



JOHNMARK BENTLEY

HEAD COACH

12th Season (Record: 106-69-1)
North Carolina, 2001

Named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year four times in his first 11 seasons as App State's head coach, JohnMark Bentley helped lead the Mountaineers to a record-setting season in 2019-20.

Under Bentley's direction, in the past six seasons, App State's 37-4 conference record ranks No. 5 nationally in all of Division I wrestling behind just Missouri, Oklahoma State, Cornell and Penn State.

Moving forward from a fourth consecutive SoCon regular-season title in 2018-19, Bentley oversaw an App State program that went 9-3 overall and had a school-record six NCAA qualifiers, including all four NCAA qualifiers who were products of North Carolina high schools.

With a dual meet winning percentage of .750 that ranked 14th nationally, App State led the country with four dual meet shutouts, was one of only three Division I teams with at least four conference champions and was one of only six teams that had all 10 starters finish the season with a winning record.

Bentley's career record stands at 106-69-1 heading into the 2020-21 season, and a 6-1 league record in 2019-20 is part of a 31-3 run against SoCon competition during the last five seasons. Since the native of nearby Newland, N.C., became App State's head coach, the Mountaineers have had 38 NCAA qualifiers and three All-Americans.

Appalachian State achieved national top-25 rankings during the 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2018-19 seasons, climbing to as high as No. 16 during a 12-3 season in 2016-17. Bentley finished third in voting for national coach of the year in 2012 and was also a finalist in 2018, when a young App State team swept both the SoCon regular-season and tournament titles.

Off the mat, App State posted a team GPA of 3.03 in the spring of 2019, and its number of community service hours recorded by the Helper Helper platform in 2018-19 ranked No. 1 among all Division I wrestling programs.

In the last five years, Bentley's program is 44-5 against non-Power Five Conference opponents with seven victories against teams from Power Five leagues: Duke (2015-16), Indiana (2015-16), No. 15 Oregon State (2016-17), No. 25 North Carolina (2016-17), Duke (2016-17), Duke (2018-19) and Duke (2019-20). While attracting some of the nation's top teams to Boone, the Mountaineers have consistently wrestled in front of standing-room-only crowds at Varsity Gym.

The wrestlers to earn All-America honors during Bentley's time in Boone are Denzel Dejournette in 2017, Kyle Blevins in 2012 and Austin Trotman in 2012.

Growing up less than 20 miles from App State, Bentley was a star wrestler at nearby Avery County High School before he became a three-time ACC champion at North Carolina. He began his coaching career as a Davidson assistant in 2003, was the head coach at Watauga High School from 2003-06, worked as an App State assistant from 2006-08 and was promoted to associate head coach during the 2008-09 season. He made his debut as App State's head coach the following season.

In 2017-18, Bentley was named the Southern Conference Coach of the Year for the third time in the last four seasons. App State went 7-0 in the Southern Conference and put eight wrestlers in the finals of the league tournament.

During a 13-3 season in 2016-17, Appalachian knocked off nationally ranked Oregon State and North Carolina before winning 10 times in a stretch of 11 regular season dual matches. The 2015-16 season ended with a Southern Conference regular season championship and SoCon Tournament championship.

As a college wrestler, Bentley was twice named team MVP at North Carolina. He was the 2001 ACC Wrestler of the Year and a 2000 University Nationals Freestyle All-American. He ranks ninth in UNC single-season win percentage with a mark of .919 after he went 31-2 in 2000-01.

He is sixth all-time with an .851 career winning percentage at Carolina and finished with 92 career wins. He was a three-year member of the UNC Student-Athletic Council and earned a degree in communications in 2001. In 2008, he earned a masters degree in school administration from App State.

A three-sport athlete at Avery High School, Bentley was the second wrestler in North Carolina high school history to win four state championships. He finished his high school career with a perfect 144-0 record, capped by a National Championship in 1997.

Bentley's brother, Matthew, wrestled at App State from 1992-96.

