OPENING TIP

- With two weeks left in the regular season, the OVC Tournament field is set and Austin Peay has already guaranteed that it can be no worse than the No. 7 seed at the conference tournament in Evansville.
- APSU has secured its third-straight winning season and its fifth-straight season without a losing record.
- Austin Peay is 20-22 all-time against the Skyhawks in Martin, Tennessee, and is looking to snap a 12-game losing streak at UT Martin and win its first game in the Elam Center since a 71-55 victory on Jan. 8, 2009.
- Austin Peay is 4-7 all-time on Valentine's Day and beat Morehead State, 84-75, the last time it played on Valentine's Day in 2019.
- Austin Peay is shooting 46.2 percent from the floor -which ranks ninth in the NCAA and second in the OVC. The Govs have not shot over 45 percent from the floor in a season since the 2002-03 team set the singleseason program record by shooting 47.4 percent.
- Austin Peay ranks third in the OVC in scoring defense (58.3 ppg), third in field-goal percentage defense (.384), and second in three-point percentage defense (.284) -- the Govs are the only team in the league that ranks in the top three in all three statistics.
- For the first time in program history, Austin Peay has held back-to-back opponents under 40 points, with Southeast Missouri and Tennessee State scoring 38 and 37 points, respectively, in its last two contests.
- The Govs are shooting 36.7 percent from three-point range, which ranks 16th in the NCAA and leads the OVC, and are averaging 6.1 made three-pointers per game, which ranks second in the OVC.
- Karle Pace and Yamia Johnson are averaging 15.6 and 15.5 points per game, respectively, and rank second and fourth in the OVC in scoring. They are the only teammates in the top five in the league in scoring.
- Pace is shooting 45.0 percent from three-point range. which ranks tenth in the NCAA and leads the OVC.

GAME PREVIEW

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

With its third-straight winning season and fifth-consecutive season without a losing record secured, Austin Peay will make its eighth-straight trip to the OVC Women's Basketball Championship. With two weeks left in the regular season, the field for the OVC Tournament is already set, with Belmont, Tennessee Tech, Austin Peay, Murray State, Eastern Illinois, UT Martin, Tennessee State, and SIUE headed to the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana, at the end of the season.

At 10-3 in the OVC, the Governors are a half-game behind second-place Tennessee Tech and are just a game-and-half behind league-leading Belmont. With five games left in the regular season, the Govs have guaranteed that they will be no worse than the No. 7 seed in the OVC Tournament. A win over UT Martin, Monday, would lock up at least the No. 5 seed for the Govs, making it impossible for UT Martin, Tennessee State, or SIUE to catch them in the standings.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

Coming off an OVC Regular Season Championship, UT Martin was picked to finish fourth in the 2021-22 OVC Preseason Poll. At 9-15 overall and 6-7 in conference play, the Skyhawks currently sit in sixth place in the OVC standings and have already secured their spot in the OVC Tournament.

This season, 13th-year head coach Kevin McMillan has had to replace his top-three scorers from a season ago, with Chelsey Perry (22.9 ppg) being drafted by the Indiana Fever in the 2021 WBNA Draft, Dasia Young (12.7 ppg) transferring to Utah, and Maddie Waldrop (10.1 ppg) graduating.

Junior guard Paige Pipkin has stepped up to lead the Skyhawks in scoring this season, averaging a team-high 13.1 points per game, which ranks ninth in the OVC. Pipkin also ranks eighth in the league in three-pointers made per game (1.5) and 14th in three-point percentage (.337).

In the OVC opener against Austin Peay, Pipkin scored a career-high 33 points, which is the best single-game scoring performance in the conference this season. Pipkin went 8-for-9 at the free-throw line against the Govs and is shooting 86.2 percent at the charity stripe this season, which ranks second in the OVC and 31st in the NCAA.

Freshman Shae Littleford is the Skyhawks' second-leading scorer, averaging 10.6 points per game, which ranks 22nd in the OVC. Robert Morris graduate transfer Holly Forbes is UT Martin's leading rebounder this season, averaging 5.8 rebounds, which ranks eighth in the OVC. Forbes also ranks 29th in the conference in scoring (9.1 ppg) and eighth in steals (1.8 spg).

