scored through the first two games of the season are the most for the team in a two-game span since 2006, when they defeated Hiram 52-7 and Denison 23-6 in weeks two and three, respectively. The Gators haven't scored more points over the first two weeks of the season since 1996, when they opened with a 61-13 win over Thiel before topping Wittenberg 26-14 in week two.

SO FAR. SO GOOD

After going a perfect 5-for-5 on extra points and hitting his first field goal attempt of the year in the week one opener at Thiel, junior kicker Zach Bednarowicz was perfect again on all five extra point attempts last week against Wooster. Bednarowicz's 13 kicking points and 10-for-10 mark on extra points both rank second best in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

BOONE BROUGHT IT

In last year's meeting at Denison, Gator defensive lineman Jahnaaman Boone had a big game, tallying four tackles for loss (resulting in 27 yards) and three quarterback sacks, as Allegheny recorded a season-high five QB takedowns. It was the first three sack game for a Gator defender since Nov. 14, 2009, when Nick Silva recorded 3.5 at Ohio Wesleyan.

GLOBAL GATORS

Two countries and 15 different states are represented on the Gators' 101-man roster. Thirty-six players call Pennsylvania home while 18 hail from New York and 10 from Florida. The member of the team furthest away from home is rfreshman wide receiver Leon Shimizu, who came to Meadville after growing up in Chalon Pago-Ordot, Guam.

CAPTAIN GATORS

The 2017 Allegheny football team captains include junior wide receiver Tristan Rhoades, senior linebackers Freddy Ruiz and Travis Thomas, and senior offensive lineman Andrew Murphy.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

The 2017 Allegheny football roster features three sets of brothers, including junior running back Tyler Balla and freshman cornerback Chase, junior quarterback Logan Lee and freshman brother Grayson, and junior linebacker Dominic Antinozzi and sophomore offensive lineman Vito.

IIP NFXT

The Gators are back in action next Saturday, Sept. 23, traveling to Delaware, Ohio for a 1 p.m. battle against North Coast Athletic Conference foe Ohio Weslevan University.

ALLEGHENY vs. DENISON - THE LAST MEETING

GRANVILLE, Ohio (Oct. 22, 2016): Denison, ranked 24th in the D3Football.com national poll, jumped out to a 28-7 halftime lead, and then held off a hard-charging Gator comeback in the second half to win 42-28.

The Big Red totaled an even 400 yards of total offense, led by 277 yards through the air and two touchdown passes from quarterback Matt lammarino. While Allegheny held the Big Red rushing attack to just 123 yards, the hosts scored four touchdowns on the ground, with two coming from Cody Farley.

Allegheny quarterback Logan Lee completed 17 of 31 passes for 194 yards and two fourth quarter touchdowns, including a 25-yarder to John McFarland and a 13-yarder to Alex Victor. McFarland finished with a career-high 115 yards on seven receptions.

Despite yielding 400 yards and 42 points, the Gator defense turned in a number of big plays in the losing effort. In the opening minute of the second half, linebacker Freddy Ruiz tallied the Gators' first defensive touchdown in over five years, recovering a fumble and taking it 27 yards for his first career touchdown. Two minutes into the fourth quarter, freshman Adrian Garcia tallied his first career interception, leading to McFarland's touchdown grab.

Allegheny's defense totaled a season-high five tackles for loss, led by freshman Jahnaaman Boone, who recorded a career-high three quarterback sacks. Jon Scroxton and Colten Buzard teamed up on a pair of quarterback sacks, while Marcus Davenport had two TFL's and a forced fumble.

In addition to his two touchdown scampers, Farley led Denison receivers with six catches for 81 yards, including a 14-yard touchdown reception in the final minute of the second half that gave Denison a 28-7 lead at the break. Denison's Dara Laja led both sides with 59 yards on the ground, while teammates Zach Neufield, Alex Raynor, and Hayden Hatten were each credited with eight tackles.

The Gators' Tristan Rhoades finished with a game-high 14 tackles, while Ruiz, Buzard, Scroxton, and Wyatt Boyler were credited with eight apiece.

LAST TIME OUT: Gators Drop Offensive Battle to Wooster

MEADVILLE, Pa. - Allegheny quarterback Logan Lee threw for four touchdowns, while the Gators totaled 436 yards of total offense, but visiting Wooster scored three unanswered touchdowns midway through the second half and showcased a powerful offense of its own to earn a 49-35 win on Community Day at Frank B. Fuhrer Field.

Lee fired four touchdown strikes for the second time in as many weeks, and the third time in his career, with Alex Victor the big beneficiary, as the speedster hauled in five catches for 159 yards and two scores, highlighted by an 80-yard bomb on the Gators' first play from scrimmage in the opening quarter.

