GATORS, ENGINEERS FACE OFF IN 2018 OPENER

The 121st season of Allegheny football opens this week, as the Gators play host to Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute at Frank B. Fuhrer Field, the first ever meeting between the two squads. Under third-year head coach B.J. Hammer, Allegheny boasts one of its most experienced squads in recent memory, as 53 letterwinners - including 17 starters - return from a 2017 season in which they finished 3-7 overall. Among the returnees are the team's leading passer (Logan Lee), rusher (Tyler Balla), receiver (Alex Victor), and tackler (Chase Balla).



Under sixth-year head coach Ralph Isernia, R.P.I. enters the 2018 season ranked 25th in the preseason D3Football.com national poll. Last season, the Engineers finished 8-3, tied for the Liberty League championship, and advanced to the NCAA Division III playoffs for the first time since 2007. Fifteen starters and 35 letterwinners return from last year's playoff team, with the bulk of the experience coming on offense, as eight of the 11 starters are back, highlighted by quarterback George Marinopoulos, who threw for 11 touchdowns, seven of which went to another returnee, senior Keaton Ackermann.

MEDIA INFORMATION

Interviews of Allegheny coaches and athletes shall be arranged through the school's office of athletic communications. On game days, locker rooms are closed to the media. Following the game, players will be available for interviews upon request once they are dismissed by the coaching staff. Due to extremely limited press box space, requests for press box and media credentials should be made to Jim Berger no later than 48 hours prior to each game.

WELCOME BACK: Allegheny boasts its most experienced roster in recent memory, as a total of 52 letterwinners return from 2017, including 24 players who made at least one start. The Gators' offense is particularly veteran-laden, as the players on the current roster accounted for 94 percent of the Gators' rushing yards and 98 percent of the team's receiving yards in 2017, while every rushing touchdown last season was scored by a current member of the team, and all but one of the school-record 34 touchdown passes were hauled in by a current Gator.

CAPTAINS OF THE SWAMP: Five players have been named co-captains for the 2018 season, including senior receiver Tristan Rhoades, senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport, senior running back Tyler Balla, junior receiver Alex Victor, and junior linebacker Corey Laskey. Davenport and Rhoades are now two-year team captains.

RHOADES THE SCHOLAR: Senior wide receiver Tristan Rhoades has been nominated for the National Football Foundation's Scholar-Athlete award, given to senior football players who hold a cumulative GPA over 3.20, are top performers on the field, and have demonstrated outstanding academic application and student and community citizenship. A biology major and psychology minor, Rhoades was a big factor in the Gators' prolific passing attack in 2017. In his first season at receiver after starting for two years at safety, Rhoades hauled in 41 catches for 759 yards and five touchdowns, with seven receptions of at least 40 yards, and three of 50 or longer.

TAKING OFFENSE: The Gators had their most prolific offense in nearly two decades in 2017. After doing so just twice in the six seasons prior, Allegheny scored 35 or more points in six different games, averaging 34.0 per contest, their highest mark since 2001 (35.3 pts/g). The 2017 Gators also gained at least 450 yards of total offense in five different games and over 500 twice, finishing with an average of 449.6 per contest, the team's most since the 2000 season (479.3 yds/g).

RECORD RECEIVER: Junior Alex Victor is coming off of the most prolific seasons for a receiver in program history. Victor earned First Team All-NCAC honors after making 52 catches for 1,037 yards and 15 touchdowns, while also gaining 234 rushing yards. He became the first player in program history to eclipse 1,000 receiving yards in a season, while the 15 TDs were also a program record. In 18 career games, Victor has a school-record 23 touchdown grabs, while his 1,591 receiving yards rank second all-time.

ALL-CONFERENCE BLOODLINES: Two of the Gators' four 2017 All-NCAC honorees hail from the same family, in running back Tyler Balla and younger brother Chase, a safety. Tyler earned Second Team All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns during his junior season, both the most in a season for a Gator since 2005. He eclipsed the 100-yard mark in five different games, while he scored at least one touchdown in seven contests. Chase became just the third Gator rookie since 2002 to earn All-NCAC honors after leading the team with 73 tackles and breaking up five passes, while also averaging 22.1 yards on 17 kick returns.

THE GENERAL LEE: Senior quarterback Logan Lee had arguably the finest single season for a signal caller in Gator history in 2017. In his second full season as a starter, Lee set school records for completions (214), passing yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33), while throwing just eight interceptions. His 160.7 pass efficiency was the fifth highest mark in team history, while he completed 61.5 percent of his passes, seventh best in the team record book. Lee threw for four or more touchdowns in five different games, including two five-touchdown performances, while he eclipsed the 300-yard mark four times, highlighted by a school-record 400-yard effort in the season finale at Oberlin.

