# **INSIDE THE SERIES**

The Series: 87th meeting in a series that dates back to 1976: the all-time series is tied, 43-43.

Series Streak: UT Martin has won the last seven meetings, dating back to 2018.

Last Meeting: UT Martin beat Austin Peay, 56-51, on Feb. 12, 2021 in Clarksville at the Dunn Center.

#### **OPENING TIP**

- Austin Peay wrapped up nonconference play on a four-game winning streak to finish 7-3, the Govs will now begin their final journey through the Ohio Valley Conference when they take on UT Martin.
- Austin Peay has played UT Martin 86 times in women's basketball, that is the second-most games the Govs have played against any OVC opponent -- APSU has played Murray State 93 times.
- Austin Peay has not trailed in a game since it fell to Tulsa, Nov. 27, at the FAU Thanksgiving Tournament. The Govs are on a four-game winning streak with four-straight wire-to-wire wins against Bellarmine, UNC Asheville, Gardner-Webb, and UT Southern.
- Through ten games, Austin Peay is shooting 46.3 percent from the floor as a team - that ranks second in the OVC. The Govs have not shot over 45 percent from the floor in a season since the 2002-03 team set the program record by shooting 47.4 percent.
- Austin Peay also ranks second in the OVC in fieldgoal percentage defense, holding teams to just 37.2 percent shooting from the floor this season.
- The Govs rank second in the OVC in scoring offense (68.7 ppg), scoring defense (56.9 ppg), and scoring margin (+11.8), they are the only OVC team that ranks in the top two in each statistic.
- The Governors lead the OVC in three-point percentage (.348) and three-point percentage defense (.243) this season. Austin Peay has connected on 64 threepointers this season, which ranks second in the league behind Belmont's 74 triples.
- Austin Peay swept the OVC weekly awards for the first time in program history this week with Yamia Johnson, Liz Gibbs, and Lyric Cole earning Player, Newcomer, and Freshman of the Week, respectively.
- Yamia Johnson and Karle Pace are averaging 16.4 and 14.4 points per game, respectively, which ranks third and fifth in the OVC.

#### **GAME PREVIEW**

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

Austin Peay will begin its final trip through the OVC when it takes on UT Martin for the 87th time in program history. The Govs and Skyhawks have the two best scoring defenses in the OVC this season, with UT Martin allowing just 54.0 points per game and Austin Peay allowing only 56.9 points per game.

The Govs have not trailed in a game since they fell to Tulsa, 61-69, on Nov. 27 at the FAU Thanksgiving Tournament. Since that loss, the Governors have scored first and never given up the lead en route to four-straight wire-to-wire wins against Bellarmine, UNC Asheville, Gardner-Webb, and UT Southern.

#### **SCOUTING UT MARTIN**

After winning the 2020-21 OVC Regular-Season Title, UT Martin fell to No. 2-seed Belmont, 83-75, in the 2021 OVC Tournament Championship. The Skyhawks finished the 2021 season in the Women's National Invitation Tournament, where they lost their opening-round contest to Nebraska before beating Louisiana and Illinois State.

This season, 13th-year head coach Kevin McMillan has had to replace his top-three scorers from a season ago, with Chelsey Perry (22.9 ppg) being drafted by the Indiana Fever in the 2021 WBNA Draft, Dasia Young (12.7 ppg) transferring to Utah, and Maddie Waldrop (10.1 ppg) graduating.

UT Martin finished a tough nonconference slate with a 3-8 record, having dropped games at Kansas State, No. 10 Louisville, and Mississippi State. The Skyhawks also fell in a tight 54-49 contest against No. 24 Virginia Tech at the San Juan Shootout in Puerto Rico.

Junior Paige Pipkin leads the Skyhawks in scoring this season, averaging 12.3 points per game, which ranks 12th in the OVC. Pipkin has also knocked down 16 three-pointers, which leads UT Martin and ranks sixth in the league.

