TOP STORYLINES

- Tuesday's sold-out game is a matchup of the only official Sun Belt East Division winners, as App State has played in three of the four contested conference title games (2018, 2019, 2021). Coastal Carolina won the East title in 2020 and represented the East in the 2022 title game.
- With a 41-40 win at ULM, App State improved to 9-1 in Sun Belt openers, including nine straight wins since a 2014 loss to Georgia Southern. The Mountaineers began league play last season with a 32-28 victory over Troy, using a Hail Mary TD to win on the same day that ESPN's College GameDay aired from Boone, and they also won their 2023 league opener on the last play.
- Michael Hughes'** career-long 54-yard field goal as time expired at ULM was the longest winning field goal to end an App State victory and the longest field goal by an App State kicker since 2000. The Mountaineers were stuck at their own 19 with 24 seconds left and no timeouts remaining before **Joey Aguilar** completed three straight sideline throws to **Kaedin Robinson** for 14, 16 and 14 yards to move the ball to the ULM 37.
- Eight of the top 10 crowds in Kidd Brewer Stadium history have occurred since the start of the 2022 season (all nine home crowds in that stretch have eclipsed 30,000). The last home game against ECU matched the stadium-record attendance of 40,168, and the Mountaineers' 50-9 record (84.8 win percentage) in home games since the 2014 transition is tied for 6th nationally.
- Coastal's last visit to App State in 2021 was also a sold-out midweek game, and that Wednesday game drew 31,061 fans — the biggest regular season crowd for a college football game on a Tuesday/Wednesday since the 2011 game between Pitt and visiting UConn drew 40,219 fans. App State won 30-27 in 2021 on **Chandler Staton's** 24-yard FG as time expired, with **Milan Tucker's** early recovery of a **Michael Hughes** onside kick helping erase a 14-0 deficit.
- Nate Noel**, who added weight to his speedy frame following an injury-plagued 2022 season, ranks No. 2 nationally at 130.2 rushing yards per game (behind just Troy running back **Kimani Vidal's** 139.2) and No. 1 at 24.6 rushing attempts per game. After surpassing 20 carries just once in his first three years, with a high of 23 in that span, Noel started this year with games of 115, 127, 193, 107 and 109 rushing yards by carrying the ball 24, 26, 25, 30 and 18 times.
- Michael Hughes** entered the weekend tied for 7th nationally in made field goals (10 of 13, with 11 being the FBS-leading total) and is tied for No. 3 among FBS kickers at 10.0 points per game after going 9 of 12 on FGs in all of 2022 with App State ranking 12th nationally in fourth-down payoff. He has made three field goals longer than 45 yards this year: 46, 50 and 54 yards.

MORE STORYLINES

- **Shawn Clark's** staff in 2023 has six new assistant coaches, including two coordinators in **Frank Ponce** (offense) and **Scot Sloan** (defense) who have both returned to Boone, plus a new Director of Athletic Performance (**Matt Greenhalgh**) who also has returned to Boone.
- **Frank Ponce**, an App State QBs coach from 2013-18 and offensive coordinator in 2021, is back for his third stint with the Mountaineers, who have one other new offensive assistant in OL coach **Mike Cummings**. Ponce helped recruit QB **Ryan Burger** and coached him at the start of App State's 2022 spring practices, before Ponce took a job at Miami. As Miami's QBs coach, Ponce also spent time recruiting **Joey Aguilar**, a California-based JUCO quarterback.
- With **Frank Ponce** following **Scott Satterfield** to Louisville after the 2018 season, App State changed offensive coordinators after the 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 seasons.
- Before being Georgia Southern's defensive coordinator from 2018-21 and coaching at Army in 2022, **Scot Sloan** coached at App State from 2010-17. App State assistants **Victor Cabral** (DL) and **Travis Cunningham** (ILBs) worked on Sloan's staff in Statesboro, and new OLBs coach **AJ Howard** was a standout App State defender while being coached by Sloan from 2014-17.
- App State's roster has 32 scholarship newcomers, including 14 from the transfer portal, as the Mountaineers ranked 120th among 133 FBS teams in returning production.
- App State has won four Sun Belt titles (plus the 2021 division title) and gone 6-1 in bowl games (with a record-setting 6-0 start) since its 2014 FBS transition. With an 88-27 record since starting 1-5 in 2014, the Mountaineers rank No. 7 among FBS teams (and No. 1 among G5 teams) with 89 wins since their transition.
- App State announced that **Armanti Edwards**, a star QB from 2006-09, will have his No. 14 retired at halftime of the App State-Georgia Southern home game on Nov. 25. The honoring of Edwards' No. 14 is the last time App State plans to take a jersey number out of circulation due to limited inventory of jersey numbers for the roster each season — current student-athletes wearing No. 14 will have the option to wear it for the remainder of their time at App State.