UT Martin has three players that rank in the top four in the OVC in minutes played, with Littleford (35.1 mpg), Pipkin (33.8 mpg), and Kyannah Grant (33.8 mpg) ranking second, third, and fourth, respectively. Forbes also averaging 30.7 minutes per game, which ranks 14th in the OVC.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE SKYHAWKS

Austin Peay trailed by as many as 19 points in the fourth quarter and was able to cut the deficit to five with just over a minute remaining in the contest, but the Govs' comeback effort ran out of steam and they fell to UT Martin, 70-62, in the OVC opener on Dec. 30, 2021, in Clarksville.

Three Governors scored in double-figures, led by 14 points from Yamia Johnson. Kasey Kidwell and Shay-Lee Kirby added 12 and 11 points, respectively, with Kidwell recording a career-high four steals and a season-high four assists. Kirby also grabbed a career-high eight rebounds to lead Austin Peay on the glass. Nina De Leon Negron led the Govs with five assists in the contest.

Paige Pipkin scored a career-high 33 points to lift UT Martin to the win in the Dunn Center. Pipkin went 8-for-9 at the charity stripe and drilled a trio of three-pointers. Shae Littleford added 16 points for the Skyhawks and played all 40 minutes of the contest. Littleford also recorded four steals, four rebounds, and three assists in the game. Kyannah Grant led UT Martin with five assists.

GOVS NOTES

BRITTANY BEGINS

With a 17-6 record and five games left to play this season, Brittany Young has secured her place as the fifth head coach in Austin Peay women's basketball history to post a winning record in their debut season. Young is tied with Susie Gardner (1996-97) for the fourth-most wins by an Austin Peay head coach in their first season and her 10 OVC wins are the third-most in a first season. Andy Blackston won 23 games and 14 OVC games during his first season at the helm in 2003-04, those are the top marks for an Austin Peay head coach in their first year.

SAINT VALENTINE'S DAY HOOPS

Dating back to 1976, Austin Peay is 4-7 in games played on Valentine's Day. However, the Govs are 3-2 in their last five Valentine's Day games and picked up a win at Morehead State, 84-75, the last time they played on Feb. 14 in 2019. Austin Peay and UT Martin have met on Valentine's Day once before, with the Skyhawks winning 91-63 at the Elam Center in 2015.

POSTSEASON STREAK

With a spot in the 2022 OVC Basketball Championship already secured, Austin Peay is set to make its eighth-consecutive trip to the postseason. The Govs' streak of eight-straight trips to the OVC Tournament – which now spans three head coaches – is the second-longest streak of postseason appearances in program history, trailing only an 11-year streak – which spanned three head coaches – from 1994 to 2004.

ROUND II TO THE GOVS

Austin Peay is 4-0 this season when it plays teams for a second time. The Govs won their second games against Morehead State, Southeast Missouri, and Tennessee State to complete season sweeps and bounced back to beat Belmont after dropping the first meeting with the Bruins. With five games left, the Govs have three more chances to complete season sweeps and two chances to avenge earlier losses.

LAST TIME THROUGH THE LEAGUE

The 88th all-time meeting between Austin Peay and UT Martin is the final regular-season OVC contest between the in-state rivals. Monday's game will make the Skyhawks the team Austin Peay has played the second-most games against in program history – trailing the 94 games against Murray State and one game ahead of the 87 against Tennessee Tech. UT Martin owns a 43-44 edge in the series thanks to an eightgame winning streak that dates back to 2018.

THAT '70s SHOW

Austin Peay is 12-0 this season when it scores 70-or-more points in a contest. When the Govs score 70-plus points, they are holding their opponents to just 56.9 points per game. A 75-72 win against Eastern Illinois, Jan. 15, is the only time this season that a team has broken the 70-point mark in the same game as the Govs.



