**#20 BUFFALOES HOST RAMS IN HOMECOMING CONTEST** - The No. 20-ranked West Texas A&M Buffaloes (3-1, 3-0 LSC) return home to the friendly confines of Kimbrough Memorial Stadium to host the Angelo State Rams (3-2, 2-0 LSC) for the 2011 WTAMU Homecoming contest. Kickoff between the Rams and Buffs is set for 6 p.m.

**THE SERIES** - The Rams lead the all-time series having won 14 of the 23 contests between the two teams, but the Buffaloes have dominated the series in the Don Carthel era having won five of the six games. WT has won five-straight ball games over the Rams since 2006 with a 21.0 point average margin of victory.

**THE COACHES** - WTAMU head coach Don Carthel is in his seventh season at the helm of the Buffalo football program. His record of 62-17 ranks second-best all-time amongst former WT head coaches. He entered the 2011 campaign nine wins shy of tying Joe E. Kerbal's mark of 68 wins. In 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Carthel is 108-63-1 overall. Since arriving at WT, Carthel is 5-1 all-time against the Rams.

Will Wagner is in his first season with the Rams after spending the previous 13 years at NCAA Division II powerhouse, Northwest Missouri. While at NWMSU, the Bearcats went 108-8 overall and were a part of 10 MIAA Championships, seven national title game appearances and three national championships. Since joining the Rams, Wagner has went 3-2, which included the head coach winning his first three games at the helm of the program.

**THE RANKINGS** - The Buffs remained at No. 20 in this week's AFCA poll following its 44-13 win over Tarleton this past Saturday. Since falling out of the rankings in week two, the Buffs have been a part of the AFCA's top-25 for the past three weeks. The Buffs moved up two spots to No. 12 in this week's D2Football.com poll.

The Rams are not ranked in either D2 polls.

**PREVIOUS MEETING** - The Buffs opened Lone Star Conference South Division play against the Rams last year, downing ASU 37-27 at San Angelo Stadium in San Angelo, back on Sept. 25, 2010. WT racked up 532 yards of total offense, which included 330 yards passing and 202 yards on the ground. Taylor Harris threw for 320 yards, but did have three interceptions on the day. WT got touchdowns from three different running backs on the day and scored another on a fake field goal. The Buffs led just 16-13 after the first quarter, but used a 21-point second quarter to ice the game. ASU scored 14 unanswered points in the third and fourth quarters, but it was too late and the WT defense held strong to close out the game and seal the victory.

**LAST TIME OUT** - The Buffs may as well have been down already 7-0 as soon as the team stepped off the bus in Stephenville, last Saturday. Tarleton's Nick Stephens executed a play-action-pass to perfection on the game's first play and Tarleton took the early 7-0 lead with just 15 seconds having come off the clock. That didn't sit well with the defense and it showed, as WT went on to outscore the Texans 44-13 over the final 59:45 left in the game. Quarterback Dustin Vaughan threw for 339 yards and two scores, while Khiry Robinson tallied a pair of touchdowns on the ground as well. Nathan Slaughter led the receiving corps with 96 yards and two touchdowns. Defensively, the Buffs were led by linebacker D.J. Ross, who came up with five solo tackles and a sack that went for a safety.

The Rams dropped its second-straight LSC contest of the season, falling 23-21 to Eastern New Mexico in San Angelo last Saturday. ASU led 21-14 with 7:15 left to play in the second quarter, but a TD (failed two-point attempt) and field goal later, the Rams found themselves on the other side of the win column as the Greyhounds came back to get the win. ASU's Blake Hamblin threw for 307 yards and a score, but it was his counterpart, Wesley Wood, who finished the day just a little better statistically, having thrown for 370 yards and two scores.

**STARTING FAST** - The Buffs have scored on its first possession in all four games this season. Tommy Hampton scored from 24 yards out in the season-opener against CSU-Pueblo, followed by Dustin Vaughan and Lance Ratliff hook-ups the next two games against Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. This past weekend, despite being down 7-0 early, Vaughan led his offense down the field and it ended with Khiry Robinson hitting pay-dirt to tie the game 7-7.

**WT STILL TOPS THE LSC IN DEFENSE** - The Buff's defense still leads the LSC in both scoring defense and total defense after five weeks of play. WT leads the league having allowed opponents to score just 16.8 points per game. Opponents have scored a conference-low seven touchdowns against the Buffaloes defense. The WT defense leads the LSC in total defense allowing opponents to just 312.5 total yards after four games. The Buffs defense has allowed just 1250 yards of combined offense (393 rushing, 857 passing).