Holly Forbes, a graduate transfer from Robert Morris, is UT Martin's second-leading scorer and ranks 21st in the conference, averaging 10.1 points per game. Forbes is averaging 6.1 rebounds per game, which leads the Skyhawks and ranks seventh in the OVC.

UT Martin has four of the top-six player in the OVC in terms of minutes played this season. Kyannah Grant (35.9 mpg), Pipkin (35.4 mpg), and Hayley Harrison (34.3 mpg) rank second, third and fourth, respectively, while Forbes (33.2 mpg) has played the sixth-most minutes in the league.

The Skyhawks have the best scoring defense in the OVC this season, holding opponents to just 54 points per game. However, UT Martin ranks last in the conference in scoring offense, averaging just 47.1 points per game this season.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST THE SKYHAWKS

Austin Peay held UT Martin to a regular-season low 56 points, but the Skyhawks knocked off the Governors, 56-51, on Feb. 12, 2021, in the Winfield Dunn Center in Clarksville.

The Govs led 10-9 after the first quarter, but UT Martin took a lead it would never give up early in the second period. Austin Peay was able to trim the deficit to just one point with 55 seconds left in the contest, but the Skyhawks made 7-of-8 free throws to close the game and hold on for a five-point win.

Maggie Knowles and Brianah Ferby led the Governors with 12 points each, with Knowles scoring all of her points from behind the three-point line. Shay-Lee Kirby was the final Gov in double-figures, knocking down a pair of triples en route to 10 points.

Dasia Young led UT Martin with 16 points and seven rebounds, while Sade' Hudson recorded 12 points and five boards. Maddie Waldrop added nine points, four rebounds, and two blocked shots.

#### **GOVS NOTES**

#### **BRITTANY BEGINS**

Brittany Young was named the 12th head coach in Austin Peay women's basketball history on Friday, March 19, 2021. Young is the eighth woman and the first African-American to lead the Austin Peay women's basketball program. She picked up her first-career win when Austin Peay beat Pikeville, 78-49, on Nov. 12 in her Winfield Dunn Center debut.

#### **NEVER TRAILED: PART IV**

Austin Peay has recorded four-straight wire-to-wire wins and has not trailed since it fell to Tulsa, Nov. 27, at the FAU Thanksgiving Tournament. The Govs have held the lead for 153:51 of the 160 minutes played in their last three games and have only been tied for 6:09 of game time.

#### LAST TIME THROUGH THE LEAGUE

Austin Peay will begin its final Ohio Valley Conference season when it takes on UT Martin, Thursday. The Govs have played the Skyhawks 86 times in women's basketball – the only OVC team they have played more is Murray State (93 games) – and the 87th meeting between the Volunteer State rivals will break a 43-43 tie in the all-time series, which dates back to 1976. The Governors and Skyhawks will meet once more in the regular season, when Austin Peay travels to Martin for the final time, Jan. 20.

#### **OVC SWEEP**

For the first time since the OVC began handing out three weekly awards during the 1985-86 season, Austin Peay swept the honors with Yamia Johnson being named the Player of the Week, Liz Gibbs being named the Newcomer of the Week, and Lyric Cole being named the Freshman of the Week, Dec. 28. The sweep also marks the first time the Govs have claimed multiple OVC weekly awards in a single week since Arielle Gonzalez-Varner and Shay-Lee Kirby were named Player of the Week and Freshman of the Week, respectively, on Dec. 30, 2019.

#### **BACK-TO-BACK**

After recording 17 points, eight rebounds, and connecting on a season-best four three-pointers against UT Southern, Yamia Johnson was named the OVC Player of the Week for the second-straight week, Dec. 28. Johnson is the first Gov to win multiple Player of the Week awards in the same season since Tearra Banks did it three times during the 2016-17 season. She is also the first to win the award in back-to-back weeks since 2004, when Gerlonda Hardin was named OVC Player of the Week on Feb. 2 and Feb. 9.

#### **GIBBS GETS IT GOING**

Liz Gibbs earned her first OVC Newcomer of the Week honors, Dec. 28, after recording season-highs with nine points and three assists, while matching her career-highs with six rebounds and two steals against UT Southern. Gibbs is the first Gov to earn Newcomer of the Week honors since Tahanee Bennell on Dec. 23, 2019.