NO WAY TO FORTY

For the first time in program history, Austin Peay has held back-to-back opponents under 40 points, with Southeast Missouri and Tennessee State scoring 38 and 37 points, respectively. The Govs held SEMO and TSU to 13 made field goals each. Before last week, the last time the Govs held a Division I team to 13-or-less field goals or 37-or-less points was when they beat Tennessee State, 62-37, in Jan. 4, 2021 and limited the Lady Tigers to 12 made field goals.

GOVERNING EFFICIENCY

Austin Peay is shooting 46.2 percent from the floor this season, which ranks ninth in the NCAA and second in the OVC. The Govs are one of just 12 teams in the country that is shooting 46 percent or better from the field this season. An Austin Peay team has not shot over 45 percent from the floor since the 2002-03 team set the single-season program record at 47.4 percent.

DEFENDING THE DUNN

Austin Peay has won seven-straight home games and is 11-1 at the Winfield Dunn Center this season, with its only loss at home coming in the OVC opener against UT Martin. The Govs' 11 wins and .917 winning percentage on Dave Loos Court are both the top marks in the conference.

DEFENSE TO OFFENSE

The Govs are 13-1 this season when scoring more points off turnovers than their opponent. Austin Peay averages 18.8 points off turnovers per game in its 17 wins while averaging just 14.0 points off turnovers per game the six times it has lost. Playing against a Tennessee State team that ranked fourth in the NCAA in turnovers forced per game, the Govs won the turnover battle, 18-19, and outscored the Lady Tigers, 16-6, in points off of turnovers.

KARLE FROM CLARKSVILLE

With a team-high 12 points against Tennessee State, Feb. 12, Karle Pace has led the Govs in scoring in four-straight games and six of the last seven games. The Clarksville native is averaging 15.6 points per game this season and 16.7 points per game in conference play, both of which rank second in the OVC. Pace also leads the OVC – and ranks 10th in the NCAA – in three-point percentage (.450) and ranks third in threes made per game (2.1).

THE ADVENTURES OF ELLA SAWYER

Ella Sawyer ranks seventh in the OVC in assists (3.3 apg), eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.3), 13th in steals (1.5 spg), and 17th in rebounding (5.1 rpg). Sawyer recorded a team-high nine rebounds and four assists against Tennessee State, Feb. 12, she has grabbed at least three rebounds in 16-straight games and 21 of 23 games and has dished out at least three assists in 15 of 23 games this season.

JOHNSON JUST SCORES

Averaging 15.5 points per game, Yamia Johnson ranks fourth in the OVC in scoring and has scored in double-figures in a team-high 21 games this season. Johnson scored in double-figures in 16-straight games to start the season and was the first Gov to record double-digit points in 16-straight games since Tearra Banks did it in 21-straight games during the 2016-17 season.

LEARNING THE LYRIC

Freshman Lyric Cole ranks second in the OVC in field-goal percentage (.638) and seventh in rebounding (5.9 rpg) this season. The Memphis native led the Govs on the glass for the team-leading 11th time this season when she grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds — which is tied for the best single-game by a Gov this season — against Southeast Missouri, Feb. 10

THE LAW OFFICES OF JOHNSON & PACE

Karle Pace and Yamia Johnson scored 25 and 22 points, respectively, against Belmont, Jan. 27, and became the first APSU duo to post 20 points in the same game since Maggie Knowles and Brianah Ferby against EKU (1/2/21). Averaging 15.6 and 15.5 points per game, Pace and Johnson rank second and fourth, respectively, in the OVC in scoring and are the only teammates that rank in the top five in the league.

GOVS NOTES

PAINT PRESENCE

Austin Peay is a 13-1 this season when it scores more points in the paint than its opponent. The Govs scored just 24 points in the paint last time out but held Tennessee State to just 16 points in the paint. The Govs have scored 30-plus points in the paint 13 times this season and are outscoring opponents by an average of 8.5 points, 33.5-25.0, in the paint per game.

D UP

Austin Peay has held three opponents under 40 points, five opponents under 50 points, and 10 opponents under 60 points this season – the 9-1 in those games, with their only loss coming at Tennessee Tech. Only two teams have been able to score 70-or-more points against an Austin Peay defense that ranks third in the OVC in scoring defense (58.3 ppg), third in field-goal percent defense (.384), and second in three-point percentage defense (.284).