**GOLDEN AMONG THE NATIONS BEST** - Senior wide receiver Brittan Golden is among the national leaders in many offensive categories heading into this weekend. The Denver City native ranks ninth in the nation in receiving yards per game as he averages 108.5 yards per contest. he is tied for 31st with his 6.25 receptions per game average and ranks tied for 55th in all-purpose yards, with 134.0 yards per game.

**BUFFALOES LEADING THE LSC/NATION IN PASSING** - It's no secret that WT likes to throw the ball on offense, and that plan has put WT atop both the LSC and national statistics as a team. WT has thrown for a total of 1,596 yards four games, averaging a nation-leading 399.0 yards per contest.

**CONTAINING THE RUSH** - The WT defense has not allowed an opposing running back to net over 100 yards in a game after four contests this season. The defense currently ranks fourth in the LSC in rush defense, but is still allowing opponents to under 100 yards per game (98.2).

**A LOOK AHEAD** - The Buffs hit the road next week to face #10 Abilene Christian at Shotwell Stadium in Abilene. The team will then return home for a two-game home swing, hosting Eastern New Mexico on Oct. 22 and hosting Central Washington that next week, Oct. 29.





**DON CARTHEL**  
**HEAD COACH**  
**SEVENTH SEASON**  
**EASTERN NEW MEXICO '74**

To say that Don Carthel has elevated the West Texas A&M football to that of national prominence would be an understatement. What Carthel has accomplished over the past five seasons at WTAMU is simply amazing, having taken a program that had won just seven games over the previous four years combined and guide it to five winning seasons, four successive NCAA Division-II playoff appearances, four LSC South Division titles, three-consecutive Lone Star Conference Championships - and 51 victories.

In 2009, playing a schedule that featured six nationally-ranked opponents, and playing the nation's then-top-ranked team twice, Carthel rallied an injury-riddled squad from a 1-5 start to six consecutive wins - posting a 7-5 mark and the

school's first bowl appearance since the 1967 season.

During his first season in Canyon, Carthel and the Buffs surprised everyone, having been picked to finish last in the LSC preseason poll, as they registered a 10-1 regular season record and captured the school's first Lone Star Conference Championship in 19 years. Excitement surrounding Carthel's program was evident as attendance soared, with a regular-season average of over 14,000 fans per game at Kimbrough Memorial Stadium. In addition to garnering local praise from alumni and area media outlets, Carthel was honored by his peers as the 2005 Lone Star Conference Coach of the Year.

Following that breakout campaign there was still work to be done as Carthel set out in 2006 to let the LSC and the rest of NCAA Division II know that WT's 2005's success was no fluke. The Buffs left little doubt, as they posted an 11-2 season and became the first squad in school history to claim back-to-back outright conference championships. In addition, WT notched another 'first' in the school record book as it claimed the program's first-ever NCAA Division II playoff victory with a 30-27 overtime win over Abilene Christian. After leading the country in Division II average attendance the previous year, Buff fans again came out in droves, helping WT rank first, nationally, in total attendance.

That only set the stage for what was to come during the 2007 campaign, as the Buffs confidently went about amassing the school's first-ever undefeated regular season, going 11-0 to claiming a third-straight Lone Star Conference championship and advance two rounds into the NCAA post-season playoffs.

Another 11-win, record shattering campaign followed in 2008, as the Buffs again were among the biggest draws in NCAA Division II. That season saw Carthel's squad set no fewer than 15 team, 21 individual, 26 LSC and eight NCAA playoff records.

Carthel graduated from ENMU with a bachelor's degree in physical education and a minor in mathematics in 1974, then went on to get his master's in physical education in 1975. He played center for the Greyhounds from 1970-73, helping ENMU to a No. 17 NAIA ranking his senior season.

In 1981, at the age of 28, Carthel became the youngest head coach in the country when he took over at Lubbock Christian College (now Lubbock Christian University), a position he held from 1981-82.

Following a stint at the University of Texas-El Paso (UTEP), Carthel returned to his alma mater to serve as head coach from 1985-91.

The elder Carthel coached at ACU from 2001 until 2004, when he was named the head coach and general manager of the Amarillo Dusters in their inaugural season in the Intense Football League. In April, 2005, Carthel resigned to take the reins at West Texas A&M.

Carthel and his wife, the former Cindy Phillips, of Farwell, Texas, have been married for 37 years, and have two adult children, Colby (the Buffs' defensive coordinator) and Courtney.