The teams traded touchdowns into the middle stages of the third quarter, before Wooster scored three times in an eight-minute span to put the game away heading into the final stanza.

In the offensive showdown, Wooster out-gained Allegheny 496-436 in total offense, with quarterback Gary Muntean completing 23 of 28 passes for 364 yards and four scores.

Though Allegheny's offense turned in another solid performance, the team's defense got the team off to a strong start. On the opening drive of the game, Wooster methodically advanced up the field, with four Muntean completions and an Allegheny roughing the passer penalty eventually setting up a Scots' first down on the Allegheny 11. On second down, Jonah Tanner snuffed out a screen pass for a five-yard loss, before a Muntean incompletion made it

fourth-and-13 on the 15 yardline. The Scots' 32-yard field goal attempt went wide right, and the game remained scoreless with just inside nine minutes left in the quarter.

The Gators wasted little time in cashing in on the momentum, as on their first play from scrimmage, Lee found Victor on a fly pattern down the middle of the field, and the speedster outraced

The Fighting Scots needed just three plays and 58 seconds to tie the game at seven, as Muntean completed a pair of passes for 65 yards, knotting the game on a 39-yard scoring strike to Jacob

Allegheny answered with a methodical drive to quickly re-gain the lead, with Lee firing first down passes to Tristan Rhoades and Ben Bachik to advance inside the Wooster 30, before connecting with Victor over the middle for a 27-vard touchdown to make it 14-7 with 2:31 left in the guarter.

After the teams traded punts to close the first stanza, Wooster used another lengthy drive to tie the game, as a 10-yard pass from Muntean to Nate Strausbaugh capped off a 10-play, 46-yard scoring drive, during which the Fighting Scots converted on a trio of third downs.

In keeping with the theme of the first half, the Gators quickly countered. A 12-yard pass from Lee to Austin French, followed by a 28-yard completion to Victor, set up first down inside the Wooster 20. A six-yard sneak from Lee and a five-yard run from Balla made it first and goal, before Lee connected with French for a nine-yard gain inside the one. Balla would then power through the middle to put the Gators up 21-14 with 4:45 left in the half.

The Scots would seize the momentum to enter the break, tying the game on a three-yard sneak from Muntean to close out six-play, 94-yard drive, before taking advantage of a Gator fumble on the ensuing possession to take a 28-21 lead on another Muntean sneak with less than a minute left in the quarter.

In the high-scoring first half, the Gators totaled 252 yards, led by Lee, who was a perfect 8-for-8 passing for 135 yards and the two scoring strikes to Victor, who had 140 first half receiving yards. Muntean was just as effective for Wooster, going 16-for-20 for 253 yards and two touchdowns.

the Wooster defense for the 85-yard touchdown.

ALLEGIENT STE

Receiving the kick to start the second half, the Gators went back to work to forge the game's fourth tie. Victor opened the drive by scampering 48 yards on an end-around to the Wooster 27. A 14-yard completion to Bachick, followed by back-to-back six yard runs from Lee and Brandon Sellers, set up first and goal at the three, before Lee found Jake Wilson out of the backfield for a three-yard touchdown pass to tie it at 28.

The Gator tie was short-lived, however, as Wooster countered by marching 65 yards in seven plays to take a 35-28 lead on a 10-yard run by Antonio Bailey. Allegheny was forced to punt on the ensuing possession, but after a bad snap, the Scots took over in Gator territory on the 42. Five plays later, Muntean and Conor Allen hooked up for a five-yard touchdown pass to take a two-touchdown lead with 1:30 left in the quarter.

On the first drive of the fourth quarter, the Gators were again forced to punt, which was returned 36 yards, before being aided by a 15-yard Allegheny penalty that gave the Scots the ball on the Gator 20. On the first play of the ensuing drive, Muntean threw his fourth touchdown pass of the game, a 21-yarder to Strausbaugh, to go up 49-28.

Allegheny pulled to within 14 points midway through the fourth quarter, with a six-play, 56-yard drive that was highlighted by a 30-yard completion to Dwaine Barber and ended with a nine-yard touchdown pass to Austin French with 6:30 left in regulation.

French's first career touchdown ended up being the final offensive play of the game for Allegheny, as Wooster converted on a trio of third downs and took advantage of a pair of Allegheny penalties to chew up the final 6:22.

Lee finished with a line of 17-for-25 for 277 yards and four touchdowns, against just one sack and zero interceptions. In addition to his 159 receiving yards, Victor also rushed for a team-best 63 yards, while Balla ran for 39 yards. French set season-highs with four catches for 27 yards.

