GATORS OPEN UP CONFERENCE PLAY AT WOOSTER

AllegHENY opens its North Coast Athletic Conference schedule with this week's tilt at Wooster. In last week's opener, AllegHENY was hampered by six turnovers in a 40-19 loss to 24th-ranked Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. In his first career start, Nazareth Greer threw for 370 yards and two touchdowns, both to Alex Victor, who finished with 245 yards receiving and a pair of touchdowns. The Gators out-gained the Engineers 441-369 in total offense, while also owning a nearly five-minute edge in time of possession.



Wooster was victorious by a 44-34 score over Bluffton in its season-opener. The Fighting Scots led 28-14 at the half and 44-14 at the end of the third quarter, before holding off a Beavers' comeback attempt in the fourth quarter. Antonio Bailey ran for 124 yards and two touchdowns, while Caden Croft completed 23 passes for 202 yards and two scores.

The Fighting Scots' defense forced five Bluffton turnovers and turned in five quarterback sacks. AllegHENY holds a 20-18 advantage in the all-time series between the two squads, but Wooster has won five straight, and six of the past eight meetings.

MEDIA INFORMATION

Interviews of Allegheny coaches and athletes shall be arranged through the school's office of athletic communications. On game days, locker rooms are closed to the media. Following the game, players will be available for interviews upon request once they are dismissed by the coaching staff. Due to extremely limited press box space, requests for press box and media credentials should be made to Jim Berger no later than 48 hours prior to each game.

ALEX AT IT AGAIN: In the Gators' season-opener with RPI, junior receiver Alex Victor hauled in nine receptions for 245 yards and two touchdowns. For his efforts, he was named to the D3Football.com Team of the Week, which recognizes the top performers at each position each week in all of Division III. The 245 yards were a career-high for Victor, and the most in a game for a Gator receiver since Jay Lewis gained 254 in a 1969 win over Carnegie Mellon. It was also the most in a single game across all NCAA divisions by a receiver this season. This marks Victor's second career D3Football.com Team of the Week nod, after previously garnering the honor following his week five performance last season against Hiram, when he made four catches for 174 yards and three touchdowns.

RECORD RECEIVER: After his prolific performance in week one, Victor now has 1,836 career receiving yards in 21 career games, just 164 off of the all-time Allegheny career record of 2,000 receiving yards set by Jon Turner in 2003. Victor's 25 career receiving touchdowns are already a school record, while he has 96 career receptions, eighth most in program history.

GREER THE GUNSLINGER: Last week against RPI, sophomore quarterback Nazareth Greer made his first career start, and completed 24 passes for 370 yards and two touchdowns. The 370 passing yards are the fourth most in a single game in program history.

TURN IT OVER: Last week against RPI, the Gator defense forced four turnovers, with one interception and three fumble recoveries. It was the first time the Gators gained four turnovers in a game since their Oct. 1, 2016 victory over Oberlin, when they also recovered three fumbles and an interception, which was returned 51 yards for a touchdown by Travis Thomas.

TAKING OFFENSE: The Gators totaled 441 yards of total offense (370 passing/71 rushing) in week one against RPI. Allegheny has now eclipsed 400 yards of total offense in six of its past 11 games, after doing so just three times between 2011-16. Additionally, the 370 passing yards were the eighth highest posted by a Division III team last week.

CAPTAIN GATORS: Allegheny's five co-captains for the 2018 season include senior defensive tackle Marcus Davenport, senior receiver Tristan Rhoades, senior running back Tyler Balla, junior linebacker Corey Laskey, and junior receiver Alex Victor.

ON THE DEFENSIVE : Senior Zach Bednarowicz was a perfect 2-for-2 on field goal attempts in week one, connecting from 22 and 32 yards out. It marked the second time in Bednarowicz's career in which he made two field goals in a game, after also going 2-for-2 in week nine last season against Wabash. The veteran kicker has now made six of his eight field goal attempts over the past two seasons, and is 3-for-3 over the span on kicks of 30 yards or longer.

