INSIDE THE SERIES

The Series: 84th meeting in a series that dates back to 1976: UTM leads the all-time series, 43-41. Series Streak: UT Martin is on a five-game winning streak dating back to 2018.

Last Meeting: UTM beat APSU, 65-61, on Jan. 18, 2020, at the Elam Center.

OPENING TIP

- Having started conference play 5-0, Austin Peay is off to its best start in the Ohio Valley Conference since the 2002-03 season.
- Austin Peay is on its first five-game OVC winning streak since 2011, when Carrie Daniel's team won four-straight games from Jan. 24 to Feb. 19.
- With a win over UT Martin, the Governors could improve to 6-0 to start OVC play for the first time since the 2002-03 season, when Susie Gardener's team went 16-0 in conference play.
- For the fourth week this season, the Govs received votes in the CollegeInsider.com Women's Mid-Major Top 25 poll.
- Nationally the Governors rank 18th in three-pointers per game (9.3), 20th in three-pointers attempted (259), and 26th in three-pointers made (84) -- they lead the OVC in all three statistics as well.
- Austin Peay is one of two teams in the OVC that rank in the top four in scoring offense (71.2 ppg) and scoring defense (62.3 ppg), because of that the Govs rank second in the league in scoring margin (+8.9).
- Brandi Ferby ranks 10th in the nation and leads the conference with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.86.
- Twin sisters Brianah and Brandi Ferby rank first (24 steals) and second (23 steals) in the OVC, respectively. in steals and lead an Austin Peay team that leads the OVC in steals (93) this season.
- Maggie Knowles leads the OVC in three-pointers made (25), and would be tied for the NCAA lead in three-point field goals made per game (4.17) if she had played in 75 percent of Austin Peay's games.
- This season Austin Peav returns players who accounted for 92.8 percent (248) of last season's record-breaking 267 three-point field goals made.

GAME PREVIEW

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

After knocking off Eastern Illinois and improving to 5-0 to start Ohio Valley Conference play, Austin Peay is off to its best start to conference play in 18 years. The last time, and only other time, the Governors went 5-0 to start OVC play was during Susie Gardner's final season at the helm, when she led Austin Peay to an undefeated OVC regular season, an OVC Regular Season title, and a third-straight OVC Tournament title. A win over UT Martin would snap a five-game losing streak to the Skyhawks and match the 2002-03 squad as only the second Austin Peay team since 1976 to start the OVC slate 6-0.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

After a first-place finish in the Ohio Valley Conference regular season in 2019-20; UT Martin was unable to capture the OVC Tournament Championship, falling to No. 3 seeded Southeast Missouri, 67-47, in the title game.

This season UT Martin was tabbed to win the league in both the OVC Coaches and SIDs Preseason Poll and the OVC Media Poll, receiving 32 of 37 first place votes in the two polls. 12th year head coach Kevin McMillan returns 13 letterwinners and four starters from last year's squad that posted a 22-10 mark overall and a 16-2 record in OVC play. Last season the Skyhawks went 13-1 at home, dropping only one contest to No. 6 Louisville, 71-63 (OT2) at the Elam Center.

This season UT Martin returns the 2019-20 OVC Player of the Year and the 2020-21 Preseason OVC Player of the Year, Chelsey Perry. Last season Perry ranked 3rd in the NCAA, averaging 23.1 points per game; this season she is averaging 27.2 points per game, which ranks second in the nation. Perry leads the OVC in three-point percentage (50%), ranks second in field-goal percentage (55.4%), and eighth in rebounding (8.2 rpg).

Last week Perry posted a 26-point, 10-rebound double-double on the road at No. 2 Louisville, before scoring a season-high 32 points at Tennessee State; which was good enough to earn her third OVC Player of the Week award this season.

Senior forward Maddie Waldrop is UT Martin's other returning First-Team All-OVC performer from 2019-20, she averaged 12.7 points and 7.8 rebounds per game last season. A 2020-21 Preseason All-OVC selection, Waldrop is averaging just 3.8 points and 5.5 rebounds per game this season, while shooting 33.3 percent from the floor.