LA ISLA DEL ENCANTO

Nina De Leon Negron leads the OVC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.9) and ranks fifth in assists (3.5 apg). The San Juan native has dished out at least three assists in 17 of Austin Peay's 23 games this season. She also recorded careerhighs with eight assists at UNC Asheville, Dec. 16, and five steals against North Alabama, Nov. 16 — both marks are tied for the best single-game total by a Governor this season.

MUCH IN THE CLUTCH

In the final two minutes of the fourth quarter, and all of overtime, when the score is within five points, Karle Pace and Yamia Johnson have combined to miss just two free throws this season. Pace is 14-for-15 at the free-throw line in these situations and Johnson is 11-for-12 this season. Johnson has also been good away from the charity stripe and is 6-for-8 from the field during the same situations.

BOOK IT!

D'Shara Booker recorded her second-career double-double with 14 points and a careerhigh 12 rebounds against Murray State, Feb. 3. Booker has scored in double-figures in five of Austin Peay's last nine games and is shooting 64.0 percent from the floor this season, which leads the OVC.

SLK FROM DOWNTOWN

Shay-Lee Kirby hit another three-pointer against Tennessee State, Feb. 12, and is now averaging 1.3 made three-pointers per game, which ranks 12th in the OVC. Kirby's 26 made threes this season are the third-most by a Gov and her 4-for-4 performance from three-point range at Southeast Missouri, Jan. 1, is tied for the second-best single-game three-point total by a Gov this season.



IT'S NOT WORTH WINNING IF YOU CANT WIN BIG

Austin Peay scored a season-high 79 points and held Southeast Missouri to just 38 points – the second-fewest points it has allowed against a Division I opponent this season – in a 41-point rout, Feb. 10, in the Dunn Center. The Governors' 41-point margin of victory is the second-largest in an Ohio Valley Conference game in program history, trailing only a 48-point, 93-45, win against Tennessee State on Feb. 15, 2003, in the Winfield Dunn Center.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

Austin Peay posted its best rebounding margin of the season when it outrebounded Southeast Missouri, 49-24, on Feb. 10 in the Dunn Center. The Governors' +25 rebounding margin against Southeast Missouri was their best single-game mark since recording a +26 rebounding margin and outrebounding Mississippi Valley State, 51-25, on Nov. 19, 2018, in Clarksville.

DON'T NEED DIRECTIONS

Austin Peay is 6-0 this season against schools with a direction in their name. The Govs have beat North Alabama, UT Southern, Eastern Illinois, Southern Illinois Edwardsville, and Southeast Missouri twice. The Govs will have two more opportunities to improve their record against directional schools when they play SIUE and Eastern Illinois to wrap up the season.

SETTING THE PACE

Karle Pace was named OVC Player of the Week for the second time this season and the third time in her career after averaging 22 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 4.0 assists per game while shooting 48.4 percent from the floor and 80 percent from three-point range in wins against Murray State and Morehead State. The Clarksville native scored 23 points and was 5-for-5 from three against the Racers, she also hit a game-winning floater with 1.2 seconds left in OT.

TWO TIMES TWO

With two OVC Player of the Week awards each, Karle Pace and Yamia Johnson are the first duo in Austin Peay history to earn multiple player of the week honors in the same season. The 2001-02 and 2002-03 teams each had three players earn player of the week, but Gerlonda Hardin was the only player to earn the award multiple times during both of those seasons.

YAMIA DOUBLES UP AGAIN

Yamia Johnson recorded her second double-double of the season and the fifth of her collegiate career when she scored 17 points and grabbed a season-high 12 rebounds at Morehead State, Feb. 5. Johnson is the second Govto post multiple double-doubles this season, joining Lyric Cole, who has two already.

GOT THE HORSES IN THE BACK

Austin Peay beat Murray State, 69-67, in overtime to pick up its fifth-straight win in the series and improve to 7-1 against the Racers since the start of 2019. The Govs have also won sevenstraight home games against the Racers and are 33-15 all-time against Murray State in the Dunn Center. The five-game winning streak in the series is Austin Peay's longest streak against Murray State since winning eight-straight games from March 6, 2009 to Feb. 13, 2012.

