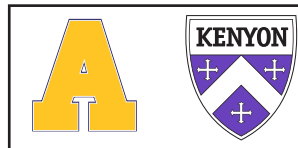

GATORS TRAVEL TO NCAC FOE KENYON

This week, the Gators look to bounce back from a disappointing 41-14 loss to NCAC-leading Wittenberg. Trailing just 10-7 at the half, the Gators saw the Tigers score 24 unanswered points in the third quarter to pull away for the convincing win. Wittenberg out-gained the Gators 458-532 in total offense, while the Gators were also hamstrung by committing seven penalties for 79 yards. The Gators, who have won two of their first three road games this season, defeated Kenyon 44-35 last season on Homecoming Day at Frank B. Fuhrer Field, snapping Kenyon's five-game winning streak in the series.



The Kenyon Lords enter week seven searching for their first win of the 2018 campaign. Last week, the Lords led Hiram 24-14 at the end of the third quarter, but Hiram would score the game's final 14 points, with the winning score coming on a two-yard Hiram rush with just 33 seconds left in regulation. Kenyon quarterback Thomas Merkle completed 33 passes for 373 yards and three touchdowns in the loss, with Ian Robertson setting a Kenyon record with 19 receptions for 192 yards. Merkle ranks second in the NCAC with 1,619 passing yards and third with nine touchdown passes, while Robertson's 68 receptions and 746 yards are both tops in the conference.

MEDIA INFORMATION

Interviews of Allegheny coaches and athletes shall be arranged through the school's office of athletic communications. On game days, locker rooms are closed to the media. Following the game, players will be available for interviews upon request once they are dismissed by the coaching staff. Due to extremely limited press box space, requests for press box and media credentials should be made to Jim Berger no later than 48 hours prior to each game.

IT'S BEEN A LONG ROAD: The Gators enter this week's matchup with Kenyon having won three of their first four road games of the 2018 season. The three road wins are already the team's most since the 2012 season, while the Gators haven't won at least four road games since 2010, when they went 4-2 away from Frank B. Fuhrer Field en-route to a 7-3 final overall record.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: The Gators' 44-35 win over Kenyon last season snapped Allegheny's five-game losing skid against the Lords. Allegheny hasn't won on the road at Kenyon since October 9, 2011, when they topped the Lords 31-17 at McBride Field.

STILL ON TOP: Through six games, Allegheny junior Alex Victor has hauled in 27 catches for 638 yards and five touchdowns. His average of 23.6 yards per reception leads the NCAC, and ranks eighth in all of NCAA Division III. Victor's 638 receiving yards are third-most in the NCAC, with Kenyon's Ian Robertson leading the league with 746.

CLIMBING THE RANKS: Allegheny senior enters this week's meeting at Kenyon with 559 rushing yards on the season, good for third in the NCAC. With 1,978 rushing yards for his career, Balla is just 22 away from becoming only the 10th player in program history to rush for over 2,000 yards. After scoring an 18-yard touchdown in last week's loss to Wittenberg, Balla has 20 rushing touchdowns for his career, the most for a Gator back since Mario Tarquinio scored 31 in a career that spanned from 2003-06.

JUST FOR KICKS: Though his long field goal attempt was blocked in last week's loss to Wittenberg, Allegheny senior kicker Zach Bednarowicz is still tied for second in the NCAC with seven field goals in eight tries, while he is also 14-for-15 on extra point kicks. His 35 kicking points rank third in the NCAC, and are already the most in a single-season for an Allegheny kicker since 2011, when Ryan Zipf scored 67 (15 FG's, 22 XP's) en-route to earning all-conference accolades.

SENSING A TREND: Senior Logan Lee's 5-yard touchdown pass to Alex Victor in the first quarter of last week's loss to Wittenberg was the 57th of his career, extending his own Allegheny program record. Lee has thrown at least one touchdown in four of his five games played this year, 14 of his past 15 games dating to the beginning of last season, and 21 of his past 24 since the start of his sophomore campaign of 2015. In the 24 games since 2015, Lee has thrown for at least two touchdowns 13 different times, including three games with three TDs, five with four, and two with five.

SACK ATTACK: After tallying two quarterback sacks in week six against Wittenberg, Allegheny's defense has totaled 25 on the season, which is tied for first in the NCAC, and sixth in all of Division III. Eleven different Gators have been credited with at least a half sack, while six have totaled two or more. Senior defensive end Marcus Davenport has led the way, producing six sacks to rank third in the NCAC.