FAMILIAR FRONT: In addition to its skill players, Allegheny also boasts an experienced offensive line. Junior guard Dom Antinozzi and junior tackle Rafael Balanquet have each appeared in all 20 games over their careers, while junior center Zach Wilson was the team's full-time starter at the position as a freshman in 2016, before missing the duration of last year due to injury. Senior Jake Reidenbach, who is slated to see the bulk of the action at guard, also has seen extensive action throughout his career, and will make the move to the line full-time after serving as the team's primary long snapper over the past three years.

ON THE DEFENSIVE : The Gator defense returns nine players who appeared in all 10 games last season, including eight who started at least twice. Senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport is the unit's most seasoned player, as he has started 29 of 30 career games, and owns 26.0 tackles for loss and 6.5 quarterback sacks. The co-captain ranked second on the team in both TFL's (11.0) and sacks (3.0) last season, while also forcing a pair of fumbles and recovering one.

FRESH FACES: A total of 41 new players dot the Gator roster for 2018, including 36 freshmen. Additionally, head coach B.J. Hammer welcomed two new assistants to his staff. Mitchell Czerniak will coach the safeties in 2018, while Cody Crawford enters his first season at Allegheny as running backs coach.

NEW FOES: This week marks the first ever meeting on the gridiron between Allegheny and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. The Gators and Engineers own two of the longest football traditions in NCAA Division III, as Allegheny fielded its first gridiron squad in 1893, and R.P.I. in 1886. The two teams have combined for 946 victories. R.P.I. is the first new opponent for Allegheny since Oct. 6, 2012, a 10-0 loss to the University of Chicago in the Windy City.

SERVING A PURPOSE: Last season, Allegheny was one of just three teams in the North Coast Athletic Conference to boast a pair of players who finished with over 1,000 all-purpose yards. Alex Victor ranked third in the conference with 1,302 (234 rushing / 1,037 receiving), while Tyler Balla gained 1,068 (955 rushing / 113 receiving) to place ninth in the league. It marked the first season that Allegheny had two players amass over 1,000 APYs since 2003, when Bryan Woods totaled 1,308 (597 receiving / 423 punt return / 288 kick return) and Jamie Sye 1,090 (931 rushing / 159 receiving).

WEALTHY RETURNS: Over coach B.J. Hammer's first two years at the helm, the Gators have boasted one of the NCAC's most formidable kick return games. In 2016, Allegheny ranked third in the NCAC in kick return average with a mark of 23.1 yards per try, bolstered by then-junior Jake Wilson, who set a NCAA Division III record with 1,268 kick return yards on the season, posting an average of 23.8 per try. Last season, the Gators again ranked third in the league with an average of 19.8 yards per return. Wilson placed second in the league with an average of 22.2 yards on 25 returns, while teammate Chase Balla took third with an average of 22.1 yards per try.

UP NEXT: Allegheny opens up a two-game road swing next Saturday, September 1, when they travel to east-central Ohio to take on North Coast Athletic Conference foe Wooster at 1 p.m. Wooster has won a pair of offensive shootouts over the Gators in each of the past two seasons, including a 49-36 decision in Meadville on Sept. 9 of last season, and a 49-40 win in Ohio on Sept. 10, 2016. The Gators will be looking for their first win over the Fighting Scots since the 2012 season-opener. After next week's bout at Wooster, the Gators will return to Ohio to face Denison in a 1 p.m. matinee on Sept. 15.

A Look at This Week's Opponent

Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute enters the 2018 season ranked 25th in the D3Football.com preseason poll... The Engineers finished 8-3 in 2017, tying for the Liberty League championship and advancing to the NCAA Division III playoffs for just the fifth time in team history... The Engineers return nearly their entire offense, including all five linemen — **Chris Neu, Jakob Grant, Bobby Boos, Aaron Castillo** and **Scott Black**. Four of the five were all-conference picks in 2017, while Neu has been named to D3Football.com's 2018 preseason All-America team... **George Marinopoulos** enters his second season as R.P.I.'s starting quarterback, and will be joined by two of his leading receivers from a season ago in **Keaton Ackermann** and **Conor Davies**... Davies also earned All-Liberty League honors after averaging 21.5 yards on kick returns... R.P.I. had a strong ground game last season, running for 19 touchdowns and averaging 178 rushing yards per game, but lost its top two rushers to graduation. **Nick Cella** is the team's most experienced running back, going for 360 yards and five touchdowns in 2017... Cornerback **Sean Egan**, an all-conference and all-region selection in 2017, leads a group of six defensive returning starters. Egan made 47 tackles and ranked among the national leaders with seven interceptions to spearhead a secondary that picked off 23 passes. **Rory McCarthy** and **D.J. Stefonsky** are also back in the secondary after combining for 91 tackles and six interceptions in 2017... The Engineers have gone 34-20 in head coach **Ralph Isernia's** five seasons, while they have finished .500 or better in each of the past six years... R.P.I. has won six straight season openers, and 16 of its last 17.

ALLEGHENY COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH B.J. HAMMER (3rd season)



B.J. Hammer was named the 34th head coach in Allegheny football program history on January 4, 2016.