#### **HISTORIC DEFENSE**

Austin Peay held UT Southern to just 35 points – the second-fewest points allowed in the modern era of program history – in a 74-35 win over the FireHawks, Dec. 21, in the Winfield Dunn Center. The 1976-77 Governors team holds the record for the fewest points allowed in a single game, having held Milligan to just 29 points in a 88-29 win on Dec. 15, 1976 in Elizabethton, Tennessee.

#### **LEARNING THE LYRIC**

Lyric Cole recorded her second-collegiate double-double with 14 points and a career-high 11 rebounds against UT Southern and was named OVC Freshman of the Week, Dec. 28, for the second time this season. Cole is the first Gov to be named Freshman of the Week twice in the same season since the 2019-20 season, when Shay-Lee Kirby picked up the award twice (Nov. 12 and Dec. 30).

#### **JOHNSON JUST SCORES**

With 17 points against UT Southern, Yamia Johnson has scored in double-figures in tenstraight games to begin her Austin Peay career. Johnson is the first Governor to score in double-figures in ten-straight games since 2019, when Keisha Gregory did it in 11-consecutive games from Jan. 31 to March 7. Johnson ranks third in the OVC in scoring this season, averaging 16.4 points per game.

#### **KEEPING PACE**

Karle Pace has scored in double-figures in nine of ten games to begin her Austin Peay career and ranks fifth in the OVC in scoring, averaging 14.4 points per game this season. The Clarksville native scored a season-high 20 points at UNC Asheville, Dec. 16, and is one of two Governors with a 20-point scoring performance this season.

#### **LA ISLA DEL ENCANTO**

Nina De Leon Negron ranks second in the OVC in assists (3.9 apg), second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.2), and is tied for tenth in steals (1.8 spg). The San Juan native recorded career-highs with eight assists at UNC Asheville, Dec. 16, and five steals against North Alabama, Nov. 16 – both marks are tied for the best single-game performance by a Gov this season.

#### **DEFENDING THE DUNN**

Austin Peay improved to 4-0 in the Winfield Dunn Center under head coach Brittany Young when it knocked off UT Southern, 74-35, on Dec. 21. Young and the Govs have won their four home games by an average of 24.3 points per game and will look to improve to 5-0 on Dave Loos Court when they host UT Martin to open OVC play.

#### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE REPORT**

Freshman Lyric Cole's 14-point, 11-rebound double-double against UT Southern, Dec. 21, is her second of the season after recording 16 points and 11 rebounds against Bellarmine, Dec. 12. Cole is the first Austin Peayfreshman to record a double-double since Brianne Alexander posted 13 points and 10 rebounds at Jackson-ville State (1/8/15). The Memphis native is also the first Gov with multiple double-doubles in a single season since Arielle Gonzalez-Varner recorded five during the 2019-20 season.

#### THE ADVENTURES OF ELLA SAWYER

After averaging a team-best 3.1 assists per game last season, Ella Sawyer ranks third in the OVC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.5) and sixth in assists (3.4 apg) this season. Sawyer also ranks eighth in the OVC in steals (1.9 spg) and recorded career-highs with eight assists and five steals – both are tied for the best single-game performance by a Gov this season – against Bellarmine, Dec. 12.

#### THREE FOR THE PEAY

After hitting 10 three-pointers against UT Southern, Austin Peay improved to 3-0 this season when it connects on double-digit triples. The Govs hit a season-best 12 three-pointers at UNC Asheville, Dec. 16, which is tied for the best single-game three-point performance in the OVC this season.

#### **GOVS NOTES**

#### **CONTROLLING THE BOARDS**

Austin Peay grabbed 52 rebounds against UT Southern, Dec. 21, matching the season-high 52 boards it pulled down in the season opener at Evansville, Nov. 9. Before the season opener against the Purple Aces, the Govs 52 boards were their best single-game mark since they recorded 54 rebounds against Brescia (12/6/14).