ALL-CONFERENCE BLOODLINES: Two of the Gators' four 2017 All-NCAC honorees hail from the same family, in running back Tyler Balla and younger brother Chase, a safety. Tyler earned Second Team All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns during his junior season, both the most in a season for a Gator since 2005. He eclipsed the 100-yard mark in five different games, while he scored at least one touchdown in seven contests. Chase became just the third Gator rookie since 2002 to earn All-NCAC honors after leading the team with 73 tackles and breaking up five passes, while also averaging 22.1 yards on 17 kick returns.

THE GENERAL LEE: Senior quarterback Logan Lee had arguably the finest single season for a signal caller in Gator history in 2017. In his second full season as a starter, Lee set school records for completions (214), passing yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33), while throwing just eight interceptions. His 160.7 pass efficiency was the fifth highest mark in team history, while he completed 61.5 percent of his passes, seventh best in the team record book. Lee threw for four or more touchdowns in five different games, including two five-touchdown performances, while he eclipsed the 300-yard mark four times, highlighted by a school-record 400-yard effort in the season finale at Oberlin.

RHOADES THE SCHOLAR: Allegheny senior receiver Tristan Rhoades has been named a finalist for the National Football Foundation's Scholar-Athlete Awards, which recognize senior players who hold a cumulative grade point average of 3.20, while also being a top contributor on the field and being involved in campus and service activities. A biology major and psychology minor, Rhoades plans to pursue medical school following graduation in May 2019. In the Gators' season-opener against RPI, Rhoades made four catches for 36 yards, while also returning two kickoffs for 64 yards, including a 45-yard return in the second quarter.

Last Time Out: Turnovers Costly as Gators Fall to #25 RPI

MEADVILLE, Pa. (Sept. 1) - Junior Alex Victor caught nine passes for 245 yards and scored two touchdowns, while sophomore quarterback Naz Greer threw for 370 yards in his first career start, but 25th-ranked R.P.I. took advantage of six Allegheny turnovers to leave Meadville with a 40-19 win.

Trailing by six with just over 10 minutes left in the third quarter, the Gators drove deep inside RPI territory, and looked primed to even the score. However, D.J. Stefonsky stepped in front of a pass at the 10-yard line and returned it 90 yards for a touchdown to up the Engineers' lead to 23-10, and the Gators were unable to recover. It was one of four interceptions on the day by the R.P.I. defense, which also forced and recovered a pair of fumbles.

Behind Greer's effort, the Gators out-gained the Engineers 441-369 in total offense, while also holding distinct advantages in both first downs (20-16) and time of possession (32:25 - 27:35).

Victor picked up either a first down or touchdown on six of his 10 touches on the day, which included touchdown receptions of 65 and 71 yards. The 245 yards were a new career best, while they mark the second most in a game in Allegheny team history, behind only Jay Lewis' 254 in a 1969 win over Carnegie Mellon.

Tristan Rhoades made four catches for 36 yards and Dwaine Barber three for 44, as Greer completed passes to nine different receivers. The sophomore signal caller also led Allegheny on the ground, running for 58 yards on eight carries.

The Gator defense also played takeaway, turning the Engineers over four times. In his first game as a Gator, Quinten Hunt picked off an interception in the second quarter, while Seth Warburton forced a pair of fumbles, and Corey Laskey forced one.

Chase Balla turned in a team-best 12 tackles, including a half sack and a fumble recovery, while Laskey had eight tackles, including a sack, and Zach Martin seven stops in his career debut.

Allegheny/Wooster - Last Meeting

On Sept. 9 of last season, Wooster broke open a 28-28 tie with three unanswered touchdowns in a nine-minute span over the third and fourth quarters to earn a 49-35 win over Allegheny in both teams' NCAC opener.