OFFENSE

- App State QB **Joey Aguilar** has totaled 12 TD passes (tied for No. 1 in the Sun Belt) and 1,225 passing yards in four games (three starts). He made his FBS debut late in the first half of the 2023 opener against Gardner-Webb (replacing injured starter **Ryan Burger**) and had four TD passes in that game. He threw for a career-high 335 yards and three TDs in the win at ULM.
- The running back room includes **Nate Noel** (Senior Bowl watch list member who is the first App State back with six straight 100-yard games since **Jalin Moore** in 2016), **Kanye Roberts** (245 yards and four TDs on 38 career carries, including a 10-yard TD at ULM), **Ahmani Marshall** (double-digit runs at ULM on his first two carries of 2023 after rushing for 228 yards over the final two games of 2022) and **Maquel Haywood** (1,334 all-purpose yards in two years at Navy).
- App State receivers **Kaedin Robinson**, **Christan Horn** and **Dashaun Davis** all have a 100-yard game with at least one TD catch this season. Horn scored twice on a six-catch, 124-yard night at ULM, where Robinson set career highs with 10 catches for 112 yards, while Davis had a career-high 117 yards on seven catches in the double-overtime loss at North Carolina.
- App State's six returning starters on offense included three interior linemen in center **Isaiah Helms**, left guard **Damion Daley** and right guard **Bucky Williams**, who have played in a combined 147 NCAA games. The Mountaineers have two new starting tackles after RT **Cooper Hodges** was drafted by the Jaguars and LT **Anderson Hardy** was signed by the Chiefs.
- The Mountaineers are 6 of 10 on fourth down, with TDs following three conversions. They scored immediately after a fourth-down conversion on two of their first three TD drives in the opener.

DEFENSE

- App State is officially allowing 30.8 points per game, but that number drops to 23.8 per 60 minutes from coordinator **Scot Sloan's** defense when taking away 13 OT points from UNC, 14 points scored on defensive touchdowns by ECU and a special teams touchdown by Wyoming.
- Over the last three games, the Mountaineers have 10 sacks and five interceptions, including a pair of pick-six TD returns by **Tyrek Funderburk** (18 yards at Wyoming; 23 yards at ULM). Kentucky's **Maxwell Hairston** is the only other FBS player with two pick-six returns this season.
- Strong safety **Jordan Favors** made several big plays in the second half at ULM. He blocked an extra point after one TD, broke up a two-point pass after another TD and forced a fumble.
- Freshman OLB **Nate Johnson** has a sack in each of the last three games, and ILB **Andrew Parker Jr.** recorded one sack in back-to-back games against ECU and Wyoming. Johnson is one of only three FBS true freshmen with at least 3.0 sacks this year, joining **TJ Parker** from Clemson and **Suntarine Perkins** from Ole Miss.
- The defense has several impact FBS transfers, including DE **Shawn Collins** (Rutgers), DE **Michael Fletcher** (Michigan State), OLB **Thomas Davis** (Miami), CB **Tyrek Funderburk** (Richmond) and CB **Jarrett Paul** (Kansas).

SPECIAL TEAMS

- **Milan Tucker**, who switched from CB to WR after the first fall scrimmage, returned after earning All-America honors as a kick returner in 2022. He is averaging 28.4 yards per return this season, with his first three returns producing gains of 41, 48 and 34 yards.

