#### **GATORS FACE ROAD TEST AT DENISON**

After winning their conference opener at Wooster in dramatic fashion by a 27-20 score, Allegheny returns home to face Denison, and looks to start 2-0 in NCAC play for the first time since 2012.

Last week at Wooster, Logan Lee came off the bench to fire a 30-yard touchdown strike to Ben Bachik with just over a minute left in regulation to break a 20-20 tie, before Seth Warburton

forced a fumble on the opening play of Wooster's ensuing possession to seal the win. It was Allegheny's first win over the Fighting Scots since 2012, and the Gators' first NCAC road win since week two of the 2014 season. This week, the Gators will be searching for their first win over Denison since 2011, as the Big Red have won five straight.

Denison was idle last week, after opening the season with a 42-21 loss to Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas on Sept. 1. The Big Red led 7-0 after the first quarter, before the Pirates scored 21

straight points in the second quarter, and would maintain the lead the rest of the way. Canaan Gebele, an All-NCAC selection a season ago, threw for 187 yards and a touchdown for Denison, while fellow All-NCAC honoree Alex Minton ran for 100 yards and scored

two of his team's three touchdowns. Denison, which finished 7-3 last season and is a combined 22-8 since the 2016 campaign, was picked to finish fourth in this year's NCAC preseason coaches poll, and received one first-place vote. Gebele and Minton highlight a group of seven returning all-conference players for the Big Red.

#### **MEDIA INFORMATION**

Interviews of Allegheny coaches and athletes shall be arranged through the school's office of athletic communications. On game days, locker rooms are closed to the media. Following the game, players will be available for interviews upon request once they are dismissed by the coaching staff. Due to extremely limited press box space, requests for press box and media credentials should be made to Jim Berger no later than 48 hours prior to each game.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Allegheny's 27-20 win last week over Wooster marked the Gators' first victory over the Fighting Scots since the 2012 season-opener, a 17-14 triumph. Last week's victory was also Allegheny's first NCAC road win since a 24-21 victory at Hiram on Sept. 20, 2014.

RECORD RECEIVER: In the win at Wooster, junior Alex Victor made six receptions for 199 yards and a touchdown to become Allegheny's all-time career record holder in receiving yards, as he enters this week with 2,035. Victor needed just 21 career games to break the previous mark of 2,000 yards established by Jon Turner in 2003. Victor's touchdown grab was a 91-yarder from quarterback Naz Greer, the second-longest touchdown pass in Allegheny history. It was Victor's 26th career touchdown, also a school record, and on Monday, he was named NCAC Offensive Player of the Week for the second time in his career.

**TOP OF THE CHARTS:** After his 199-yard performance at Wooster, Alex Victor has now made 15 catches for 444 yards through the first two games of the season. The 444 yards rank first in the NCAA across all classifications heading into week three.

**TAKING OFFENSE:** The Gators totaled 469 yards of total offense (344 passing/125 rushing) in the week two win against Wooster. Allegheny has now eclipsed 400 yards of total offense in seven of its past 11 games, after doing so just three times between 2011-16. The Gators' currently top the NCAC in both total offense (455.0 yds/g) and passing offense (357.0 yds/g), with the passing total currently good for 10th in NCAA Division III.

**GREER THE GUNNER:** In his first two career starts under center, sophomore quarterback Naz Greer has completed 45 passes for 655 yards and three touchdowns. His 655 passing yards top the NCAC and rank ninth in NCAA Division III, while it is the highest total posted by a Gator quarterback in his first two career starts in program history.

FRESH FACES: Through the first two weeks of the 2018 season, three of the Gators' top defenders are first-year members of the team. Outside linebacker Bryan Lopez currently ranks second on the team in both total tackles (16) and tackles for loss (3.0), while cornerback Quinten Hunt is third on the squad with 15 tackles, and safety Zach Martin fourth with 13. Additionally, Lopez and Hunt own both of the Gators' interceptions on the season, while Hunt owns a forced fumble, and Martin a pass breakup.

