## HEADLINES

### LEADING OFF

- Fresh off a 3-1 record at the Tar Heel Invitational in Chapel Hill last weekend, the App State softball team is slated to head to Knoxville, Tenn., to wrap up its road tournament schedule with the Tennessee Invitational this Friday-Sunday. App State will play a doubleheader on Friday and Saturday before wrapping up play with a single game on Sunday.
- While in Knoxville, App State will square off with No. 1 Tennessee two times and No. 23 Penn State on Saturday. This weekend will feature three of App State's four games against high-major teams this season.

### QUICK HITS

- App State enters the weekend in Knoxville on its best 13-game start in program history, owning a win in 11 of its first 13 games. App State started the year with eight straight wins before falling for the first time on a walk-off home run against UNCG on Feb. 14.
- In fact, both of App State's losses this season have come via an extra-inning walk-off home run. Along with the Spartans' ninth-inning game-winning home run, North Carolina defeated App State via an eighth-inning walk-off home run on Feb. 20.
- The Mountaineers enter the Tennessee Invitational with the fewest losses in the Sun Belt Conference with just two entering Friday. App State's .846 win/loss percentage is ranked 20th in the country entering the weekend. App State is one of just 21 teams in the country with two or fewer losses entering the weekend.
- App State has gotten off to an 11-2 start this season thanks to the help of an eight-game win streak to open the season. That win streak marked App State's first win streak of eight or more games since 2021 (nine games). The Mountaineers' eight-game win streak marked its second-longest in program history, bested only by that nine-game win streak in 2021.
- Because of App State's torrid start to the 2026 season, it enters the Tennessee Invitational as the No. 24-ranked team in D1 Softball's Mid-Major rankings. App State jumped into the poll for the first time last Monday. Entering Friday, the Mountaineers are one of five Sun Belt teams in this week's rankings.
- Three of App State's four games against Power Four competition this season are set to come this weekend in Knoxville. Additionally, the Mountaineers will play against two ranked teams this weekend in No. 1 Tennessee and No. 23 Penn State. These will be App State's first three games against ranked teams this season.
- Additionally, the Mountaineers will look for their first win against a Power Five opponent in over six years this weekend. App State has come close to breaking that skid over the last two years, as three of its last six games against high-major opponents have been decided by three or fewer runs. App State has also taken two Power Four opponents (Auburn - 2025 and North Carolina - 2026) to extra innings since last season.
- The Mountaineers' matchups vs. the No. 1-ranked Volunteers this weekend will be their first against a top-ranked squad in program history. App State has beaten one ranked team in its history, defeating No. 23 Louisiana back on March 25, 2023.
- This will also be the Mountaineers' first trip outside the state of North Carolina this season. App State has traveled to Wilmington (Feb. 6-8), Greensboro (Feb. 12-14) and Chapel Hill (Feb. 20-22) so far this year. App State won't travel further than 350 miles from Boone until April 10, when it heads to Monroe, La.

## COACH NOTES

- Whitney Jones was named App State Softball's sixth head coach on May 22, 2024. She is in her second season at the helm.
- Has led App State to its best start in program history through 13 games with an 11-2 record. Also posted the second-longest win streak in program history at eight games to open the season.
- Guided App State to six program records in 2025, including home runs (58), doubles (74), slugging percentage (.480) and on-base percentage (.372).
- Led the Mountaineers to their first Sun Belt Tournament berth since 2022 in her first season as a collegiate head coach. App State's sixth-place finish in the league standings marked its second-highest seed at the tournament as a member of the league.
- Posted 13 Sun Belt wins in 2025 and a winning record against league foes, which tied the program record for wins as a Sun Belt member. Additionally, App State's 13-11 record marked its first winning record in league play in its Sun Belt history.
- Jones has competed in the Women's College World Series as both a player and a coach. She appeared in the WCWS in 2013 as a player and twice as a coach at Washington.
- Known for her proclivity as a hitting coach, Jones helped Ohio State hitters bash 65 homers, the second-most in the Big Ten, and a .497 slugging percentage in 2024.
- At UCF, she helped guide the Knights to their first-ever Super Regionals appearance, using an explosive offense that saw top-50 nationwide marks in four offensive categories.
- Father, Carl, played professional baseball for two years in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching as far as AAA Richmond.