2022 RECAP: Coastal 35, App State 28
CONWAY, S.C. — Coastal Carolina survived a furious finish App State to claim a 35-28 victory in a Thursday night game.

Trailing 35-14 early in the fourth, Chase Brice threw a 42-yard touchdown pass to Tyler Page with 11:02 left and followed a Nick Hampton fumble recovery with a 5-yard touchdown on a quarterback keeper with 3:01 remaining.

Starting the next defensive series with all three timeouts at their disposal, the Mountaineers (5-4, 2-3) put Coastal into a third-and-11 scenario from its 24 with 2:53 left thanks to safety Jackson Greene's first-down breakup and defensive lineman DeAndre Dingle-Prince's second-down stop for a 1-yard loss. Grayson McCall's 47-yard, over-the-top completion to Jared Brown moved the chains and enabled the Chanticleers (7-1, 5-1) to run out the clock.

2021 RECAP: App State 30, Coastal 27
BOONE, N.C. —Chandler Staton's 24-yard field goal as time expired lifted App State to a dramatic win against No. 14 Coastal Carolina in front of 31,061 fans on a Wednesday night.

With the previously unbeaten Chanticleers (they were 6-0 at the time) serving as the highest-ranked FBS team to ever visit The Rock, Malik Williams caught 10 passes for a career-high 206 yards. Chase Brice threw for 347 yards and two touchdowns to help App State overcome an early 14-0 deficit, with Milan Tucker's recovery of a Michael Hughes onside kick playing a key role in that early rally.

Defensively, the Mountaineers limited Coastal to 55 rushing yards — 208.5 below its season average — on 29 attempts. App State limited the Chants to 16 offensive yards on 10 fourth-quarter plays, only one of which produced a first down. They punted three times in the fourth quarter and five times in the game after totaling just 10 punts in their first six games.

2020 RECAP: Coastal 34, App State 23
CONWAY, S.C. — App State moved ahead for the final time on Chandler Staton's 45-yard field goal with 11:47 left. The Mountaineers remained ahead 23-21 until Reese White scored on a 3-yard run for the 15th-ranked Chanticleers with 2:24 left, and D'Jordan Strong's 38-yard interception return for a TD on a fourth-and-20 pass from deep in App State's own territory in the final 90 seconds sealed the outcome.

SHAWN CLARK

After coming back to Boone to coach at his alma mater, Shawn Clark not only became App State's head coach, but he has begun his tenure with a record-breaking bowl victory, a nine-win debut season and a 10-win regular season in 2021.

Hired as the 22nd head football coach in App State history on Dec. 13, 2019, Clark was the only first-year FBS head coach in 2020 to win at least nine games, and he followed that by directing the Mountaineers to a 2021 Sun Belt East Division title during a 10-4 season that pushed his record to 20-7. A 17-14 win at No. 6 Texas A&M in 2022 — the program's highest-profile victory since the 2007 upset of Michigan — led to ESPN's College GameDay airing from Boone the following week.

With App State alum/country music star Luke Combs picking his alma mater as ESPN's guest picker and Lee Corso putting on the giant Yosef head, the Mountaineers delivered with a dramatic victory against Troy.

The 48-year-old Clark, whose contract runs through the 2026 season, entered the 2023 season with a 26-13 record.

He made his official head coaching debut while leading the Mountaineers to a 31-17 victory against UAB in the 2019 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl eight days after his introductory press conference. Ranked 18th in the final Amway Coaches Poll of the season, App State went 13-1 to become the first Sun Belt team and the first FBS team from North Carolina to win 13 games in a season.

In 2020, while playing in the nation's No. 5-ranked league, the Mountaineers secured a Myrtle Beach Bowl title and were one of just 13 teams nationally with at least nine victories — the three losses were against teams with a combined 28-5 record. They were the outright leader in wins by an FBS program in the state of North Carolina for the third straight year and either the outright leader or co-leader for the sixth straight year.