MY OLD KENTUCKY WINNING STREAK

Austin Peay is on a 13-game winning streak against teams from the state of Kentucky. During the streak, which dates back to 2019, the Govs have won five games against Murray State, three games against Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State, and one game against Pikeville and Bellarmine.

PACE PERFECT

Karle Pace was a perfect 5-for-5 from three-point range against Murray State. Pace's five threes are the best single-game mark by a Governor this season and her 100-percent performance is tied for the best single-game three-point percentage in the OVC this season.

GOVS NOTES

RED OUT FOR THE BRU[W]IN

For the first time since Jan. 15, 2015 – 2,570 days prior – Austin Peay beat Belmont, 70-68, during a Red Out game in the Dunn Center. The victory against the Bruins snapped a ninegame, seven-year losing streak and gave the Governors just their second win over Belmont since they joined the OVC in 2013. The win against Belmont was played in front of Austin Peay's largest women's basketball crowd of the season, with 982 Governors fans in attendance.

AIM SMALL, MISS SMALL

Austin Peay shot 60.5 percent from the floor against Tennessee State, Jan. 22 – that is the fourth-best single-game field-goal percentage in program history and just the sixth time in program history a team has shot over 60 percent from the field in a game. The Govs also shot a season-best 72.7 percent from three-point range against TSU. Austin Peay's 60.5 field-goal percentage is the second-best single-game mark in the OVC this season and the 72.7 percent from three-point range is the best mark in the league this season.

26 FOR 24

Yamia Johnson's season-high 26 points against Eastern Illinois is the best single-game scoring performance by a Gov this season. The 26 points are also her best single-game total since she scored 29 points against Tennessee State (1/25/21) while playing for Jacksonville State and it is the best single-game total by a Gov since Brianah Ferby scored 26 points at North Alabama (11/25/20).

BETTER ON OUR SIDE

In eight career games against Austin Peay, while playing for Eastern Illinois, Karle Pace averaged 10.8 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 3.1 assists per contest. The Clarksville native scored 19 points in both meetings with the Governors during her junior season and knocked down five three-pointers in the game played in the Winfield Dunn Center on Feb. 1, 2020. In her first game playing against Eastern Illinois, Pace recorded 15 points, four rebounds, and three assists against her former team.

COLE'S BLOCK PARTY

Freshman Lyric Cole recorded a career-high four blocked shots at Southeast Missouri, Jan. 1. Cole's four-block outing is the best single-game performance by a Governor since Kelen Kenol blocked four shots at Evansville (12/2/17).

BACK-TO-BACK

Yamia Johnson was named the OVC Player of the Week on Dec. 21 and Dec. 28. Johnson is the first Gov to win multiple Player of the Week awards in the same season since Tearra Banks did it three times during the 2016-17 season. She is the first to win the award in back-to-back weeks since 2004, when Gerlonda Hardin was named Player of the Week on Feb. 2 and Feb. 9.



HEADED DOWNTOWN

After 47 years in the Winfield Dunn Center, Austin Peay basketball will move to F&M Bank Arena in downtown Clarksville during the 2022-23 season. F&M Bank Arena is owned by Montgomery County and will be operated by Sabertooth Sports & Entertainment (SS&E). The new arena on the corner of First Street and College Street will hold approximately 6,000 fans for concerts, 5,500 for basketball games, and 5,000 for hockey games.

COLE WORLD

Lyric Cole has been named the OVC Freshman of the Week two times, Dec. 14 and Dec. 28, this season. The Memphis native is the first Austin Peay freshman to be named the freshman of the week twice in the same season since Shay-Lee Kirby picked p the award twice, Nov. 12 and Dec. 30, during the 2019-20 campaign.

GIBBS GETS IT GOING

Liz Gibbs earned her first OVC Newcomer of the Week honors, Dec. 28, after scoring nine points and matching her season-high with three assists against UT Southern. Gibbs also posted career-highs with six rebounds and two steals against UT Southern, helping her become the first Gov to earn Newcomer of the Week honors since Tahanee Bennell on Dec. 23, 2019.

