SERIES HISTORIES

ST. JOHN'S: First Meeting

NOTABLY: Austin Peay has not played any of the members of the Big East since it reformed in 2013. However, they are 5-15 against the league's current membership.

WESTERN KENTUCKY: 48th meeting, WKU leads 32-15

SERIES STREAK: WKU, 1 win

LAST MEETING: WKU def. APSU, 3-0 (9/24/2019). The Gobs had few answers for the WKU duo of Paige Briggs (11-0-17) and Lauren Matthews (11-1-18), which led WKU to 45 kills and a .400 attack percentage. APSU's Tegan Seyring led the Gobs with seven kills.

NOTABLY: Western Kentucky has dominated the series since 1988, winning 15 of the 16 matches played. The Gobs famously won a five-set decision in Clarksville in October 2018, their first win the series since 1997. The Gobs are 5-21 against WKU in matches played at Bowling Green, last winning there during the 1996 season.

OHIO: 2nd meeting, Ohio leads 1-0

SERIES STREAK: Ohio, 1 win

LAST MEETING: OU def. APSU, 3-0 (8/28/2015). Austin Peay opened the 2015 season against Ohio. Ashley Slay's seven kills led an APSU offense held to a .032 attack percentage. Jaime Kosiorek posted 14 kills to lead Ohio, which won with a .190 attack percentage and 11 blocks.

NOTABLY: Ohio will be the third Mid-American Conference foe the Gobs have faced this season. They defeated Miami-Ohio in five sets during the opening weekend before dropping a three-set decision to Western Michigan last weekend in Terre Haute.

FROM THE SERVE

Austin Peay's volleyball team closes its pre-Ohio Valley Conference slate when it competes in the WKU Invitational, Friday-Saturday, at E.A. Diddle Arena.

The Gobs open the event with tough Friday matches against a hot St. John's squad at 10:30 a.m. before facing host and nationally-ranked Western Kentucky in the 6:30 p.m. nightcap. Austin Peay then faces Ohio in a 3:30 p.m. contest to conclude its stay.

APSU head coach Taylor Mott is beginning to hone in on a steady group of contributors after the season's first three weeks with six Gobs seeing action in all 12 sets last weekend: right side Tegan Seyring, right side Mikayla Powell, outside hitter Brooke Moore, middle blocker Maggie Keenan, setter Caroline Waite and libero Jessica Lary. In addition, defensive specialist Erin Eisenhart and setter Kelsey Mead were active in 11 sets.

The Gobs return to action this weekend after seeing their front-row defense put together an impressive weekend at Indiana State, recording 32 blocks (2.67 per set). Keenan led the effort with 17 blocks while Powell added 10 blocks. Seyring (7), middle blocker Jaida Clark (8), and Moore (5) also had a helping hand, or two, in the mix.

Following this weekend's action, Austin Peay prepares for its home-opening and OVC-opening weekend. The Gobs host defending champion Morehead State in a two-match series, Friday-Saturday, at the Dunn Center.

FIRST SWINGS

- Outside hitter **Brooke Moore**, a Preseason All-OVC selection, is one of only eight Gobs players to record both 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs during their career. She enters the weekend with 1,292 kills (5th all-time) and 1,333 digs (13th).
- Moore, who was an all-tournament selection at Marshall and Harvard, posted 29 kills (2.41/set) and 32 digs (2.67/set) at Indiana State. Her 15 kills and 13 digs against host Indiana State was her fifth double-double this season.
- Right-side hitter **Mikayla Powell**, the 2020-21 NJCAA Division II National Player of the Year, earned all-tournament honors at the Indiana State Invitational, last weekend, finishing the weekend with a season-high 18 kills and .417 attack percentage against host Indiana State.
- Right-side hitter **Tegan Seyring** posted back-to-back double digit kill outings last weekend, scoring 13 kills against IUPUI and 15 kills against host Indiana State. She averaged 2.92 kills and hit at a .238 clip during the weekend.
- The Gobs setter tandem of **Caroline Waite** and **Kelsey Mead** are in their second year combining to quarterback the Gobs offense. Mead is averaging 4.62 assists and 1.59 digs per set with nine aces. Waite has averaged 5.30 assists and 2.36 digs per set over the opening three weeks.
- Middle blocker **Maggie Keenan** has recorded five or more blocks five times this season, including a streak of four straight matches that ended with a four-block effort at Indiana State. She has a team-best 35 blocks (1.35/set) this season.
- Libero **Jessica Lary** took over at libero during the Gobs weekend at Harvard. In her five sets as the starting libero, she has averaged 4.72 digs per set
- Outside hitter **Marlayna Bullington** joins the indoor squad this season after claiming OVC Beach Freshman of the Year honors last season while helping the Gobs win the inaugural OVC beach volleyball title.
- Outside hitter **Jaida Clark** broke out with her first double-digit kill outing of the season, scoring 12 kills against Indiana State, last Saturday.

2021 VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2021 Ohio Valley Conference Volleyball Championship will be held at the site of the 2021 OVC regular-season champion, Nov. 18-22. The top eight teams in the regular-season standings will comprise the tournament field. The tournament champion will earn the conference's automatic bid to the 2020 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship.

Austin Peay has claimed three OVC tournament titles, winning the 1991, 2010 and 2017 editions of the event.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- In addition to her work with the Govs, Mott was named to the NCAA Women's Beach Volleyball Committee in March 2021. She also serves as a member of the NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball South Region Advisory Committee.
- In 2017, Mott was first Austin Peay coach to win the Ohio Valley Conference's Coach of the Year award since 1992. She claimed her second-straight OVC Coach of the Year award in 2018, becoming the second Govs coach to accomplish that feat, joining OVC and APSU Hall of Famer Cheryl Holt.
- Her 2017 and 2018 teams became the first in program history to win back-to-back OVC regular-season titles.
- She has also led APSU to three consecutive 20-win seasons (2016-18) for only the third time in program history.
- Led Austin Peay to program-record 30 victories in 2017, including a record 27 regular-season wins, both breaking records set in 1992.
- Her 2017 squad was the first Austin Peay team to win both the regular-season and tournament championships in the same season.
- Her 2016 squad was one of Division I's most improved teams, posting a 12½-game improvement from 2016, finishing with a 24-11 record and jumping to third in the OVC race with a 12-4 record.
- In the past three seasons (2016-18) Austin Peay has posted more victories than any other Division I program in the state of Tennessee.
- Guided the 2013 and 2014 teams to the OVC tournament despite injuries dominating the storyline each season. Her 2013 team was hurt by a spate of injuries in the nonconference slate while the 2014 team saw just three athletes record more than 100 sets played.
- In her first season at Austin Peay (2012), Mott led the Govs to a four-game improvement over the previous season. After opening the campaign with a 2-8 record, the Governors won 17 of their final 24 during the regular season.
- Began coaching career and spent 13 seasons at Division II Flagler (1999-2011) where she posted a 304-158 career mark, including 11 consecutive 20-win seasons and led the Saints to two NCAA Division II Elite Eight appearances.