In 2021, the Mountaineers' 10-2 regular season included signature wins against in-state foe East Carolina (36,752 fans witnessed App State jump out to a 33-9 lead in Charlotte's Bank of America Stadium against the AAC's third-place finisher), longtime rival Marshall, 14th-ranked Coastal Carolina and Black Saturday rival Georgia Southern (the 27-3 win tied for App State's second-largest margin of victory over the Eagles).

Clark has helped lead record-setting runs to conference titles and bowl victories, not just at App State, where he played from 1994-98 and had served as an assistant since 2016, but also in four other leagues during his two decades of college coaching experience.

Working for championship-winning programs at Louisville and Eastern Kentucky before being part of a bowl win for Big Ten member Purdue and coaching at Kent State, Clark has been a vital part of App State's historic FBS success.

Clark graduated from App State with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 1998 and earned a master's degree in education from Louisville in 2003.

His wife, Jonelle, was a standout softball student-athlete at Eastern Kentucky and was inducted into ECU's Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008. The Clarks have two children: a daughter, Giana, and a son, Braxton.

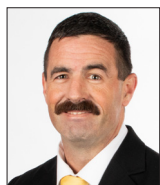

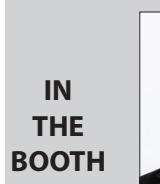

APP STATE RECORD AT KIDD BREWER STADIUM SINCE 2003: 117-21

In addition to boasting one of the most picturesque settings for college football with App State's campus and the natural beauty of the High Country serving as a backdrop, Kidd Brewer Stadium also stakes claim to being one of the toughest venues in the nation.

With 61 seasons completed in the stadium, which opened as Conrad Stadium on Sept. 15, 1962, App State boasts a 270-79-5 all-time record at The Rock.

With the construction of the \$50 million north end zone facility, removal of the track and installation of new turf, The Rock had a new look in 2021, as the end zone facility opened for fans before a November 2020 game against Georgia State. Hall of Fame coach Jerry Moore was also honored before the 2021 opener at The Rock with a plaza and statue in his name.

The new end zone facility houses the football locker room, weight room, offices and team areas, as well as 1,000 club level seats, athletic training spaces, retail and dining service facilities.

The 2023 home win against East Carolina matched the 2022 home opener against North Carolina by drawing a stadium-record 40,168 fans, and every home game since the start of the 2022 season has had an attendance figure exceeding 30,000.

In 2022, App State set single-season school and Sun Belt records with an average home crowd of 33,566. The Mountaineers broke the previous league and program records of 30,441 they had established in 2021.

App State also led the Sun Belt Conference in home attendance in 2016, 2017 and 2019.

Kidd Brewer Stadium's official seating capacity was 16,650 in 2007, but several expansion projects, including construction of the 120,000-square-foot App State Athletics Center, have almost doubled the capacity.

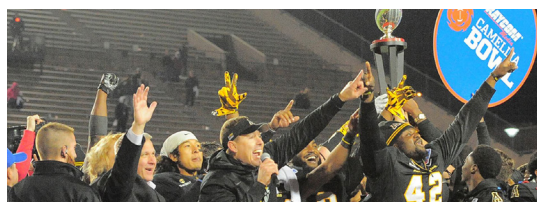

- Switched from strong safety to free safety after the 2022 season, following the arrival of new App State defensive coordinator Scot Sloan
- Led team with 13 tackles in the 2023 opener and added nine more against UNC before intercepting a pass against ECU, then had a team-high 10 stops at ULM
- Had team-leading 73 tackles in 2022 to go with 2.0 tackles for loss, three pass breakups, a forced fumble and an interception (to open the Robert Morris game)
- Also recorded double-digit tackles in wins against Troy (12 stops) and Old Dominion (11 stops)
- As a true freshman in 2019, made one of the biggest plays of App State's historic 13-1 season by returning an interception 20 yards for a touchdown to break a 6-6 tie late in the first half of a 20-15 win at South Carolina