OVC SWEEP

For the first time since the OVC began handing out three weekly awards during the 1985-86 season, Austin Peay swept the honors with Yamia Johnson, Liz Gibbs, and Lyric Cole being named the OVC Player, Newcomer, and Freshman of the Week, respectively, on Dec. 28. The sweep also marks the first time the Govs have claimed multiple OVC weekly awards in a single week since Arielle Gonzalez-Varner and Shay-Lee Kirby were named Player and Freshman of the Week, respectively, on Dec. 30, 2019.

HISTORIC DEFENSE

Austin Peay held UT Southern to just 35 points – the second-fewest points allowed in the modern era of program history – in a 74-35 win over the FireHawks, Dec. 21. The 1976-77 Governors team holds the record for the fewest points allowed in a single game, having held Milligan to just 29 points in a 88-29 win on Dec. 15, 1976.

ROOKIE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman Lyric Cole's 14-point, 11-rebound performance against UT Southern, Dec. 21, is her second double-double of the season. Cole is the first Austin Peay freshman to record a double-double since Brianne Alexander at Jacksonville State (1/8/15) and was the first Gov to record multiple double-doubles in a single season since Arielle Gonzalez-Varner recorded five in 2019-20.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

A prep standout at Clarksville's Rossview High School, Karle Pace helped lead the Hawks to their first-ever Class 3A State Tournament as a freshman and wrapped up her prep career with a 101-29 mark overall and a 53-3 record in district play. After graduating from EIU and transferring to Austin Peay, Pace is the first Gov from Clarksville since Jemiah Harrison – also a Rossview product – during the 2017-18 season.

FROM A LAND DOWN UNDER

According to "The Pick and Roll" – an Australian basketball website – Ella Sawyer is one of 137 Australians playing NCAA Division I Women's Basketball this season. Sawyer is the only Australian in the Ohio Valley Conference this year, but she squared off with five Aussies when the Governors played Davidson, Nov. 26, at the FAU Thanksgiving Tournament.

ASUN RISES

On July 1, 2022, Austin Peay will become the 13th member of the ASUN Conference. The Governors women's basketball team has spent 44 years in the Ohio Valley Conference, where it has won three regular-season titles, seven tournament championships, and had three players named the OVC Player of the Year.

TENNESSEE STATE RECAP

NC44

CLARKSVILLE - Coming off one of the best defensive performances in program history, the Austin Peay State University women's basketball team was even better in the encore, holding Tennessee State to just 37 points - the fewest points the Governors have allowed against a Division I opponent this season - in a 57-37 Ohio Valley Conference victory, Saturday, in the Winfield Dunn Center.

Neither team was able to do much offensively early in the contest. Austin Peay (17-6, 10-3 OVC) was finally able to get on the scoreboard at the 7:22 mark when Ella Sawyer converted a layup for the first two of her 10 points. After the Sawyer basket, neither team was able to score again until the 4:33 mark when Tennessee State's Lacy Robbins went 1-for-2 at the free-throw line to get the Tigers on the board for the first time.

The scoring picked up in the quarter's final two minutes as Governors built an 8-5 lead when Sawyer found Lyric Cole for a layup with 45 seconds left on the clock. But Tennessee State (11-14, 6-8 OVC) was able to get the quarter's final points when Gia Adams knocked down a pair of free throws with 32 seconds remaining and Austin Peay led, 8-7, after 10 minutes.

The Govs opened the second quarter on a 5-0 run with a Kasey Kidwell layup and a Karle Pace threepointer stretching the lead to 13-7 with 7:30 on the clock. Trailing by six, the Tennessee State offense finally found a bit of a rhythm and went on a 6-1 burst to bring the score back within a single point, 14-13 with 5:07 left before the half.

After the teams traded baskets, Pace drilled backto-back threes to give the Govs their biggest lead of the first half, 22-15, with 1:26 left before the break. But the Pace triples were the Governors final points of the half as the Lady Tigers were able to trim the deficit to four points, 22-18, at the half.