## FROM THE NOTEBOOK

### THE 26TH YEAR

- App State opened its 26th season on Feb. 6 against Kennesaw State.
- The Mountaineers own 530 wins entering the weekend. App State notched its 500th win in program history against Lehigh last Feb. 28.

### OUR HOME TURF

- The 2026 season will mark the second season for App State at the newly constructed Sywassink/Lloyd Family Stadium.
- App State opened the stadium last season on March 21, 2025, against Georgia Southern, after playing its home games at its on-campus home since 2007.
- The Mountaineers will play 18 home games this season, marking the most in a season since 2016.

### THE MOUNTAINEER CLASSIC

- App State will host the Mountaineer Classic from March 6-8, hosting the Queens Royals and the Furman Paladins.
- The Mountaineer Classic will be the first tournament that App State will host in program history.

### YEAR 2 WITH COACH JONES

- Head coach Whitney Jones is currently in her second season at the helm of the program and has already taken this team to new heights.
- In year one, which was Jones' first season as a collegiate head coach, App State won 23 games. This was the second-most by an App State first-year head coach in program history (Shae Wesley - 26 in 2011).
- Additionally, App State's 13 Sun Belt wins in Jones' first year marked the second-most by a first-year head coach in team history (Wesley - 15 in 2011).

### WHO'S BACK?

- The Mountaineers returned eight position players who started at least 35 games and one pitcher who started in 27 games last season to the 2026 squad.
- Highlighting the returners are Sophie Moshos, Makayla McClain, Grace Barrett, Macy Hamby and Leah Gore.
- McClain and Barrett were both named All-Sun Belt in 2025, while also receiving Preseason All-Sun Belt honors on Jan. 28.
- Moshos, who was named to the All-Sun Belt second team in 2025, is back for her second season in the Black and Gold after striking out 118 hitters last season and finishing 13th in the Sun Belt in earned run average (3.51).

### WHO'S NEW?

- In addition to the returners, the Mountaineers welcomed four collegiate transfers and five freshmen to the mountain in 2026.
- The transfer class includes Emilie Ching (Florida Atlantic), Dakota Daniel (Alabama A&M), KB Bradshaw (Gaston College) and Gabriella Aughton (Boston College).
- The freshmen class includes Camryn Fisher (Pitcher - Ellington, Conn.), Taylor Schafer (Infielder - Schererville, Ind.), Emersyn Presutty (Outfielder - Charlotte, N.C.), Kate English (Utility - Ball Ground, Ga.) and Madison Fletcher (Utility - Millers Creek, N.C.).
- App State's incoming class has made an immediate impact already this season as newcomers have combined to scorch 39 hits and bash 10 of App State's 20 home runs.

### AN EXPERIENCED GROUP

- App State entered the 2026 season with one of the more experienced teams in the Sun Belt Conference.

Entering the Tennessee Invitational, the Mountaineers boast 11 top-50 national rankings. Most notably, App State stands in the top 50 in the country in ERA (33rd - 2.61), home runs (32nd - 20), runs per game (48th - 7.0) and walks (47th - 57). To put that into context, App State finished with a top-50 national ranking in just one category last season (home runs per game - 40th).

Makayla McClain did something on Feb. 13 that few other people have done by hitting two grand slams in the same game against Columbia. To put into context what McClain did in three innings against the Lions, only 13 players in Major League Baseball history have ever hit two grand slams in the same game. McClain's eight RBIs against the Lions set App State's single-game record for RBIs, surpassing the previous mark of six set in 2017 by Ally Walters.

The Mountaineers have played complete this season, and enter play this weekend with a +48 run differential (91-43). App State's pitching staff is allowing just 3.3 runs per game, while its offense is scoring seven runs per game. Additionally, App State's defense enters the weekend ranked tied for second in the Sun Belt and 51st nationally in fielding percentage at .972. Six of the Mountaineers' 11 wins have come by three or more runs.