In the offensive shootout, both teams' quarterbacks put up sterling numbers. Allegheny's Logan Lee completed 17 of 25 passes for 282 yards and four touchdowns, while Wooster's Gary Muntean went 23-for-27 for 364 yards and four scores. Neither signal caller threw an interception.

The Gators' Alex Victor gained 222 yards of total offense, gaining 63 yards on four rushes, while making five receptions for 159 yards and two touchdowns, which measured 85 and 27 yards, respectively.

Nick Strausbaugh was Muntean's favorite target, hauling in four catches for 136 yards and two scores, while teammate Jacob Lewis made four grabs for 90 yards and a touchdown. Wooster's Antonio Bailey ran for 78 yards and a touchdown on 19 carries.

Defensively, Travis Thomas and Freddy Ruiz each had 11 tackles to lead Allegheny, while Colten Buzard made nine stop, including 1.5 sacks.

Marcus Bowers and Robert Alvarez each had seven stops for Wooster, with Alvarez recording his team's lone sack. Beau Greenwood made six tackles, forced a fumble, and was credited with a pass breakup.

It marked the second straight offensive battle between the two squads, after Wooster earned a 49-40 win over the Gators in week two of the 2016 campaign.

A Look at This Week's Opponent

The Wooster Fighting Scots defeated Bluffton 44-34 in its season opener last Saturday on the road. Antonio Bailey ran for 124 yards and two touchdowns on 21 carries, while the Fighting Scot defense surrendered just 34 rushing yards, forced four turnovers, and totaled five sacks. Making his first start, quarterback Caden Croft completed 23 passes for 202 yards and two touchdowns, with Nick Strausbaugh hauling in seven catches for 49 yards and a score, and Jacob Lewis four receptions for 50 yards and a touchdown. Defensively, Cornelius Gyamfi had five tackles, including three for loss and one sack, while Marcus Bowers had two sacks and forced a fumble. Robert Alvarez had four tackles, a sack, a forced fumble, and a pass breakup, and was named the NCAC's Defensive Player of the Week... Wooster returns eight starters on offense and nine on defense from a 2017 season in which they finished 6-4 overall, and 5-4 in the NCAC. Strausbaugh was a First Team All-NCAC and All-Region honoree last season after setting school records with 1,315 receiving yards and 17 touchdown receptions... Bailey was also an all-conference performer a season ago after running for 835 yards and eight touchdowns... The Fighting Scots were picked to take sixth in the 2018 NCAC Preseason Coaches' Poll

ALLEGHENY COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH B.J. HAMMER (3rd season)



B.J. Hammer was named the 34th head coach in Allegheny football program history on January 4, 2016.

After posting a 1-9 mark in his first season at Allegheny in 2016, the program's rebuilding took big strides in 2017, as the Gators finished 3-7 while posting prolific numbers on both sides of the ball. Offensively, Allegheny averaged 34.0 points and 449.6 yards per game, both of which were the Gators' most since 2002. Sophomore Alex Victor earned First Team All-NCAC honors after setting school records for receiving yards (1,037) and touchdowns (15), while Tyler Balla became the first Gator running back to earn All-NCAC laurels after rushing for 955 yards and 10 touchdowns. Quarterback Logan Lee also had a record-breaking season, setting new Gator single-season marks in nearly every passing category, including completions (214), yards (3,002), and touchdowns (33).

The 2017 Gator defense also saw a pair of All-NCAC recipients. Defensive end Colten Buzard set a new Allegheny single-season mark with 20.5 tackles for loss, while tying a 17-year old school record with 12.0 sacks. Defensive back Chase Balla became the first Gator rookie to earn All-NCAC honors since 2014, as he finished with a team-best 73 tackles while breaking up five passes.

