## GATORS RETURN HOME TO TAKE ON BATTLING BISHOPS

This week, Allegheny returns home for the first time since week one, as the Gators take on North Coast Athletic Conference foe Ohio Wesleyan. The Gators will be looking to bounce back from a disappointing 42-0 loss to Denison a week ago, a game in which Allegheny managed just eight first downs and was out-gained 495-144 in total offense. Leading 21-0 at the half, the Big Red put the game away with three touchdowns in a seven-minute span in the third quarter. The Gators will also be looking to snap a long losing skid against Ohio Wesleyan, as the Battling Bishops have won six straight meetings between the two squads, including four straight in Meadville, dating back to 2011.



Ohio Wesleyan earned a 9-7 win over Wooster in dramatic fashion last Saturday, as freshman kicker Gabe Philhower connected on a 27-yard field goal in the closing seconds to seal the comeback victory. It was Philhower's third field goal of the day, and the rookie was named NCAC Player of the Week on Monday. The Battling Bishops gained just 214 yards of total offense in the win, but the team's defense forced four turnovers and allowed just 3.9 yards per play. The win evened OWU's record at 1-1, as the Battling Bishops dropped another low scoring affair in week one, a 10-7 loss to Otterbein. Through their first two games of the season, the Battling Bishops' defense has allowed an average of just 261.0 yards per game, and leads the NCAC with seven forced turnovers, including five fumble recoveries.

## MEDIA INFORMATION

Interviews of Allegheny coaches and athletes shall be arranged through the school's office of athletic communications. On game days, locker rooms are closed to the media. Following the game, players will be available for interviews upon request once they are dismissed by the coaching staff. Due to extremely limited press box space, requests for press box and media credentials should be made to Jim Berger no later than 48 hours prior to each game.

**WELCOME BACK:** This week, Allegheny will welcome back the 1968 Gator football team as guests of honor to recognize the 50th anniversary of the first Presidents' Athletic Conference title in program history. The 1968 Gators finished 7-1 overall, and a perfect 6-0 in the PAC, clinching the conference title with a dramatic 35-32 win at Thiel. Four members of the 1968 team - offensive linemen Jim Stover and Peter Blufarb, quarterback Mike Ganey, and receiver/defensive back Jay Lewis - earned First Team All-PAC honors, while four players (Lewis, Ganey, Stover, John Boughton), along with head coach John Churkran and assistant coach Bob Garbark, have subsequently been inducted into the Allegheny Hall of Fame. It was the first of three PAC titles won by the Gators before moving to the North Coast Athletic Conference for the 1984 season.

**SACK RACE:** Through the first three games of the season, the Allegheny defense has recorded 10 sacks to rank third in the NCAC. Nine different Gators have been credited with at least a half sack, led by the tandem of senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport (2.5) and senior linebacker Seth Warburton (2.0). Sophomore linebacker Chase Balla and junior linebacker Bryan Lopez each have 1.5 quarterback takedowns. While the Gator defense has totaled 10 sacks, the Gator offensive has suffered just six, the second fewest in the conference.

**TOP OF THE CHARTS:** Despite being limited to just one catch for 19 yards in an injury-shortened outing at Denison last week, Gator junior receiver Alex Victor continues to lead the NCAC in receiving yards (463), yards per catch (28.9), touchdown receptions (9), and all-purpose yards (502). Victor, who is expected to play this week, currently ranks fourth in the nation in NCAA Division III with 463 reception yards. Just 22 games into his career, Victor owns Allegheny career records in receiving yards (2,054) and touchdown catches (26), while he is tied for fifth all-time with 102 career receptions.

**USING THE FORCE:** Allegheny senior linebacker Seth Warburton currently leads the NCAC - and is tied for first in NCAA Division III - with three forced fumbles on the season. Warburton forced a pair in the season-opener vs. R.P.I., while adding his third a week later in the Gators' win over Wooster. The three forced fumbles are already the most in a single-season for a Gator since 2015, when Nick Murgo finished with three in 10 games, while Warburton is seeking to become the first Gator to force four fumbles in a season since Jon Olshock in 2000.

**SEEING RED:** The Gators currently rank fifth in the NCAC in red zone offense, coming away with points in four of six trips inside the 20-yardline. However, the Gators have yet to score a touchdown inside the red zone, with all four scores coming by way of field goals from Zach Bednarrowicz. Ohio Wesleyan enters play with the worst red zone performance in the NCAC this season, as they've connected on three field goals and no touchdowns on eight trips.