After posting a 1-9 mark in his first season at Allegheny in 2016, the program's rebuilding took big strides in 2017, as the Gators finished 3-7 while posting prolific numbers on both sides of the ball. Offensively, Allegheny averaged 34.0 points and 449.6 yards per game, both of which were the Gators' most since 2002. Sophomore Alex Victor earned First Team All-NCAC honors after setting school records for receiving yards (1,037) and touchdowns (15), while Tyler Balla became the first Gator running back to earn All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns. Quarterback Logan Lee also had a record-breaking season, setting new Gator single-season marks in nearly every passing category, including completions (214), yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33).

The 2017 Gator defense also saw a pair of All-NCAC recipients. Defensive end Colten Buzard set a new Allegheny single-season mark with 20.5 tackles for loss, while tying a 17-year old school record with 12.0 sacks. Defensive back Chase Balla became the first Gator rookie to earn All-NCAC honors since 2014, as he finished with a team-best 73 tackles while breaking up five passes.

In his first season at the helm, Hammer saw a pair of his players earn All-NCAC honors, including senior John McFarland and junior Jake Wilson. McFarland ended his career as one of the most prolific tight ends in program history, and hauled in 48 catches for 552 yards. Wilson established an NCAA Division III record with 1,268 kick return yards, averaging 24.5 yards per try, and breaking off five returns of 50 yards or longer. As a team, the Gator offense saw an increase of an average of 9.0 points and 83 yards per game from the 2015 season, while the team's pass defense ranked in the top five of the NCAC.

Hammer arrived at Allegheny after spending five seasons as the defensive coordinator at fellow North Coast Athletic Conference member Wabash College. There, he led a defensive unit that consistently ranked among NCAA Division-III's best. During his five-year tenure, the Little Giants posted a record of 51-7, making three appearances in the NCAA Division-III playoffs and winning NCAC championships in 2011 and 2015. He mentored the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year in four of his five seasons as defensive coordinator, while 22 Wabash defenders were First Team All-NCAC honorees, and four were named All-America.

In 2015, the Little Giants finished 12-1, including a perfect 8-0 in the NCAC, and advanced to the third round of the NCAA playoffs. Hammer's defense ranked third nationally with 26 interceptions, fourth in rushing defense (72.2 yds/g), fifth in total defense (240.9 yds/g), and seventh in quarterback sacks (42). Eight Little Giant defenders earned All-NCAC honors, including six First Team selections. Wabash ended the year ranked seventh in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3Football.com Top 25 polls.

In 2014, Hammer was named a Division-III Coordinator of the Year finalist after his unit led D-III in rushing defense (66.3 yds/g) and quarterback sacks (4.6 sacks/g), while ranking third in total defense, fifth in tackles for loss, and 12th in scoring defense. Little Giant linebacker Cody Buresh was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-America by both D3Football.com and the AFCA.

The 2013 Wabash defense led the nation in total defense (220.7 yds/g), fumbles recovered (19), and turnover margin (+24), while placing second in tackles for loss (11.6 TFL/g) and rushing defense (63.1). In 2012, the Little Giants placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and 10th in rushing defense, while linebacker CJ Gum earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year award for a second straight season.

In his first season as the Wabash defensive coordinator, the Little Giants ranked fifth in the nation in rushing defense (78.1 yds/g), 11th in scoring defense (12.9 pts/g), and 12th in total defense (249.4 yds/g), while they paced the NCAC in every defensive statistical category. In addition to Gum being named the conference's top defender, linebacker AJ Akinribade was named NCAC Newcomer of the Year.

Prior to his five-year tenure at Wabash, Hammer spent eight seasons on the football staff at Whittier College. After working as the Poets' defensive coordinator from 2003-05, Hammer was promoted to head coach, a position he held from 2006-10. Posting a 12-33 overall record, Hammer rebuilt a program that had just 13 players on its roster in 2003 to one that averaged a roster size of over 100. Thirty Whittier players were named All-Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC), while the Whittier defense ranked second in the conference in total defense in 2006, and its rushing offense ranked second in the SCIAC in both 2009 and 2010.

Before his stint in California, Hammer spent the 2002 season as the linebackers coach at Heidelberg College, after beginning his coaching career in 2001 as the outside linebackers coach at Wabash.

Hammer graduated from Wabash in 2001, and is regarded as one of the top defenders to ever suit up for the Little Giants. He graduated as the school's record holder for tackles for loss in a game (five), season (23), and career (58), as well as single-season sacks (15), while he is tied with younger brother Blair as the Little Giants' all-time record holder in career sacks with 27.5. Team captain in 2000, Hammer was a two-time All-American and three-time All-Conference honoree, and was named the 2001 Pete Vaughn Award, which is given annually to the top Wabash senior athlete as voted upon by the athletic department.

A native of Carmel, Indiana, Hammer and wife Emily are the parents of daughters Layla and Ellie, and son William. They reside in Meadville.