OFFENSIVE LINE

- Isaiah Helms (center), Damion Daley (left guard) and Bucky Williams (right guard) started together in the last six games of 2022 and have thrived in Boone
- Helms has played 51 NCAA games, with starts in all 30 of his App State game appearances since leaving Western Carolina, and Daley has 44 FBS game appearances (31 starts at App State after being at Colorado State/Georgia Military College)
- Williams has played in 52 NCAA games (with 45 combined starts at App State/Austin Peay)
- Five former App State linemen participated in NFL camps in August

Attendance at Kidd Brewer Stadium was 36,075, the second-largest crowd in Kidd Brewer Stadium history behind last year's season opener against North Carolina (40,168).
App State won its ninth home opener in the last 10 tries.
The Mountaineers improved to 9-0 all-time against Gardner-Webb and won against an FCS team for the 10th time in 11 tries since moving up to the FBS ranks in 2014.
This was the first matchup and win against a ranked FCS team since a 33-21 win at No. 24 Wofford in 2013.
App State improved to 49-9 in home games since 2014, the sixth-best winning percentage nationally in that span (and best among Group of Five programs).
First-time starters included QB Ryan Burger, LT Jack Murphy, RT Jayden Ramsey, SS Jordan Favors, DE Shawn Collins, CB Tyrek Funderburk, ILB Kyle Arnholt, OLB Donovan Spellman and DT Markus Clark.
2022 All-American kick returner Milan Tucker was in midseason form with a 48-yard return on the opening kickoff, his only return of the game.
Michael Hughes connected on a career-long 43-yard field goal that gave App State a 31-24 lead at the end of the third quarter.
Nate Noel rushed for 115 yards and a touchdown, his 10th career 100-yard rushing performance.
In his App State debut, running back Maquel Haywood rushed 11 times for 45 yards.
Nick Ross totaled a career-high 13 tackles to lead the defensive unit.

Aguilar, Second-Half Takeaways Provide Key Spark

BOONE, N.C. — With the reset button hit, App State opened the 2023 season by winning in front of a big crowd at The Rock.

Newcomers and non-starters delivered some of the biggest plays during the 45-24 victory against Gardner-Webb in front of 36,075 fans — the second-biggest crowd in Kidd Brewer Stadium history.

In relief of starter Ryan Burger, who went 7 of 11 with an early TD pass before exiting for the rest of the game with a finger injury, Joey Aguilar completed 11 of his 13 passes for 174 yards and four TDs. He threw a TD on his first play for the Mountaineers and set a school record for the most TD passes by a quarterback in his App State debut.

“You have to go out there and just play, no matter if it’s first, second, third,” he said. “It’s always next guy up, and you just have to be prepared.”

“Joey came in, his first collegiate pass for App State is a touchdown, and that gave us the spark we needed,” head coach Shawn Clark said.

Eli Wilson, Kaedin Robinson, Dalton Stroman, Dashaun Davis and Christan Horn had one touchdown catch apiece, and Nate Noel rushed for 115 yards and one touchdown on a career-high 24 carries.

Three turnovers forced in a span of eight minutes from late in the third quarter to midway through the fourth enabled the Mountaineers to gain separation from the Runnin’ Bulldogs, who led 24-21 in the third quarter before App State scored the final 24 points.

With App State ahead 31-24, defensive end Michael Fletcher’s second QB pressure of the game led to an interception from Jackson Greene, who returned the ball 25 yards to the Gardner-Webb 23. Noel followed a 16-yard run with a 7-yard score, and pressure from Shawn Collins contributed to an INT by fellow newcomer Jack Scroggs shortly thereafter.

Kevin Abrams-Verwayne later forced a fumble that was recovered by Montez Kelley, and Aguilar’s fourth TD pass capped the scoring.

GAME NOTES

It was App State's seventh OT game at the FBS level (1-6 record) and 14th overall (4-10 record).

This was the third time since 2016 that the Mountaineers took a nationally ranked team to OT on the road. The others were a 20-13 loss at No. 9 Tennessee in 2016 and a 45-38 loss at No. 9 Penn State in 2018.

The Mountaineers' last eight games against Power Five opponents have all been decided by seven points or less, a stretch that includes the 34-31 road win against the Tar Heels in 2019 and the 63-61 loss to them last year in Boone.

