SERIES HISTORY:

All-Time Series: ASU leads the series 21-6

Last Meeting: Apr. 21, 2024: StEU, 7-5 – Austin, Texas

The Rams hold a firm grip throughout the series history, averaging over seven runs a game. However, the Hilltoppers earned a series split in Austin during the 2024 regular season.

LAST TIME OUT:

Angelo State earned the fifth series sweep of the season after taking down Texas A&M-Kingsville in two doubleheaders on the road by a combined score of 32-6 to extend the Rams winning streak to 10 games.

Offensively, Weston Valasek carried the Rams with a home run, two doubles and a total of 6 RBIs on day one. On day two, Chase Pendley was the hero in game three with as he knocked in three RBIs including the go-ahead run the top of the seventh inning. Lane Hutchinson provided three RBIs to help the Rams secure game four and the sweep.

On the mound, Dax Dathe twirled a gem in game one as he carried a no hitter into the seventh but ultimately settled for his first career complete game shutout as the senior right hander struck out seven Javelinas. Nick Wilson, Josh Reed and Ryan Free each earned wins after their respective efforts in games two, three and four respectively.

SCOUTING THE HILLTOPPERS:

St. Edward's enters the weekend with a 27-11 (26-10, LSC) record as the Hilltoppers have won seven of their last ten games. Last time out, StEU bounced back after a game one loss to take the series against Lubbock Christian at home.

At the plate, StEU ranked seventh in the conference with a .305 team batting average. Connor Cox highlights the Hilltoppers' offensive success as he is the reigning Lone Star Conference Hitter of the Week after tying the conference record for doubles in a game (4). The junior outfielder also hit two home runs and contributed 11 total runs towards the series win.

The Hilltoppers sit within the top five of the conference with a 5.44 team ERA. Kobe Jaramillo is the Friday night ace of the staff as the senior from Bishop, Texas sports a perfect 6-0 record, holds a 2.64 ERA, which is second in the conference, and leads the conference with 71 strikeouts as he's limited opponents batters to a .201 average.

QUICK HITS:

- ASU leads DII in numerous offensive categories including; Batting Average (.382), On Base Percentage (.511), and Runs Scored (384).
- Jacob Guerrero has reached base safely in 33 of the 34 games he has appeared in this season.
- Chase Pendley holds the Rams longest active hitting and on-base streak at 10 games each.
- The Rams have scored 20+ runs in four games thus far in 2025, one more than the entire 2024 season.
- The Blue and Gold are 24-2 when they out hit their opponents this season.
- The Rams have scored more runs in the first inning, 72, than any other inning this season.
- Justin Harris and Brett Smajstrla have registered inside the park home runs this season.
- Five pitchers have registered a save for the Rams; Caleb Heuertz (2), Josh Reed (2), Luke Olson (2), Jude Cook (1) and Keene Kreuzler (1).
- Eight pitchers have held opponents' batting average below .300.

MEET THE STAFF - HEAD COACH KEVIN BROOKS



Kevin Brooks has guided the Angelo State baseball program to seven NCAA Division II College World Series appearances with seven South Central Championships and has compiled an impressive 814-361 overall record since starting the ASU program in 2005. In 2023, the Rams claimed the Division II National Championship for the first time in program history.

The only coach in ASU baseball history, he has recorded 12 trips to the NCAA postseason. The Rams are the only Lone Star Conference team to ever make the College World Series and the first team since 2007 to appear in the National Championship series in back-to-back seasons. Brooks has taken the team to the CWS seven times in 20 seasons at the helm, including back-to-back appearances in 2015-2016 and four consecutive seasons in 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024. The Rams have also won the Lone Star Conference tournament championship six times, including sweeping the competition in 2015, 2021, 2022, and while also winning in 2007 and 2012. The Rams have never had a losing season under Brooks and have compiled 40-plus wins in 12 seasons.

His list of accomplishments includes the 2023 NCAA Division II national title, the NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles in 2007, 2015, 2016, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024. The Rams earned LSC regular-season titles in 2012, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2022, and 2023 while winning the tournament championship in 2012,

2015, 2021, 2022, and 2023. He has coached 132 All-Lone Star Conference selections, 59 All-Region picks and 30 All-American selections. Brooks has also prepared his players for the next level as 52 former Rams have played or are currently playing professional baseball. The Rams finished the 2023 season with a 56-9 overall record, setting the program and LSC record for wins in a season on their way to the national title. ASU finished with a 40-8 conference record to win the regular-season before sweeping the conference tournament and earning the top-seed in the regional tournament. Kade Bragg set a conference record with a 15-1 overall record on the mound while earning NCAA Division II Pitcher of the Year by three different organizations.

The 2007 Rams finished with a 51-20 (.718) mark and set five individual and seven team Lone Star Conference records along the way. The program itself set a new record by reaching the Division-II College World Series in only its third season of existence, the fastest such trip in NCAA history. Brooks' Rams have only finished lower than second in the Lone Star Conference postseason tournament once since the ASU program was revived in 2005 and he earned the Sportsman of the Year award from the San Angelo Standard-Times for his outstanding leadership and success on the field in 2007.

Prior to his arrival at Angelo State, Brooks was an assistant coach at Hardin-Simmons University from 2000-03 and an assistant coach at the University of Texas-San Antonio in 2000. Preceding that, he was a volunteer assistant coach at Texas A&M in 1999 helping the Aggies to the Big XII title in their run to the NCAA Division I College World Series. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Incarnate Word from 1994-1998 and lent his knowledge to the Jayhawk League where he worked as a summer coach in 1993 and for the Hays (Kan.) Larks in 1995.