#### **DEFENSE TO OFFENSE**

The Governors are 7-0 this season when they score more points off turnovers than their opponent. The Govs forced 18 turnovers and converted those into 20 points last time out against UT Southern while holding the FireHawks to just 10 points off turnovers. Austin Peay has averaged 20.7 points off turnovers per game in its seven wins this season while averaging just 13.7 points off turnovers per game in the three contests it has lost.

#### FROM A LAND DOWN UNDER

According to "The Pick and Roll" -- an Australian basketball website -- Ella Sawyer is one of 137 Australians playing NCAA Division I Women's Basketball this season. Sawyer is the only Australian in the Ohio Valley Conference this year, but she squared off with five Aussies when the Govs played Davidson, Nov. 26, at the FAU Thanksgiving Tournament.

#### **FIRST-TIME FOES**

Austin Peay played six first-time opponents during its 2021-22 nonconference slate and played its final of five-straight games against first-time foes when it beat Gardner-Webb, 73-62, on Dec. 18. The Govs went 4-2 against first-time opponents, with wins against Pikeville, Bellarmine, UNC Asheville, and Gardner-Webb and losses to Davidson and Tulsa.

#### **GETTING ACQUAINTED**

Austin Peay is set to join the ASUN Conference on July 1, 2022. This season, the Governors are 2-0 against ASUN foes in nonconference action with wins against North Alabama, Nov. 16, and Bellarmine, Dec. 12, in the Winfield Dunn Center. The next time the Govs see the Lady Lions and Knights will be in ASUN play during the 2022-23 season.

#### **HOOPIN' IN HINKLE**

Austin Peay picked up its second win against Butler and its first-ever win in Hinkle Fieldhouse when it knocked off the Bulldogs, 68-65, on Nov. 20. The Governors trailed at the end of the first quarter but took a lead with 9:24 left in the second quarter which they would not relinquish for the rest of the contest.



#### **HEADED DOWNTOWN**

After 47 years in the Winfield Dunn Center, Austin Peay basketball will move to F&M Bank Arena in downtown Clarksville during the 2022-23 season. F&M Bank Arena is owned by Montgomery County and will be operated by Sabertooth Sports & Entertainment (SS&E). The new arena on the corner First Street and College Street will hold approximately 6,000 fans for concerts, 5,500 for basketball games, and 5,000 for hockey games.

#### **TOP-CALIBER TRANSFERS**

2019-20 First Team All-OVC selection Karle Pace and 2020-21 First Team All-OVC selection Yamia Johnson both transferred to Austin Peay following the arrival of Brittany Young. Pace ranked sixth in the OVC in scoring (15 ppg) during the 2019-20 season, and Johnson ranked fourth in the league in scoring (14.9 ppg) just a year ago.

#### PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Jacksonville State transfer Yamia Johnson was named a Preseason All-OVC selection for the 2021-22 season. Austin Peay was also picked to finish fifth in the league's preseason poll – which is voted on by the OVC's head coaches and sports information directors – that is the Govs best preseason position since a fourth-place selection prior to the 2019-20 season.

#### **BETTER ON OUR SIDE**

In eight career games against Austin Peay, Karle Pace averaged 10.8 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 3.1 assists per contest. The Clarksville native scored 19 points in both meetings with the Governors during her junior season and knocked down five three-pointers in the game played in the Dunn Center on Feb. 1, 2020. In a pair of games against the Govs during her junior season at Jacksonville State, Yamia Johnson averaged 17.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 2.5 made three-pointers per game.

#### **NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

A prep standout at Clarksville's Rossview High School, Karle Pace helped lead the Hawks to their first-ever Class 3A State Tournament as a freshman and wrapped up her prep career with a 101-29 mark overall and a 53-3 record in district play. After graduating from EIU and transferring to Austin Peay, Pace is the first Gov from Clarksville since Jemiah Harrison – also a Rossview product – during the 2017-18 season.