**WEALTHY RETURNS:** Through the first three weeks of the 2018 campaign, Allegheny's Tristan Rhoades and Chase Balla rank third and fourth, respectively, in the NCAC in kick return average, as Rhoades is averaging 22.6 yards per try, and Balla 20.5. The Gators are one of just two teams in the conference to have two players average over 20 yards per return, joining DePauw, while Rhoades' 45-yard return in the season-opener against R.P.I. ranks as the longest by an NCAC player this season.

**MR. CONSISTENT:** Senior running back Tyler Balla enters the week ranked fifth in the NCAC in rushing yards, averaging 76.7 per game. After rushing for a team-high 74 yards in last week's loss at Denison, Balla has now run for at least 65 yards in 11 of the team's last 13 games. Over that span, he has topped the 100-yard mark seven times, the most 100-yard rushing performances in a career since Mario Tarquinio totaled 14 between 2003-06.

**IT'S BEEN A WHILE:** This week, the Gators look to earn their first win over Ohio Wesleyan since Oct. 23, 2010, a 41-21 Allegheny triumph at Frank B. Fuhrer Field. In the offensive battle, the two teams combined for 913 yards, with Gator quarterback T.J. Salopek completing 31 of 35 passes for 342 yards and three touchdowns, all thrown to Terry Hartford. Tied at seven at the end of the first quarter, the Gators scored 24 unanswered points in an eight-minute span in the second quarter, and the Bishops were unable to recover. Allegheny was 7-for-7 in the red zone, and overcame 406 passing yards from OWU's Mason Espinosa.

**CAPTAIN GATORS:** Allegheny's five co-captains for the 2018 season include senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport, senior receiver Tristan Rhoades, senior running back Tyler Balla, junior linebacker Corey Laskey.

**UP NEXT:** Next Saturday (Sept. 29), the Gators will cross state lines to face Hiram College in a 1 p.m. NCAC bout. Last season in Meadville, Allegheny blitzed the Terriers 57-40, as the Gators gained 539 yards of total offense, while forcing four Hiram turnovers. Allegheny will then enter its bye week, before returning to Frank B. Fuhrer Field to take on Wittenberg on Oct. 13.

## ALLEGHENY vs. OHIO WESLEYAN - THE LAST MEETING

**DELAWARE, Ohio (Sept. 23, 2017)** - Thirteen unanswered points in the third quarter proved to be the difference, as host Ohio Wesleyan defeated Allegheny 37-21 on a sweltering afternoon at Selby Stadium.

Allegheny totaled 20 more yards of total offense, and nearly doubled up Ohio Wesleyan in both first downs and time of possession, but the Gators couldn't overcome a pair of turnovers and eight penalties en-route to their third straight loss.

Tyler Balla rushed for 117 yards to top the century mark for the third time in four games, while Tristan Rhoades eclipsed 100 receiving yards for the second straight week, hauling in seven passes for 104 yards.

A 37-yard Anthony Sanfillippo field goal midway through the first quarter gave the Battling Bishops the lead, and they would stay in front for the rest of the game.

In the second frame, the teams would each score a pair of touchdowns, with the Gators' points coming via a two-yard scoring plunge from Balla with 7:35 left in the half, and a two-yard touchdown pass from Logan Lee to Ben Bachik with just four seconds left, to make the score 17-14 in favor of OWU at the break.

The Gators came up empty on three drives in the third quarter, and the Bishops added on, with a 43-yard run from A.J.

Jones pushing the score to 23-14 with 7:58 left, and a 57-yard touchdown pass to Mher Tcholakian with 1:45 left upping the OWU lead to 30-14.

The Bishops scored their third unanswered touchdown with 8:25 left in the fourth quarter, with Jones scoring from three yards out to cap off a lengthy 10-pay, 91-yard drive, essentially sealing the win.

Allegheny closed out the scoring with 5:04 left, when Nazareth Greer threw his first career touchdown pass, a three-yard toss to Austin French, to make it 37-21. Allegheny's defense forced three-and-outs on OWU's final two drives, but the Gator offense was unable to respond down the stretch, and the Bishops closed out the win.

Lee completed 23 of 40 passes for 200 yards and a touchdown, but was picked off twice. In addition to Rhoades' 104-yard effort, Bachik totaled career-highs with six catches for 94 yards. Chase Balla paced the Allegheny defense with seven tackles and a pair of pass breakups, while Clarence Long totaled six stops.