Louisville transfer Seygan Robins is UT Martin's second-leading scorer this season, averaging 9.2 points per game. The redshirt sophomore guard is also dishing out 3.7 assists per game, which leads the Skyhawks and ranks fifth in the OVC this season.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE SKYHAWKS

Austin Peay knocked down a dozen three-pointers and held an 11-point lead at halftime, but they were unable to hold on and a late UT Martin rally knocked off the Governors, 65-61, on Jan. 18, 2020 in the Elam Center.

Maggie Knowles and Ella Sawyer led the Govs with 17 and 14 points, respectively, with Knowles connecting on five three-pointers and Sawyer hitting a trio of triples. Knowles also pulled down a team-high 6 rebounds, while Sawyer recorded 3 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 block, and 1 steal.

Brandi Ferby also pulled down 6 rebounds for the Govs, while dishing out a team-high 5 assists. Brianah Ferby was the final Governor in double-figures, hitting three triples en route to 11 points.

The OVC Player of the Year, Chelsey Perry, led UT Martin with 25 points and 12 rebounds; scoring 19 points and pulling down 9 rebounds in the second half alone. Tamiah Stanford also scored 11 points and grabbed 5 rebounds, she was the only other Skyhawk in double-figures.

GOVS NOTES



RED-HOT START

After beating Eastern Illinois to improve to 5-0 in the Ohio Valley Conference, Austin Peay is off to its best start in conference play since the 2002-03 season, when Susie Gardener led the Govs to a perfect 16-0 mark in the OVC. This season marks only the second time since 1976 that the Governors have started OVC play with five-straight wins.

ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR, FIVE...

The Governors are on a five-game OVC winning streak for the first time since 2011, when Carrie Daniels' squad won five-straight games from Feb. 3 to Feb. 19. If Austin Peay can pick up its sixth-straight conference win, it will mark the first six-game OVC winning streak since 2004, when Andy Blackston's team won eight-straight conference games from Jan. 24 to Feb. 19.

GOVS ON THE GLASS

Austin Peay pulled down a season-high 50 rebounds at SIUE, marking the first time the Govs have hit the half-century mark on the glass since they grabbed 51 rebounds against Tennessee State (2/6/2020). The Governors outrebounded SIUE, 50-32, despite the Cougars entering the game with the OVC's best rebounding margin at the time.

GOVS HELP GOVS

Austin Peay dished out 21 assists on 26 made field goals at SIUE; the Govs 21 assists against the Cougars were their second-best single-game total this season, behind only a 22-assist effort against Trevecca (11/28/20).

THREE FOR THE PEAY

Nationally Austin Peay ranks 18th in three-point field goals per game (9.3), 20th in three-pointers attempted (259), and 26th in three-point field goals made (84) – the Govs also led the OVC in all three statistics. The Governors connected from three-point range 11 times last time out against Eastern Illinois and have made doubledigit triples in six games this season.

TAKEAWAYS

The Governors have recorded double-digit steals in four out of their last five games and lead the OVC with 93 steals this season. Austin Peay is also averaging 10.3 steals per game this season, which ranks second in the conference.

BY THE MARGINS

At this point in the season, Austin Peay is one of two teams in the OVC to have a positive scoring margin (+8.9), rebounding margin (+1.2), and turnover margin (+3.11) – Southeast Missouri is the only other team in the league to have a positive margin in all three statistics.

BOTH ENDS OF THE FLOOR

The Governors are one of two teams in the OVC that rank in the top four in the conference in scoring offense (71.2 ppg) and scoring defense (62.3 ppg), and because of that Austin Peay ranks second in the OVC in scoring margin (+8.9) – Belmont is the only other team in the league that ranks in the top four in scoring offense and defense.

FROM DOWNTOWN...

Maggie Knowles has made at least three three-pointers in five-straight games, she leads the OVC and ranks 36th in the country in three-point field goals made (25). Knowles is also averaging 4.17 made three-pointers per game, which would be tied for the NCAA lead if she had played in 75 percent of Austin Peay's games this season.

KNOWLES KNOWS

Maggie Knowles is the Austin Peay career three-point percentage leader, she is currently shooting 42 percent from downtown in her collegiate career.

BALL SECURITY, JOB SECURITY

With 27 assists and just 7 turnovers this season, Brandi Ferby leads the OVC and ranks 10th in the NCAA with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.86. In her career, she has dished out 181 assists and only turned the ball over 83 times – good for a career assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.18.