Seven of App State's last eight games against AP Top 25 foes have ended with one-possession final margins, and the only exception was a 34-23 loss at Coastal Carolina in 2020 after App State held a lead going into the final three minutes.

Michael Fletcher and Brendan Harrington had sacks for an App State defense that made several big stops in short-yardage situations, including two big plays involving Jordan Favors.

Facing a fourth-and-1 scenario from the App State 44 early in the fourth quarter, Joey Aguilar faked a handoff and lofted a pass into the hands of well-covered tight end Miller Gibbs for 19 yards on a play with only one player out on a receiving route. Dalton Stroman went up high with one hand to snag a pass in traffic for a 18-yard gain to the UNC 18, and Milan Tucker's 10-yard reception set up Nate Noel's go-ahead score.

First-time starters for the Mountaineers included freshman OLB Nate Johnson, junior QB Joey Aguilar and redshirt sophomore LT Markell Samuel.

Milan Tucker gained 41 yards on his only kick return, and Michael Hughes had a career-long FG of 46 yards.

App State Drops Two-OT Heartbreaker in Kenan

CHAPEL HILL — Another App State-North Carolina showdown. Another sold-out thriller going down to the final seconds — and, in this case, being decided with the clock no longer needed.

After the Mountaineers and 17th-ranked Tar Heels traded scores to begin overtime, UNC opened the second overtime with a touchdown and made a defensive stop to cap a 40-34 victory against App State.

The Mountaineers' last eight games against Power Five foes have all been decided by seven points or less. App State held five leads and came close to improving to 3-1 in its last four games vs. ranked foes.

"I'm at a loss for words, but I'm very proud of our team," Shawn Clark said. "I'm never going to second-guess anything our players have done. They're hurting, but we're Mountaineers. We'll bounce back from this."

Joey Aguilar completed 22 passes for 272 yards and two TDs in his first start. Dashaun Davis accounted for one of the TDs on a night in which he caught seven passes for a career-high 117 yards, and Nate Noel rushed a career-high 26 times for 127 yards with two touchdowns.

App State's offensive line paved the way for 219 rushing yards while allowing no sacks against a defense that recorded nine sacks and allowed minus-2 rushing yards the previous week at South Carolina.

Michael Hughes kicked a game-tying, 33-yard field goal with 1:22 left in the fourth quarter, and the Tar Heels (2-0) missed a 39-yard attempt wide left as time expired to send the game into OT at 27-all.

Three runs to begin OT from Noel, including a 7-yard TD, gave App State a 34-27 lead before UNC answered back with a 17-yard TD run. With UNC having possession to start the second OT, Drake Maye scored on a 13-yard keeper, but Jordan Favors and Caden Sullivan combined on a conversion tackle. An incomplection, 2-yard run and 3-yard completion preceded a fourth-and-5 incomplection near the end zone.

GAME NOTES

App State now owns two of the three 40,000-attendance games in the history of the Sun Belt Conference. The record is a 2009 Louisiana home game against Southern that had 41,357 fans.

The Mountaineers increased their all-time series lead over East Carolina to 21-12 and have a 2-0 advantage with both teams as FBS members.

App State improved to 50-9 in home games since 2014, the sixth-best winning percentage nationally in that span (and best among Group of Five programs).

The Mountaineers improved to 31-1 when winning the turnover battle since 2018, including a 17-1 mark with Shawn Clark as the head coach.

First-time starters for the Mountaineers included TE David Larkins and OLB Thomas Davis.

App State has started a season with three straight performances of 40-plus points for the first time since 2010. The Mountaineers finished 10-3 that season and were Southern Conference Co-Champions.

It was Nate Noel's fourth straight 100-yard game dating back to last year, becoming the first App State player to do that since Darrynton Evans in 2018.

Through two and a half games after he entered in the second quarter for injured starter Ryan Burger against Gardner-Webb, Aguilar has thrown for nine touchdowns and accounted for 10, while only tossing a pair of INTs.

Returning All-American kick returner Milan Tucker scored his first career receiving touchdown.