MARCUS MAKES IT HAPPEN: One of Allegheny's top defensive players in last week's win at Wooster was senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport, who totaled eight tackles, 3.0 TFLs, and 2.0 sacks. It marked Davenport's second career game with at least two sacks, after his 2.5 sack performance in a win over Hiram on Sept. 20 of last season. He is now one of just three Allegheny players to own at least two career two-sack games since 2008, joining Colten Buzard (2005-17) and Chris Patrick (2012-15). A four-year starter on the line, Davenport currently ranks as the Gators' active career leader in tackles (112), tackles for loss (20.0), and sacks (8.5).

**OLD RELIABLE:** For the second straight week, Allegheny senior Zach Bednarowicz was a perfect 2-for-2 on field goal attempts, connecting on tries of 21 and 23 yards in the Gators' win over Wooster. Bednarowicz is also 4-for-4 on extra point tries through the first two weeks of the season. The veteran has connected on six straight field goals dating back to week nine of last season, and is 7-for-9 overall on three-point attempts since the start of last year. He is also 35-for-38 on extra point tries over the span

COMEBACK KIDS: Logan Lee's 30-yard touchdown pass to Ben Bachik with 1:26 left in the fourth quarter propelled the Gators to last week's 27-20 win at Wooster. It was the third time since 2012 that the Gators earned a win after either trailing or being tied with less than 10 minutes left in the fourth quarter. The previous time was on Sept. 20, 2014, when Nick Deichler scored a go-ahead touchdown with just over eight minutes left in the final stanza to pull the Gators past Hiram 24-21. Prior to that, on Sept. 22, 2012 at Wabash, Allegheny's Tyler Smith ran for a 9-yard touchdown with 8:26 left in the fourth quarter to forge a 17-17 tie, before Ryan Mong's 28-yard field goal on the second possession of overtime sealed the win.

**THE CENTURY CLUB:** Senior Tyler Balla ran for 116 yards in last week's win at Wooster, marking his sixth career 100-yard rushing game. Since 2000, only two Allegheny players own more 100-yard rushing efforts, as Mario Tarquinio turned in 14 between 2003-06, and Shane Ream, Allegheny's all-time leading rusher, posted 22 between 1998-2001.

LEE THE GENERAL: Allegheny senior quarterback Logan Lee continues to climb the Gator career leaderboard in a number of passing categories. Through 30 career games, the veteran ranks second in team history with 52 career touchdown passes, just three from tying 2003 graduate Bubba Smith's school record of 55. Lee also ranks fourth in both completions (419) and passing yards (5,463), while his six career 300-yard passing games are the most by a quarterback in program history.

**CAPTAIN GATORS:** Allegheny's five co-captains for the 2018 season include senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport, senior receiver Tristan Rhoades, senior running back Tyler Balla, junior linebacker Corey Laskev.

**UP NEXT:** Next Saturday (Sept. 22), Allegheny returns home to face NCAC foe Ohio Wesleyan in a 1 p.m. game at Frank B. Fuhrer Field. It marks the Gators' first home game since the opening week of the season, while the squad will be looking for its first win over the Battling Bishops since Oct. 23, 2011. At half-time of next week's game, Allegheny will recognize the 1968 Gator football team that won the Presidents' Athletic Conference championship. The Gators will then go three more weeks without a home game, as they travel to Hiram on Sept. 29 and enjoy the bye week on Oct. 5, before hosting Wittenberg on Oct. 13.

## **ALLEGHENY vs. DENISON - THE LAST MEETING**

MEADVILLE, Pa. (Sep. 16, 2017) - In a battle of prolific offenses, visiting Denison showcased its propensity for the big play in defeating Allegheny 62-26 at Frank B. Fuhrer Field.

The Gators gained 472 yards of total offense, their highest single-game output since 2011, but the visiting Big Red rode the hot hand of quarterback Canaan Gebele to roll up 746 yards, including 479 through the air. Five of Denison's touchdowns covered 30 or more yards, with Gebele and Malik Webster connecting on touchdown strikes of 60 and 72 yards, both in the second quarter.