FANTASTIC FERBYS

Brianah Ferby leads the OVC in steals (24) and ranks third in steals per game (2.67), while her twin sister Brandi ranks second in steals (23) and fourth in steals per game (2.56). Brianah and Brandi rank 46th and 53rd in the NCAA, respectively, in steals this season.

FULL-COURT PRESSURE

The Governors full-court press forced 20 turnovers last time out against Eastern Illinois, and has forced at least 20 turnovers in five out of the last six games. The Govs defense is averaging 20.6 turnovers forced per game, which ranks 34th in the country and second in the OVC.

DEFENSIVE GEM

The Govs beat Tennessee State, 62-37, marking the first time in 19 years and only the fourth time since reliable record keeping began in 1976 that Austin Peay women's basketball has held their opponent under 40 points in a single game. The three other times the Govs held the opposition under 40 points in program history are:

Dec. 15, 1976 at Milligan (W, 88-29) Jan. 4, 1984 vs. Belmont (W, 60-38) Dec. 2, 2002 vs. Ohio (W, 69-38)

#TWINNING

According to an independent study, Austin Peay's Brandi and Brianah Ferby are one of 23 sets of twins sisters playing NCAA Division I women's basketball on the same team this season. The Ferby sisters are also one of 47 sets of sisters on the same roster in the NCAA this season.

DOWN-UNDER DUO

According to "The Pick and Roll" — an Australian Basketball website — Tahanee Bennell and Ella Sawyer are two of 125 Australians playing NCAA Division I Women's Basketball in 2020-21. The Govs duo of Bennell and Sawyer make Austin Peay one of 30 women's basketball programs to have multiple Australian players on its roster this season.

AUSSIES IN THE OVC

According to "The Pick and Roll" there are a total of four Australian women's basketball players in the OVC this season, with Eastern Illinois' Grace McRae and Eastern Kentucky's Georgia Baldwin joining the Governors duo of Bennell and Sawyer.

CLARKSVILLE WORLD'S FAIR

Last season, Tahanee Bennell and Ella Sawyer became the first Australian players in Austin Peay women's basketball history. This year the Governors welcomed Finland's Selina Dockery and Puerto Rico's Nina De Leon Negron, both of whom are the first from their home country to play for the Governors.

OVC STREAKS

Head coach David Midlick and the Govs picked up their sixth-straight win against Tennessee State, Jan. 4, making that their longest active winning streak against an OVC opponent. The Governors also picked up their fifth-straight win against Eastern Kentucky, Jan. 2, and their fourth-straight win against SIUE, Jan. 7.

20-POINT DUOS

Maggie Knowles and Brianah Ferby scored 22 and 20 points, respectively, against Eastern Kentucky; they are the second Govs duo to score 20+ points in a single game this season. Brianah Ferby scored 26 points and Shay-Lee Kirby scored 24 points in the Govs season opener against North Alabama, Nov. 25.

CAGING THE COUGARS

Austin Peay has won four-straight games against SIUE – by an average of 15.3 points per game. The four-game winning streak against SIUE is the Governors longest winning streak against the Cougars in the 13-year series history.

TAMING THE TIGERS

The Govs have won six-straight games against Tennessee State – by an average of 22.3 points per game – and head coach David Midlick is 6-1 against TSU while at Austin Peay. Last season the Govs beat the Lady Tigers, 87-55, in the Gentry Center, the 32-point win was Austin Peay's biggest win on the road in series history.

CORRALLING THE COLONELS

The Governors have won five-straight games against Eastern Kentucky – by an average of 20.6 points per game – and have won the last five games against EKU that were contested in the Dunn Center. Austin Peay's current winning streak is its best in the series since the Govs won seven-straight games against the Colonels from 2002 to 2004.

BORDER BATTLE THEFT

The Governors recorded 17 steals in their win on the road at Murray State, that is the most in a single game since they posted 18 steals against Evansville (11/21/19). Brandi and Brianah Ferby led the Govs in steals, with each of the twin sisters recording five steals in the contest.

BORDER PROTECTION

After sweeping the regular-season series against Murray State for the first time since 2012 last season, the Governors have won three-straight games against the Racers and have won five out of the last six meetings.