Bentley and his wife, Aaron, have two children: one daughter, Katie Elizabeth, and one son, Luke Franklin.

HEAD ASSISTANT COACH

First Season
Kent State, 2016

After following an All-America wrestling career with four seasons in which he coached four All-Americans as an Oregon State assistant, Ian Miller joined App State's program as the head assistant coach in September 2020.

With three top-six NCAA finishes, Miller earned All-America recognition three times while wrestling at Kent State from 2011-16. He was also a University Nationals freestyle champion in both 2012 and 2014, when he was named the event's most outstanding wrestler.

Working as a Pac-12 assistant at Oregon State from 2016-20, Miller helped coach 10 conference champions and 14 NCAA qualifiers, with four of those claiming All-America status. The Beavers finished the 2018-19 and 2017-18 seasons ranked in the top 25 by several publications.

Miller graduated from Kent State with a Bachelor of Science in Human Movement and a minor in Athletic Coaching. He wrestled at 149 pounds and 157 pounds as a four-time national qualifier, highlighted by a fourth-place finish as a sophomore in 2014.

The only Kent State wrestler with three top-six NCAA finishes, Miller ranks third in school history with 138 career wins and fourth with 36 career pins. He was named the MAC Freshman of the Year in 2012 and the Kent State University Male Athlete of the Year in 2015 before closing his career with a third straight MAC title in 2016.

His championship runs at the University Nationals in 2012 and 2014 occurred in the 70- and 74-kilogram weight classes.

The native of Oak Harbor, Ohio, won a Division II high school state championship as a junior, was the runner-up as a senior and placed third as a sophomore.

First Full-Time Season (Second Overall)
App State, 2019

In October 2020, App State promoted App State Wrestling alum Randall Diabe to the role of full-time assistant coach.

Diabe completed his App State Wrestling career in 2018-19 and made his coaching debut as a volunteer assistant for the Mountaineers in 2019-20, helping them go 9-3 overall, produce a school-record six NCAA qualifiers, post a Division I-best four shutouts and finish as one of only six teams that had all 10 starters post a winning record.

A two-time NCAA Championships qualifier, Diabe finished his competitive career in 2019 with a 77-48 record after being named All-Southern Conference at 197 pounds and earning an automatic NCAA berth thanks to his title at the SoCon Championship in Boone.

A native of Greensboro, N.C., Diabe went 26-7 as a senior and 14-1 in App State's duals, including 14-0 against Division I programs. He went 5-0 in SoCon duals to go unbeaten for the second straight season, and entering the NCAA Championships, he was ranked No. 16 nationally by the NCAA Coaches' Panel, No. 18 in the RPI and No. 13 by InterMat.

As a junior, Diabe was 20-9 at 197 pounds, and he had an undefeated Southern Conference record in duals (7-0) to earn all-conference recognition.

Diabe graduated from App State in December 2019 with a degree in health promotion and a minor in nutrition.

In October 2020, App State named DJ Fehlman a volunteer assistant coach for the Mountaineers.

Fehlman, who is from Warren, Pa., wrapped up his Lock Haven career earlier this year as a three-time NCAA qualifier who also was named an NWCA Division I Scholar All-American.

He went 113-44 in his final four years at Lock Haven, made the round of 16 at the NCAAs in 2019 and had several high-level matchups at 133 pounds with App State national qualifier Codi Russell.

Fehlman qualified for the NCAAs as a redshirt senior, redshirt junior and redshirt freshman. He also won the Lock Haven's "Sportsmanship Award" in 2020.

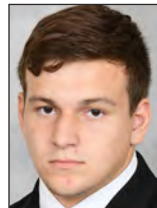

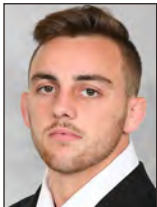

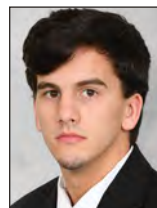