In Brooks' 30-plus years of coaching experience, he coached Major League Baseball National League All-Star Lance Berkman when he played summer ball for the Hays Larks. With Brooks' guidance, the Hays Larks finished second in the 1995 National Baseball Congress (NBC) World Series behind the 1996 USA Olympic Baseball Team.

A graduate of Baylor University, Brooks earned his bachelor's degree in secondary education and played baseball for the Bears baseball team from 1988-1991. He also holds a master's degree in physical education from Incarnate Word.

The Brooks household includes his wife Robyn, Sons Kannon & Jake, daughters Bailey, Reese and Bree.



MEET THE STAFF - ASSISTANT COACHES



ASSISTANT COACH - ADAM FOSTER

Adam Foster finished his fifth season as the pitching coach for the Angelo State baseball program after the conclusion of the 2023-24 season.

In just a short time with ASU, Foster has helped turn the Rams into one of the top pitching staffs in the country. During the 2023 national championship season, the Rams led the Lone Star Conference in ERA at 3.36, shutouts with 11, 577 strikeouts, while holding opponents to the lowest batting average at .225. The Rams' pitching staff also ranked third in Division II in ERA, second in WHIP, first in hits allowed, and second in strikeouts.

Foster coached the 2023 NCAA Division II Pitcher of the Year in Kade Bragg who led Division II in ERA at 1.20 and victories with a 15-1 overall record. The Rams also had

two pitchers drafted in July of 2023 with Bragg going in the 17th round and Aaron Munson in the 19th.

In 2021, the Rams held the lowest team ERA in the Lone Star Conference at 3.16, led in strikeouts with 478, and gave up the fewest total runs. In Division II, the Rams finished second overall in ERA, second in total shutouts with seven, and fourth in strikeouts. Starting pitcher Trent Baker was drafted by the Cardinals in the ninth round.

Before ASU, Foster was the Head Baseball Coach at Georgetown High School. During his time at GHS Foster amassed 192 wins in 7 seasons. Coach Foster spent 16 seasons with GHS baseball and helped over 100 players reach the next level. Of those 100 players, 13 played professional baseball. During his time as Head Coach, Foster led the Eagles to their first-ever state tournament in 2015, and again in 2019, finishing second in the state both years. In 2018, the Eagles set the 5A record for wins in a season with 41. Before his time at Georgetown High School Foster spent two years as a hitting instructor and infield coach at New Mexico Highlands University in Las Vegas, N.M.

A graduate of West Texas A&M University, Foster earned a Bachelor's of Science degree while being a member of the football and baseball program. Foster and his wife Christy have two daughters, Baylie and Samantha, and a son Andrew, his wife Allie, and two grandchildren Mazie and Steele.



ASSISTANT COACH - SAM MOTE

Sam Mote joined the ASU coaching staff in 2018 and has helped elevate the Rams to one of the best hitting teams in the country, leading the Lone Star Conference in batting average in four of his seven seasons.

During the 2023 National Championship season, Mote helped the Rams to the fifth best batting average in the country at .342 while also ranking third on-base percentage (.454) and runs (597). The Rams also held the top fielding percentage in Division II at .985.

2022 was the best offensive season the Rams have had, scoring a program record of 677 runs which led all of Division II. The Rams finished with a .357 batting average which was the fourth highest in the country while leading Division II in on-base percentage

(.470), doubles (166), and ranking second in hits with 763 while making their second straight CWS appearance.

While at Angelo State, Mote has coached eight different NCAA Division II All-Americans including the 2019 NCAA Division II Player of the Year, Josh Elvir.

Prior to his time at ASU, Mote was a volunteer assistant at Texas A&M – Corpus Christi. Before that, he spent two years as an assistant coach at the University of Northwestern Ohio. In 2016 he helped lead the Racers to program records in doubles, home runs and slugging percentage, followed by a 2017 season that placed UNOH in the top-10 of the NAIA concerning hits and runs per game. Mote has also spent three years as an assistant coach at Iowa Western Community College, where he won the 2014 NJCAA National Championship and came in fifth at the NJCAA World Series in 2015.

The Ram assistant has also coached various summer league teams, worked as a scout director for the Prep Baseball Report Ohio and a site director for Pastime Tournaments.

Mote played collegiate baseball at Wright State University, winning a Horizon League Tournament Title in 2009 and a Horizon League Regular Season Championship in 2010.

FOSTER FIELD AT 1ST COMMUNITY CREDIT UNION STADIUM



The Angelo State baseball team has compiled an overall record of 366-124 at Foster Field at 1st Community Federal Credit Union Stadium, one of the nicest stadium in all of Division II baseball. The stadium, located at the corner of Jackson Street and University Drive was built in 2000 and renovated prior to the 2016 season.

The field features 4,200 permanent seats, a Daktronics inning-by-inning scoreboard with video display, and the field received a new lighting system in the fall of 2019. The 2016 renovations to the stadium include new turf on the entire field except the pitching mound, new blue chair-backs and a new outfield fence.

In addition, the facility has a large press box area, major-league style dugouts and

state-of-the-art bullpens and batting cages for practicing and warming up. The stadium contains concession and restroom areas as well as special clubhouse style seating areas for entertaining corporate sponsors are located on either side of the press box. The field dimensions are 325 feet down the lines, 370 feet to the gaps and 395 feet to deep centerfield.

In 2017, when ASU hosted both the Lone Star Conference Championship and the South Central Regional, more than 43,000 fans came out to games, leading all of Division II. That number was also good for 49th across Divisions I, II and III, placing them ahead of schools like Oklahoma, Sam Houston State, Dallas Baptist and Stephen F. Austin.

NCAA DIVISION II ATTENDANCE RECORD

During the 2023 NCAA Division II South Central Super Regionals, the Rams set a new D2 attendance record for a single game against Colorado Mesa with 3,247 fans, breaking their own record set a season prior.