Defensively, Travis Thomas and reigning NCAC Defensive Player of the Week Freddy Ruiz each had 11 tackles apiece for the Gators, while Colten Buzard finished with nine tackles, and a game-best 1.5 sacks.

Bailey paced Wooster's ground game with 79 yards on 24 tries, while Strausbaugh made four catches for 128 yards, and Allan five grabs for 54.

HEAD COACH B.J. HAMMER Second Season

BJ Hammer was named the 34th head coach in Allegheny football program history on January 4, 2016.

In his first season at the helm, Hammer saw a pair of his players earn All-NCAC honors, including senior John McFarland and junior Jake

Wilson. McFarland ended his career as one of the most prolific tight ends in program history, and hauled in 48 catches for 552 yards. Wilson established an NCAA Division III record with 1,268 kick return yards, averaging 24.5 yards per try, and breaking off five returns of 50 yards or longer. As a team, the Gator offense saw an increase of an average of 9.0 points and 83 yards per game from the 2015 season, while the team's pass defense ranked in the top five of the NCAC.

Hammer arrived at Allegheny after spending five seasons as the defensive coordinator at fellow North Coast Athletic Conference member Wabash College. There, he led a defensive unit that consistently ranked among NCAA Division-III's best. During his five-year tenure, the Little Giants posted a record of 51-7, making three appearances in the NCAA Division-III playoffs and winning NCAC championships in 2011 and 2015. He mentored the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year in four of his five seasons as defensive coordinator, while 22 Wabash defenders were First Team All-NCAC honorees, and four were named All-America.

In 2015, the Little Giants finished 12-1, including a perfect 8-0 in the NCAC, and advanced to the third round of the NCAA playoffs. Hammer's defense ranked third nationally with 26 interceptions, fourth in rushing defense (72.2 yds/g), fifth in total defense (240.9 yds/g), and seventh in quarterback sacks (42). Eight Little Giant defenders earned All-NCAC honors, including six First Team selections, highlighted by defensive tackle Tyler McCullen, who was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and a D3Football.com All-American. Wabash ended the year ranked seventh in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3Football.com Top 25 polls.

In 2014, Hammer was named a Division-III Coordinator of the Year finalist after his unit led Division-III in rushing defense (66.3 yds/g) and quarterback sacks (4.6 sacks/g), while ranking third in total defense, fifth in tackles for loss, and 12th in scoring defense. Little Giant linebacker Cody Buresh was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-America

by both D3Football.com and the AFCA.

The 2013 Wabash defense led the nation in total defense (220.7 yds/g), fumbles recovered (19), and turnover margin (+24), while placing second in tackles for loss (11.6 TFL/g) and rushing defense (63.1). In 2012, the Little Giants placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and 10th in rushing defense, while linebacker CJ Gum earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year award for a second straight season.

In his first season as the Wabash defensive coordinator, the Little Giants ranked fifth in the nation in rushing defense (78.1 yds/g), 11th in scoring defense (12.9 pts/g), and 12th in total defense (249.4 yds/g), while they paced the NCAC in every defensive statistical category. In addition to Gum being named the conference's top defender, linebacker AJ Akinribade was named NCAC Newcomer of the Year.

Prior to his five-year tenure at Wabash, Hammer spent eight seasons on the football staff at Whittier College. After working as the Poets' defensive coordinator from 2003-05, Hammer was promoted to head coach, a position he held from 2006-10. Posting a 12-33 overall record, Hammer rebuilt a program that had just 13 players on its roster in 2003 to one that averaged a roster size of over 100. Thirty Whittier players were named All-Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC), while the Whitter defense ranked second in the conference in total defense in 2006, and its rushing offense ranked second in the SCIAC in both 2009 and 2010.

Before his stint in California, Hammer spent the 2002 season as the linebackers coach at Heidelberg College, after beginning his coaching career in 2001 as the outside linebackers coach at Wabash.

Hammer graduated from Wabash in 2001, and is regarded as one of the top defenders to ever suit up for the Little Giants. He graduated as the school's record holder for tackles for loss in a game (five), season (23), and career (58), as well as single-season sacks (15), while he is tied with younger brother Blair as the Little Giants' all-time record holder in career sacks with 27.5. Team captain in 2000, Hammer was a two-time All-American and three-time All-Conference honoree, and was named the 2001 Pete Vaughn Award, which is given annually to the top Wabash senior athlete as voted upon by the athletic department.

A native of Carmel, Indiana, Hammer and wife Emily are the parents of daughters Layla and Ellie, and son William.