## Last Time Out: Host Denison Blanks Gators in NCAC Action

**GRANVILLE, Ohio (Sept. 15, 2018)** - Behind a strong ground game and a stout defense, host Denison defeated Allegheny 42-0 in a North Coast Athletic Conference meeting at Deeds Field.


The Big Red (1-1, 1-0 NCAC) ran for 296 yards and four touchdowns, while limiting the Gators (2-1, 1-1 NCAC) to just 203 yards of total offense and eight first downs.

Denison took the lead on its opening possession of the first quarter, when a one-yard touchdown run from Alex Minton capped off a nine-play, 68-yard drive and put the hosts up 7-0 with just over nine minutes left in the quarter. The teams would then trade scoreless possessions over the next several minutes, before Denison's Dara Laja capped off the first quarter with a 70-yard touchdown run to make it 14-0 with just under a minute left in the opening stanza.

The Allegheny defense came to life on Denison's first trip of the second quarter, as Bryan Lopez and Marcus Davenport teamed up for a six-yard sack on second down, before Seth Warburton followed with a quarterback takedown of his own to knock the Big Red back inside their own 20 and force a punt.

On its next possession, Denison quarterback Canaan Gebele would complete a pair of first down passes, but the Gator defense responded yet again, with Kyle McGee and Emmanuel De La Noval teaming up for another second down sack, before Clarence Long broke up a third down pass to force another Denison punt.

Tyler Balla ran for a pair of first downs on the Gators' next trip, but the drive would stall out, and Denison would respond with a six-play, 73-yard drive that was capped off with another one-yard Minton touchown plunge that gave the hosts a 21-0 lead with 1:03 left in the half.

Gebele led the Big Red on another scoring drive to open up the third quarter, as he ran for 23 yards and passed for 26, including a 14-yard touchdown toss to David Weimar that made the score 28-0 with 12:17 remaining in the quarter. Following another Allegheny punt, Gebele hooked up with Cody Farley for a 37-yard touchdown to push the lead to 35-0 with 8:01 left in the quarter.

Allegheny would counter with its longest drive of the afternoon. Pinned down inside their own 10 following a penalty on the kickoff, Logan Lee found Ben Bachik with an 11-yard pass, before Balla netted 32 yards on three straight runs to bring the ball to midfield. A pair of Kobe Pinkey rushes netted seven yards, but the drive would stall, and an incomplete pass would give the ball back to Denison on downs. Two plays later, Gebele scrambled 16 yards for a touchdown with just over four minutes left in the quarter.

Quinten Hunt's second interception of the season ended Denison's first drive of the fourth quarter, and the Gator offense would then embark on a lengthy drive. A pair of penalties on the Gators set up second and 25 at their own 40, but a nine-yard pass from Lee to Angel Alvarez, a nine-run scramble by Lee, and a 37-yard completion from Lee to Bachik gave Allegheny first and goal inside the Denison eight. A pair of runs would advance the ball just inside the one, but Denison's defense held, forcing an incomplete pass on fourth-and-goal with 7:33 left to quash the Gators' scoring chance.

The Gator defense would yield just two yards to the Big Red over the next three plays to force a punt, but a roughing the kicker penalty gave Denison a first down, and the hosts would then go to the ground to run out the clock and close out the win.

In his first start of the season, Lee completed 11 of 28 passes for 119 yards. Balla led the Allegheny ground game with 74 yards on 15 carries, while Bachik finished with three catches for 57 yards.

Defensively, Warburton, McGee, Davenport, and David Perez were each credited with six tackles. Warburton finished with three tackles for loss, while assisting on a pair of sacks.

Gebele led the Denison offense, competing nine of 12 passes for 206 yards, while rushing nine times for 50 yards. He was one of four Big Red players to finish with at least 40 rushing yards, with Laja gaining 84 yards on six tries to lead the way. Ryan Hallinan topped Denison with eight tackles, while Nate Keirn had six stops and one of his team's four sacks.

## ALLEGHENY COACHING STAFF

### HEAD COACH B.J. HAMMER (3rd season)



B.J. Hammer was named the 34th head coach in Allegheny football program history on January 4, 2016.

After posting a 1-9 mark in his first season at Allegheny in 2016, the program's rebuilding took big strides in 2017, as the Gators finished 3-7 while posting prolific numbers on both sides of the ball. Offensively, Allegheny averaged 34.0 points and 449.6 yards per game, both of which were the Gators' most since 2002. Sophomore Alex Victor earned First Team All-NCAC honors after setting school records for receiving yards (1,037) and touchdowns (15), while Tyler Balla became the first Gator running back to earn All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns. Quarterback Logan Lee also had a record-breaking season, setting new Gator single-season marks in nearly every passing category, including completions (214), yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33).