CONFERENCE OPENER TIDBITS

Austin Peay is 21-23 all-time in Ohio Valley Conference openers, and after their last win at Murray State, the Govs are 12-9 on the road in OVC openers. Before this season, the last time the Governors had opened the conference slate on the road was on Jan. 3, 2015, when they beat Eastern Kentucky, 81-71.

STARTING WITH THE RACERS

Austin Peay is now 5-3 all-time against Murray State in OVC openers. Before this season, the last time the two had met to kick off the conference slate was on Jan. 11, 2003, when the Govs beat the Racers, 62-61, in the CFSB Center. The Governors are on a three-game winning streak against the Racers in OVC openers and are 3-1 all-time in conference openers played in Murray, Kentucky.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTES

Last season the Governors won an OVC-best nine non-conference games, and closed out the non-conference slate on a four game winning streak. The Govs went 2-2 in non-conference action this season; and dating back to last season, Austin Peay has won 11 out of its last 15 non-conference tilts.

DOUBLE-DIGIT GOVS

The home opener against Trevecca marked the first time since Feb. 20, 2020, at SIUE, that five Govs scored in double-figures in a single game: Maggie Knowles (22), Nina De Leon Negron (16), Brianah Ferby (14), Myah LeFlore (11), and Kelen Kenol (10).

SHE'S A FRESHMAN

After leading the Govs with 8 rebounds, including 5 on the offensive end, in her collegiate debut at North Alabama; Nina De Leon Negron showed off her versatility, posting 16 points, 6 assists, and 4 rebounds in her home debut against Trevecca.

NOVEMBER NUMBERS

After going 5-1 in the month of November last season, the Governors went 2-0 in November this season. In David Midlick's career at Austin Peay, the Govs are 22-15 (.595%) in the 11th month on the calender.

ON THE HOME FRONT

With a win over Trevecca in the home opener, the Governors have won four-straight homeopening contests in the Dunn Center. The last time the Govs won four-straight home openers was a part of a five-game winning streak from 2000 to 2004.

SEASON-OPENING STREAK

For the first time since the 1995 and 1996 seasons, the Governors have won their season-opening contest in back-to-back years.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Austin Peay picked up its first win on the road in a season-opening game since Nov. 28, 1987, when Marvin Williams' squad knocked off Southern Indiana, 77-72. The Govs snapped a 33-year, 14-game losing streak in season openers played on the road when they beat North Alabama, 88-78.

LATE START

November 25 was the latest the Governors have opened the season since the 1995-96 season, when they knocked off Bethel, 89-61, in the season opener on November 25 in the Winfield Dunn Center.

THE ADVENTURES OF ELLA SAWYER

In the final week of the 2019-20 regular season, Ella Sawyer scored 21 points and knocked down a pair of triples against Morehead State; before connecting on six three-pointers and pouring in a career-high 26 points at Murray State on her way to being named the OVC Freshman of the Week. Later that week, Sawyer was also named to the 2019-20 OVC All-Newcomer team

SMASH! BANG! TO VICTORY!

Austin Peay posted an 18-win regular season in 2019-20, which was the program's best win total since the 2003-04 squad won 20 regular-season contests.

POSTSEASON STREAK

Last season Austin Peay made its sixth-straight trip to the OVC Women's Basketball Championship, that is the second-longest streak of consecutive postseason appearances in program history – behind only a 10-year streak from 1993-2004.

FIVE-FOR-FIVE

In five seasons at the helm, David Midlick has guided the Govs to five-straight OVC Women's Basketball Tournaments. That is the second-longest streak by a coach in program history, trailing only Susie Gardner, who led Austin Peay to the postseason in seven-consecutive seasons from 1997-2003.

BY 29 LENGTHS

The Governors 29-point blowout win on the road at Murray State in the 2019-20 regular-season finale was the biggest win on the road in Murray, Kentucky in program history. It also marked the biggest road win by either team in the 43-year history of the Austin Peay-Murray State women's basketball series.

THREE-POINT RECORD

Last year Austin Peay broke the program's single-season team three-point record for the second-straight season. The 2018-19 team set the mark at 241 triples, before the 2019-20 squad connected from downtown 267 times.