After Tatyana Davis opened the second half with a layup for two of her team-high 11 points, Austin Peay went on a 12-0 run that spanned the game's next 7:14. The run started with a pair of Sawyer three-pointers and the Govs led, 28-20, at the 7:36 mark. After four-straight points from Cole, the Govs' advantage was 12 points with 5:09 left in the third. Yamia Johnson knocked down a pair of free throws to cap the run and stretch the Govs led, 34-20, with 2:27 left in the frame.

Tennessee State was able to get the deficit back to 12 points with less than a minute left in the third period, but a Liz Gibbs layup with 14 seconds on the clock gave the Governors a 14-point lead, 37-23, at the start of the fourth period.

After four-straight points to open the fourth quarter Austin Peay led by 18 points with 8:33 left in the game. Tennessee State responded with a 9-1 run that was capped by a Davis three-pointer, trimming the Austin Peay advantage to 44-32 with 6:12 left in the game. But that was as close as the Lady Tigers would get, as the Govs went on an 11-1 run that ended with four-straight points from Shay-Lee Kirby ad gave Austin Peay its biggest lead of the game, 55-33, with 1:50 left to play.

Tennessee State was able to convert some free throws down the stretch, but it was too little. too late as the Governors cruised to their fourth-straight OVC win and their seventh-straight win on Dave Loos Court.

Austin Peay State University Director of Athletics Gerald Harrison has again turned to a young coach who has risen through the ranks and gained a reputation as a diligent recruiter to lead one of the department's flagship programs. The APSU athletics department introduced Brittany Young as the 12th head women's basketball coach in program history on March 17, 2021, in the Winfield Dunn Center.

Young takes over the Austin Peay women's basketball program after a season as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mississippi State. In her season with the Bulldogs, she helped sign KN'isha Godfrey, a four-star rated recruit by espnW and the No. 8 point guard in the country to aid the program's rebuilding process.

When former Mississippi State head coach Nikki McCray-Penson moved to Starkville after three seasons at Old Dominion, Young joined her. The pair led a successful three-season turn at Old Dominion where they helped the program reach its first postseason appearance since 2015 amidst back-to-back 20-win campaigns.

In Young's second year in Norfolk, Old Dominion boasted the seventh-youngest roster in the country after signing nine athletes during their first season. Despite the youth movement, the Monarchs posted a 13-win improvement from an 8-23 season to a 21-11 record in 2018-19. That 12½-game improvement was sixth-best among Division I teams and ODU qualified for the Postseason WNIT. Ajah Wayne, a member of a nine-player recruiting class, was named to both the Conference USA All-Freshman Team and All-Defensive Team.

The following season, ODU rolled to a 24-6 record and finished second in Conference USA. The Monarchs were a potential at-large team (ranked No. 33 in RPI) before the Conference USA and NCAA Tournaments were canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Three ODU athletes earned All-Conference USA honors and guard Aziah Hudson was named the league's Sixth Player of the Year.

Before joining McCray-Penson the past four seasons, Young spent two seasons as assistant coach at Stetson. She helped the Hatters back-to-back 20-win campaigns: a 20-12 mark in 2015-16 and a 26-7 record in 2016-17 that included a 13-1 conference record to win the Atlantic Sun regular-season title. Stetson qualified for national postseason play each season, participating in the 2016 Women's Basketball Invitational and the 2017 Postseason WNIT.

Young's first full-time coaching position was at Daytona State College (2013-15). She was the program's recruiting coordinator, director of player development, director of operations, academic coordinator, and strength and conditioning liaison. The Falcons improved from 11-17 in 2013-14 to 23-8 in 2014-15, winning a share of the Mid-Florida Conference title.

Young, a Moncks Corner, South Carolina native, was a CoSIDA Academic All-District and all-conference performer at Francis Marion University. She was a member of the school's all-decade team and earned team "Most Valuable Player" honors twice.

In addition to her success on the court, Young was President of the Student Athletic Advisory Council and was just one of 26 recipients of the NCAA Ethnic Minority and Women's Enhancement Postgraduate Scholarship for Careers in Athletics in 2011. She graduated from Francis Marion in 2008 with a degree in Political Science.