In his first season at the helm, Hammer saw a pair of his players earn All-NCAC honors, including senior John McFarland and junior Jake Wilson. McFarland ended his career as one of the most prolific tight ends in program history, and hauled in 48 catches for 552 yards. Wilson established an NCAA Division III record with 1,268 kick return yards, averaging 24.5 yards per try, and breaking off five returns of 50 yards or longer. As a team, the Gator offense saw an increase of an average of 9.0 points and 83 yards per game from the 2015 season, while the team's pass defense ranked in the top five of the NCAC.

Hammer arrived at Allegheny after spending five seasons as the defensive coordinator at fellow North Coast Athletic Conference member Wabash College. There, he led a defensive unit that consistently ranked among NCAA Division-III's best. During his five-year tenure, the Little Giants posted a record of 51-7, making three appearances in the NCAA Division-III playoffs and winning NCAC championships in 2011 and 2015. He mentored the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year in four of his five seasons as defensive coordinator, while 22 Wabash defenders were First Team All-NCAC honorees, and four were named All-America.

In 2015, the Little Giants finished 12-1, including a perfect 8-0 in the NCAC, and advanced to the third round of the NCAA playoffs. Hammer's defense ranked third nationally with 26 interceptions, fourth in rushing defense (72.2 yds/g), fifth in total defense (240.9 yds/g), and seventh in quarterback sacks (42). Eight Little Giant defenders earned All-NCAC honors, including six First Team selections. Wabash ended the year ranked seventh in both the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and D3Football.com Top 25 polls.

In 2014, Hammer was named a Division-III Coordinator of the Year finalist after his unit led D-III in rushing defense (66.3 yds/g) and quarterback sacks (4.6 sacks/g), while ranking third in total defense, fifth in tackles for loss, and 12th in scoring defense. Little Giant linebacker Cody Buresh was named the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-America by both D3Football.com and the AFCA.

The 2013 Wabash defense led the nation in total defense (220.7 yds/g), fumbles recovered (19), and turnover margin (+24), while placing second in tackles for loss (11.6 TFL/g) and rushing defense (63.1). In 2012, the Little Giants placed eighth nationally in scoring defense and 10th in rushing defense, while linebacker CJ Gum earned the NCAC Defensive Player of the Year award for a second straight season.

In his first season as the Wabash defensive coordinator, the Little Giants ranked fifth in the nation in rushing defense (78.1 yds/g), 11th in scoring defense (12.9 pts/g), and 12th in total defense (249.4 yds/g), while they paced the NCAC in every defensive statistical category. In addition to Gum being named the conference's top defender, linebacker AJ Akinribade was named NCAC Newcomer of the Year.

Prior to his five-year tenure at Wabash, Hammer spent eight seasons on the football staff at Whittier College. After working as the Poets' defensive coordinator from 2003-05, Hammer was promoted to head coach, a position he held from 2006-10. Posting a 12-33 overall record, Hammer rebuilt a program that had just 13 players on its roster in 2003 to one that averaged a roster size of over 100. Thirty Whittier players were named All-Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC), while the Whittier defense ranked second in the conference in total defense in 2006, and its rushing offense ranked second in the SCIAC in both 2009 and 2010.

Before his stint in California, Hammer spent the 2002 season as the linebackers coach at Heidelberg College, after beginning his coaching career in 2001 as the outside linebackers coach at Wabash.

Hammer graduated from Wabash in 2001, and is regarded as one of the top defenders to ever suit up for the Little Giants. He graduated as the school's record holder for tackles for loss in a game (five), season (23), and career (58), as well as single-season sacks (15), while he is tied with younger brother Blair as the Little Giants' all-time record holder in career sacks with 27.5. Team captain in 2000, Hammer was a two-time All-American and three-time All-Conference honoree, and was named the 2001 Pete Vaughn Award, which is given annually to the top Wabash senior athlete as voted upon by the athletic department.

A native of Carmel, Indiana, Hammer and wife Emily are the parents of daughters Layla and Ellie, and son William. They reside in Meadville.