Gator quarterback Logan Lee also turned in a prolific showing in defeat, completing 24 of 37 passes for a career-high 317 yards and two touchdowns, marking the first 300-yard passing game for a Gator signal caller since Oct. 15, 2011, when Jordan Fowler threw for 211.

Tristan Rhoades haule in both of Lee's touchdown passes, the first two TD grabs of the converted safety's career, while he nothced career-highs with eight receptions and 139 yards. Classmate Tyler Balla also scored a pair of touchowns and reached the century mark for the first time on the season with 108 yards on 20 carries.

Three different Denison receivers topped the 100yard mark, as David Weimar made eight catches for 120 yards, Charlie Mueller seven for 133, and Webster four for 157. Gebele completed 22 of 30 passes for 402 yards, while Cody Farley ran for 113 yards on just five tries.

Jonah Tanner made eight tackles to lead Allegheny, including one for a three-yard loss, while Craye Nehler and Chase Balla finished with three tackles apiece.

Brice Winans was Denison's top defender on the afternoon, making 11 tackles and forcing a fumble. The Big Red sacked Lee four times on the afternoon, with Chase Struewing credited with 1.5 quarterback sacks.

## Last Time Out: Late Touchdown Pushes Gators Past Fighting Scots

**WOOSTER, Ohio** – Logan Lee's 30-yard touchdown pass to Ben Bachik with 86 seconds left in regulation lifted Allegheny to a 27-20 victory over Wooster in both teams' North Coast Athletic Conference opener.

Following the Bachik-to-Lee hookup, the Gators' Seth Warburton forced a fumble recovered by teammate Terran Moore with 59 seconds left in regulation to officially seal the Gator win.

Leading 14-0 after the first quarter and 20-10 after the third, the Bachik touchdown and Warburton forced fumble quashed a fourth quarter Wooster rally, and give the Gators their first win over the Fighting Scots since week one of the 2012 season.

Junior Alex Victor continued to rewrite the Allegheny record books, as he made six catches for 199 yards and a touchdown to become the team's all-time leader in career receiving yards, as he now has 2,035 for his career to break Jon Turner's previous mark of 2,000 set in 2004. Victor's 91-yard touchdown reception from Nazareth Greer was a new career-long, and was the 26th of his career, adding on to his school record.

Tyler Balla turned in his sixth career 100-yard rushing game, gaining 116 yards on 26 carries, while the Gator defense tallied five quarterback sacks, including two from Marcus Davenport, while Bryan Lopez made 10 tackles and picked off his first career interception.

Neither team found the scoreboard in a briskly-paced first quarter. On its first possession, Wooster used a pair of long passes to advance inside the red zone, but the Gator defense held, and forced a missed 31-yard field goal. Wooster's offense again came up empty on its second trip of the game, with the Gators forcing a turnover on downs after David Perez broke up a fourth down pass attempt.

The teams would trade punts over the remainder of the quarter, before the Gators started off the second stanza in fine fashion. Facing a third-and-sixth on their own

nine yard line, Greer found Victor with a short pass, and the junior speedster did the rest, out-racing the Wooster defense for the 91-yard score to put the visitors on top 7-0.

A sack from Chase Balla thwarted Wooster's ensuing possession, and Greer went back to the air to up the Gators' lead. The sophomore signal caller found Victor for a 29-yard completion, before hooking up with receiver Jared Shaw for a 36-yard touchdown to give the Gators a 14-0 lead with just inside 10 minutes left in the half.

Wooster returned the favor on its next trip, with Caden Croft hooking up with Nick Strausbaugh for a 59-yard score with 8:04 left until the half, before the Gators put together a lengthy drive of nearly five minutes that culminated with a 21-yard field goal from Zach Bednarowicz with 3:45 to go that gave Allegheny a 17-7 lead, which would remain the score at the half.