CAPTAINS OF THE SWAMP: Allegheny's five co-captains for the 2018 season include senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport, senior receiver Tristan Rhoades, senior running back Tyler Balla, junior linebacker Corey Laskey.

UP NEXT: Next week, the Gators will celebrate Homecoming and Blue and Gold weekend when they return to the friendly confines of Frank B. Fuhrer Field for a 1:00 p.m. matchup against DePauw University.

ALLEGHENY vs. KENYON - THE LAST MEETING

MEADVILLE, Pa. (Oct. 14, 2017) – Allegheny recovered from a nine-point third quarter deficit to post a 44-35 victory over Kenyon in a back-and-forth Homecoming Day battle at Frank B. Fuhrer Field.

Trailing 28-19 midway through the third quarter, the Gators responded with 23 points in less than 13 minutes of game action, with Logan Lee's 35-yard touchdown pass to Angel Alvarez with 8:41 left in regulation proving to be the game-winner. The Allegheny defense would put an exclamation point on the win when Colten Buzard sacked Kenyon quarterback Thomas Merkle in the end zone with 1:02 left to close out the game's scoring and seal the victory.

Logan Lee completed 19 passes for a career-high 324 yards, while throwing five touchdown passes for the second time in a three-game span. Alex Victor racked up 154 all-purpose yards and scored three touchdowns, including two through the air and a 75-yard run on the Gators' opening play from scrimmage in the first quarter.

Victor scored his second touchdown of the day in the waning minutes of the first quarter on a six-yard pass from Lee to put the Gators up 13-6, but Kenyon would score two unanswered touchdowns to go up 21-13 with 11:19 left in the first half. Allegheny closed out the first half's scoring, with a one-yard pass from Lee to Austin French. The two-point try failed, and the Lords took a 21-19 lead into the intermission.

Kenyon upped the lead to 28-19 on a Seamus McCurren touchdown run with 8:00 left in the third, but 90 seconds later, Victor hooked up with Lee on a 30-yard touchdown pass to cut the deficit to 28-26.

The Gators briefly pulled ahead on the opening play of the fourth quarter, when Lee threw a five-yard touchdown strike to Tristan Rhoades to push the Gators in front 34-28, but Kenyon would quickly take a 35-34 lead on D.J. Manley's 56-yard interception return touchdown.

The ensuing drive was capped off with Lee's scoring strike to Alvarez, before Buzard's safety in the final minute closed out the day's scoring and sealed the win for Allegheny.

The Gators out-gained the Lords 485-406 in total offense. Rhoades made four catches for 102 yards and Victor six for 72, while Victor gained 85 rushing yards, and Tyler Balla 72.

For Kenyon, Merkle completed 33 of 51 passes for 260 yards and two touchdowns, with Robertson hauling in 12 grabs for 100 yards, and McCurren rushing 20 times for 136 yards.

Last Time Out: Third Quarter Surge Lifts #16 Wittenberg Past Gators

MEADVILLE, Pa. (Oct. 13, 2018) – Behind 24 unanswered points in the third quarter, visiting Wittenberg topped the Gators 44-14 on a rainy Saturday at Frank B. Fuhrer Field.

Holding onto a tenuous 10-7 halftime lead, the visiting Tigers (6-0, 5-0 North Coast Athletic Conference) out-scored the Gators (3-3, 3-2 NCAC) 24-0 over the decisive third quarter to pull away for the win. Paced by 368 passing yards from quarterback Jake Kennedy, the Tigers out-gained the Gators 453-238 for the game.

After being pinned inside its own two-yard line following a beautiful punt from Cody Went, the Tigers went to work on an impressive drive, marching 98 yards in 10 plays to take a 7-0 lead on a 12-yard Kennedy pass to Jeff Tiffner with 6:34 remaining in the opening stanza.

The teams would trade punts over the next several possessions, before the Gators ended the opening quarter driving, as Logan Lee connected with Alex Victor for a 14-yard pass on the final play of the frame to set up first down inside the Wittenberg 40.

Two plays into the second quarter, Lee found Dwaine Barber for a 17-yard reception, before a pass interference infraction on Wittenberg gave the Gators a first down on the Wittenberg 15. Passes to Ben Bachik and Tristan Rhoades would give Allegheny first-and-goal inside the five, before Lee capped off the drive by finding Victor over the middle in the back of the end zone for a four-yard touchdown. Zach Bednarowicz's extra point topped off the 13-play, 55-yard drive, and tied the game at 7-7 with 9:03 left in the first half.