#### **KNOWLES KNOWS**

Maggie Knowles has made 153 three-pointers on 399 attempts in her career. Entering her senior year, Knowles is APSU's career three-point percentage leader, having shot 38.3 percent from three-point range in her first three seasons.

#### **POSTSEASON STREAK**

Dating back to 2015, Austin Peay has made seven-consecutive trips to the OVC Women's Basketball Tournament. The Govs current streak — which spans two head coaches — is the second-longest streak of consecutive post-season appearances in program history, trailing only an 11-year streak — which spanned three head coaches — from 1994 to 2004.

#### **ASUN RISES**

On July 1, 2022, Austin Peay will become the 13th member of the ASUN Conference. The Governors women's basketball team has spent 44 years in the Ohio Valley Conference, where it has won three regular-season titles, seven tournament championships, and had three players named the OVC Player of the Year. This season, the Govs are set to take on future ASUN foes North Alabama, Nov. 16, and Bellarmine, Dec. 12, in nonconference action.

#### **UT SOUTHERN RECAP**

CLARKSVILLE - For the fourth-straight game, Austin Peay State University women's basketball team never trailed, as the Governors put together one of the best defensive performances in program history and held UT Southern to just 35 points - the second-fewest points allowed in the modern era of program history - in a 74-35 win, Tuesday, in the Winfield Dunn Center.

Austin Peay (7-3) had three players score in doublefigures, with Yamia Johnson and Karle Pace leading with way with 17 and 15 points, respectively. Lyric Cole was the third Gov in double-figures, the freshman from Memphis posted her second-career double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds.

The Govs got on the scoreboard first for the fourthstraight game, taking a lead that UT Southern would not match or take at any point in the contest when Pace drilled a three-pointer at the 8:56 mark in the opening quarter. Coming off the bench, Johnson got the next bucket for the Governors, knocking down her first of a season-high four three-pointers to push the lead to 6-0 with 7:21 left in the quarter.

After a pair of Taylor McNairy free throws got the FireHawks on the scoreboard, Johnson connected on her second-straight three-pointer from the same corner of the court to put the Govs ahead, 9-2, with 5:41 left in the first quarter. Austin Peay's early three-point barrage continued following UT Southern's first field goal of the contest, with Pace burying her second triple to push the lead to 12-4 with 4:12 left on the clock.

After converting a layup to stretch the lead to 10 points for the first time, Johnson hit her third triple of the day - from the same corner of the court - to give the Governors a 17-6 lead with just under three minutes remaining in the quarter.

With the lead at 11 points and 34 seconds remaining in the opening quarter, freshman Kaiden Glenn knocked down the first three-pointer of her Austin Peay career to stretch the lead to 22-8. but UT Southern's Takiyah Goff scored two of her team-high 12 points at the buzzer to cut the lead to 22-10 after ten minutes of basketball.

To start the second quarter, Austin Peay went on a 19-0 run that spanned 8:19 seconds. Pace scored the first four points of the run before Cole scored her first points of the game to push the lead to 28-10 with 8:11 left before halftime.

Leading by 19 points, Liz Gibbs pushed the lead above 20 points for the first time in the game when she scored four-straight points to give the Governors a 33-10 advantage at the 5:16 mark in the second quarter. Johnson followed Gibbs' four points with her fourth three-pointer of the day before another Gibbs' layup stretched the lead to 28 points with 3:50 left in the half.

Freshman Lamiah Walker capped off the 19-0 run by giving Austin Peay its first 30-point lead of the day, knocking down a jumper to make the score 41-10 with 2:00 left before the half. UT Southern was able to get on the board and halt the run with a pair of free throws before Keonna Chumbley connected on the FireHawk's only field goal of the quarter with 1:26 left on the clock, but Cole closed the opening half with a second-chance layup and the Governors led 43-14 at halftime.

After UT Southern opened the second quarter on a 4-0 run, a Kasey Kidwell three-pointer and a fast-break layup for Pace put the Govs back ahead by 30 points, 48-18, with 8:17 left in the quarter. The Firehawks had their best offensive quarter in the third quarter, but the Governors still held UT Southern to just 13 points in the frame and led 61-27 at the start of the fourth quarter.