The third quarter would begin with both teams embarking on lengthy drives that would result in field goals, as Wooster's Henry Whyte hit a 20-yarder with 6:55 left in the third, before Bednarowicz came on to make his second three-pointer of the day, this one from 23 yards out, that put the Gators on top 20-10 with 3:28 remaining in the quarter.

The fourth quarter opened with Strausbaugh hauling in a 56-yarder from Croft to set up first-and-goal inside the Allegheny 10, but Allegheny would cede just three yards over the next three plays, which included a Davenport sack. The Fighting Scots were forced to settle with another successful Whyte kick to trim the gap to 20-13 with 12:06 left.

After an Allegheny three-and-out, Wooster looked primed to tie it, with a 49-yard run from Antonio Bailey setting up first-and-goal inside the two yardline. However, an unsportsmanlike penalty followed by a false start infraction pushed the ball back to the 21. A pair of short completions brought the ball to the Gator 17, but Lopez would step in front of a Croft pass on the one-yard line to end the 8-play, 88-yard drive.

Wooster's defense answered right back with an interception of its own at the Gator 11-yard line, and this time, the Fighting Scot offense would cash in on the short field, with Croft scoring on a quarterback keeper to tie the game at 20-20 with 3:33 left in regulation.

Taking over at their own 25 yardline with 3:26, the Gators orchestrated the decisive scoring drive with Logan Lee under center, with the veteran signal caller seeing his first action of the season after missing the duration of preseason and the season opener with an injury.

Victor opened the drive with a 13-yard run, before catching a 19-yard pass from Lee to set up first down for Allegheny at the Wooster 43. After a four-yard run from Balla, Lee hooked up with Tristan Rhoades for a 10-yard pass to move the ball to the Wooster 30. Lee then lofted a pass into the end zone to Bachik, who hauled in the pass and tiptoed just inside the pylon for the Gator touchdown. Bednarowicz's extra point was good, and the Gators led 27-20 with 1:20 left to play. Lee was a perfect 3-for-3 for 59 yards on the game-deciding drive.

Wooster started its final drive at its own 36 yardline, and a 22-yard pass to Strausbaugh bringing the ball inside the Allegheny 45. Croft would then try a quarterback sneak, and the ball was jarred loose by Warburton and picked up by Terran Moore to abruptly halt the comeback attempt. A trio of runs from Balla would then run out the clock, and seal the Gator victory.

Greer completed 14 of 25 passes for 285 yards and two touchdowns. Bachik and Rhoades each made three receptions, with the former going for 46 yards, and the latter 35

Defensively, Quinten Hunt led Allegheny with 11 tackles, including a tackle for loss, while he forced a fumble. Two of Lopez's 10 tackles were behind the line of scrimmage, while Davenport turned in three TFL's and eight total tackles.

For Wooster, Croft completed 21 passes for 376 yards, with Strausbaugh finishing with seven catches for 179 yards. Bailey gained 114 yards on the ground on 20 carries, while Mark Herron paced the Fighting Scot defense with seven tackles, along with a forced fumble.

## ALLEGHENY COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH B.J. HAMMER (3rd season) B.J. Hammer was named the 34th head coach in Allegheny football program history on January 4, 2016.

After posting a 1-9 mark in his first season at Allegheny in 2016, the program's rebuilding took big strides in 2017, as the Gators finished 3-7 while posting prolific numbers on both sides of the ball. Offensively, Allegheny averaged 34.0 points and 449.6 yards per game, both of which were the Gators' most since 2002. Sophomore Alex Victor earned First Team All-NCAC honors after setting school records for receiving yards (1,037) and touchdowns (15), while Tyler Balla became the first Gator running back to earn All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns. Quarterback Logan Lee also had a record-breaking season, setting new Gator singleseason marks in nearly every passing category, including completions (214), yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33).

The 2017 Gator defense also saw a pair of All-NCAC recipients. Defensive end Colten Buzard set a new Allegheny singleseason mark with 20.5 tackles for loss, while tying a 17-year old school record with 12.0 sacks. Defensive back Chase Balla became the first Gator rookie to earn All-NCAC honors since 2014, as he finished with a team-best 73 tackles while breaking up five passes.