Kennedy opened the ensuing drive with a pair of completions for 16 yards to bring the ball into Allegheny territory, but after a costly penalty, the Tiger drive was snuffed out when Chase Balla and Marcus Davenport teamed up for a nine-yard sack on third down to force a Wittenberg punt.

The Gators went three-and-out on their next trip, and the Tigers countered with another lengthy drive to close out the half. Wittenberg would eventually advance inside the Allegheny five, but the Gator defense would hold, and the Tigers' Adam Aquista connected on a 21-yard field goal as time expired to take a 10-7 lead into the intermission.

Receiving the opening kick in the second half, the Tigers wasted little time in upping their lead. On the second play of the half, Kennedy hooked up with Jeff Kayser for a 40-yard pass that set up first down inside the Gator 30. Three plays later, Tiffner hauled in his second touchdown grab of the day, this one from 12 yards out, to put the Tigers up 17-7 with 12:21 left in the third quarter.

The Gators looked to counter with a productive drive. After completing a 16-yard pass to Barber and a nine-yarder to Austin French, Lee hooked up with Tristan Rhoades for a 31-yard gain that set up first down on the Wittenberg 11-yard line. After the drive stalled, Bednarowicz's 26-yard field goal on fourth down was blocked.

The Tigers quickly cashed in on the blocked kick, as on the next play, Kennedy hit Thaddeus Snodgrass over the middle, and the receiver out-raced the defense for an 80-yard touchdown that put the visitors in front 24-7.

Allegheny was forced to punt on each of its next three trips, and the Tigers answered with points each time to close the quarter, as Kennedy threw a 52-yard touchdown to Liam Dugan and Aquista connected on a 21-yard field goal to up the lead to 34-7 at the close of the third quarter.

After Kennedy's fifth touchdown pass of the day, a 19-yarder to Dugan, pushed the lead to 41-7 in the opening minute of the fourth quarter, the Gators mounted a successful drive on their penultimate possession of the afternoon.

Kobe Pinkney kept the drive alive when he rumbled for three yards on fourth-and-one at the Wittenberg 42, before Lee hooked up with French for a 13-yard pass that brought the ball inside the Tigers' 30. A four-yard run from Pinkney, a three-yard keeper from Lee, and a four-yard pass to Victor gave the Gators first down at the Wittenberg 18, before Tyler Balla burst through the line and into the end zone for his fifth rushing touchdown of the season to close out the afternoon's scoring with 6:19 left to play.

Lee completed 17 passes for 155 yards, with Victor hauling in a team-best four catches for 22 yards, and Rhoades three receptions for a team-leading 49 yards. Balla ran for 46 yards to top Allegheny.

Defensively, Quinten Hunt posted a team-high eight tackles, including two behind the line of scrimmage. Corey Laskey made seven stops, assisting on one tackle for loss, while Davenport totaled six tackles, one TFL, and a half sack.

Kennedy completed 21 of 31 passes for 378 yards and five touchdowns, with Tiffner making nine catches for 104 yards and two scores. The Gators limited Wittenberg to just 75 rushing yards on the day, with the Tigers' Nick Kendall gaining 47 to lead both teams. Michael Ford led the Wittenberg defense with nine tackles, while Daniels had six tackles, 2.5 TFL's, and 1.5 sacks in addition to his blocked kick.

ALLEGHENY COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH B.J. HAMMER (3rd season)



B.J. Hammer was named the 34th head coach in Allegheny football program history on January 4, 2016.

After posting a 1-9 mark in his first season at Allegheny in 2016, the program's rebuilding took big strides in 2017, as the Gators finished 3-7 while posting prolific numbers on both sides of the ball. Offensively, Allegheny averaged 34.0 points and 449.6 yards per game, both of which were the Gators' most since 2002. Sophomore Alex Victor earned First Team All-NCAC honors after setting school records for receiving yards (1,037) and touchdowns (15), while Tyler Balla became the first Gator running back to earn All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns. Quarterback Logan Lee also had a record-breaking season, setting new Gator single-season marks in nearly every passing category, including completions (214), yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33).