Austin Peay built its biggest lead of the afternoon in the fourth quarter, with Pace knocking down another triple to stretch the advantage to 37 points before a Johnson free throw and layup put the Govs ahead by 40 points, 69-29, for the first time with 6:56 left to play.

After a UT Southern basket, Glenn pushed the advantage back to 40 points before Walker gave Austin Peay a 41-point advantage - its biggest lead of the day - when she knocked down a free throw with 5:08 on the clock. The Govs scored just once more in the contest, with Cole converting a layup to push the lead back to 41 points, 74-33, with 1:13 remaining, but UT Southern scored the final points of the contest and Austin Peay cruised to a 39-point victory and extended its winning streak to four games.

# BRITTANY YOUNG

Position: Head Coach • Alma Mater: Francis Marion, 2008

**Experience: 1st Season at Austin Peay** 

Austin Peay State University Director of Athletics Gerald Harrison has again turned to a young coach who has risen through the ranks and gained a reputation as a diligent recruiter to lead one of the department's flagship programs. The APSU athletics department introduced Brittany Young as the 12th head women's basketball coach in program history on March 17, 2021, in the Winfield Dunn Center.

Young takes over the Austin Peay women's basketball program after a season as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mississippi State. In her season with the Bulldogs, she helped sign KN'isha Godfrey, a four-star rated recruit by espnW and the No. 8 point guard in the country to aid the program's rebuilding process.

When former Mississippi State head coach Nikki McCray-Penson moved to Starkville after three seasons at Old Dominion, Young joined her. The pair led a successful three-season turn at Old Dominion where they helped the program reach its first postseason appearance since 2015 amidst back-to-back 20-win campaigns.

In Young's second year in Norfolk, Old Dominion boasted the seventh-youngest roster in the country after signing nine athletes during their first season. Despite the youth movement, the Monarchs posted a 13-win improvement from an 8-23 season to a 21-11 record in 2018-19. That 12½-game improvement was sixth-best among Division I teams and ODU qualified for the Postseason WNIT. Ajah Wayne, a member of a nine-player recruiting class, was named to both the Conference USA All-Freshman Team and All-Defensive Team.

The following season, ODU rolled to a 24-6 record and finished second in Conference USA. The Monarchs were a potential at-large team (ranked No. 33 in RPI) before the Conference USA and NCAA Tournaments were canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Three ODU athletes earned All-Conference USA honors and guard Aziah Hudson was named the league's Sixth Player of the Year.

Before joining McCray-Penson the past four seasons, Young spent two seasons as assistant coach at Stetson. She helped the Hatters back-to-back 20-win campaigns: a 20-12 mark in 2015-16 and a 26-7 record in 2016-17 that included a 13-1 conference record to win the Atlantic Sun regular-season title. Stetson qualified for national postseason play each season, participating in the 2016 Women's Basketball Invitational and the 2017 Postseason WNIT.

Young's first full-time coaching position was at Daytona State College (2013-15). She was the program's recruiting coordinator, director of player development, director of operations, academic coordinator, and strength and conditioning liaison. The Falcons improved from 11-17 in 2013-14 to 23-8 in 2014-15, winning a share of the Mid-Florida Conference title.

Young, a Moncks Corner, South Carolina native, was a CoSIDA Academic All-District and all-conference performer at Francis Marion University. She was a member of the school's all-decade team and earned team "Most Valuable Player" honors twice.

In addition to her success on the court, Young was President of the Student Athletic Advisory Council and was just one of 26 recipients of the NCAA Ethnic Minority and Women's Enhancement Postgraduate Scholarship for Careers in Athletics in 2011. She graduated from Francis Marion in 2008 with a degree in Political Science.

Following her playing career, Young was a graduate assistant at South Carolina under Dawn Staley. During her two seasons at South Carolina (2011-13), the nationally-ranked Gamecocks twice earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament. She obtained her master's degree in Sport and Entertainment Management from South Carolina in 2013.