The 2017 Gator defense also saw a pair of All-NCAC recipients. Defensive end Colten Buzard set a new Allegheny single-season mark with 20.5 tackles for loss, while tying a 17-year old school record with 12.0 sacks. Defensive back Chase Balla became the first Gator rookie to earn All-NCAC honors since 2014, as he finished with a team-best 73 tackles while breaking up five passes.

In his first season at the helm, Hammer saw a pair of his players earn All-NCAC honors, including senior John McFarland and junior Jake Wilson. McFarland ended his career as one of the most prolific tight ends in program history, and hauled in 48 catches for 552 yards. Wilson established an NCAA Division III record with 1,268 kick return yards, averaging 24.5 yards per try, and breaking off five returns of 50 yards or longer. As a team, the Gator offense saw an increase of an average of 9.0 points and 83 yards per game from the 2015 season, while the team's pass defense ranked in the top five of the NCAC.

Hammer arrived at Allegheny after spending five seasons as the defensive coordinator at fellow North Coast Athletic Conference member Wabash College. There, he led a defensive unit that consistently ranked among NCAA Division-III's best. During his five-year tenure, the Little Giants posted a record of 51-7, making three appearances in the NCAA Division-III playoffs and winning NCAC championships in 2011 and 2015. He mentored the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year in four of his five seasons as defensive coordinator, while 22 Wabash defenders were First Team All-NCAC honorees, and four were named All-America.

In 2015, the Little Giants finished 12-1, including a perfect 8-0 in the NCAC, and advanced to the third round of the NCAA playoffs. Hammer's defense ranked third nationally with 26 interceptions, fourth in rushing defense (72.2 yds/g), fifth in total defense (240.9 yds/g), and seventh in quarterback sacks (42). Eight Little Giant defenders earned All-NCAC honors, including six First Team selections. Wabash ended the year ranked seventh in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3Football.com Top 25 polls.

In 2014, Hammer was named a Division-III Coordinator of the Year finalist after his unit led D-III in rushing defense (66.3 yds/g) and quarterback sacks (4.6 sacks/g), while ranking third in total defense, fifth in tackles for loss, and 12th in scoring defense. Little Giant linebacker Cody Buresh was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-America by both D3Football.com and the AFCA.

The 2013 Wabash defense led the nation in total defense (220.7 yds/g), fumbles recovered (19), and turnover margin (+24), while placing second in tackles for loss (11.6 TFL/g) and rushing defense (63.1). In 2012, the Little Giants placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and 10th in rushing defense, while linebacker CJ Gum earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year award for a second straight season.

In his first season as the Wabash defensive coordinator, the Little Giants ranked fifth in the nation in rushing defense (78.1 yds/g), 11th in scoring defense (12.9 pts/g), and 12th in total defense (249.4 yds/g), while they paced the NCAC in every defensive statistical category. In addition to Gum being named the conference's top defender, linebacker AJ Akinribade was named NCAC Newcomer of the Year.

Prior to his five-year tenure at Wabash, Hammer spent eight seasons on the football staff at Whittier College. After working as the Poets' defensive coordinator from 2003-05, Hammer was promoted to head coach, a position he held from 2006-10. Posting a 12-33 overall record, Hammer rebuilt a program that had just 13 players on its roster in 2003 to one that averaged a roster size of over 100. Thirty Whittier players were named All-Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC), while the Whittier defense ranked second in the conference in total defense in 2006, and its rushing offense ranked second in the SCIAC in both 2009 and 2010.

Before his stint in California, Hammer spent the 2002 season as the linebackers coach at Heidelberg College, after beginning his coaching career in 2001 as the outside linebackers coach at Wabash.

Hammer graduated from Wabash in 2001, and is regarded as one of the top defenders to ever suit up for the Little Giants. He graduated as the school's record holder for tackles for loss in a game (five), season (23), and career (58), as well as single-season sacks (15), while he is tied with younger brother Blair as the Little Giants' all-time record holder in career sacks with 27.5. Team captain in 2000, Hammer was a two-time All-American and three-time All-Conference honoree, and was named the 2001 Pete Vaughn Award, which is given annually to the top Wabash senior athlete as voted upon by the athletic department.

A native of Carmel, Indiana, Hammer and wife Emily are the parents of daughters Layla and Ellie, and son William. They reside in Meadville.