The 2017 Gator defense also saw a pair of All-NCAC recipients. Defensive end Colten Buzard set a new Allegheny single-season mark with 20.5 tackles for loss, while tying a 17-year old school record with 12.0 sacks. Defensive back Chase Balla became the first Gator rookie to earn All-NCAC honors since 2014, as he finished with a team-best 73 tackles while breaking up five passes.

In his first season at the helm, Hammer saw a pair of his players earn All-NCAC honors, including senior John McFarland and junior Jake Wilson. McFarland ended his career as one of the most prolific tight ends in program history, and hauled in 48 catches for 552 yards. Wilson established an NCAA Division III record with 1,268 kick return yards, averaging 24.5 yards per try, and breaking off five returns of 50 yards or longer. As a team, the Gator offense saw an increase of an average of 9.0 points and 83 yards per game from the 2015 season, while the team's pass defense ranked in the top five of the NCAC.

Hammer arrived at Allegheny after spending five seasons as the defensive coordinator at fellow North Coast Athletic Conference member Wabash College. There, he led a defensive unit that consistently ranked among NCAA Division-III's best. During his five-year tenure, the Little Giants posted a record of 51-7, making three appearances in the NCAA Division-III playoffs and winning NCAC championships in 2011 and 2015. He mentored the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year in four of his five seasons as defensive coordinator, while 22 Wabash defenders were First Team All-NCAC honorees, and four were named All-America.

In 2015, the Little Giants finished 12-1, including a perfect 8-0 in the NCAC, and advanced to the third round of the NCAA playoffs. Hammer's defense ranked third nationally with 26 interceptions, fourth in rushing defense (72.2 yds/g), fifth in total defense (240.9 yds/g), and seventh in quarterback sacks (42). Eight Little Giant defenders earned All-NCAC honors, including six First Team selections. Wabash ended the year ranked seventh in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3Football.com Top 25 polls.

In 2014, Hammer was named a Division-III Coordinator of the Year finalist after his unit led D-III in rushing defense (66.3 yds/g) and quarterback sacks (4.6 sacks/g), while ranking third in total defense, fifth in tackles for loss, and 12th in scoring defense. Little Giant linebacker Cody Buresh was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-America by both D3Football.com and the AFCA.

The 2013 Wabash defense led the nation in total defense (220.7 yds/g), fumbles recovered (19), and turnover margin (+24), while placing second in tackles for loss (11.6 TFL/g) and rushing defense (63.1). In 2012, the Little Giants placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and 10th in rushing defense, while linebacker CJ Gum earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year award for a second straight season.

In his first season as the Wabash defensive coordinator, the Little Giants ranked fifth in the nation in rushing defense (78.1 yds/g), 11th in scoring defense (12.9 pts/g), and 12th in total defense (249.4 yds/g), while they paced the NCAC in every defensive statistical category. In addition to Gum being named the conference's top defender, linebacker AJ Akinribade was named NCAC Newcomer of the Year.

Prior to his five-year tenure at Wabash, Hammer spent eight seasons on the football staff at Whittier College. After working as the Poets' defensive coordinator from 2003-05, Hammer was promoted to head coach, a position he held from 2006-10. Posting a 12-33 overall record, Hammer rebuilt a program that had just 13 players on its roster in 2003 to one that averaged a roster size of over 100. Thirty Whittier players were named All-Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC), while the Whittier defense ranked second in the conference in total defense in 2006, and its rushing offense ranked second in the SCIAC in both 2009 and 2010.

Before his stint in California, Hammer spent the 2002 season as the linebackers coach at Heidelberg College, after beginning his coaching career in 2001 as the outside linebackers coach at Wabash.

Hammer graduated from Wabash in 2001, and is regarded as one of the top defenders to ever suit up for the Little Giants. He graduated as the school's record holder for tackles for loss in a game (five), season (23), and career (58), as well as single-season sacks (15), while he is tied with younger brother Blair as the Little Giants' all-time record holder in career sacks with 27.5. Team captain in 2000, Hammer was a two-time All-American and three-time All-Conference honoree, and was named the 2001 Pete Vaughn Award, which is given annually to the top Wabash senior athlete as voted upon by the athletic department.

A native of Carmel, Indiana, Hammer and wife Emily are the parents of daughters Layla and Ellie, and son William. They reside in Meadville.

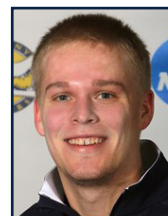