The Mountaineers held ECU to 99 rushing yards in the game, including minus-5 in the second half.

Record-Tying Crowd Watches App State Top Pirates

BOONE, N.C. — A record-tying crowd for the long-awaited return of an in-state rival. And a satisfying, bounce-back result to boot.

Facing East Carolina in Boone for the first time since 1979, App State pulled away in the second half to claim a 43-28 victory against the Pirates with a crowd of 40,168 rocking Kidd Brewer Stadium. That total matched the stadium record set in 2022 for North Carolina's season-opening visit to the High Country.

An action-packed day that started with Yosef ziplining from the seventh-floor tower onto the field while holding the American flag ended with App State scoring 33 of the final 40 points.

The Mountaineers (2-1) intercepted three passes and recorded four sacks while overcoming two defensive TDs scored by the Pirates, who led 21-10 in the second quarter. One of those touchdowns was a short pick-sick touchdown return, but Joey Aguilar fired three touchdown passes after that and finished 17 of 29 for 241 yards as App State played its third straight in-state opponent to open the 2023 season.

After the Mountaineers fell in two overtimes at North Carolina and gave up an opening-drive touchdown to ECU (0-3), Nate Noel scored from 68 yards out on App State's second offensive play and posted his fourth straight 100-yard game (dating back to last season) with a career-high 193 yards on 25 attempts.

Nick Ross, Jordan Favors and Omari Philyaw all intercepted passes against first-time ECU starter Alex Flinn. Andrew Parker Jr., Markus Clark, Brodrick Gooch and Nate Johnson came away with sacks for a defense that limited the Pirates to 42 second-half yards on 25 plays.

"I'm proud of our football team and really proud of our defense to give up 14 points all day," App State head coach Shawn Clark said. "I just want to thank the fans. We can't thank you enough for tying the all-time attendance record here at App State. The students were incredible."

App State lost its nonconference finale despite holding a lead until the 1:52 mark of the fourth quarter and despite controlling the stats in total yardage (417 to 208), first downs (27 to 7), time of possession (40:25 to 19:35) and third down conversions (10-of-19 to 3-of-12).

The Mountaineers more than doubled the time of possession against a Wyoming team that entered the day ranked 12th in the nation averaging 33:30 per game.

This was the first game in which App State did not score an offensive touchdown since a 2013 loss at Georgia (45-6).

Michael Hughes tied his career high with four made field goals – all in the first half – including a career-long 50-yarder that put the Mountaineers up 12-7 at the close of the first half. The 50-yarder was the longest by an App State kicker since Chandler Staton's 53-yarder against Georgia Southern in 2017.

Wyoming's blocked field goal and 62-yard return for a touchdown that was the eventual game winner was the first time App State has ever allowed a blocked field goal return for a score.

The Mountaineers held Wyoming's offense to just 208 yards, seven first downs and 3-of-12 on third-down conversions. Seventy-five of the Cowboys' 208 yards came on one play.

Solo sacks came from Nate Johnson and Andrew Parker Jr.

Trevor Moffitt tackled a Wyoming running back for a loss for a big stop on a third-and-1.

Nate Noel, the nation's leading rusher entering the weekend, rushed for 107 yards on a career-high 30 attempts, the third time in four games this season he has logged a career high in attempts.

Cowboys Rally Past App State In Closing Minutes

LARAMIE, Wyo. — App State cornerback Tyrek Funderburk's 18-yard interception return for a touchdown following four first-half field goals from Michael Hughes extended App State's fourth-quarter lead to a two-score margin, but Wyoming returned a blocked field goal for a go-ahead touchdown with 1:52 left and intercepted a pass at the Cowboys' 6-yard line with 12 seconds left to seal a 22-19 win.

Funderburk's defensive touchdown gave the Mountaineers (2-2) a 19-7 advantage early in the fourth quarter of their nonconference finale. After a Mitchell Lake punt had pinned Wyoming at its 5 early in the fourth quarter, a bobbled swing pass that was knocked forward into the air by the back ended up in the hands of Funderburk, who raced untouched to the end zone.