THE 200-CLUB

For the first time in program history, the Governors made 200-plus three pointers in back-to-back seasons. The 2018-19 and 2019-20 squads join the 2002-03 Govs as the only teams in program history with more than 200 made triples in a season.

BOMBS AWAY

Last year the Governors attempted a program record 845 three pointers. They were the first team in program history to attempt 750-plus three pointers in a season and were only the second team to attempt more than 600 three-point field goals in a season.

With 2:19 left in the period, Maggie Knowles finally found some open space and connected on her first triple of the contest to push the Governors lead to double-digits for the first time in the game. When Eastern Illinois' Abby Wahl answered the Knowles three-pointer with a triple of her own, the Govs wasted no time getting the three points back, as Nina De Leon Negron buried a three of her own with 1:19 left in the period to extend the lead back to ten.

Wahl would score the final points of the first quarter, but the Governors held a 19-11 lead after the first ten minutes of action. The second quarter was the only period of the game where Eastern Illinois was able to outscore Austin Peay. Wahl scored seven of her game-high 19 points, but the Panthers were only able to trim the Govs lead to four, and Austin Peay took a 33-29 lead into the locker room at halftime.

In the third period it was Austin Peay's threepoint shooting that carried the load on the offense end, as the Governors shot 62.5 percent from behind the arc and drilled five triples in the frame. It was Bennell who sparked the threepoint barrage for the Govs, connecting from deep on back-to-back possessions to stretch the lead to 8 with 6:23 left in the quarter.

After the Panthers were able to cut the Govs lead to just a single point, Brandi Ferby buried her only three-pointer of the contest to get the offense in rhythm again. Two possessions later. De Leon Negron knocked down her second three of the contest to put the Governors back up by eight with 2:22 left in the period.

Following a pair of made free throws by the Panthers, Bennell finished what she started, connecting on her third three-pointer of the quarter to give Austin Peay a 53-44 lead. But Eastern Illinois would not go away, and the Panthers scored four-straight points to close out the quarter, trimming the Govs advantage to just five points.

After both teams traded free throws to start the final quarter, Knowles stepped into a three-pointer from way outside the arc, igniting the Austin Peay bench and pushing the lead back to eight. But the Panthers had an answer once again, with Morgan Litwiller converting an old-fashioned three-point play to equal the Knowles triple.

With 4:24 left to play, Bennell drew an offensive foul and then drilled her fourth three-pointer of the day on the ensuing offensive possession. The Governors would go on to knock down ten free throws in the final 2:30 second of the contest, putting the game on ice and picking up their fifth-straight win to start OVC play.

- Midlick has led the Governors to the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament in each of his first five seasons at the helm. His
 five-straight trips to the OVC Tournament is the second-longest streak by a coach in program history, trailing only Susie
 Gardner, who led the Governors to the postseason in seven-consecutive seasons from 1997-2003.
- During the 2019-20 season, Midlick led the Govs to an 18-win regular season, which was the program's best win total since the 2003-04 squad won 20 regular-season contests.
- Midlick's Govs have made 200-plus three-pointers in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history; with the 2018-19 squad initially setting the single-season three-point record at 241 triples, before the 2019-20 broke that record with 267 three pointers.
- In his first four seasons in Clarksville, Midlick coached four First-team All-OVC players: Tiasha Gray (2015-16), Tearra Banks (2016-17), Brianne Alexander (2017-18), and Keisha Gregory (2018-19) -- Banks was also named the 2016-17 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year.
- Austin Peay is Midlick's second head coaching position. He was head coach at Division II Delta State for two seasons (2012-14), leading the Lady Statesmen to the South Region Final in 2012-13. Midlick finished his Delta State tenure with a 45-16 record.
- During his three-season collegiate career at Ole Miss, Midlick played in 80 games, averaging 5.8 points and 2.3 assists per game. He led the 1988-89 Rebels in free-throw percentage and was fourth on the team in scoring. Midlick made 42.9 of his field goals, 41.2 percent of his three-pointers and 83.7 percent of his free throws during his career.
- Midlick excelled academically at Mississippi, earning Academic All-SEC honors each of his three seasons. He also was a
 Male Scholar-Athlete selection in 1991 and a nominee for the H. Boyd McWhorter SEC Male Scholar-Athlete of the Year
 Award.