In his first season at the helm, Hammer saw a pair of his players earn All-NCAC honors, including senior John McFarland and junior Jake Wilson. McFarland ended his career as one of the most prolific tight ends in program history, and hauled in 48 catches for 552 yards. Wilson established an NCAA Division III record with 1.268 kick return vards, averaging 24.5 yards per try, and breaking off five returns of 50 yards or longer. As a team, the Gator offense saw an increase of an average of 9.0 points and 83 yards per game from the 2015 season, while the team's pass defense ranked in the top five of the NCAC.

Hammer arrived at Allegheny after spending five seasons as the defensive coordinator at fellow North Coast Athletic Conference member Wabash College. There, he led a defensive unit that consistently ranked among NCAA Division-III's best. During his five-year tenure, the Little Giants posted a record of 51-7, making three appearances in the NCAA Division-III playoffs and winning NCAC championships in 2011 and 2015. He mentored the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year in four of his five seasons as defensive coordinator, while 22 Wabash defenders were First Team All-NCAC honorees, and four were named All-America.

In 2015, the Little Giants finished 12-1, including a perfect 8-0 in the NCAC, and advanced to the third round of the NCAA playoffs. Hammer's defense ranked third nationally with 26 interceptions, fourth in rushing defense (72.2 yds/g), fifth in total defense (240.9 yds/g), and seventh in quarterback sacks (42). Eight Little Giant defenders earned All-NCAC honors, including six First Team selections. Wabash ended the year ranked seventh in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3Football.com Top 25 polls.

In 2014, Hammer was named a Division-III Coordinator of the Year finalist after his unit led D-III in rushing defense (66.3 yds/g) and quarterback sacks (4.6 sacks/g), while ranking third in total defense, fifth in tackles for loss, and 12th in scoring defense. Little Giant linebacker Cody Buresh was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-America by both D3Football.com and the AFCA.

The 2013 Wabash defense led the nation in total defense (220.7 yds/g), fumbles recovered (19), and turnover margin (+24), while placing second in tackles for loss (11.6 TFL/g) and rushing defense (63.1). In 2012, the Little Giants placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and 10th in rushing defense, while linebacker CJ Gum earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year award for a second straight season.

In his first season as the Wabash defensive coordinator, the Little Giants ranked fifth in the nation in rushing defense (78.1 yds/g), 11th in scoring defense (12.9 pts/g), and 12th in total defense (249.4 yds/g), while they paced the NCAC in every defensive statistical category. In addition to Gum being named the conference's top defender, linebacker AJ Akinribade was named NCAC Newcomer of the Year.

Prior to his five-year tenure at Wabash, Hammer spent eight seasons on the football staff at Whittier College. After working as the Poets' defensive coordinator from 2003-05. Hammer was promoted to head coach, a position he held from 2006-10. Posting a 12-33 overall record, Hammer rebuilt a program that had just 13 players on its roster in 2003 to one that averaged a roster size of over 100. Thirty Whittier players were named All-Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC), while the Whitter defense ranked second in the conference in total defense in 2006, and its rushing offense ranked second in the SCIAC in both 2009 and 2010.

Before his stint in California, Hammer spent the 2002 season as the linebackers coach at Heidelberg College, after beginning his coaching career in 2001 as the outside linebackers coach at Wabash.

Hammer graduated from Wabash in 2001, and is regarded as one of the top defenders to ever suit up for the Little Giants. He graduated as the school's record holder for tackles for loss in a game (five), season (23), and career (58), as well as single-season sacks (15), while he is tied with younger brother Blair as the Little Giants' all-time record holder in career sacks with 27.5. Team captain in 2000, Hammer was a two-time All-American and three-time All-Conference honoree, and was named the 2001 Pete Vaughn Award, which is given annually to the top Wabash senior athlete as voted upon by the athletic department.

A native of Carmel, Indiana, Hammer and wife Emily are the parents of daughters Layla and Ellie, and son William. They reside in Meadville.