The Cowboys (3-1) responded immediately with a 75-yard touchdown run up the middle by Harrison Waylee on the first play of the next series. App State answered with a clock-chewing, grind-it-out series that lasted 18 plays, covered 55 yards and ate up 9 minutes, 32 seconds.

Wyoming blocked a 47-yard field goal that could have pushed the App State advantage to 22-14 with less than two minutes remaining. Instead, DeVonne Harris blocked the attempt before Jakorey Hawkins scooped up the loose ball and raced 62 yards in the other direction for a touchdown. A successful two-point try gave the Cowboys a three-point lead.

App State moved from its 31 to the Wyoming 20 in the closing minute, with a defensive pass interference setting up first down with 17 seconds left, but Wrook Brown picked off a deep throw in the middle of the field.

Nate Noel led the offense by rushing for 107 yards on a career-high 30 carries, and Joey Aguilar threw for 200 yards.

Overall, App State finished with large advantages in first downs (27-7), total yards (417-208, including just 31 through the air for Wyoming) and possession time (40:25-19:35).

GAME NOTES

App State won its ninth straight Sun Belt opener and its second straight on the final play (following last year's Hail Mary win over Troy).

The Mountaineers won on the road for the first time this season after last-second losses to then-No. 17 UNC (40-34 in 2OT) and Wyoming (22-19).

Trailing by two in the final six minutes and needing a goalline stand to keep it a one-possession game, App State forced a fourth-and-goal situation from the 1 thanks to Markus Clark's third-down stop for no gain. ULM attempted a play-action pass, but defensive backs Tyrek Funderburk and Nick Ross combined on a huge sack to give the Mountaineers a shot.

App State had three timeouts left as ULM (2-2, 0-1) took over possession with 1:26 remaining. Three stops, including one for a 4-yard loss by Nick Ross, forced ULM to punt after running off only 19 seconds.

App State earned its first win of the year when losing the turnover battle. Under coach Shawn Clark, the Mountaineers are 17-1 when winning the turnover battle, 5-10 when losing, and 7-3 when they have the same number of turnovers as the opponent.

Nate Noel rushed for 109 yards on 18 attempts, his fifth 100-yard effort in five games this season and his sixth straight over the century mark dating back to last year. He's the first App State player with six straight 100-yard games since Jalin Moore had six straight in 2016.

Tyrek Funderburk scored on a 23-yard pick six to become the first App State player with pick sixes in back-to-back games since Steven Jones Jr. in 2021.

Jordan Favors blocked an extra point to maintain App State's 35-34 lead and broke up a two-point pass after the next ULM touchdown.

Hughes' 54-Yard FG At Horn Lifts App State To Win

MONROE, La. — Michael Hughes came up huge at crunch time. Hughes' career-long 54-yard field goal as time expired — the longest game-winning field goal to end an App State victory in program history — delivered a 41-40 league victory at ULM to open Sun Belt play. "Everyone involved in our program just showed resilience," head coach Shawn Clark said. "The odds of us winning that football game were not good, but everyone stuck together."

The longest App State field goal since 2000 — and tied for the third-longest in program history — capped a six-play, 43-yard march after the Mountaineers (3-2, 1-0) had regained possession at their own 20 with 1:02 left on the clock and no timeouts remaining.

With App State still stuck at its 19 with 24 seconds left, Joey Aguilar completed three straight throws to Kaedin Robinson for 14, 16 and 14 yards to move the ball to the ULM 37 with four seconds showing on the clock. Christian Johnstone delivered the snap to Conner Maynard, whose clean hold set up a pure kick with plenty of distance.

"I knew it was going to be a long one, but we practice those kicks every day in practice," Hughes said. "I had the confidence in me that was just built up over the years. It's just trusting the guys around me. "I hit the same field goal in warmups from 59. The camera guy was perfect on my line. I played my line, hit the ball and game over."

Trailing by two in the final six minutes, App State forced a fourth-and-goal situation from the 1, and ULM attempted a play-action pass, but Tyrek Funderburk and Nick Ross combined on a huge sack.