Following her playing career, Young was a graduate assistant at South Carolina under Dawn Staley. During her two seasons at South Carolina (2011-13), the nationally-ranked Gamecocks twice earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament. She obtained her master's degree in Sport and Entertainment Management from South Carolina in 2013.

GOVS SET TO JOIN ASUN BEGINNING JULY 2022

CLARKSVILLE—Austin Peay State University, in a move ratified by its Board of Trustees, announced an official move to the ASUN Conference beginning with the 2022-23 athletics season, with the conference quickly accepting the Governors as its full 13th member.

The Governors move to the ASUN after being members of the Ohio Valley Conference since 1962, during which time Austin Peay won 69 league titles—including 21 since 2010. All 17 of Austin Peay's intercollegiate athletic programs will move to the ASUN and upon joining the league will be immediately eligible for conference awards, postseason play and NCAA Tournament automatic berths.

Now the Govs are on the move, into an ASUN committed to becoming the next great FCS football conference. Beginning in Fall 2022, the Govs will be joined by football-playing members Central Arkansas, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Kennesaw State and North Alabama—cementing the league with the necessary six members to guarantee an automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. In addition to the football-playing members of the league, the Govs will regularly meet Bellarmine, Florida Gulf Coast, Jacksonville, Liberty, Lipscomb, North Florida and Stetson in league competition.

"I am excited to take this next step for the university and our athletics department," said Austin Peay President Dr. Michael Licari. "The ASUN Conference will help us showcase all of the great things we're doing athletically and academically. The ASUN will put us in new markets that will boost our recruiting ability and allow us to better engage our passionate alumni base. This is a move to position our University well both now and in the future."

During its last full year of competition (2018-19), the ASUN enjoyed its most successful postseason with 19 postseason wins. In addition, ASUN student-athletes have excelled academically. More than 70 percent of ASUN student-athletes earned a year-long 3.0 GPA each of the past three years. Those levels of success align perfectly with Austin Peay Director of Athletics Gerald Harrison's belief in the Total Gov Concept.

"This is an incredible day for our University, our athletes and coaches, and all citizens of Stacheville," Harrison said. "I could not be more excited to help lead Austin Peay into a new era of growth, which will help expand and enhance our brand, our footprint and the quality of our product both athletically and academically. As challenging as this opportunity is—and make no mistake, we are facing a step up in competition level—it's even more exciting to embark on this journey to elevate the profile of this department.

"From the beginning, I've said Austin Peay is a sleeping giant, a juggernaut hiding in plain sight with the right people in place to become great. Today is the next step down the path to greatness, and we are closer than ever to achieving the status we covet—to be the most complete athletics department in our league. And now, that league will be the ASUN."

The ASUN will be in its 44th season when Austin Peay begins play in Fall 2022. The ASUN is now the 15th NCAA Division I conference to sponsor FCS football. The addition of football brought the total number of ASUN sponsored sports to 20.

This move will exponentially increase Austin Peay's market share. There are more than 10,000,000 television homes within the ASUN's seven-state footprint, with member institutions nestled inside seven of the area's top-10 regional TV markets. Additionally, states within the ASUN footprint have experienced tremendous population growth in recent years, at a growth rate of more than five percent over the last decade.

According to a recent study, there are more than 45,000 Austin Peay alumni living in and around the current ASUN footprint, furthering Austin Peay's ambitions to regularly and consistently visit those markets, the majority of which comprise major metropolitan areas around the southeastern United States, to connect with Governors past and future living in these locales.

"Austin Peay brings a tradition of success and a recognized brand that speaks to overall institutional achievement," ASUN Commissioner Ted Gumbart said. "The entire Clarksville area is growing and APSU is central to that dynamic. The Governors carry an institutional reputation of academic and athletic success that we are extremely proud to add to the ASUN. President Licari and Director of Athletics Harrison provide outstanding leadership to the university and its athletics program, and we value their vision for Austin Peay's continued growth and success. The ASUN will provide a tremendous home for Austin Peay, and our entire membership will benefit from having APSU as an ASUN member. This is a perfect example of a win-win partnership."

Austin Peay will officially complete the move to the ASUN on July 1, 2022.