#### **GOVS SET TO JOIN ASUN BEGINNING JULY 2022**

CLARKSVILLE—Austin Peay State University, in a move ratified by its Board of Trustees, announced an official move to the ASUN Conference beginning with the 2022-23 athletics season, with the conference quickly accepting the Governors as its full 13th member.

The Governors move to the ASUN after being members of the Ohio Valley Conference since 1962, during which time Austin Peay won 69 league titles—including 21 since 2010. All 17 of Austin Peay's intercollegiate athletic programs will move to the ASUN and upon joining the league will be immediately eligible for conference awards, postseason play and NCAA Tournament automatic berths.

Now the Govs are on the move, into an ASUN committed to becoming the next great FCS football conference. Beginning in Fall 2022, the Govs will be joined by football-playing members Central Arkansas, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Kennesaw State and North Alabama—cementing the league with the necessary six members to guarantee an automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. In addition to the football-playing members of the league, the Govs will regularly meet Bellarmine, Florida Gulf Coast, Jacksonville, Liberty, Lipscomb, North Florida and Stetson in league competition.

"I am excited to take this next step for the university and our athletics department," said Austin Peay President Dr. Michael Licari. "The ASUN Conference will help us showcase all of the great things we're doing athletically and academically. The ASUN will put us in new markets that will boost our recruiting ability and allow us to better engage our passionate alumni base. This is a move to position our University well both now and in the future."

During its last full year of competition (2018-19), the ASUN enjoyed its most successful postseason with 19 postseason wins. In addition, ASUN student-athletes have excelled academically. More than 70 percent of ASUN student-athletes earned a year-long 3.0 GPA each of the past three years. Those levels of success align perfectly with Austin Peay Director of Athletics Gerald Harrison's belief in the Total Gov Concept.

"This is an incredible day for our University, our athletes and coaches, and all citizens of Stacheville," Harrison said. "I could not be more excited to help lead Austin Peay into a new era of growth, which will help expand and enhance our brand, our footprint and the quality of our product both athletically and academically. As challenging as this opportunity is—and make no mistake, we are facing a step up in competition level—it's even more exciting to embark on this journey to elevate the profile of this department.

"From the beginning, I've said Austin Peay is a sleeping giant, a juggernaut hiding in plain sight with the right people in place to become great. Today is the next step down the path to greatness, and we are closer than ever to achieving the status we covet—to be the most complete athletics department in our league. And now, that league will be the ASUN."

The ASUN will be in its 44th season when Austin Peay begins play in Fall 2022. The ASUN is now the 15th NCAA Division I conference to sponsor FCS football. The addition of football brought the total number of ASUN sponsored sports to 20.

This move will exponentially increase Austin Peay's market share. There are more than 10,000,000 television homes within the ASUN's seven-state footprint, with member institutions nestled inside seven of the area's top-10 regional TV markets. Additionally, states within the ASUN footprint have experienced tremendous population growth in recent years, at a growth rate of more than five percent over the last decade.

According to a recent study, there are more than 45,000 Austin Peay alumni living in and around the current ASUN footprint, furthering Austin Peay's ambitions to regularly and consistently visit those markets, the majority of which comprise major metropolitan areas around the southeastern United States, to connect with Governors past and future living in these locales.

"Austin Peay brings a tradition of success and a recognized brand that speaks to overall institutional achievement," ASUN Commissioner Ted Gumbart said. "The entire Clarksville area is growing and APSU is central to that dynamic. The Governors carry an institutional reputation of academic and athletic success that we are extremely proud to add to the ASUN. President Licari and Director of Athletics Harrison provide outstanding leadership to the university and its athletics program, and we value their vision for Austin Peay's continued growth and success. The ASUN will provide a tremendous home for Austin Peay, and our entire membership will benefit from having APSU as an ASUN member. This is a perfect example of a win-win partnership."

Austin Peay will officially complete the move to the ASUN on July 1, 2022.
